UIC brings a five-game winning streak into Saturday's contest at Akron...The Flames begin a three-game road trek through Ohio against the Zips, following Saturday's game with consecutive Horizon League contests against Youngstown State and Cleveland State...UIC is currently in its best 12-game start to a season since starting the 2003-04 campaign 9-3...Junior guard Josh Mayo paces the Flames and the entire Horizon League with 19.0 points per game...Mayo is averaging 23.8 ppg on 60 percent (36-for-60) shooting from the field during UIC's current winning streak...Freshman reserve guard Robert Kreps has scored in double figures in every game during the Flames' win streak, averaging 14.4 ppg in 22.2 minutes per contest in the last five games...UIC is outscoring foes by an average of 16.2 ppg during the win streak...The Flames are 2-0 vs. Mid-American Conference teams thus far in 2007-08... Akron is paced by Jeremiah Wood's 13.7 ppg, one of four Zips scoring nine or more points per game.

Zip Notes: Akron enters Saturday's game with a 9-2 record, fueled by a pair of four-game winning streaks in its last nine games. The Zips have won four in a row heading into their game with the Flames, defeating UIC's Horizon League mate Youngstown State in a 79-59 victory at Rhodes Arena on Dec. 21st. The Zips are scoring 74.5 points per game and outscoring their foes by an average margin of 12.2 points per game. Senior forward Jeremiah Wood leads the Akron attack with 13.7 ppg and 9.6 rpg. Senior guards Nick Dials (12.6 ppg) and Chicago-area native Cedrick Middleton (11.5 ppg) also average in double figures. Akron is 6-0 at home this year. Head coach Keith Dambrot is in his fourth season at the helm of the Zips with a career record of 77-29.

UIC AND AKRON, THE SERIES:

The Flames and the Zips have met on six prior occasions, with the Flames holding a 4-2 advantage. The last meeting between the two teams took place last season, with UIC winning an 86-80 decision over the Zips at the Pavilion. UIC and Akron were conference mates for two seasons in the Mid-Continent Conference, splitting four meetings as league foes during the 1990-91 and 1991-92 seasons.

LAST TIME WE MET:**UIC 86, Akron 80 – Dec. 16, 2006 (UIC Pavilion)**

Five Flames scored in double figures to pace UIC to an 86-80 win over visiting Akron at the Pavilion. T.J. Gray scored a team-high 19 points on 5-for-9 shooting from behind the arc. Josh Mayo scored 14 points, while Scott VanderMeer pitched in 11 points, nine rebounds and four blocked shots. Trailing 76-73 with just over two minutes remaining, UIC went on a 7-0 spurt that began a 13-4 game-closing run to rally for the win. Akron's Romeo Travis scored a game-high 24 points, followed by 15 from Cedrick Middleton and 13 from Nick Dials.

A QUICK LOOK BACK:**UIC 97, Howard 58 – Dec. 22, 2007 (UIC Pavilion)**

There was plenty of holiday cheer at the UIC Pavilion following UIC's 97-58 victory over visiting Howard last Saturday afternoon. The Flames extended their winning streak to five games and remained a perfect 6-0 at home this season after picking up a decisive victory in their final game at the Pavilion in the calendar year. Karl White Jr. scored a career-high 20 points to lead the way, while teammates Josh Mayo (18 points), Robert Kreps (13), Jermaine Dailey (10) and Robert Bush (10) also scored in double figures. UIC was balanced on both ends in a game that featured the Flames' biggest margin of victory since a 40-point win over North Central on Dec. 8, 2001. Defensively the Flames forced the Bison into 31 turnovers while finishing with a Pavilion-record 25 steals. Mayo led the way with four thefts. On the offensive end UIC scored the most points in a regulation game since putting up 102 in a win against Milwaukee on Jan. 9, 2003.

COMMON FOE:

The one opponent that both UIC and Akron have already played in 2007-08 is Winthrop. The Eagles have defeated both the Flames (72-58 on Nov. 16) and the Zips (68-58 on Dec. 4) this year.

WHAT'S UP NEXT:

The Flames will return home in time for the calendar to switch to 2008 before heading back to Ohio to play their first Horizon League road games of the season, facing Youngstown State on Jan. 3 and Cleveland State on Jan. 5.

UIC AND THE MAC:

UIC enters Saturday's game with Akron owning an all-time record of 34-30 against teams currently in the Mid-American Conference. The Flames are 2-0 against the MAC this season after wins against Central Michigan and Toledo.

