UIC heads on a two-game Horizon League trek through Ohio this weekend, beginning this Thursday night against Youngstown State inside the Beeghly Center...That game will be followed by a Saturday night clash against pre-season league favorite Cleveland State at the Wolstein Center...This weekend begins a grueling stretch of six of the next eight on the road for UIC...The Flames will seek to break a two-game losing streak and snap out of a funk of three losses in their last four games...UIC has lost its last two to the Penguins in Youngstown but has beaten Youngstown State in their last two meetings, both of which took place at the UIC Pavilion...After averaging 72.9 ppg in their first nine contests, the Flames are averaging just 63.0 ppg in their last four games...Senior guard Josh Mayo leads the league in scoring (19.5 ppg)...Senior center Scott VanderMeer is the league's leading rebounder (9.0 rpg) and shot-blocker (2.7 bpg)...Junior forward Jeremy Buttell is averaging 6.4 ppg and 5.6 rpg since making his first start of the season on Dec. 6.

Penguin Notes: Youngstown State has won three of its last five after beginning the season 1-7. This past Saturday the Penguins nearly had a victory over Wright State, one of the league's hottest teams with a six-game winning streak. Youngstown State had a 33-20 lead at intermission, but the Raiders rallied back. The Penguins trailed by one with 23 seconds left after a pair of successful free throws by Wright State's Todd Brown and had possession, but DeAndre Mays missed a jumper with 15 seconds left and a three-pointer as time expired. Kelvin Bright paces the Penguins in scoring at 14.2 ppg, while Sirlester Martin is the league's second-leading rebounder (7.5 rpg) behind UIC's Scott VanderMeer (9.0 rpg). Chicago native Vance Cooksey, who attended Marian Catholic, averages 5.3 ppg for Youngstown State. Jerry Slocum is 34-68 in his fourth year as YSU head coach.

FLAMES VS. PENGUINS, THE SERIES:

UIC is 18-2 all-time against Youngstown State. The Flames won 16 consecutive meetings against the Penguins to open the series before losing two straight, both at the Beeghly Center in the last two seasons. UIC enters Thursday's contest having won two straight over the Penguins, a regular-season victory at the UIC Pavilion and a 2008 Horizon League Championship opening round win in Chicago.

LAST TIME WE MET:**UIC 70, Youngstown State 59 - Mar. 4, 2008 (UIC Pavilion)**

The UIC men's basketball team rode a hot-shooting first half to build a lead it would never relinquish in a 70-59 victory over Youngstown State in the first round of the 2008 Horizon League Tournament at the UIC Pavilion. UIC shot 58.3 percent (14-for-24) from the field in the opening period, using a 10-0 run that took less than two minutes in the early stages of the game to build a lead that would expand to as much as 16 entering the break. The Flames would lead by as many as 19 points just four minutes into the second half before Youngstown State would begin to chip away. The Penguins chopped their deficit to nine with just under four minutes remaining, but UIC pulled away with a 7-2 spurt that quelled the YSU comeback attempt. Robert Bush scored a team-high 14 points, while Josh Mayo added 13 and Spencer Stewart tallied 10. Scott VanderMeer pulled down a game-high 13 rebounds.

LAST TIME WE MET IN YOUNGSTOWN:**Youngstown State 80, UIC 68 - Jan. 3, 2008 (Beeghly Center - Youngstown, Ohio)**

The UIC men's basketball team fell for the first time in Horizon League play in 2007-08 following an 80-68 loss to Youngstown State at the Beeghly Center. UIC was led by Karl White Jr.'s 21 points, surpassing his career-high point output for the second time in the Flames' last three games. Scott VanderMeer had a double-double of 10 points and 11 rebounds. Josh Mayo chipped in 17 points and five assists. Youngstown State was paced by 24 points and 15 rebounds from John Barber and 26 points from Vytas Sulskis. The Penguins were hot from the start, shooting 61 percent (20-for-33) from the field in the first half. A 6-0 run by the hosts in the final two minutes of the opening stanza created an 11-point deficit for the Flames at halftime. UIC was unable to dig out of the early hole, shooting just 27 percent (7-for-26) in the game's final 20 minutes.

MAYO AND VANDERMEER VERSUS YOUNGSTOWN:

Senior Josh Mayo is averaging 15.0 ppg in seven career games against Youngstown State, but the efficient way he's scored has been most impressive. He is shooting 52.5 percent (32-for-61) from the field and 54.1 percent (20-for-37) from downtown against Youngstown. He also has a 3.1 assist-to-turnover ratio, with 28 helpers to just nine turnovers against the Penguins. Senior Scott VanderMeer is averaging 9.0 ppg, 7.4 rpg and 2.0 bpg in five career games against Youngstown State.

