\*Quick Notes: The UIC men's basketball team looks to get back on the winning track on Saturday as the Flames open a two-game road trip at Detroit...This will be the 25th all-time meeting between the two schools with Detroit holding a 17-7 edge in the series...The Flames and Titans split last year's season series with each team winning on their home court...UIC last tasted victory at Calihan Hall on Jan. 18th, 2003, with a 77-74 triumph over the Titans...Saturday's contest is a battle between the two longest tenured coaches in the Horizon League in Perry Watson (13th season) and Jimmy Collins (10th season), who combine for 23 years and 390 wins on the sidelines...Senior Justin Bowen ranks in the top five in the Horizon League in both scoring (16.0 ppg/5th) and rebounding (7.6 rpg/3rd), and is coming off a 26-point, 13-rebound effort on Thursday night versus Cleveland State...Freshman Josh Mayo is averaging 16.0 points and shooting 53% from the field in his last three games...UIC is 4-0 this season in games played on Saturday...The Flames are back on the road on Wednesday when they play at Wright State.

#### TITAN NOTES:

Detroit welcomes UIC to Calihan Hall on Saturday on the heels of a one-point loss to Horizon League-leader UW-Milwaukee on Wednesday night, a game in which the Titans watched a 10-point lead vanish in the final four minutes. Detroit is 3-4 in league play this season with all three wins coming at home. The Titans are 7-1 at Calihan Hall overall this season. On the floor, Detroit is paced by junior guard Brandon Cotton. The former McDonald's All-American, who missed the three games prior to the team's tilt with the Panthers, is averaging 15.6 points per game. Forwards Chuck Bailey and Torvoris Baker combine for almost 20 points and 14 rebounds per game in the post. Headmaster Perry Watson is the longest tenured coach in the Horizon League.

#### UIC vs. DETROIT - SERIES NOTES:

- \* Detroit leads the all-time series between the two schools 17-7, but the two schools split their two meetings last season with each winning on their home floor.
- \* UIC is 2-9 all-time at Calihan Hall.
- \* The Flames' last win at Calihan, and its last win in the series, came in front of a national television audience when Cedrick Banks out-dueled Willie Green in a 77-74 triumph on Jan. 18, 2003.

#### LAST TIME WE MET:

##### UIC 63, Detroit 57

##### January 20, 2005 \* UIC Pavilion

UIC notched its fifth-straight win and moved into a tie for second place in the Horizon League with a 63-57 victory over visiting Detroit at the Pavilion. Senior Cedrick Banks led the way for the Flames with a game-high 28 points. Junior Rocky Collum added a career-high 13 points and four assists while junior Justin Bowen came off the bench to snag a team-best eight rebounds. The Flames defense was, once again, showcased as UIC held its fifth consecutive opponent under 60 points while limiting the Titans to just 39% shooting from the field.

#### QUITE A PAIR OF COACHES:

Saturday's game between UIC and Detroit pits the Horizon League's two longest tenured head coaches in Jimmy Collins and Perry Watson, who combine for 390 wins at their respective institutions. Watson, a former assistant at Michigan, is in his 13th season on the sidelines for the Titans and has guided his program to 236 victories and a pair of NCAA Tournament wins. Collins, a former assistant at Illinois, is the Flames' all-time winningest coach with 154 career victories and three NCAA Tournament appearances on his resume.

#### LAST TIME OUT:

##### Cleveland State 87, UIC 83

##### January 19, 2006 \* UIC Pavilion

Despite career-best performances from senior Justin Bowen and freshman Josh Mayo, UIC dropped a heartbreaker to visiting Cleveland State on Wednesday night at the Pavilion. Bowen tabbed his sixth double-double of the season in the loss, finishing with a career-high 26 points and 13 rebounds. Mayo tabbed a personal-best 22 points and five assists. Raheem Moss led five Vikings in double figures with 16 points. Cleveland State crashed the boards hard in the contest, out-rebounding UIC, 46-40, including 24 offensive rebounds which led to 27 second-chance points. UIC trailed the Vikings by two in the waning seconds and had an attempt to tie the game, but sophomore Karl White's driving lay-in rimmed out with :04 left.

**WHAT'S UP NEXT:**

UIC continues on the road next week, traveling to Dayton, Ohio to take on Wright State on Wednesday, January 25<sup>th</sup> at the Nutter Center. The Flames and Raiders split their two meetings last season with each team winning on their home floor.

**PLENTY OF CLOSE GAMES:**

UIC has had more than its fair share of nail-biters this season. UIC has already played four overtime games, had four contests decided by a single point and seven decisions by five points or less. The Flames, who are 2-2 in overtime games, are now 3-4 in games decided by less than five points after their 87-83 loss to Cleveland State on Jan. 19<sup>th</sup>.

**QUITE A NIGHT FOR BOWEN:**

Senior Justin Bowen enjoyed a standout night in a losing effort on Wednesday, Jan. 19<sup>th</sup>, versus Cleveland State. The 6-foot-7 forward tabbed a career-high 26 points, going 10-of-14 from the field, 13 rebounds, three steals and two assists. It was Bowen's team – and Horizon League-best sixth double-double this season.

