Panther Notes: Milwaukee broke a three-game losing streak on Thursday with a 68-53 home win over Loyola that clinched a at least a tie for fourth place in the Horizon League standings for the Panthers. The Panthers are 9-6 at home this season. After a loss to UIC on Dec. 6 was the fourth of six consecutive losses that pushed the Panthers to a 3-7 mark, Milwaukee won nine of its next 10 to stay in the Horizon League race. Paige Paulsen is Milwaukee's leading scorer (13.8 ppg) and rebounder (6.3 rpg). Rob Jeter is in his third season as the head coach at Milwaukee.

UIC AND MILWAUKEE, THE SERIES:

UIC trails the all-time series against Milwaukee, 20-30. The Flames are 6-19 against the Panthers in Milwaukee. The Flames last won at U.S. Cellular Arena on Feb. 15, 2006, when Josh Mayo scored 21 points to lead six Flames in double figures in a 94-86 overtime victory over a Milwaukee squad the fell in the second round of the NCAA Tournament to eventual national champion Florida. The UIC win in 2006 snapped the Panthers' 19-game home winning streak.

LAST TIME WE MET:**UIC 91, Milwaukee 73 – Dec. 6, 2007 (UIC Pavilion)**

It was a sweet return home for UIC as the Flames defeated Milwaukee, 91-73, in the Horizon League opener for both teams at the UIC Pavilion. Josh Mayo scored a team-high 29 points on 10-of-12 shooting from the field in just 27 minutes for the Flames. Robert Kreps chipped in a career-best 14 points, hitting a trio of treys, while Jeremy Buttell pulled down a game-high nine rebounds. In the Flames' first home game since Nov. 13, UIC began conference play on a high note with an impressive performance at the Pavilion. After trailing by as many as seven midway through the first half, UIC outscored the Panthers 34-15 to close the opening stanza. The Flames put up 11 unanswered points in a span of 1:54 to turn a three-point deficit into an eight-point advantage, which UIC would extend to 12 heading into intermission. The second half opened with a show by Mayo. The junior guard splashed in three from long range within the first five minutes of the period to help UIC build its advantage up to 18. Mayo, who was 5-for-6 from downtown for the game, would finish with 16 points in just 13 minutes of work during the final half. The Flames shot 61 percent from the field for the game, highlighted by 6-for-8 (75 percent) shooting from three-point land in the game's last 20 minutes. Spencer Stewart sent fans home in a frenzy after netting a wild shot from three-quarters court as the shot clock ticked down with a minute left in the game.

LAST TIME WE MET AT U.S. CELLULAR ARENA:**Milwaukee 76, UIC 65 – Jan. 17, 2007**

UIC was unable to overcome a three-point barrage from host Milwaukee in the first half as the Panthers defeated the Flames, 76-65, at U.S. Cellular Arena. Milwaukee went 12-for-19 from behind the arc in the first 20 minutes to take a 23-point lead into intermission. The score was knotted at 21-21 when the Panthers knocked down five straight triples in a two-minute stretch which sparked a 27-4 run to end the period. Ricky Franklin was 4-for-4 and Allan Hanson was 3-for-4 from behind the arc in the first half. The Flames would not back down in the second stanza, hitting five three-pointers of their own late in the game to cut the Panthers' lead to eight, 72-64. Time was not on UIC's side, though, as a pair of free throws by Hanson and a bucket by Kaylan Anderson helped UW-Milwaukee make one final stand. The loss spoiled junior Othys Jeffers' seventh double-double of the year, as he finished with 23 points and 11 rebounds. T.J. Gray scored 13 points while Josh Mayo added 10. Avery Smith scored 19 points to lead four Panthers in double figures. Paige Paulsen tabbed 18 points and eight rebounds.

A QUICK LOOK BACK:

Green Bay 76, UIC 73 - Feb. 28, 2008 (Green Bay, Wis.)

