UIC will close out its regular season home schedule on Wednesday night with a Horizon League contest against nationally-ranked Butler at the UIC Pavilion...The Flames defeated then-No. 12 Butler in overtime, 73-67, in the last meeting between the two teams at the Pavilion on Jan. 10, 2007...UIC has given up 55 points or less in three of its last four games and is allowing an average of just 57.0 ppg during that span...Sophomore point guard Spencer Stewart has handed out six assists in each of the last three games and is averaging 5.8 assists per game in UIC's last five contests...Junior guard Josh Mayo continues to pace UIC in scoring at 18.1 ppg...Mayo is scoring an average of 10.3 of his points in the second half alone... UIC is 11-1 at home this year and has won 14 of its last 15 at the Pavilion...The game marks just the fourth time that a Top 25 team has played UIC at the Pavilion...UIC is 2-1 all-time against ranked foes at home...A win would help the Flames surpass their 2006-07 victory total of 14.

Bulldog Notes: Butler enters Wednesday's contest on an eight-game winning streak, its third such run of consecutive victories this season. Only top-ranked Memphis (25-0) has a better record than the Bulldogs to date. Butler is ranked eighth in both the ESPN/USA Today coaches' poll and the Associated Press Top 25, making the Bulldogs the highest-ranked Horizon League team in history. Senior point guard Mike Green paces Butler with 15.1 points per game while also pulling down a team-leading 6.3 rebounds per contest. Along with the three-point threats of seniors A.J. Graves (76-for-216 3PT FGM-A) and Pete Campbell (69-for-157 3PT FGM-A), Butler also has an inside presence with freshman forward Matt Howard (.600 field goal percentage, 5.7 rpg). Brad Stevens is in his first year as Butler's head coach after serving the last six as an assistant at Butler.

UIC AND BUTLER, THE SERIES:

UIC is 11-23 all-time against Butler. The Bulldogs have won two in a row over the Flames, both at Hinkle Fieldhouse, and five of the last six. The Flames are 7-8 against Butler at the UIC Pavilion.

LAST TIME WE MET:**Butler 73, UIC 57 – Jan. 26, 2008 (Indianapolis, Ind.)**

UIC suffered a 73-57 loss at No. 14/15 Butler inside Hinkle Fieldhouse. Josh Mayo scored 19 to lead the Flames. Scott VanderMeer scored 12 points and grabbed seven rebounds. The Bulldogs went on a 12-0 run early in the first half to build a lead it would not relinquish. Butler shot 68 percent (17-for-25) in the opening period to take a 43-30 lead into halftime. UIC would get within eight on two separate occasions in the second half, but the Flames could get no closer.

LAST TIME WE MET AT THE PAVILION:**UIC 73, No. 12 Butler 67 – Jan. 10, 2007**

Josh Mayo scored 19 points and hit a big three-pointer in overtime to lead the Flames to a wild 73-67 victory over No. 12 Butler at the UIC Pavilion. The Flames had never defeated a team ranked that high. Butler's A.J. Graves scored a season-high 31 points, 26 in the second half and three in overtime, but it wasn't enough to hold off the Flames, who led for nearly the entire game. After going 0-for-7 from three-point range in the first 20 minutes, Graves hit 6 of 10 second-half 3-pointers. The guard hit a deep three to cut the deficit to 58-56 with 20 seconds to go, then drew a foul and hit both free throws with 16.3 seconds left to send the game to overtime. The Bulldogs led twice early in overtime but UIC went 3-for-3 on three-pointers and 6-for-6 from the free throw line in the extra period. Jovan Stefanov's second three in OT made it 66-64. Butler retook the lead when Graves matched it, but Mayo responded with a three-pointer for the Flames, and Gray finished Butler off with four straight free throws.

UIC will head to Cedar Falls, Iowa to face Northern Iowa as part of the O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters this Saturday, Feb. 23 at 7:05 p.m. Central.

SENIOR NIGHT:

The Flames will celebrate Senior Night prior to Wednesday's game. This year's UIC men's basketball senior class includes Robert Bush, Jermaine Dailey, Ebenezer Noonoo and Karl White Jr.