STARTING TO STREAK:

The Flames are currently on a season-high five-game winning streak. Here are some of the keys to UIC's recent success:

- * Since Dec. 6 junior guard Josh Mayo has averaged 23.8 points per game, scoring 18 points or more in each game.
- * UIC is averaging 83.0 points per game while shooting 53.2 percent (151-for-284) from the field during the streak.
- * The Flames are outscoring their opponents by an average of 16.2 ppg during the last five wins.
- * Freshman guard Robert Kreps has been on fire, averaging 14.4 ppg and shooting 59.5 percent (25-for-42) from the floor. Kreps is 15-of-28 (53.6 percent) from beyond the three-point line during the last five games.
- * The Flames' regular starting five of Mayo, Spencer Stewart, Scott VanderMeer, Karl White Jr. and Jermaine Dailey are a combined 96-for-167 from the field for a collective clip of 57.5 percent in the last five games.
- * Three of UIC's regular starting five are shooting 50 percent or better from the field during the last five games: Mayo (60.0 percent), VanderMeer (50 percent) and Dailey (87.5 percent).
- * UIC has received superb inside scoring efficiency. Center Scott VanderMeer and forward Jermaine Dailey are shooting a combined 62 percent (31-for-50) from the floor in UIC's last five games.

CAN'T HOLD THE MAYO:

Most of the summer publicity about UIC centered on junior guard Josh Mayo, a preseason All-Horizon League selection. The third-year Flames standout has showed this season that he is more than capable of handling the high expectations as he leads the team and the entire Horizon League in scoring (19.0 ppg) and three-point shooting (60.6 percent) while ranking second on the team in assists (3.42 apg) and field goal percentage (54.8 percent).

MORE MAYO:

- * Mayo is one of just two players in the nation to shoot over 50 percent from the field and from behind the arc while also shooting over 90 percent from the free throw line. Mayo is shooting 54.8 percent (69-for-126) from the floor, 60.6 percent (40-for-66) from three-point land and 90.9 percent (50-for-55) from the charity stripe. Only Utah State's Jaycee Carroll can claim the same feat, with Carroll shooting 53.6 percent (103-for-192) from the field, 51.6 percent (47-for-91) from behind the three-point line and 94.5 percent (52-for-55) from the foul line.
- * In UIC's opener versus Bradley on Nov. 10, the Merrillville, Ind., native scored a career-best 34 points, eight better than his previous single-game high, to key the Flames' 84-75 win.
- * Mayo's 34-point performance is the highest point production in a single game by any Horizon League player so far this season.
- * Mayo scored 29 points in just 27 minutes against Milwaukee on Dec. 6. He shot 10-for-12 from the field, including 5-for-6 from beyond the arc, and tallied 16 of those points in 13 second-half minutes.
- * The junior guard followed up his 29-point performance against Milwaukee with a 32-point surge against Green Bay two days later. He scored 20 of his 32 points in the first half, propelled by 6-for-7 shooting from downtown in the opening stanza. The six treys in the first half were the most Mayo has ever hit in one period.
- * Mayo scored 16 of his game-high 22 points in the second half to rally UIC from a seven-point halftime deficit to defeat Toledo, 66-56, on Dec. 19.
- * In six home games this season Mayo is averaging 24.7 points per game. At the Pavilion in 2007-08 he is shooting 64.9 percent (48-for-74) from the field and 67.6 percent (25-for-37) from three-point land.
- * In 12 games this season Mayo has scored in double-figures in all but one.
- * UIC's leading scorer in seven of its 12 games has been Mayo.
- * Mayo has drained at least one three-pointer in every game this season. He has made a three-point field goal in 15 consecutive contests dating back to last season.
- * The junior guard has hit his last 24 free throw attempts, all during the Flames' five-game winning streak.

HOME SWEET HOME:

In six games at home this season UIC has shot 54.1 percent (180-for-333) from the field and 54.6 percent (65-for-119) from behind the three-point line. UIC has shot 50 percent or better from the field in five of its six home games, including a 60 percent performance against Milwaukee on Dec. 6. The only game the Flames did not finish with 50 percent shooting from the field at home this year was against Green Bay on Dec. 8, a contest in which they shot 49 percent from the floor.

KARL HAS A CAREER DAY:

Senior guard Karl White Jr. scored a career-best 20 points on 9-for-11 shooting in just 20 minutes against Howard on Dec. 22. White eclipsed his previous high of 17 he set as a rookie during the 2004-05 season.