Karl White Jr.'s game-tying three-pointer with 8.5 seconds remaining capped UIC's furious rally from a seven-point deficit with under a minute left in regulation, but Green Bay guard Troy Cotton hit a three with 2.6 seconds on the clock to send the Flames to a heart-breaking 76-73 loss at the Resch Center on Thursday night. Josh Mayo scored 18 points and Jermaine Dailey registered his first career double-double with career highs of 14 points and 12 rebounds for UIC. The Flames trailed 70-63 when a bucket by Spencer Stewart cut the Green Bay advantage down to five with 42.7 seconds left. After Ryan Tillema missed the front end of a one-and-one at the other end, Stewart came down and nailed a trey to get the Flames within two. Mike Schachtner hit one of two at the line to put Green Bay back up by three when White hit a tough fadeaway in traffic near the right baseline to bring UIC within one. Following a pair of successful free throws by Schachtner with 14 seconds on the game clock, White dribbled the ball up court and pulled up for a three that he swished to even the contest at 73-73. Out of a timeout, the Flames pressured the Phoenix in the backcourt, but the hosts were able to get the ball to the right corner where Cotton stood waiting and hit the go-ahead basket from behind the three-point line. The Flames were able to get the ball to Mayo, who created an open look from the top of the arc and released a game-tying attempt that bounced off the rim at the buzzer. White finished with 13 points off the bench, scoring 11 in the second half and five in the game's final 18 seconds.

WHAT'S UP NEXT:

UIC will play in a first-round game in the 2008 Horizon League Men's Basketball Championship this Tuesday, Mar. 4. The opponent, game site and time will be determined on Saturday night.

CAN'T HOLD THE MAYO:

Most of the summer publicity about UIC centered on junior guard Josh Mayo, a preseason All-Horizon League selection. The third-year Flames standout has showed this season that he is more than capable of handling the high expectations as he leads the team in scoring (17.8 ppg) and three-point shooting (49.7 percent). His scoring average is the second-best in the Horizon League, while his three-point accuracy is third-best in the nation.

ONE OF THE BEST BEYOND THE ARC:

UIC remains one of the nation's most accurate three-point shooting teams according to the most recent NCAA Division I statistical rankings released on Friday, Feb. 29. The Flames own the country's seventh-best percentage from behind the three-point line at 40.7 percent (222-for-545).

JOSH NEAR THE TOP OF THE CHARTS:

UIC's main deep threat is junior guard Josh Mayo. Mayo currently ranks third in the nation in individual three-point field goal percentage at 49.7 percent (90-for-181), just behind Utah State's Jaycee Carroll (50.3 percent) and Boise State's Tyler Tiedeman (50.0 percent). For six weeks from Jan. 10 until Feb. 21, Mayo held the best three-point accuracy among all Division I players.

THE THREE-BALL A GOOD GAUGE FOR SUCCESS:

Much of UIC's success in the win-loss column has been contingent on its success shooting the basketball from beyond the three-point arc. In 15 wins the Flames have shot 48.4 percent (132-for-273) from behind the three-point line, while UIC has posted a 33.1 (90-for-272) three-point field goal percentage in 14 defeats.

MAYO MAKES MANY FROM LONG RANGE:

Josh Mayo is averaging 3.10 successful three-point attempts per contest to lead the Horizon League in the category and rank 28th nationally in treys made per game. He has made three or more three-point baskets in a game on 17 different occasions this year, including a five-game stretch with four treys or more from Dec. 6 through Dec. 22. Mayo has canned at least two three-pointers in all but three games this season.

KARL SCORING MORE AS A SENIOR:

Senior guard Karl White Jr. entered the 2007-08 season with a career-high point output of 17 that was set as a rookie in the 2004-05 campaign. White had only scored in double figures on 12 occasions in 70 games prior to this year. Through 27 games this season White has already scored in double figures 11 times, including eight times in his last 17 appearances, and has posted 19 or more points on four occasions.

