UIC HEAD COACH
Jimmy Collins
(115-103, 8th season)

Head Coach Jimmy Collins is in his eighth season at the helm of the UIC men's basketball program. The veteran mentor has compiled a current record of 115-103 with the Flames, making him the second all-time winningest head coach at UIC. He has captured a conference regular season (1998) and league tournament crown (2002) during his tenure and has guided the Flames to back-to-back postseason appearances and back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time in school history.

Named co-conference coach of the year after his first season with the Flames, Collins has also guided UIC to its only two NCAA Tournament appearances in school history, taking the team to the Big Dance in both 1998 and 2002. He also guided the Flames to their first-ever NIT bid last season.

Collins, who served as an assistant coach at Illinois for 13 years prior to his arrival at UIC, earned All-American honors as a player at New Mexico State, averaging 20.1 ppg while leading the Aggies to the Final Four.

COLLINS COACHING QUICK FACTS

* Collins has propelled UIC to its first two NCAA Tournament bids (1998, 2002) and first NIT berth (2003) in school history.

* Collins has led UIC to three 20-win seasons: 22 (1997-98); 20 (2001-02); 21 (2002-03).

* Collins is 18 wins behind Bob Hallberg (1987-96) for the top spot in the UIC career coaching victories list.

* Collins has guided UIC to a league regular-season (1998) and league tournament title (2002) during his tenure.

* Collins is the second-longest tenured coach in the Horizon League behind Perry Watson of Detroit.

* Collins has posted a record of 68-27 at home during his career at UIC.

* Collins was an assistant coach at the University of Illinois for 13 years, including the 1989 season in which the Fighting Illini advanced to the Final Four.

2003-04 UIC MEN'S BASKETBALL

SETTING THE SCENE:

UIC plays at the UIC Pavilion for the last time in 2003 on Saturday as they welcome Northwestern. The Flames have won their last two games and are vying for their second straight home win over a Big Ten opponent. Following Saturday's game, UIC opens Horizon League play at UW-Milwaukee on Dec. 23rd, then closes out 2003 by meeting Illinois at the United Center on Dec. 30th.

SCOUTING NORTHWESTERN:

Northwestern enters Saturday's tilt with a record of 5-3 and on a three-game winning streak after posting a dramatic win over Arizona State at home on Wednesday night. The Wildcats are paced this season by senior Jitim Young. Young is averaging a team-high 18.1 points and 6.9 rebounds per game. Vedran Vukusic (13.6 ppg) and T.J. Parker (11.0 ppg) also average in double figures for Northwestern. The Wildcats are coached by Bill Carmondy, who is in fourth season at Northwestern.

LAST TIME WE MET:

UIC 70, Northwestern 53 - Welsh-Ryan Arena - Dec. 19, 2002

UIC's **Cedrick Banks** netted 31 points to help lead the Flames to a 70-53 win over Northwestern at Welsh-Ryan Arena. Banks tallied 20 points in the opening stanza, including 13 straight points in one stretch that helped stake UIC to a nine-point lead early in the first half. For the game, Banks was 12-of-18 from the field, including a personal-high tying five three-pointers. The Flames weren't all Banks, though, as they shot 58% from the field as a team while outrebounding the Wildcats, 42-15, and outscoring them 26-10 in the post. Evan Seacat paced the Wildcats with 16 points, all in the second half, while T.J. Parker added 15.

UIC vs. NORTHWESTERN - QUICK NOTES

* This is the fifth all-time meeting between UIC and Northwestern with the Wildcats holding a 3-1 edge in the series.

* This is the first time in the series the game has been played at the UIC Pavilion.

* Northwestern is the first Big Ten team to play at the Pavilion since Michigan State battled the Flames on Nov. 21, 1997. A game UIC won, 70-58.

* UIC is 6-32 all-time versus teams from the Big Ten with two of the six wins coming during Jimmy Collins' tenure with the Flames.

* Including his 13 years as an assistant coach at Illinois, Collins is 24-2 in games against Northwestern.

* UIC will be looking to give the Horizon League its first victory over the Big Ten on Saturday, as league schools are 0-7 this season against the Big Ten.

LAST TIME OUT:**UIC 86, Illinois State 74 (Dec. 13, 2003)**

UIC senior **Cedrick Banks** had the hot hand in the first half, then senior Aaron Carr heated things up in the second stanza as the Flames posted a 12-point win over visiting Illinois State. Banks scored 20 of his 22 points in the first half while Carr tallied 20 of his game-high 23 points in the second period. UIC shot 54% from the field in the game, posting its 13th straight home non-conference win. Martell Bailey also had a strong game for the Flames, collecting his third career double-double with 13 points and 12 rebounds.

NON-CONFERENCE HOME SUCCESS:

UIC has been dominant on its home floor versus non-conference foes over the last four years, going 17-1. The Flames, who have won their last 13 at home versus non-league opponents, suffered their lone defeat during that span versus South Florida, 67-51, on Dec. 17th, 2000.

LOOKING TO DEFEND HIS TITLE:

Reigning NCAA Division I assist leader **Martell Bailey** is in the hunt to defend his title this season, averaging a career-best 8.4 assists per game through UIC's first 10 contests. Bailey is currently ranked third in the nation behind Greg Davis (10.7 apg) of Troy State and Lamar Searight (8.8 apg) of Grambling.

