Quick Notes:

UIC returns home to host Central Michigan at the UIC Pavilion this Saturday night... The Flames are in the midst of playing five of eight games at home, including three of the next five... Saturday's game against Central Michigan marks the third straight season that UIC will play the Chipewas... Last Saturday's 67-63 loss to DePaul at the Pavilion was just the Flames' third defeat in the last 18 home contests... Senior guard Josh Mayo, the reigning Horizon League Player of the Week, is averaging a league-leading 18.8 ppg... Mayo has scored in double figures in every game thus far... Fellow senior Scott VanderMeer is leading the league in both rebounding (7.8 rpg) and blocked shots (3.5 bpg)... Tuesday's win over Howard marked the first time this season that the Flames have used a starting lineup more than once this season... The starting lineup of Mayo, VanderMeer, Spencer Stewart, Robo Kreps and Rob Eppinger was the second straight game they have started together... UIC will hit the road next Wednesday to take on SEC foe Vanderbilt.

Chippewa Notes: Central Michigan moved to 2-2 on the young season after a 70-68 overtime victory over UIC's Horizon League mate, Wright State, on Nov. 22 in Mount Pleasant, Mich. The Chippewas overcame a four-point deficit with just under two minutes remaining in the extra session with three-pointers off the fingertips of Jeremy Allen and Robbie Harman, the latter serving as the game-winner with two seconds left. In addition to being Central Michigan's second Horizon League foe, UIC is also the Chippewas' second Chicago-based opponent; CMU lost at Chicago State, 84-74, on Nov. 20. 6-foot-8 center Chris Kellerman, a native of downstate O'Fallon, Ill., leads Central Michigan in scoring with 17.0 ppg and pulls down 6.5 rpg, which is second only to Jacolby Hardiman's 8.3 boards per contest. Ernie Ziegler, a former assistant to Ben Howland at UCLA, is in his third season as Central Michigan's head coach.

FLAMES VS. CHIPPEWAS, THE SERIES:

UIC trails the all-time series against Central Michigan, 3-2. The Flames have won the last two meetings, both coming in the last two seasons. UIC is 1-1 against Central Michigan at the Pavilion.

LAST TIME WE MET:

UIC 65, Central Michigan 52 – Nov. 28, 2007 (Rose Arena – Mount Pleasant, Mich.)

Scott VanderMeer's double-double and a big night for Jermaine Dailey highlighted a balanced attack for UIC in the Flames' 65-52 victory over Central Michigan at Rose Arena. VanderMeer finished with a game-high 16 points and a contest-leading 10 rebounds while swatting away three Chippewa shots. Dailey completed his night with 10 points, six rebounds and four blocked shots. UIC shot 58 percent (14-for-24) from the field in the first half to take an 11-point advantage into intermission. VanderMeer led the way with 10 points and six boards in the period. The Flames would build their advantage to as many as 17 in the second half, but Central Michigan would go on a 14-0 run to trim UIC's lead to three with less than eight minutes remaining. The momentum swung back into the Flames' favor with one athletic play. Giordan Watson went in for what seemed like an uncontested lay-in that would have cut the Central Michigan deficit to just one point, but the Chippewa guard was turned away when Dailey jumped into the lane for an emphatic block at the 7:05 mark. Dailey came back on the other end for a layup, and Tori Boyd hit a clutch three-pointer at the 5:37 mark to put the Flames up by eight. After turning away numerous Chippewa threats, UIC would finish the game on a 7-0 run.