MAYO CLIMBING UIC'S CAREER SCORING LIST:

Josh Mayo became the 19th member of UIC's 1,000 career point club after hitting a jumper at the 15:56 mark of the first half in UIC's win over Cleveland State on Jan. 31. The third-year guard now stands at 1,160 career points, good for 13th place in school history.

JOSH ON A DOUBLE-DIGIT STREAK:

Josh Mayo has scored in double figures in 24 consecutive games, the longest active streak in the Horizon League and the longest stretch of double-digit scoring performances in his career. He has scored in double figures in all but one game this season.

DAILEY IMPACT:

Jermaine Dailey is unleashing his best for last as his college career winds down. In his last eight games Dailey is averaging 7.8 points, 5.8 rebounds and shooting 67.5 percent (27-for-40) from the floor. He has scored 13 or more points in three of UIC's last five games, including a career-high 14 points to go along with a career-best 12 rebounds for his first career double-double at Green Bay on Feb. 28.

IF WE MAKE HALF OF OUR SHOTS, WE WIN:

The formula for success has been pretty simple for UIC this season: shooting 50 percent or better from the field equals a victory. The Flames are a perfect 11-0 when hitting at a clip of 50 percent or better from the floor.

SCOTT'S NEW YEAR'S REBOUNDING RESOLUTION:

Scott VanderMeer's rebounding numbers have jumped since the start of the new year. In 16 games since the calendar switched to 2008, VanderMeer is averaging 8.3 rebounds per game with six double-digit rebounding games under his belt during that span. In 13 games this season that took place at the end of the calendar year 2007, the junior center was pulling down just 5.8 rebounds per contest and rebounded in double figures just once.

DEFENSE DOING THE TRICK:

UIC had allowed foes to score just 56.2 points per game during a stretch of six straight contests prior to this past Thursday's game against Green Bay, as opposed to the 68.2 ppg UIC was allowing prior to that span. During that recent six-game stretch the Flames were forcing foes to shoot just 37.9 percent (124-for-327) from the field collectively. Compare that to the 42.2 percent that opponents have shot all season against the Flames and the 43.0 percent (548-for-1275) UIC's foes shot in the Flames' first 22 games of the season. The 76 points allowed to Green Bay on Feb. 28 was the most UIC has allowed since giving up 76 to Wright State back on Jan. 17.

HOME AND AWAY LIKE NIGHT AND DAY:

It's seems like there have been two UIC teams in 2007-08: a nearly invincible home team and an unpredictable squad on the road. Here are UIC's numbers in 13 home games, 13 true road games and 16 games away from the Pavilion (12 road games and three neutral site contests):

SCOTT A BARRIER TO THE BASKET FOR OPPONENTS:

Scott VanderMeer is one of the nation's leading shot-blockers with 77 swats in 29 games for a Horizon League-leading average of 2.7 bpg. VanderMeer entered the weekend ranked 19th in the country in blocks per game and has recorded seven games with five blocked shots this season. He has totaled 40 blocks over UIC's last 15 games. VanderMeer holds UIC's single-season (111 blocks in 2006-07) and career (188) records for blocked shots, establishing the career mark less than two years into his Flames tenure.

2007-08 UIC FLAMES MEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

SPENCER LENDS A HELPING HAND (WHETHER IT WAS BROKEN OR NOT):

Spencer Stewart has helped ignite the Flames' offense since returning from a six-game hiatus on Jan. 24 after recovering from a broken left hand. Stewart is averaging 5.5 assists per game in his last eight ballgames while giving up just 2.6 turnovers per game, close to an even 2-to-1 assist-to-turnover ratio. He has had at least five assists in his last six games.