A QUICK LOOK BACK:

Wright State 52, UIC 51 - Feb. 16, 2008 (Dayton, Ohio)

A pair of free throws by Wright State's Cooper Land with 6.9 seconds left were the difference in UIC's 52-51 loss to the Raiders at the Ervin J. Nutter Center on Saturday night. Josh Mayo paced all scorers with 16 points, scoring 14 of those in the second half for the Flames. UIC led for a majority of the final period, going up by as many as six points with just over four minutes remaining after Mayo hit his fourth three-pointer of the second half. With the Flames nursing a two-point lead, it was deja vu as a driving Duggins found Brown in the right corner for a go-ahead three-pointer with 58 seconds on the game clock. A last second three by Brown in the right corner on a pass from Duggins was the same play that helped the Raiders pull out a one-point win over the Flames in Chicago on Jan. 17. The Flames regained the lead after Scott VanderMeer put back a missed runner in the lane by Mayo with 19 seconds to go. As the clock ran down Land drove baseline and ran into VanderMeer, who was whistled for a foul that sent Land to the charity stripe for a pair. The Raider freshman calmly swished in both from the line to put Wright State up 52-51. Mayo heaved a desperation attempt from three-quarters court that looked on line but bounced off the top of the rim as time ran out.

CAN'T HOLD THE MAYO:

Most of the summer publicity about UIC centered on junior guard Josh Mayo, a preseason All-Horizon League selection. The third-year Flames standout has showed this season that he is more than capable of handling the high expectations as he leads the team in scoring (18.1 ppg) and three-point shooting (51.9 percent). His scoring average is the second-best in the Horizon League, while his three-point shooting is the best in the nation.

ONE OF THE BEST BEYOND THE ARC:

UIC remains one of the nation's most accurate three-point shooting teams according to the most recent NCAA Division I statistical rankings released on Tuesday, Feb. 19. The Flames own the country's fifth-best percentage from behind the three-point line at 41.4 percent (204-for-493).

JOSH AT THE TOP OF THE CHARTS:

UIC's main deep threat is junior guard Josh Mayo. For the sixth week in a row Mayo leads all of NCAA Division I in individual three-point field goal percentage, standing atop the rankings as of Tuesday, Feb. 19 at 51.9 percent (83-for-160). In 15 Horizon League games Mayo is hitting from downtown at a rate of 51.0 percent (52-for-102). At home his three-point accuracy is more impressive; Mayo has missed just 18 of his 72 three-point attempts at the UIC Pavilion, good for a success rate of 63.2 percent from behind the Pavilion's arcs.

THE REVENGE FACTOR:

UIC has done well in exacting a little payback against Horizon League teams. So far the Flames have picked up home wins over all three league teams that they have lost to on the road. After suffering defeats to Youngstown State, Cleveland State and Valparaiso away from the Pavilion, UIC has beaten all three at home in the second meeting against each team. Butler is the only team left of the league crop in which UIC has lost to on the road before the second meeting takes place at the Pavilion.

THE THREE-BALL A GOOD GAUGE FOR SUCCESS:

Much of UIC's success in the win-loss column has been contingent on its success shooting the basketball from beyond the three-point arc. In 14 wins the Flames have shot 48.2 percent (124-for-257) from behind the three-point line, while UIC has posted a 33.9 (80-for-236) three-point field goal percentage in 12 defeats.

MAYO MAKES MANY FROM LONG RANGE:

Josh Mayo is averaging 3.19 successful three-point attempts per contest to lead the Horizon League in the category and rank 26th nationally in treys made per game. He has made three or more three-point baskets in a game on 16 different occasions this year, including a five-game stretch with four treys or more from Dec. 6 through Dec. 22. Mayo has canned at least three treys in six of his last seven games.

KARL POURING IN THE POINTS OF LATE:

Senior guard Karl White Jr. entered the 2007-08 season with a career-high point output of 17 that was set as a rookie in the 2004-05 campaign. White had only scored in double figures on 12 occasions in 70 games prior to this year. Through 24 games this season White has already scored in double figures 10 times, including seven of his last 14 games, and has posted 19 or more points on four occasions.

