#### Quick Notes:

UIC wraps up a two-game Horizon League road trip through northeast Ohio this Saturday night against pre-season league favorite Cleveland State...The Flames seek to snap a three-game skid...UIC and Cleveland State split their two-game series last season, with each team winning at home...Saturday's game will feature four Preseason All-Horizon League players in UIC seniors Josh Mayo and Scott VanderMeer and Cleveland State seniors J'Nathan Bullock and Cedric Jackson...Mayo continues to lead the Horizon League in scoring at 19.5 ppg... VanderMeer is the league's top rebounder (9.1 rpg) and shot blocker (2.9 bpg)... Through four league games Mayo is averaging 20.5 ppg while VanderMeer is averaging 13.5 ppg and 10.3 rpg... Saturday's game is the second of six road games among the Flames' next eight contests... UIC has won five of its last six against the Vikings in Cleveland... The Flames have won just once in their last eight games in the state of Ohio.

**Viking Notes:**

Cleveland State has won two in a row and seven of its last eight heading into Saturday's contest against UIC. Senior forward J'Nathan Bullock scored 20 to lead the Vikings past Loyola, 76-50, at the Wolstein Center on Thursday. Cleveland State is still the only team to have defeated No. 11/9 Syracuse this season, as senior guard Cedric Jackson hit a three-quarter court heave that beat the buzzer and the Orange, 72-69, at the Carrier Dome on Dec. 15. Bullock leads the Vikings in scoring (15.2 ppg) and rebounding (6.8 rpg), while Jackson is the Horizon League's leading assist man (5.2 apg). Cleveland State qualified for the NIT last season, where the Vikings lost to Dayton, 66-57, on March 19, 2008 in Dayton, Ohio. Gary Waters is in his third season as Cleveland State's head coach, with a record of 43-39 guiding the Vikings.

**FLAMES VS. VIKINGS, THE SERIES:**

UIC is 32-29 all-time against Cleveland State, having won 10 of the last 13 meetings.

**LAST TIME WE MET:****UIC 74, Cleveland State 68 - Jan. 31, 2008 (UIC Pavilion)**

Josh Mayo scored a game-high 29 points as the UIC men's basketball team knocked off visiting Cleveland State, 74-68, at the UIC Pavilion. The Flames overcame a four-point halftime deficit by outscoring the Vikings 12-2 in the first six minutes of the second half. Mayo was 9-for-11 from the field and 4-for-5 from downtown. The junior guard became the 19th player in UIC history to score at least 1,000 points in a career after sitting on 998 points coming into the contest. Robert Bush pulled down a career-high 10 rebounds, while Scott VanderMeer added 14 points, six rebounds and five blocked shots. Joe Davis tallied 27 points to pace the Vikings. The Flames swatted away 11 Cleveland State shots, tying a Pavilion record for most blocked shots by one team.

**LAST TIME WE MET IN CLEVELAND:****Cleveland State 68, UIC 51 - Jan. 5, 2008 (Wolstein Center - Cleveland, Ohio)**

A rough shooting night hindered the UIC men's basketball team in a 68-51 loss at Cleveland State at the Wolstein Center. Robert Bush scored 12 points and Josh Mayo added 11 for UIC. Scott VanderMeer also blocked five shots for the Flames. J'Nathan Bullock scored a game-high 16 points for the host Vikings. The Flames would lead by as many as six early in the first half, but Cleveland State used a 13-2 run in the middle of the period to take a lead it would never relinquish. UIC shot 33.3 percent (10-for-30) in the first half. It didn't get better for the Flames in the second half, as UIC went just 6-for-26 (23.1 percent) from the floor in the game's final 20 minutes.

**MAYO AND VANDERMEER VERSUS CLEVELAND STATE:**

It should not be shocking that two of UIC's top performers in past meetings against Cleveland State are two of UIC's top players against almost every team. Seniors Josh Mayo and Scott VanderMeer have solid career numbers in a variety of categories in four career games apiece against the Vikings:

**Mayo:** 4 GM, 75 PTS (18.8 PPG), 21-for-38 FG (55.3%), 10-for-19 3PT FG (52.6%)

**VanderMeer:** 4 GM, 27 PTS (6.8 PPG), 22 REB (5.5 RPG), 22 BLK (5.5 BPG)

**WHAT'S NEXT:**

The Flames return home to host Valparaiso on Thursday, Jan. 15 at 7 p.m. inside the UIC Pavilion. UIC will then host 20th-ranked Butler on Saturday, Jan. 17 at 1 p.m. in a nationally-televised game on ESPN2.