**YOU CAN'T HOLD THE MAYO:**

Freshman Josh Mayo had his best shooting night in a UIC uniform on Wednesday, Jan. 19<sup>th</sup>, at home versus Cleveland State, netting 7-of-10 shots en route to a career-high 22 points. Mayo converted a personal-best four three-pointers while adding five assists and two steals versus the Vikings.

**A BITTER SEPARATION:**

Junior walk-on Greg Zimny, who was providing a spark off the bench for UIC in a back-up point guard role the last two weeks, suffered a tough setback on Jan. 19<sup>th</sup>, separating his right shoulder while diving for a loose ball. Zimny had already tabbed two points and two assists, without a turnover, in the game versus Cleveland State prior to the injury.

**JUSTIN TIME:**

Senior Justin Bowen is enjoying a standout final campaign for the Flames this season, leading the team in scoring (16.0 ppg), rebounding (7.6 rpg) and field goal percentage (54%) while rating in the top five in the Horizon League in each category. Bowen, who entered the year with career averages of 5.9 ppg and 4.1 rpg, has scored in double-figures in 16 of his 18 games played and has a team- and Horizon League-best six double-doubles this season, including a 26-point, 13-rebound effort on Jan. 19<sup>th</sup> versus Cleveland State.

**JEFFERS MAKING A BID FOR TOP NEWCOMER HONORS:**

Sophomore Othys Jeffers has enjoyed an impressive start to his UIC career as he currently leads the team in assists (2.8 apg) and blocks (0.8 bpg) while ranking second in scoring (12.3 ppg), rebounding (7.4 rpg) and field goal percentage (51%). The 6-foot-5 forward, who owns four double-doubles this season, recorded eight points, nine rebounds and a career-high tying seven assists versus Cleveland State on Jan. 19<sup>th</sup>.

**FAB FROSH:**

UIC freshman Josh Mayo has played beyond his years to start his collegiate career. The Merrillville, Ind., native took over the starting spot at point guard 14 games ago and hasn't looked back, averaging 10.3 points and three assists per outing as a starter. Mayo currently rates third on the team in scoring at 9.5 points per game and is tied for the team lead in assists (2.8 apg). Mayo also ranks first on the team in free throw shooting at 85% while he tops the squad in three-pointers made with 26. Two of Mayo's best performances have come in two of UIC's biggest wins this season as he recorded 21 points and four assists in the team's win at Georgia Tech and then netted 11 of his 16 points in the final minute of regulation and overtime in UIC's triumph over Ole Miss.

**PASSING THEIR BOARDS:**

UIC has hit the boards hard thus far in 2005-06, pulling down 38.2 rebounds per game while owning a +4.6 rebounding margin. The Flames have out-rebounded their opponent in 14 of their 18 games this year and have snagged at least 15 offensive caroms in nine outings. Senior Justin Bowen leads the team in rebounding at 7.6 rpg, which ranks third in the Horizon League. Sophomore Othys Jeffers is right behind Bowen at 7.4 rebounds per outing, which rates fifth in the league.

### NO SOPHOMORE SLUMP FOR BUSH:

Sophomore Robert Bush has elevated his game as a sophomore. The 6-foot-4 guard is averaging 6.7 points and 2.1 rebounds per game while shooting 42% from the field and 34% from three-point range for the Flames this season. Bush, who averaged just one point and less than a rebound per game in limited duty as a freshman, has started in 13 games this year. On Jan. 11th at UW-Green Bay, Bush tied his career-high with 16 points, including a personal-best four three-pointers.

### COACH COLLINS IS NO. 1:

Headmaster Jimmy Collins continues to add to his record as UIC's all-time winningest men's basketball coach in his 10th season with the Flames as he now boasts 154 career victories after the team's triumph over Youngstown State on Dec. 31st. Collins, who has guided UIC to its only three NCAA Tournament appearances during his tenure, became the program's all-time leader in wins last season with career victory No. 134 in a road triumph at UNC Wilmington on Dec. 12th. He garnered career win No. 150 on Dec. 10, 2005 versus Mississippi.

### A SUCCESSFUL NON-CONFERENCE RUN:

UIC endured a rigorous non-league slate this season with contests against teams from the BIG EAST, Big Ten, ACC and SEC. The Flames opened the year with five games in 10 days, starting in Fairbanks, Alaska for the BP Top of the World Classic and finishing with a trip through Georgia to take on Georgia Tech and Georgia Southern. UIC is fresh off its first-ever victory over an SEC school with its win over Mississippi on Dec. 10th, and a Big Ten road triumph at Northwestern. The Flames also bested preseason favorites from the Big Sky (Montana State), Mountain West (San Diego State) and Southern Conference (Davidson) during non-league play.