LAST TIME WE MET AT THE PAVILION:

UIC 84, Central Michigan 62 – Feb. 17, 2007

Othys Jeffers scored a game-high 24 points, all in the second half, to pace UIC to a decisive 84-62 victory over Central Michigan at the UIC Pavilion as part of the 2007 O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters series. The Flames shot 59 percent (17-for-29) in the final 20 minutes of play to score 55 points in the second stanza, their best point total in a period that season. Jeffers, who also pulled down a game-best nine rebounds, was one of four Flames to score in double figures. Josh Mayo pitched in 16 points to go along with a game-high eight assists. Scott VanderMeer scored six while blocking five Chippewa shots. Jeffers was unstoppable in the final half, shooting 8-for-11 and going perfect at the charity stripe (8-for-8) to score all 24 of his points. The junior's second-half effort was the first time a UIC player scored 20 or more points in a period since Cedrick Banks accomplished the feat with 23 points in the first half against Wright State on Feb. 23, 2005. Holding on to a 44-37 lead with 13:21 left, the Flames went on 16-6 run in just over a four-minute span to take a double-digit command they would hold the rest of the way.

LAST TIME OUT:

UIC 68, Howard 54 – Nov. 25, 2008 (Burr Gymnasium – Washington, D.C.)

UIC broke open a close game with a decisive 28-9 run to start the second half in a 68-54 victory over host Howard at Burr Gymnasium on Tuesday night. Scott VanderMeer scored 13 points and pulled down 12 rebounds to register his 10th career double-double for the Flames. The senior center also blocked five shots. Robo Kreps also added 13 while Josh Mayo scored 12. The Bison shot 53.8 percent in the first half, led by Eugene Myatt's hot showing. Myatt made six of his nine first-half attempts, many of them off-balanced and contested, for 13 points in the opening 20 minutes to stake Howard to a four-point advantage at intermission. But the Flames came out fired up on both ends of the floor after the halftime break. UIC used a quick 7-0 run, capped by a Mayo three-pointer, to begin the session and retake the lead. Howard would cut the deficit down to one, but another Mayo trey helped the Flames rattle off 14 unanswered points to build a double-digit lead that proved to be insurmountable. Spencer Stewart (seven points, eight rebounds, six assists) highlighted the UIC outburst at the 8:40 mark with a no-look behind-the-back bounce pass to Kreps for an easy layup that pushed the Flames' advantage to 13. UIC would go up by as many as 16 before the evening was finished. The Flames' aggressive zone defense forced the Bison into a huge drop in their field goal shooting, as Howard made just 29.2 percent (7-for-24) from the floor after the break. Myatt only scored six more points on 2-for-6 shooting.

JIMMY VS. THE MAC:

UIC head coach Jimmy Collins is 15-11 all-time against schools that currently configure the Mid-American Conference, including 2-2 against Central Michigan.

FLAMES AT THE PAVILION UNDER COLLINS:

Since taking over the reigns in the 1996-97 season, head coach Jimmy Collins has seen plenty of good things at the UIC Pavilion. UIC is 117-47 at the Pav under Collins, with the Flames winning 10 of his 13 home openers.

THAT'S THE JOSH WE KNOW:

Josh Mayo scored 20-plus points for the 17th time in his career with a game-high 23 points against DePaul on Nov. 22 that followed a season-high 27 against UNI on Nov. 19. Mayo has led UIC in scoring 33 times during his career. He is currently in sole possession of 11th place on UIC's career scoring charts (1,282).

PAVILION A JOSH PIT:

In his fourth season at UIC, Josh Mayo has become very comfortable shooting on the Flames' home court. For his career Mayo is shooting 48.3 percent (196-for-406) from the floor and 46.7 percent (106-for-227) from downtown. With an increased scoring load on his shoulders last season, Mayo delivered at home by shooting 55.4 percent (93-for-168) from the field and 57.8 percent (52-for-90) from beyond the arc.

MAYO MAKES 'EM AT THE LINE:

Josh Mayo has started the 2008-09 season a perfect 18-for-18 at the free throw line. An 85.8 percent (297-for-346) career free throw shooter (a percentage that would rank as the best in school history), Mayo holds two of the longest streaks of consecutive free throws made in school history, including the school-best streak of 38 that he established last season. He also made 24 in a row, the fourth-best run of consecutive free throws made at UIC, last year.