**LAST TIME OUT:**

**Youngstown State 80, UIC 70 – Jan. 8, 2009 (Youngstown, Ohio)**

Josh Mayo scored 20 points and Scott VanderMeer pitched in his sixth double-double of the season, but the UIC men's basketball team was unable to overcome a hot offensive second half by host Youngstown State in the Flames' 80-70 loss at the Beeghly Center on Thursday night. UIC shot 50 percent (29-for-58) for the game, thanks mostly to an opening period in which the Flames shot 54.8 percent (17-for-31) to go up by as many as 13 points with less than two minutes left before halftime. But the Penguins closed the first half with six unanswered points to cut their deficit down to seven headed into the break, and then the hosts proceeded to shoot 55.6 percent (15-for-27) from the floor while converting 16 of their 18 attempts from the free throw line in the game's final 20 minutes to post the most points against the Flames in a half (49) and a game (80) thus far this season. Mayo tallied 15 of his 20 in the second half also assisted on five other buckets for the game. VanderMeer scored 11 and pulled down 10 rebounds for his sixth double-double of the year, matching his single-season career high in that category. Tori Boyd scored 10 points, while Rob Eppinger scored all 10 of his points off the bench in the first half on perfect 5-for-5 shooting from the field. Youngstown State made more free throws in the second half alone (16) than UIC attempted for the entire game (14). An inability to take advantage of their few charity stripe chances also came back to haunt the Flames, as UIC hit just seven from the line.

**CAN'T HOLD THE MAYO FROM SCORING:**

There is no doubt that senior guard Josh Mayo is the Flames' go-to guy, and his stats prove that he is living up to his billing as the Horizon League's Preseason Player of the Year. The Horizon League's top returning scorer after averaging 17.1 ppg as a junior, Mayo leads the league in scoring this season at 19.5 ppg. The Merrillville, Indiana-bred sharpshooter is averaging 20.5 ppg in four conference contests and has scored at least 18 points in each of his last three games. In UIC's marquee road victories over Vanderbilt and Georgia Tech, Mayo averaged 23.5 ppg and shot 60.0 percent (9-for-15) from three-point range.

**JOSH ON NAISMITH WATCH:**

In late December the Atlanta Tipoff Club unveiled the 2008-09 Naismith Trophy Early Season Watch List, and senior guard Josh Mayo was listed as one of 50 of the nation's finest players in the running for college basketball's most prestigious individual honor. Mayo joined reigning Naismith Trophy winner Tyler Hansbrough of North Carolina, Davidson's Stephen Curry and 47 other standouts from across the country on the list. The Naismith Trophy will be awarded for the 40th consecutive season during the 2009 NCAA Men's Final Four in Detroit.

**VANDERMEER DOES THE DOUBLE DIP:**

The art of the double-double has become a favorite activity of senior center Scott VanderMeer. Through 14 games the 7-foot pivot has six double-doubles, matching his career-high output in the category that was established last season. He has missed two other double-doubles this year by a mere rebound. VanderMeer, who now has 14 career double-doubles, is close to averaging a double-double with 13.2 ppg and 9.1 rpg in his season stat line.

**SCOTTY THE KING OF SWAT:**

After blocking five Youngstown State shots on Thursday, senior center Scott VanderMeer's Horizon League record for career blocked shots is now at 236 and counting. VanderMeer broke the career record with three blocks against Toledo on Dec. 23, surpassing the previous mark of 226 in less than three seasons. Not only does VanderMeer own the career record, but he also has the single-season (111 in 2006-07) and single-game (9 vs. Cleveland State on Jan. 27, 2007) league records for rejections. VanderMeer's career average for blocks per game in a UIC uniform is 3.0 bpg.

**EPPINGER MATCHES CAREER HIGHS IN A HALF:**

Junior forward Rob Eppinger had a half to remember against Youngstown State on Thursday, matching his career highs for points (10) and made field goals (5) in just nine first-period minutes against the Penguins. Eppinger was a perfect 5-for-5 from the field during the half.

**SPENCER CUTTING DOWN ON MISCUES:**

Junior guard Spencer Stewart has been more careful with the rock of late, with a 3-to-1 assist-to-turnover ratio in his last three games. In the Flames' last contest, Stewart dished out six helpers without committing a single turnover. It was his first game with no turnovers and at least six assists since a seven-assist, zero-turnover game against Loyola on Jan. 13, 2007. Stewart is averaging 4.7 assists per game, the second-best mark in the Horizon League.