MAYO CLIMBING UIC'S CAREER SCORING LIST:

Josh Mayo became the 19th member of UIC's 1,000 career point club after hitting a jumper at the 15:56 mark of the first half in UIC's win over Cleveland State on Jan. 31. The third-year guard now stands at 1,114 career points, tying Jordan Kardos for 14th place on UIC's all-time scoring list. Mayo is also just seven points away from entering the Horizon League's all-time Top 100 scoring list.

JOSH RAISES HIS SIGHTS AGAINST LEAGUE FOES:

Josh Mayo's numbers against Horizon League foes so far this season are pretty impressive. He is averaging 19.5 points per league game, shooting 47.2 percent (91-for-193) from the floor and 51.0 percent (52-for-102) from downtown in 15 conference contests while scoring 16 or more points in all but three of those games.

SCOTT'S NEW YEAR'S REBOUNDING RESOLUTION:

Scott VanderMeer's rebounding numbers have jumped since the start of the new year. In 13 games since the calendar switched to 2008, VanderMeer is averaging 9.2 rebounds per game with six double-digit rebounding games under his belt during that span. In 13 games this season that took place at the end of the calendar year 2007, the junior center was pulling down just 5.8 rebounds per contest and rebounded in double figures just once.

FLAMES LOVE HOME COOKIN':

There's been something about the UIC Pavilion that has brought out the best in its occupant this season. The Flames are a 11-1 at home in 2007-08 and have won 14 of their last 15 at the Pavilion dating back to last year. UIC is shooting 51.4 percent (340-for-661) from the field as a team at home and 50.4 percent (118-for-234) from beyond the Pavilion's three-point arcs. The Flames are averaging over 10 more points at home (80.0) than their season average (69.8) and outscore opponents at the Pavilion by a 14.5-point margin. UIC has shot 50 percent or better at home on nine occasions this year.

FLAMES AT HOME AGAINST THE TOP 25:

UIC has hosted a Top 25 team on three previous occasions prior to Wednesday's game against No. 8 Butler at the Pavilion. The Feb. 20 game versus the Bulldogs marks the latest point in a season that a ranked team has come to the Pavilion. Here's how UIC has fared against Top 25 teams at the Pavilion:

DEFENSE DOING THE TRICK:

UIC has allowed foes to score just 60.0 points per game in the last five contests, as opposed to the 68.0 ppg UIC was allowing prior to that span. During that five-game stretch the Flames are forcing foes to shoot just 37.8 percent (111-for-294) from the field collectively. Compare that to the 42.2 percent that opponents have shot all season against the Flames and the 43.3 percent (523-for-1208) UIC's foes were shooting in the Flames' first 21 games of the season.

HOME AND AWAY LIKE NIGHT AND DAY:

It's seems like there have been two UIC teams in 2007-08: a nearly invincible home team and an unpredictable squad on the road. Here are UIC's numbers in 12 home games, 11 true road games and 14 games away from the Pavilion (11 road games and three neutral site contests):

2007-08 UIC FLAMES MEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

MAYO SECONDS THAT EMOTION:

Josh Mayo has been doing most of his damage in the second half of late. In his last six games Mayo has scored in double figures after intermission on four occasions and has averaged 12.5 points in the game's final 20 minutes over the course of his last six outings. He is averaging 19.3 ppg overall during that same span. For the season Mayo is averaging 10.3 ppg of his total average of 18.1 ppg following halftime.

SCOTT A BARRIER TO THE BASKET FOR OPPONENTS:

Scott VanderMeer is one of the nation's leading shot-blockers with 73 swats in 26 games for a Horizon League-leading average of 2.8 bpg. VanderMeer entered the week ranked 16th in the country in blocks per game and has recorded seven games with five blocked shots this season. He has totaled 36 blocks in UIC's last 12 games. VanderMeer holds UIC's single-season (111 blocks in 2006-07) and career (182) records for blocked shots.