WHAT'S NEXT:

The Flames face preseason league favorite Cleveland State at the Wolstein Center on Saturday, Jan. 10 at 6 p.m. Central. The game will air live on WIND 560 AM.

LAST TIME OUT:

Green Bay 66, UIC 61 – Jan. 3, 2009 (UIC Pavilion)

A furious rally attempt late in regulation by the UIC men's basketball team could not overcome a poor shooting second half by the Flames in a 66-61 loss to Green Bay at the UIC Pavilion. The Flames cut a 16-point deficit with 7:30 remaining all the way down to three with just 32 seconds left, but UIC was unable to get any closer. UIC shot just 28.6 percent (8-for-28) from the field in the game's final 20 minutes, including a 1-for-11 second-half showing from behind the three-point line. The Phoenix had a completely opposite display from the floor, shooting 50 percent from both the field (13-for-26) and downtown (4-for-8). Josh Mayo led UIC with 22 points and six assists. Scott VanderMeer added nine points and eight rebounds, while freshman forward Jelani Poston brought a spark off the bench with eight points and four rebounds in 11 minutes. Green Bay's Terry Evans led all scorers with 28 points on 11-for-16 shooting to go with eight rebounds. The Flames started off strong, going up by as many as 11 in the first half. UIC led 20-9 on Rob Eppinger's layup with 6:50 in the opening stanza before the well went dry for the hosts. Green Bay proceeded to go on a 15-0 run over the next four minutes to take a 22-20 lead as the Flames took, and missed, just four shots in that span. UIC evened up the game going into break on Robo Kreps' long jumper to beat the buzzer. But the Flames' shooting woes continued into the second half, as UIC missed its first five shots of the period and went on to go 2-for-17 from the floor over the course of the half's first 12 minutes. The Phoenix took advantage of the Flames' shooting slump, going up 52-36 on Ryan Tillem's three. That's when UIC went on its run. Chris Buchanan scored five points and Poston added a pair of free throws in a 40-second span to bring the deficit down to nine. After Green Bay went back up by 14, UIC went on a 9-0 run that was capped by Poston's three-point play. A see-saw battle that took place predominantly at the charity stripe saw the Flames continue to chip their disadvantage down. Mayo hit a pair of free throws that brought UIC to within three, and Rahmon Fletcher hit just one of two at the other end to put Green Bay up 63-59 with 31 seconds left. Spencer Stewart missed a runner, and Poston's close-range fadeaway after getting the offensive board was unsuccessful. There was a scrum for the loose ball underneath the UIC bucket, and it was deemed that the Flames had called a timeout when they were without any left that caused the officials to assess UIC a technical foul. Mike Schachtner hit the subsequent free throws to put the Phoenix up six with 12 seconds left, essentially cementing the game for the visitors.

MAYO IS THE MAN:

Senior guard Josh Mayo is proving why he was selected as the Horizon League's Preseason Player of the Year. The 5-foot-11 sharpshooter, who entered this season as the league's top returning scorer by averaging 17.1 ppg in 2007-08, is currently averaging a league-leading 19.5 ppg. In UIC's marquee road victories over Vanderbilt and Georgia Tech, Mayo averaged 23.5 ppg and shot 60.0 percent (9-for-15) from three-point range.

VANDERMEER DANDY AT DOUBLE-DOUBLES:

Senior center Scott VanderMeer is off to a fantastic start to his final collegiate campaign, averaging 13.4 ppg and 9.0 rpg through 13 games. VanderMeer already has five double-doubles through that span, including three in his last seven contests, and has just missed recording two more double-doubles by a rebound. He has 13 career double-doubles and is just one shy of matching last season's total of six.

THE HAND THAT'S HOT BELONG TO SCOTT:

A big reason for the Flames' solid 5-2 December can be attributed to the performance of senior center Scott VanderMeer. VanderMeer averaged 14.3 ppg, 9.9 rpg and shot 48.4 percent (45-for-93) from the floor last month.

VANDERMEER CLAIMS HORIZON LEAGUE TRIPLE CROWN FOR BLOCKS:

Senior center Scott VanderMeer added another Horizon League record to his impressive list of accomplishments on Dec. 23 when his three blocks against Toledo gave him 227 career blocked shots, a new league record for career blocks. VanderMeer surpassed the old mark of 226 set by Evansville's Dan Godfread (1985-90). It took VanderMeer less than three full seasons to break the mark. He now owns the league record for career blocks (231), single-season blocks (111 in 2006-07) and single-game blocks (9 vs. Cleveland State, Jan. 27, 2007).