**RARE OCCURANCES:**

- UIC shot 50 percent (29-for-58) from the field during Thursday's 80-70 loss at Youngstown State, the first time that the Flames have shot 50 percent or better from the floor and lost since a 92-87 defeat to the Penguins inside the very same Beeghly Center back on Feb. 3, 2007. UIC shot 50 percent (34-for-68) in that game as well.
- With Youngstown State finishing this past Thursday's game with a 44.8 percent (26-for-58) clip, it was also the first time UIC shot better than its opponent and lost since the season opener saw the Flames shot 35.1 percent (20-for-57) to Bradley's 32.6 percent (15-for-46) in a 67-61 loss to the Braves.
- Thursday marked the first time that UIC lost a game this season in which sophomore forward Tori Boyd scored in double figures. The Flames were previously 6-0 when Boyd tallied 10 points or better.
- The 80-70 loss to Youngstown State was the first game that UIC lost this season by a double-digit margin.

**MAYO CLIMBING THE SCORING CHARTS:**

Senior guard Josh Mayo continues to climb UIC's career scoring rankings. He is currently in eighth place on UIC's career scoring list with 1,480 points and needs just 58 points to move into a tie for seventh with former UIC great and NBA draftee Ivan Daniels (1,538 points from 1981-1985).

**BOYD BETTER OFF THE BENCH:**

Sophomore forward Tori Boyd has been the Flames' top sixth man this season, averaging a team-best 9.5 ppg as a reserve in 11 contests. In three starts, Boyd's average dips to 7.0 ppg. The most telling sign of Boyd's value off the bench: UIC is 0-3 when he starts and 8-3 when he's not in the starting lineup.

**WE NEED THAT EARLY-SEASON ROBO BACK:**

Sophomore guard Robo Kreps started off the season red-hot, averaging 14.0 ppg, shooting 49.2 percent (31-for-63) from the field and 44.4 percent (12-for-27) from three-point range in UIC's first six games. He scored nine or more points five times in those six games, including a pair of 20-plus point road performances. In eight games since his 23-point outing against Vanderbilt on Dec. 3, Kreps is only averaging 7.0 ppg while shooting just 30.4 percent (21-for-69) from the floor.

**JB JUST BETTER WHEN HE STARTS:**

Junior forward Jeremy Buttell has had better production when he's among the first five on the floor. In seven starts the Colleyville, Texas native is averaging 5.6 ppg and 5.4 rpg in 18.1 minutes per game, while he only averages 1.4 ppg, 2.7 rpg and 9.1 mpg in his seven games off the bench.

**DEFENSE WAS FUELING THE FLAMES:**

UIC's three-game skid can be traced back to defense. The Flames were allowing just 63.2 ppg in their first 11 games, while UIC's last three opponents are averaging nearly 10 points more (72.3 ppg). UIC had allowed 70-plus points just once (a win over UNI) during its 8-3 start; the Flames have allowed 70-plus points, including a season-high 80 to Youngstown State on Thursday, twice in the last three contests. UIC went from allowing 62.6 ppg in non-conference play to 71.5 ppg in Horizon League games.

**IS DOWNTOWN CLOSED?:**

The Flames' success from behind the three-point arc has dipped in the last three games compared to UIC's first 11 contests. UIC is shooting just 25.4 percent (15-for-59) from beyond the arc in its last three games, all losses, compared to the Flames' 36.5 percent (74-for-203) clip from downtown prior to that stretch. It has been a reversal for the Flames' foes; opponents were shooting just 27.6 percent (66-for-239) from three-point land in UIC's first 11 games, while the last three teams to face UIC have combined to shoot 38.8 percent (26-for-67) from that same distance.

**UIC INKS LOUIS GREEN IN EARLY SIGNING PERIOD:**

UIC head men's basketball coach Jimmy Collins announced on Nov. 12 that Louis Green (Hillside, Ill./St. Joseph H.S.) has signed a National Letter of Intent to play for the Flames beginning in the 2009-10 campaign. Green is a 6-foot-9, 240-pound center who plays for legendary head coach Gene Pingatore at St. Joseph High School in Westchester. A varsity starter since his sophomore season, Green was a teammate of current NCAA Division I student-athletes Demetri McCamey (Illinois) and Evan Turner (Ohio State) on the Chargers' 2007 IHSA Sectional championship squad. Green played this past summer with the Illinois Flames AAU team under coach Dedrick Shannon.