A BANNER NIGHT ON THE BOARDS:

Scott VanderMeer's 21-rebound night at Valparaiso on Jan. 24 marked many a milestone. The career-high performance for the Flames' junior center matched Chuck Lambert's 21-rebound game against Northeastern Illinois on Dec. 6, 1974 for the third-most rebounds in a single game by a UIC player. It was also the most in a single game by a Horizon League player this season and the second-best amount all-time by a league player during a league game. VanderMeer's 21 rebounds was also the second-most in a conference game by any Division I player this season according to ESPN.com's Around the Rim. Only Indiana's D.J. White's 22-rebound performance at Michigan on Jan. 8 was better. The showing is tied for the fourth-most rebounds all-time in a single game (league or non-conference) by a player in the Horizon League.

ROBO NOT PLAYING LIKE A ROOKIE:

True freshman Robert Kreps has not looked like a first-year player, with plenty of notable performances to prove it. "Robo" scored in double figures in seven consecutive games from Dec. 1 through Dec. 29, reaching a career-high 19 points twice and averaging 14.4 ppg on 58.1 percent (36-for-62) shooting during that span. Kreps scored a team-leading 15 points in 21 minutes off the bench last Thursday at Detroit, the fifth time this season that Kreps has led UIC in scoring.

HIGH-SCORING AFFAIRS SUIT FLAMES FINE:

The results are much better for UIC as the scoring gets higher. The Flames are 11-2 when scoring 70 or more points and a perfect 6-0 when reaching 80-plus points. UIC is just 3-10 when posting 69 points or less.

UIC SIGNS POSTON, NEELY:

The first two official additions to the 2008-09 UIC men's basketball team have been announced as 6-foot-7 forward Jelani Poston (Chicago, Ill./Harmony Community School [Cincinnati]) and 6-foot-1 guard Zavion Neely (Chicago, Ill./John Hope College Prep) signed National Letters of Intent to play for the Flames beginning next year. Poston averaged 18 points and 11 rebounds per game as a junior at Chicago's Boys to Men Academy in 2006-07 and is considered by Rivals.com as the Horizon League's top power forward prospect. Neely is a highly-acclaimed combo guard at Hope, where he is considered one of the best players in the Chicago Public League's competitive Red Central.

SPENCE = WINNING:

The Flames are better with point guard Spencer Stewart in the starting lineup. UIC is 12-6 this year with Stewart among the first five on the floor, as opposed to 2-4 without his services at all and 0-2 with him coming off the bench. The Flames have won nine of their last 11 games with Stewart as a starter and are 18-12 the past two seasons when Stewart starts. All three of UIC's winning streaks this year have involved Stewart starting each game during the Flames' respective runs of victory.

BENCH PRODUCTION:

The Flames have received increased offense from the bench in their last five games, as UIC's reserves have outscored opposing reserves 128-90. Robert Kreps and Karl White Jr. have led the bench charge with 8.8 ppg and 7.2 ppg, respectively, in that span. Jovan Ignjatovic has been pretty efficient off the bench of late as well. The sophomore forward has made his last six field goal attempts over the last four games and has shot 80.0 percent (8-for-10) from the floor over his last five outings, a span in which he is averaging 8.0 minutes per contest.

DAILEY IMPACT:

Senior forward Jermaine Dailey made the most of his start against Detroit last Thursday, scoring a career-high 13 points on a 6-for-7 performance from the field. In his last four starts Dailey is averaging 7.3 ppg, 4.0 rpg and shooting 70.0 percent (12-for-14) from the floor.

CLOSE CALLS:

Saturday's 52-51 defeat at Wright State was UIC's third loss of the year to come by just a single point. The Flames don't prefer close games; the closest games UIC has won this season came by five points (on two occasions), while 11 of UIC's 14 wins have come by nine or more points.

BRING ON A BIG CROWD:

As of Tuesday afternoon less than 30 tickets remained for Wednesday's contest between UIC and Butler at the Pavilion. The biggest crowd of the year at the Pavilion was UIC's season opener against Bradley on Nov. 10, 2007, which brought in 6,080 fans. The Pavilion attendance record was set on Nov. 22, 1996 against Illinois in Jimmy Collins' first game as UIC head coach. The game brought in a record 8,715 fans, a mark that can never be reached again due to the reconfiguration of seating at the Pavilion, which is now listed at holding just 8,000 fans.