A BANNER NIGHT ON THE BOARDS:

Scott VanderMeer's 21-rebound night at Valparaiso on Jan. 24 marked many a milestone. The career-high performance for the Flames' junior center matched Chuck Lambert's 21-rebound game against Northeastern Illinois on Dec. 6, 1974 for the third-most rebounds in a single game by a UIC player. It was also the most in a single game by a Horizon League player this season and the second-best amount all-time by a league player during a league game. VanderMeer's 21 rebounds was also the second-most in a conference game by any Division I player this season according to ESPN.com's Around the Rim. Only Indiana's D.J. White's 22-rebound performance at Michigan on Jan. 8 was better. The showing is tied for the fourth-most rebounds all-time in a single game (league or non-conference) by a player in the Horizon League.

ROBO NOT PLAYING LIKE A ROOKIE:

True freshman Robert Kreps has not looked like a first-year player, with plenty of notable performances to prove it. "Robo" scored in double figures in seven consecutive games from Dec. 1 through Dec. 29, reaching a career-high 19 points twice and averaging 14.4 ppg on 58.1 percent (36-for-62) shooting during that span. Kreps has led UIC in scoring on five different occasions, and in his last five games he is averaging 7.6 ppg while shooting 51.7 percent (15-for-29) from the field and 53.8 percent (7-for-13) from downtown.

UIC SIGNS POSTON, NEELY:

The first two official additions to the 2008-09 UIC men's basketball team have been announced as 6-foot-7 forward Jelani Poston (Chicago, Ill./Harmony Community School [Cincinnati]) and 6-foot-1 guard Zavion Neely (Chicago, Ill./John Hope College Prep) signed National Letters of Intent to play for the Flames beginning next year. UIC HEAD COACH
Jimmy Collins
(191-170, 12th season)

Head Coach Jimmy Collins enters his 12th season at the helm of the UIC men's basketball program. The veteran mentor is not only the winningest coach in school history with 191 career wins, but is also the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois. He has captured a conference regular season title (1998) and two league tournament crowns (2002, 2004) during his tenure, and has guided the Flames to three 20-win seasons in the last five years, including a school-record 24 victories in 2003-04.

Named co-conference coach of the year after his first season with the Flames, Collins has also guided UIC to its only three NCAA Tournament appearances in school history, taking the team to the Big Dance in 1998, 2002 and 2004. He also guided the Flames to their first-ever NIT bid in 2003.

Collins, who served as an assistant coach at Illinois for 13 years prior to his arrival at UIC, earned All-American honors as a player at New Mexico State, averaging 20.1 ppg while leading the Aggies to the Final Four during his senior season.

JIMMY COLLINS FAST FACTS

- * Jimmy Collins was introduced as the ninth head coach in UIC history on March 27, 1996.
- * Collins has propelled UIC to its first three NCAA Tournament bids (1998, 2002, 2004) and first NIT berth (2003) in school history.
- * Collins has led UIC to four 20-win seasons in his 11-plus years on the sidelines: 22 (1997-98); 20 (2001-02); 21 (2002-03); 24 (2003-04).
- * Collins is the program's all-time winningest coach with 191 career victories.
- * Collins has guided UIC to a league regular-season (1998) and two league tournament titles (2002, 2004) during his tenure.
- * Collins is the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois and the second-longest tenured coach in the Horizon League behind Perry Watson of Detroit.
- * Collins was an assistant coach at the University of Illinois under Lou Henson for 13 years, including the 1989 season in which the Fighting Illini advanced to the Final Four.
- * As Illinois' top recruiter, Collins' high-profile Illini signees included: Kendall Gill, Nick Anderson, Marcus Liberty, Deon Thomas, Kiwane Garris and Lowell Hamilton.
- * Collins is the co-chairman of the Chicago Special Olympics.
- * Collins and his family are heavily involved with the Lupus Foundation of America Illinois Chapter. His daughter, Erica, serves on the Board of Directors for the Illinois Chapter.
- * Collins, as well as the rest of his 1970 New Mexico State Final Four squad, were inducted into the school's Hall of Fame on Feb. 7th, 2004.
- * Collins is a former first-round draft pick of the Chicago Bulls (1970).
- * Collins served as a hearing officer for the Cook County Probation Department prior to his appointment as an assistant coach at Illinois.