**THE POSTMAN DELIVERS QUICKLY:**

Freshman forward Jelani Poston made a big impact in little time against Green Bay on Jan. 3, scoring a career-high eight points and pulling down four rebounds in 10 late second-half minutes to spur UIC's rally attempt. Poston's energy and production off the bench helped UIC chip a 16-point deficit down to three. In three games in which he has played at least nine minutes (vs. DePaul, at Toledo, vs. Green Bay), Poston is averaging 5.3 ppg and 4.0 rpg in just 12.0 mpg while shooting 55.6 percent (5-for-9) from the floor and going to the line nine times (making six).

**LEAGUE LEADERS:**

There are plenty of Flames atop the Horizon League statistical leader board. Senior guard Josh Mayo continues to pace the conference in scoring at 19.5 ppg, while fellow senior Scott VanderMeer is the league's top rebounder (9.1 rpg) and shot-blocker (2.9 bpg). Mayo also leads the league in three-pointers made per game (3.2), and rates fourth in three-point field goal percentage (42%) while he is the league's second-best free throw shooter at 88 percent. Junior guard Spencer Stewart is second in the league in assists (4.7 apg) with Mayo ranking four spots behind in the category at 3.7 apg.

**FLAMES IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS:**

Seniors Josh Mayo and Scott VanderMeer are also ranked in the Top 50 of numerous national statistical categories, according to the latest NCAA rankings unveiled earlier this week. Mayo is 39th overall in scoring (19.5 ppg), 21st in three-pointers made (3.3), 34th in three-point field goal percentage (43.4), and 28th in free throw percentage (88.5). VanderMeer is 12th nationally in blocks (2.7 bpg) and 38th in rebounding (9.0 rpg). As a team the Flames are ranked 11th in free throw percentage (76.8).

**UIC HEAD COACH**  
**Jimmy Collins**  
**(202-177, 13th season)**

Head Coach Jimmy Collins is in his 13th season at the helm of the UIC men's basketball program. The veteran mentor is not only the winningest coach in school history with 202 career wins, but is also the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois and the Horizon League. He has captured a conference regular season title (1998) and two league tournament crowns (2002, 2004) during his tenure, and has guided the Flames to four 20-win seasons, including a school-record 24 victories in 2003-04.

Named co-conference coach of the year after his first season with the Flames, Collins has also guided UIC to its only three NCAA Tournament appearances in school history, taking the team to the Big Dance in 1998, 2002 and 2004. He also guided the Flames to their first-ever NIT bid in 2003.

Collins, who served as an assistant coach at Illinois for 13 years prior to his arrival at UIC, earned All-American honors as a player at New Mexico State, averaging 20.1 ppg while leading the Aggies to the Final Four during his senior season.

**JIMMY COLLINS FAST FACTS**

- \* Jimmy Collins was introduced as the ninth head coach in UIC history on March 27, 1996.
- \* Collins has propelled UIC to its first three NCAA Tournament bids (1998, 2002, 2004) and first NIT berth (2003) in school history.
- \* Collins has led UIC to four 20-win seasons in his 12 years on the sidelines: 22 (1997-98); 20 (2001-02); 21 (2002-03); 24 (2003-04).
- \* Collins is the program's all-time winningest coach with 202 career victories, the only coach in UIC history to have 200-plus wins.
- \* Collins has guided UIC to a league regular-season (1998) and two league tournament titles (2002, 2004) during his tenure.
- \* Collins is the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois and the longest tenured coach in the Horizon League.
- \* Collins was an assistant coach at the University of Illinois under Lou Henson for 13 years, including the 1989 season in which the Fighting Illini advanced to the Final Four.
- \* As Illinois' top recruiter, Collins' high-profile Illini signees included: Kendall Gill, Nick Anderson, Marcus Liberty, Deon Thomas, Kiwane Garris and Lowell Hamilton.
- \* Collins is the co-chairman of the Chicago Special Olympics.
- \* Collins and his family are heavily involved with the Lupus Foundation of America Illinois Chapter. His daughter, Erica, serves on the Board of Directors for the Illinois Chapter.
- \* Collins, as well as the rest of his 1970 New Mexico State Final Four squad, were inducted into the school's Hall of Fame on Feb. 7th, 2004.
- \* Collins is a former first-round draft pick of the Chicago Bulls (1970).
- \* Collins served as a hearing officer for the Cook County Probation Department prior to his appointment as an assistant coach at Illinois.