APPROACHING A PAVILION RECORD:

If UIC can beat No. 8 Butler this Wednesday and secure a home game for the Horizon League Tournament on March 4, that will set up this year's squad to match the best record for a Flames team at the Pavilion. UIC had a school record 13-1 mark at the Pavilion during the 1997-98 campaign.

NEARING 200:

After securing career victory No. 190 last Monday against Valparaiso, UIC head coach Jimmy Collins is now just 10 wins shy of 200 career wins. Collins is already UIC's all-time winningest coach after winning for the 134th time as the Flames' mentor against UNC Wilmington on Dec. 12, 2004.

A BANNER SCORING SEASON:

With four regular season games left and at least one game in the Horizon League Tournament, Josh Mayo can continue to cement his name among UIC's all-time greatest scorers. Mayo needs just 23 points to score the most points in a Flames uniform in a single season since Cedrick Banks put up 541 in 2004-05.

AN ELITE GROUP:

Josh Mayo enters Wednesday's game with 1,114 career points, 257 career assists and 95 career steals. The only Flames to ever score over 1,000 points, hand out over 300 assists and pilfer at least 100 steals are Craig Lathen (1981-85) and Kenny Williams (1990-94).

UIC HEAD COACH
Jimmy Collins
(190-168, 12th season)

Head Coach Jimmy Collins enters his 12th season at the helm of the UIC men's basketball program. The veteran mentor is not only the winningest coach in school history with 190 career wins, but is also the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois. He has captured a conference regular season title (1998) and two league tournament crowns (2002, 2004) during his tenure, and has guided the Flames to three 20-win seasons in the last five years, including a school-record 24 victories in 2003-04.

Named co-conference coach of the year after his first season with the Flames, Collins has also guided UIC to its only three NCAA Tournament appearances in school history, taking the team to the Big Dance in 1998, 2002 and 2004. He also guided the Flames to their first-ever NIT bid in 2003.

Collins, who served as an assistant coach at Illinois for 13 years prior to his arrival at UIC, earned All-American honors as a player at New Mexico State, averaging 20.1 ppg while leading the Aggies to the Final Four during his senior season.

JIMMY COLLINS FAST FACTS

- * Jimmy Collins was introduced as the ninth head coach in UIC history on March 27, 1996.
- * Collins has propelled UIC to its first three NCAA Tournament bids (1998, 2002, 2004) and first NIT berth (2003) in school history.
- * Collins has led UIC to four 20-win seasons in his 11-plus years on the sidelines: 22 (1997-98); 20 (2001-02); 21 (2002-03); 24 (2003-04).
- * Collins is the program's all-time winningest coach with 190 career victories.
- * Collins has guided UIC to a league regular-season (1998) and two league tournament titles (2002, 2004) during his tenure.
- * Collins is the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois and the second-longest tenured coach in the Horizon League behind Perry Watson of Detroit.
- * Collins was an assistant coach at the University of Illinois under Lou Henson for 13 years, including the 1989 season in which the Fighting Illini advanced to the Final Four.
- * As Illinois' top recruiter, Collins' high-profile Illini signees included: Kendall Gill, Nick Anderson, Marcus Liberty, Deon Thomas, Kiwane Garris and Lowell Hamilton.
- * Collins is the co-chairman of the Chicago Special Olympics.
- * Collins and his family are heavily involved with the Lupus Foundation of America Illinois Chapter. His daughter, Erica, serves on the Board of Directors for the Illinois Chapter.
- * Collins, as well as the rest of his 1970 New Mexico State Final Four squad, were inducted into the school's Hall of Fame on Feb. 7th, 2004.
- * Collins is a former first-round draft pick of the Chicago Bulls (1970).
- * Collins served as a hearing officer for the Cook County Probation Department prior to his appointment as an assistant coach at Illinois.