GREAT START:

UIC's 8-2 record matches the second-best start in school history. The 1990-91 squad also opened the year with an 8-2 record, before finishing 15-15. The best start was set by the 1997-98 Flames, who under the direction of **Jimmy Collins** opened the year by going 10-1 en route to a 22-6 season.

TOPS IN THE LEAGUE:

Heading into this weekend's action, UIC finds itself leading the Horizon League in scoring margin (+9.9), turnover margin (+5.90) and assist-to-turnover ratio (1.30).

DOUBLING UP:

UIC senior point guard **Martell Bailey** collected his third career double-double on Dec. 13th with 13 points, a season-high, and 12 assists in the Flames' win over Illinois State. It was also the fifth time in 10 games a UIC player has tallied a double-double this year. Senior **Armond Williams** has two to his credit this season while **Cedrick Banks**, **Elliott Poole** and Bailey have each recorded one double-double.

AWESOME ARMOND:

Senior forward **Armond Williams** has stepped up his game of late, averaging 15.0 points and 8.2 rebounds per game while shooting 58% from the field in UIC's last four outings. Williams, who led UIC with nine double-doubles last season, has posted a pair of double-doubles in his recent run, including a 14-point and 11-rebound effort versus Northern Illinois on Dec. 5th.

MOVING UP THE CHARTS:

UIC senior **Martell Bailey**, the reigning NCAA Division I assist leader, moved into second place on the UIC all-time assist list on Dec. 13th with his 12-assist performance versus Illinois State. Bailey, who now has 490 career assists, moved past UIC Hall of Famer Kenny Williams into the second spot, but is still 265 helpers

THIS BANKS ALWAYS OPEN:

Preseason Horizon League Player of the Year and CollegelInsider.Com Mid-Major All-American **Cedrick Banks** has lived up to his billing so far this season, leading the Flames in scoring (19.6 ppg) while ranking second in steals (1.9 spg) and assists (2.2 apg) and third in rebounding (4.1 rpg). Banks has scored 20-plus points in seven games this year and has scored 25 or more on three occasions. He also collected his first double-double in almost two years with a 20-point, 10-rebound effort in a win over Mercer on Nov. 17th.

'STATE'-ING THEIR CASE:

UIC has had great success against Illinois universities and colleges in the last four years, going 18-4 since the start of the 2000-01 campaign. UIC, which went 7-0 against state schools last year, is 2-1 this season versus state schools. The Flames still have in-state contests with Northwestern and Loyola on the schedule this season, as well as a match-up with Illinois at the United Center on December 30th.

OUR NEWCOMERS AREN'T SO NEW ANY MORE:

With 10 games under their belts, newcomers **Elliott Poole** and **Justin Bowen** are beginning to come into their own as strong performers off the bench for the Flames. Over the last five games, Poole, who is the team's second-leading rebounder, is averaging 5.6 points and 4.8 rebounds per game while Bowen is chipping in with 4.2 ppg and 3.2 rpg with both seeing less than 20 minutes per contest on the floor.

CONTINUING TRENDS:

Dating back to the 2000-01 season, UIC is 23-0 when they shoot better than 50% from the field in a game and are 48-7 when leading at the half. The Flames are also 22-1 when tallying 80 or more points in a game during that span.

ASSISTING PAST EVANSVILLE:

UIC senior point guard **Martell Bailey** set a new career-high on Nov. 25th versus Evansville with his 15 assists. The reigning NCAA Division I assist leader, who also tabbed six points and a season-high rebounds in the win over the Purple Aces, reached his new high-water mark while committing just a single turnover. The 15 assists was the third-most in UIC single-game history and was the most assists in a game by a Flame since Craig Lathen's 17-assist night versus Cleveland State in 1984. For the season, Bailey is now averaging a Horizon League best 8.4 apg and owns a 2.5-to-1 assist-to-turnover ratio.

BANKS AT 1,000 POINTS AND CLIMBING:

With his first basket of the game versus Mercer on Nov. 17th, senior **Cedrick Banks** became the 17th player in UIC history to reach the 1000-point plateau for his career. Banks, the team's leading scorer, has already moved into 11th place on the UIC all-time scoring list with 1,163 points, and needs just 68 more to crack the Top 10.

ALL-PUBLIC LEAGUE TEAM:

The Chicago Public League is widely recognized as one of the most talent-rich prep leagues in the state of Illinois and one of the most recruited leagues in the country, having produced numerous collegiate All-Americans and NBA stars. It's no wonder why then that there will be many times this season when the five UIC players on the floor will all be former All-Chicago Public League honorees. All in all, the Flames feature eight public leaguers, including **Martell Bailey** (Westinghouse), **Cedrick Banks** (Westinghouse), **Justin Bowen** (Marshall), **Aaron Carr** (Lincoln Park), **Marcetteaus McGee** (Farragut), **Elliott Poole** (Farragut), **Armond Williams** (Austin), and **Josh Williams** (Whitney Young).

GREAT SCOTT:

UIC senior center **Joe Scott** had his best outing of the season in the Flames' win over Mercer on Nov. 16th to clinch third place in the 2003 Dell BCA Classic. Scott tallied 15 points and eight rebounds in 23 minutes for UIC. Those were his best numbers since a 15-point, 8-rebound effort versus Samford on Dec. 16th of last season.

FANTASTIC FIVE:

The Flames return plenty of firepower for the 2003-04 campaign as all five starters, all of whom are seniors, are back in the lineup. This starting rotation combined for 68.7 points and 23.5 rebounds per game last year and is totaling over 60 points and 20 rebounds an outing this season.