TORI TAKES CHARGE AGAINST UNI:

After a short night plagued by foul trouble against Bradley on Nov. 14, Tori Boyd rebounded with the best game of his young career against UNI last Wednesday night. He scored a career-best 17 points thanks to a red-hot 4-for-5 evening from behind the three-point line. It was his best-ever output from downtown. Boyd also added a career-high seven rebounds to lead the Flames in that category.

ROBO SOLID:

Robo Kreps continued where he left off in 2007-08 when he scored a career-high 24 points in UIC's season opener at Bradley on Nov. 14. His effort against the Braves was the third straight game that he scored in double digits dating back to last season. The second-year guard has yet to commit a turnover this season to go with eight assists.

HERE COMES THE POST-MAN:

Highly-touted freshman forward Jelani Poston made his collegiate debut against UNI on Wednesday, playing just four minutes, but his workload increased times four against DePaul. Poston played 16 minutes, grabbed five rebounds and scored four points, including two on a nice dunk off a Spencer Stewart no-look feed. He also spent time guarding former prep teammate Mac Koshwal of the Blue Demons. The two played together at Chicago's Boys to Men Academy in 2006-07.

VANDERMEER DOES THE DOUBLE-DOUBLE AGAIN:

Senior center Scott VanderMeer opened 2008-09 with his ninth career double-double by scoring 15 points and taking down 11 boards against Bradley on Nov. 14. On Tuesday he turned in double-double No. 10 with 13 points and 12 rebounds against Howard.

DON'T HOLD THE MAYO:

Senior guard Josh Mayo proved he was more than able of taking the reigns as the Flames' go-to guy last season. The 5-foot-11 guard averaged 17.1 points per game, the second-best scoring average in the Horizon League in 2007-08. Mayo, a 2008 All-Horizon League First Team selection, scored in double-figures in all but two of the Flames' 33 contests last year, including nine 20-plus point performances and a pair of 30-plus point outbursts. He enters his final college season as the Horizon League's Preseason Player of the Year, a Preseason All-Horizon League First Team pick and a collegeinsider.com Preseason Mid-Major All-American. He is the first UIC player to have earned all three honors since Cedrick Banks pulled the same trifecta prior to 2004-05.

THE THREE WAS KEY:

One of the Flames' biggest weapons last season was the three-point shot. UIC shot 39.1 percent (237-for-606) as a team from downtown in 2007-08, led by Josh Mayo's 47.0 percent (94-for-200) shooting from beyond the arc. Mayo led the nation in three-point field goal percentage for six consecutive weeks before finishing the year seventh nationally in the category last season, while the Flames ranked 25th as a team in the final three-point percentage listing. In 18 wins last year the Flames shot 45.0 percent (141-for-313) from behind the three-point line, while UIC has posted a 32.8 (96-for-293) three-point field goal percentage in 15 defeats. Through three games in 2008-09, the Flames seem to have that same dependence on the three-point shot; in two losses UIC is shooting 18.6 percent (8-for-43) from downtown, while the Flames hit 62.5 percent (10-for-16) from three-point land in their victory over UNI on Nov. 19.

SCOTT THE KING OF SWAT:

7-foot senior center Scott VanderMeer has made his name turning away opponents' shots. VanderMeer already owns the single-season (111 in 2006-07) and career (210) blocks records at UIC in just over two seasons, getting to 210 blocked shots with five swats in each of the last two games, the first time he's had back-to-back five block games since accomplishing the feat against posting two consecutive five-swat outings on Nov. 17 and Nov. 19 against Charlotte and Wichita State, respectively. In two games in a UIC uniform against Central Michigan, VanderMeer has eight blocked shots, in addition to two blocks in two games against the Chippewas when he was a freshman at Bowling Green in 2004-05. He now stands just 17 blocks from establishing a new Horizon League career record.

2008-09 UIC FLAMES MEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

EPPINGER STOUT IN FIRST START:

Newcomer Rob Eppinger made a nice impression in front of the home fans against UNI on Nov. 19, scoring 10 points on 5-for-7 shooting during a 28-minute outing that was his first Division I start. He added nine points in 13 first-half minutes against Howard on Nov. 25.