DAILEY STARTS TO BECOME A PRESENCE:

Since earning his first start of the season against Central Michigan on Nov. 28 and getting five more starting nods since, senior Jermaine Dailey is averaging 6.3 points, 4.5 rebounds and 2.0 blocks per game in which he is among the first five on the floor. He is averaging 5.5 rebounds in UIC's last four games. UIC is 5-1 with Dailey in the starting lineup this year. Dailey has made his last 11 field goal attempts dating back to Dec. 8.

STARTING OFF LEAGUE PLAY RIGHT:

UIC is 2-0 in Horizon League play for the second straight season following a nine-point win over Green Bay on Dec. 8. The Flames won their Horizon League opener for the third straight season after their 91-73 win over Milwaukee on Dec. 6. The last time UIC went 2-0 in conference play in consecutive seasons was a string of four straight 2-0 league starts from 1991-92 through 1994-95.

ROBO A SCORING MACHINE:

True freshman Robert Kreps has elevated his offensive game of late. The rookie reserve guard has scored in double figures in each of the last six games, averaging 13.7 points per game in 22.5 minutes off the bench during that span. He scored a career-high 19 points against DePaul on Dec. 15, hitting a career-best four of his six three-point attempts. During his recent hot six-game stretch Kreps is shooting 57.1 percent (28-for-49) from the field and 53.1 percent (17-for-32) from beyond the arc.

DOWNTOWN - WHERE EVERYTHING'S WAITING FOR UIC:

Much of UIC's success this season has come from its outside shooting. UIC is hitting three-pointers at a Horizon League-leading clip of 46 percent (103-for-224), almost as good as its overall field goal percentage (48 percent, 313-for-652). The Flames are averaging 8.6 successful treys per game this season, with Josh Mayo leading the way with an average of 3.3 successful three-point attempts and a 60.6 percent (40-for-66) showing from behind the arc this season. UIC is 77-for-150 (51.3 percent) from downtown in eight wins and just 26-for-74 (35.1 percent) from behind the arc in four losses.

SCOTT SCORING MORE:

The work that junior center Scott VanderMeer put in on his offensive game throughout the offseason is already paying off early in the 2007-08 season. So far VanderMeer has a personal-best single-season average of 9.5 points per game, putting up a career-high 19 in UIC's win over UIS on Nov. 13 and adding 16 against Central Michigan on Nov. 28. He has scored in double digits in six of UIC's first 12 contests. Compare that to his 2006-07 numbers of 5.1 ppg, six out of 32 games with double-figure scoring and a career-high point output of 12.

THE MORE POINTS, THE BETTER:

UIC seems to do much better when the scoring gets higher. Six of the Flames' eight wins have featured UIC outputs of 76 points or more, while all four of UIC's losses have featured final outputs of 63 points or lower by the Flames. UIC has scored 65 points or more in all eight of its wins.

INTERMISSION INDICATOR:

The Flames' status at halftime has been a pretty good indicator of the final outcome of the game. UIC has led heading into intermission in seven of its eight wins, while the Flames have went into the break trailing or tied in all four of their defeats. The only time UIC trailed at halftime and went on to win the game was a 66-56 come-from-behind win over Toledo on Dec. 19.

BUTTELL GETS BOARDS:

Sophomore forward Jeremy Buttell has shown strong ability to rebound in his first 12 games in a Flames uniform. Buttell is averaging 5.6 rebounds, the second-most on the team, mostly as a reserve. He has five games with nine or more caroms, including four double-digit rebounding performances. Buttell is averaging 6.4 rebounds during UIC's current five-game winning streak.

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS:

Outside of the Flames' 0-3 early-season trip to the U.S. Virgin Islands Paradise Jam that was part of a brutal stretch of five games in nine days and three contests in four days, UIC has done well in the non-conference portion of its slate. The Flames are 6-1 in non-conference contests on the mainland, averaging 75.0 points per game against foes outside the Horizon League in a non-tournament setting. UIC has beaten foes from the BIG EAST (DePaul), Missouri Valley (Bradley) and Mid-American Conference (Central Michigan, Toledo).

2007-08 UIC FLAMES MEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

UIC SIGNS POSTON, NEELY:

The first two official additions to the 2008-09 UIC men's basketball team have been announced as 6-foot-7 forward Jelani Poston (Chicago, Ill./Harmony Community School [Cincinnati]) and 6-foot-1 guard Zavion Neely (Chicago, Ill./John Hope College Prep) signed National Letters of Intent to play for the Flames beginning next year. Poston averaged 18 points and 11 rebounds per game as a junior at Chicago's Boys to Men Academy in 2006-07 and is considered by Rivals.com as the Horizon League's top power forward prospect. Neely is a highly-acclaimed combo guard at Hope, where he is considered one of the best players in the Chicago Public League's competitive Red Central.