### ACC...CHECK...SEC...CHECK...BIG TEN...CHECK:

UIC recorded a pair of firsts already this season with the program's first-ever wins over an Atlantic Coast Conference and Southeastern Conference opponent. The Flames disposed of Georgia Tech in Atlanta, 73-51, back on Nov. 25th and then rallied past Mississippi in overtime, 87-75, on Dec. 10th. UIC added another impressive win to its resume on Dec. 14th with a 71-62 triumph at Northwestern. The Flames are the only team in the country that can boast non-conference wins over teams from the ACC, SEC and Big Ten this season.

### NO TROUBLE TABBING DOUBLE-DOUBLES:

UIC forwards Justin Bowen and Othys Jeffers have combined for 10 double-doubles through 18 this season. Bowen leads the Horizon League with six this season while Jeffers has tabbed four double-dips. The Flames totaled 12 double-doubles all of last season with Armond Williams leading the squad with four.

### PAINT PRODUCTION:

UIC has been effective scoring down low this season with 46% of its total points being scored in the paint. The Flames, who average 68.7 points per game, are scoring 31.9 per outing in the paint. UIC has scored at least 32 points in the paint in 11 of its last 12 games.

### FLAMES SIGN A PAIR FOR 2006-07:

UIC inked a pair of players this fall for the 2006-07 season as Edwardsville, Ill., guard Spencer Stewart and Houston-area forward Jonathan Blake signed National Letters of Intent with the Flames. Stewart, 6-foot-4, garnered All-State honors last season at Edwardsville High School, averaging 9.4 points, 9.1 assists, 7.8 rebounds and 3.8 steals per game for the Tigers. Blake, 6-foot-5, was an All-District performer at Cypress Springs High School, totaling 13.6 points and 6.0 rebounds per contest.

### JEFFERS COMES WITH A UIC PEDIGREE:

Newcomer Othyus Jeffers, who sat out last season while attending UIC after playing one year of junior college basketball, has a family legacy with the Flames basketball program, as he is the cousin of former standout Mark Miller. With his permission, Jeffers will don Miller's No. 12 jersey, which was retired by UIC in 2000. Jeffers is a product of Hubbard High School and averaged 22.3 points and 10.8 rebounds per contest back in 2003-04 at Los Angeles Southwest Community College.

### POOLE CLOSED FOR THE SEASON

UIC senior Elliott Poole was declared academically ineligible for the remainder of the 2005-06 season on Jan 6th. The 6-foot-7 forward was averaging 7.3 points and 4.4 rebounds for the Flames. Poole, whose best moment came when he scored the game-winning bucket in UIC's Horizon League Tournament championship game triumph over UW-Milwaukee in 2004, has exhausted all of eligibility thus ending his playing career at UIC.

## UIC HEAD COACH Jimmy Collins (154-133, 10th season)

Head Coach Jimmy Collins is in his 10th season at the helm of the UIC men's basketball program. The veteran mentor is not only the winningest coach in school history with 154 career wins, but is also now the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois. He has captured a conference regular season title (1998) and two league tournament crowns (2002, 2004) during his tenure, and has guided the Flames to three 20-win seasons in the last four years, including a school-record 24 victories in 2003-04.

Named co-conference coach of the year after his first season with the Flames, Collins has also guided UIC to its only three NCAA Tournament appearances in school history, taking the team to the Big Dance in 1998, 2002 and 2004. He also guided the Flames to their first-ever NIT bid in 2003.

Collins, who served as an assistant coach at Illinois for 13 years prior to his arrival at UIC, earned All-American honors as a player at New Mexico State, averaging 20.1 ppg while leading the Aggies to the Final Four during his senior season.

### JIMMY COLLINS FAST FACTS

- \* Jimmy Collins was introduced as the ninth head coach in UIC history on March 27, 1996.
- \* In the midst of his 10th season with UIC, Collins is the longest tenured Division I men's basketball head coach in the state of Illinois.
- \* Collins has propelled UIC to its first three NCAA Tournament bids (1998, 2002, 2004) and first NIT berth (2003) in school history.
- \* Collins has led UIC to four 20-win seasons in his eight years on the sidelines: 22 (1997-98); 20 (2001-02); 21 (2002-03); 24 (2003-04).
- \* Collins is the program's all-time winningest coach with 154 career victories.
- \* Collins has guided UIC to a league regular-season (1998) and two league tournament titles (2002, 2004) during his tenure.
- \* Collins is the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois and the second-longest tenured coach in the Horizon League behind Perry Watson of Detroit.
- \* Collins was an assistant coach at the University of Illinois under Lou Henson for 13 years, including the 1989 season in which the Fighting Illini advanced to the Final Four.
- \* As Illinois' top recruiter, Collins' high-profile Illini signees included: Kendall Gill, Nick Anderson, Marcus Liberty, Deon Thomas, Kiwane Garris and Lowell Hamilton.
- \* Collins is the co-chairman of the Chicago Special Olympics.
- \* Collins, as well as the rest of his 1970 New Mexico State Final Four squad, were inducted into the school's Hall of Fame on Feb. 7th, 2004.
- \* Collins is a former first-round draft pick of the Chicago Bulls (1970).
- \* Collins served as a hearing officer for the Cook County Probation Department prior to his appointment as an assistant coach at Illinois.