ROBO A MACHINE:

Sophomore guard Robo Kreps had a rookie campaign to remember as a true freshman in 2007-08. Kreps appeared in all 33 games and averaged 8.1 points per game, the third-best scoring mark on the team last year. He shot 48.7 percent (92-for-189) from the floor and 46.2 percent (49-for-106) from behind the three-point line. Kreps' given first name is Robert, which is what he went by last year, but prefers to go by his life-long nickname Robo.

HOME COOKIN':

UIC took care of its home court last season, accumulating a sparkling 12-2 record at the UIC Pavilion that was the Flames' best home mark since a 13-1 record in 1997-98. The Flames shot 49.8 percent (381-for-765) as a team at home, including a team season clip of 47.7 (125-for-262) from downtown, while outscoring opponents by an average of 12.9 ppg.

JOSH AS MONEY AS BANKS:

Josh Mayo is the Flames' most prolific scorer since Cedrick Banks donned a UIC uniform from 2001-2005. Banks finished his career as UIC's all-time leading scorer with 2,097 points in four seasons. Here is how Merrillville native Mayo, who earned the same trifecta of accolades (league Preseason POY, Preseason All-League First Team, collegeinsider.com Mid-Major All-American) this preseason that Banks garnered prior to his senior season in 2004-05, stacks up to the former pride of Westinghouse High School after each played 95 games at UIC:

UIC HEAD COACH
Jimmy Collins
(196-173, 13th season)

Head Coach Jimmy Collins is in his 13th season at the helm of the UIC men's basketball program. The veteran mentor is not only the winningest coach in school history with 196 career wins, but is also the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois and the Horizon League. He has captured a conference regular season title (1998) and two league tournament crowns (2002, 2004) during his tenure, and has guided the Flames to four 20-win seasons, including a school-record 24 victories in 2003-04.

Named co-conference coach of the year after his first season with the Flames, Collins has also guided UIC to its only three NCAA Tournament appearances in school history, taking the team to the Big Dance in 1998, 2002 and 2004. He also guided the Flames to their first-ever NIT bid in 2003.

Collins, who served as an assistant coach at Illinois for 13 years prior to his arrival at UIC, earned All-American honors as a player at New Mexico State, averaging 20.1 ppg while leading the Aggies to the Final Four during his senior season.

JIMMY COLLINS FAST FACTS

- * Jimmy Collins was introduced as the ninth head coach in UIC history on March 27, 1996.
- * Collins has propelled UIC to its first three NCAA Tournament bids (1998, 2002, 2004) and first NIT berth (2003) in school history.
- * Collins has led UIC to four 20-win seasons in his 12 years on the sidelines: 22 (1997-98); 20 (2001-02); 21 (2002-03); 24 (2003-04).
- * Collins is the program's all-time winningest coach with 196 career victories.
- * Collins has guided UIC to a league regular-season (1998) and two league tournament titles (2002, 2004) during his tenure.
- * Collins is the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois and the longest tenured coach in the Horizon League.
- * Collins was an assistant coach at the University of Illinois under Lou Henson for 13 years, including the 1989 season in which the Fighting Illini advanced to the Final Four.
- * As Illinois' top recruiter, Collins' high-profile Illini signees included: Kendall Gill, Nick Anderson, Marcus Liberty, Deon Thomas, Kiwane Garris and Lowell Hamilton.
- * Collins is the co-chairman of the Chicago Special Olympics.
- * Collins and his family are heavily involved with the Lupus Foundation of America Illinois Chapter. His daughter, Erica, serves on the Board of Directors for the Illinois Chapter.
- * Collins, as well as the rest of his 1970 New Mexico State Final Four squad, were inducted into the school's Hall of Fame on Feb. 7th, 2004.
- * Collins is a former first-round draft pick of the Chicago Bulls (1970).
- * Collins served as a hearing officer for the Cook County Probation Department prior to his appointment as an assistant coach at Illinois.