BOYD A BREATH OF FRESH-MAN AIR:

Freshman forward Tori Boyd made an exciting debut in a UIC uniform against Bradley on Nov. 10. The 6-foot-5 rookie wing scored 11 points on 4-for-9 shooting from the field and netted two clutch treys to spur a 9-0 UIC run in the first half. Boyd made his first collegiate start against Central Michigan on Nov. 30 and scored nine points, pulled down a season-best six boards and hit another clutch trey in the second half to help the Flames cease a late Chippewa run. In two starts this season Boyd is averaging 9.0 points and 3.5 rebounds when among the first five on the floor.

MAYO TAKES ADVANTAGE OF THE CHARITY STRIPE:

UIC guard Josh Mayo's consecutive free throws made streak ended at a school-record 38 against Winthrop on Nov. 16. Mayo went 20 for his last 20 from the foul line in 2006-07 and began this season 18-for-18 until missing his final attempt against the Eagles. The streak lasted a span of seven games. His 38 consecutive free throws converted eclipsed the old mark of 36 set by Bill Merchantz (which was set over a span of 10 games) in 1977-78. Since his last miss against Illinois State on Dec. 1, Mayo has made his last 24 free throw attempts.

BLOCK PARTY:

UIC center Scott VanderMeer had 10 games last season in which he recorded at least five blocked shots. He has already notched five-block games in four of UIC's first 12 contests of 2007-08. VanderMeer leads the league in total blocks (36) and blocks per game (3.0) while rating 12th nationally in bpg as of Dec. 28.

NEW ADDITION:

The Flames added walk-on guard Humberto Huerta to the roster at the end of the fall semester. Huerta, who attended Chicago's Lane Tech H.S., will practice with the team and dress for home games.

UIC HEAD COACH
Jimmy Collins
(184-160, 12th season)

Head Coach Jimmy Collins enters his 12th season at the helm of the UIC men's basketball program. The veteran mentor is not only the winningest coach in school history with 184 career wins, but is also the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois. He has captured a conference regular season title (1998) and two league tournament crowns (2002, 2004) during his tenure, and has guided the Flames to three 20-win seasons in the last five years, including a school-record 24 victories in 2003-04.

Named co-conference coach of the year after his first season with the Flames, Collins has also guided UIC to its only three NCAA Tournament appearances in school history, taking the team to the Big Dance in 1998, 2002 and 2004. He also guided the Flames to their first-ever NIT bid in 2003.

Collins, who served as an assistant coach at Illinois for 13 years prior to his arrival at UIC, earned All-American honors as a player at New Mexico State, averaging 20.1 ppg while leading the Aggies to the Final Four during his senior season.

JIMMY COLLINS FAST FACTS

- * Jimmy Collins was introduced as the ninth head coach in UIC history on March 27, 1996.
- * Collins has propelled UIC to its first three NCAA Tournament bids (1998, 2002, 2004) and first NIT berth (2003) in school history.
- * Collins has led UIC to four 20-win seasons in his 11-plus years on the sidelines: 22 (1997-98); 20 (2001-02); 21 (2002-03); 24 (2003-04).
- * Collins is the program's all-time winningest coach with 184 career victories.
- * Collins has guided UIC to a league regular-season (1998) and two league tournament titles (2002, 2004) during his tenure.
- * Collins is the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois and the second-longest tenured coach in the Horizon League behind Perry Watson of Detroit.
- * Collins was an assistant coach at the University of Illinois under Lou Henson for 13 years, including the 1989 season in which the Fighting Illini advanced to the Final Four.
- * As Illinois' top recruiter, Collins' high-profile Illini signees included: Kendall Gill, Nick Anderson, Marcus Liberty, Deon Thomas, Kiwane Garris and Lowell Hamilton.
- * Collins is the co-chairman of the Chicago Special Olympics.
- * Collins and his family are heavily involved with the Lupus Foundation of America Illinois Chapter. His daughter, Erica, serves on the Board of Directors for the Illinois Chapter.
- * Collins, as well as the rest of his 1970 New Mexico State Final Four squad, were inducted into the school's Hall of Fame on Feb. 7th, 2004.
- * Collins is a former first-round draft pick of the Chicago Bulls (1970).
- * Collins served as a hearing officer for the Cook County Probation Department prior to his appointment as an assistant coach at Illinois.