ROAD WARRIORS:

After a 5-10 road campaign in 2007-08, UIC is off to a much better start away from the Pavilion. The Flames already have four road wins to their credit, with a 4-2 mark in hostile territory and notable road victories over Vanderbilt and Georgia Tech. Last season UIC didn't chalk up its fourth road victory until Feb. 23, 2008 against Northern Iowa. UIC has a chance to get its fifth road win of 2008-09 this weekend.

SIXTH MAN OF THE YEAR, SO FAR:

Sophomore Tori Boyd has proven to be a spark plug for the Flames off the bench this season. After scoring just two points as a starter in the season opener at Bradley, Boyd has found much more success coming off the bench, averaging 9.5 points and 3.6 rebounds in 11 games as a reserve. In two games as a starter he is averaging just 5.5 ppg. For the season, Boyd is fourth on the team in scoring at 8.8 ppg, shooting 43.2 percent from the field.

BUTTELL BETTER IN THE STARTING FIVE:

Junior forward Jeremy Buttell's production has been much better when he is on the floor with the first five. Buttell is averaging 6.5 ppg and 5.8 rpg in six games as a starter, compared to 1.4 ppg and 2.7 rpg in his seven games off the bench.

MAYO PASSES MILLER ON UIC SCORING LIST:

Senior Josh Mayo continues his climb up the UIC career scoring chart. On Saturday Mayo scored 22 to push his career scoring total to 1,460 points, allowing him to pass up the legendary Mark Miller (1,458 career points) and claim the eighth spot on UIC's career scoring rankings. Mayo is on pace to crack the top five by the end of the season.

THE POSTMAN DELIVERS QUICKLY:

Freshman forward Jelani Poston made a big impact in little time against Green Bay this past Saturday, scoring a career-high eight points and pulling down four rebounds in 10 late second-half minutes to spur UIC's rally attempt. Poston's energy and production off the bench helped UIC chip a 16-point deficit down to three. In three games in which he has played at least nine minutes (vs. DePaul, at Toledo, vs. Green Bay), Poston is averaging 5.3 ppg and 4.0 rpg in just 12.0 mpg while shooting 55.6 percent (5-for-9) from the floor and going to the line nine times (making six). If Poston's numbers in 10 games are prorated to averages per 40 minutes, he is predicted to post 15.9 ppg and 12.1 rpg.

LEAGUE LEADERS:

There are plenty of Flames atop the Horizon League statistical leader board. Senior guard Josh Mayo continues to pace the conference in scoring at 19.5 ppg, while fellow senior Scott VanderMeer is the league's top rebounder (9.0 rpg) and shot-blocker (2.7 bpg). Mayo also leads the league in three-pointers made per game (3.3), while junior guard Spencer Stewart is second in the league in assists (4.6 apg).

FLAMES IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS:

Seniors Josh Mayo and Scott VanderMeer are also ranked in the Top 50 of numerous national statistical categories, according to the latest NCAA rankings unveiled earlier this week. Mayo is 39th overall in scoring (19.5 ppg), 21st in three-pointers made (3.3), 34th in three-point field goal percentage (43.4), and 28th in free throw percentage (88.5). VanderMeer is 12th nationally in blocks (2.7 bpg) and 38th in rebounding (9.0 rpg). As a team the Flames are ranked 11th in free throw percentage (76.8).

TORI'S USUALLY THE STORY IN THE OUTCOME:

A good indicator of the Flames' success is the production of sophomore forward Tori Boyd. In UIC's eight wins, Boyd is averaging 10.9 ppg and 4.1 rpg while shooting 40.0 percent (8-for-20) from downtown in 25.6 minutes per game. In the Flames' five losses, Boyd is averaging just 5.6 ppg and 3.0 rpg while shooting just 1-for-9 (11.1 percent) from three-point range in 19.2 mpg. Plagued by foul trouble in two games last week, Boyd averaged just 14.5 minutes in a pair of UIC losses and posted just 4.0 ppg and 2.0 rpg.

KREPS KEEPS CONTRIBUTING:

Sophomore guard Robo Kreps has had some memorable performances in the early part of his second season. He opened the year with a career-high 24-point showing against Bradley on Nov. 14, and he added 23 points in UIC's road win over Vanderbilt on Dec. 3. Kreps is UIC's second-leading scorer on the road, averaging 13.3 ppg in six away games.

2008-09 UIC FLAMES MEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

SPENCER RUNNING THE POINT:

Junior Spencer Stewart is, once again, the team leader in assists, averaging 4.6 helpers per game. Stewart, who ranks second in the Horizon League in assists, has been dishing out plenty of late, averaging 4.9 apg in his last nine outings, including a season-high eight assists in the Flames' win over Central Michigan on Nov. 29.

ALWAYS IN THE GAME:

Even in defeat, the Flames have been in every game they've played thus far. UIC has not lost a game by more than seven points this season, with a 67-60 road defeat at the hands of previously-unbeaten Illinois State serving as UIC's largest margin in a loss.

LIVING AND DYING FROM DOWNTOWN:

Much of UIC's success in the win-loss column is predicated on the Flames' exploits from behind the three-point arc. In eight victories the Flames are shooting 44.2 percent (57-for-129) from three-point range, while in five losses UIC is hitting from downtown at a clip of 23.3 percent (27-for-116). Josh Mayo, UIC's leading three-point shooter, is connecting on threes at a rate of 57.7 percent (30-for-52) in the Flames' wins, while Mayo has shot just 27.7 percent (13-for-47) in defeats. Getting those missed attempts has also been a key; UIC has outrebounded the foes it has beaten by an average margin of 9.1 rpg, while the Flames have lost the battle on the glass in their five losses by an average of 5.4 rpg.

OFFENSIVE GLASS CLEANING:

The Flames owe most of their rebounding advantage to their work on the offensive boards. Of UIC's 330 total rebounds, 176 are on the offensive end. The Flames lead the league in rebounding (38.9 rpg) and are second in offensive rebounding (13.5 orgg), thanks mainly to Scott VanderMeer's league-best 3.9 orgg.

UIC INKS LOUIS GREEN IN EARLY SIGNING PERIOD:

UIC head men's basketball coach Jimmy Collins announced on Nov. 12 that Louis Green (Hillside, Ill./St. Joseph H.S.) has signed a National Letter of Intent to play for the Flames beginning in the 2009-10 campaign. Green is a 6-foot-9, 240-pound center who plays for legendary head coach Gene Pingatore at St. Joseph High School in Westchester. A varsity starter since his sophomore season, Green was a teammate of current NCAA Division I student-athletes Demetri McCamey (Illinois) and Evan Turner (Ohio State) on the Chargers' 2007 IHSA Sectional championship squad. Green played this past summer with the Illinois Flames AAU team under coach Dedrick Shannon.

UIC HEAD COACH
Jimmy Collins
(202-176, 13th season)

Head Coach Jimmy Collins is in his 13th season at the helm of the UIC men's basketball program. The veteran mentor is not only the winningest coach in school history with 202 career wins, but is also the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois and the Horizon League. He has captured a conference regular season title (1998) and two league tournament crowns (2002, 2004) during his tenure, and has guided the Flames to four 20-win seasons, including a school-record 24 victories in 2003-04.

Named co-conference coach of the year after his first season with the Flames, Collins has also guided UIC to its only three NCAA Tournament appearances in school history, taking the team to the Big Dance in 1998, 2002 and 2004. He also guided the Flames to their first-ever NIT bid in 2003.

Collins, who served as an assistant coach at Illinois for 13 years prior to his arrival at UIC, earned All-American honors as a player at New Mexico State, averaging 20.1 ppg while leading the Aggies to the Final Four during his senior season.

JIMMY COLLINS FAST FACTS

- * Jimmy Collins was introduced as the ninth head coach in UIC history on March 27, 1996.
- * Collins has propelled UIC to its first three NCAA Tournament bids (1998, 2002, 2004) and first NIT berth (2003) in school history.
- * Collins has led UIC to four 20-win seasons in his 12 years on the sidelines: 22 (1997-98); 20 (2001-02); 21 (2002-03); 24 (2003-04).
- * Collins is the program's all-time winningest coach with 202 career victories, the only coach in UIC history to have 200-plus wins.
- * Collins has guided UIC to a league regular-season (1998) and two league tournament titles (2002, 2004) during his tenure.
- * Collins is the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois and the longest tenured coach in the Horizon League.
- * Collins was an assistant coach at the University of Illinois under Lou Henson for 13 years, including the 1989 season in which the Fighting Illini advanced to the Final Four.
- * As Illinois' top recruiter, Collins' high-profile Illini signees included: Kendall Gill, Nick Anderson, Marcus Liberty, Deon Thomas, Kiwane Garris and Lowell Hamilton.
- * Collins is the co-chairman of the Chicago Special Olympics.
- * Collins and his family are heavily involved with the Lupus Foundation of America Illinois Chapter. His daughter, Erica, serves on the Board of Directors for the Illinois Chapter.
- * Collins, as well as the rest of his 1970 New Mexico State Final Four squad, were inducted into the school's Hall of Fame on Feb. 7th, 2004.
- * Collins is a former first-round draft pick of the Chicago Bulls (1970).
- * Collins served as a hearing officer for the Cook County Probation Department prior to his appointment as an assistant coach at Illinois.
