UIC will cap a three-game road string in Ohio with a Horizon League contest at Cleveland State this Saturday night...The Flames will seek to snap a two-game skid... UIC is averaging 79.3 points per game in its last three contests...The Flames have won five in a row on the road at Cleveland State dating back to 2002-03...Senior guard Karl White Jr. has scored 20-plus points in his last two games... Junior guard Josh Mayo is averaging 18.4 points per game overall and 26.0 ppg in three Horizon League games... Mayo is shooting 70 percent (14-for-20) from three-point range in league action...Senior forward Jermaine Dailey has averaged 5.8 rebounds per game in 20.5 minutes per contest in the Flames' last six games...Junior center Scott VanderMeer has pulled down an average of 9.0 rebounds per game in UIC's last pair of games...Sophomore forward Jeremy Buttell is averaging 6.6 rpg in 17.0 mpg off the bench since Dec. 15...Cleveland State is paced by Cedric Jackson's 15.7 ppg.

**Viking Notes:** Cleveland State heads into Saturday's game 9-5 overall and 2-0 in Horizon League play. The Vikings have won five of their last seven games following Thursday night's 63-55 victory over Loyola at the Wolstein Center. Junior guard Cedric Jackson paces the Viking offensive attack with 15.7 points per game, followed by 14.3 ppg and a team-best 5.9 rpg from junior forward J'Nathan Bullock. Gary Waters is in his second season at the helm of the Vikings and owns a record of 19-26 at Cleveland State. Waters, who has also coached at Kent State and Rutgers, is 190-161 in 12 seasons as a head coach.

**UIC AND CLEVELAND STATE, THE SERIES:**

UIC is 31-28 all-time against Cleveland State. The Vikings are the Flames' second-most played conference opponent behind Green Bay (74 games).

**UIC VS. CLEVELAND STATE SERIES NUGGETS:**

- \* UIC and Cleveland State have played each other at least once every season since the 1981-82 campaign.
- \* The Flames are 13-12 all-time against the Vikings in Cleveland.
- \* UIC has won nine of its last 11 games against Cleveland State, including seven in a row from 2002-03 through 2004-05.
- \* The Flames have won five consecutive road games at Cleveland State dating back to 2002-03.
- \* UIC is 16-10 against Cleveland State overall and 8-3 against the Vikings on the road under Jimmy Collins.
- \* The two teams split last season's two-game series, with the road team winning each time.
- \* UIC's active leader in scoring against the Vikings is Josh Mayo. The junior guard is averaging 17.0 ppg while also averaging 3.0 assists per contest in two career outings against Cleveland State.
- \* Mayo has not played against the Vikings since the 2005-06 season, missing last season's series after re-aggravating an early-season Achilles injury prior to last season's meeting in Cleveland and missing the Pavilion matchup between the two teams due to a death in the family.
- \* Senior forward Jermaine Dailey is averaging 7.0 ppg and 4.0 rpg in two meetings against the Vikings.
- \* Common foes to date between the two teams include Youngstown State and Central Michigan. The Penguins have a win over the Flames and a loss to the Vikings, while both UIC and Cleveland State have defeated the Chippewas.

**LAST TIME WE MET:****Cleveland State 60, UIC 55 – Jan. 27, 2007 (UIC Pavilion)**

Double-double outings from Othys Jeffers and Jovan Stefanov highlighted a valiant showing by short-handed UIC in a 60-55 loss to Cleveland State at the UIC Pavilion. With only seven active players for the contest, UIC rode big performances from its remaining cast members to keep within striking distance of the Vikings. Jeffers scored 17 points and pulled down a game-high 15 rebounds in 35 minutes. Stefanov poured in a game-best 23 points while grabbing 11 boards, playing every minute but one. Scott VanderMeer had a game to remember, swatting away a career-best nine shots to set a new Pavilion single-game blocks record. VanderMeer was just three points and a block short of a triple-double after picking up 12 rebounds and scoring seven points. UIC outrebounded the Vikings by a 55-37 margin, including a 20-7 advantage on the offensive glass, yet the Flames could only manage 14 second-chance points. Cleveland State took a six-point advantage after a Raheem Moss trey seven minutes into the second half, but the Flames would not go away. Five straight Stefanov points, including a huge three-point shot with just under three minutes remaining, gave UIC a 49-48 lead. Bahaadar Russell then answered with a three of his own just 12 seconds later to give Cleveland State a lead it would not relinquish.

**A QUICK LOOK BACK:**

**Youngstown State 80, UIC 68 – Jan. 3, 2008 (Youngstown, Ohio)**

UIC fell for the first time in Horizon League play this season after an 80-68 loss to Youngstown State at the Beeghly Center on Thursday night. UIC was led by Karl White Jr.'s 21 points, surpassing his career-high point output for the second time in the Flames' last three games. Scott VanderMeer turned in his second double-double of the season with 10 points and 11 rebounds. Josh Mayo chipped in 17 points and five assists. Youngstown State was paced by 24 points and 15 rebounds from John Barber and 26 points from Vytas Sulskis. The Penguins were hot from the start, shooting 61 percent (20-for-33) from the field in the first half. YSU was led by 20 first-half points, fueled by 4-of-5 three-point shooting, from Sulskis. A 6-0 run by the hosts in the final two minutes of the opening stanza created an 11-point deficit for the Flames at halftime. UIC was unable to dig out of the early hole, shooting just 27 percent (7-for-26) in the game's final 20 minutes. The loss prevented UIC from going 3-0 in conference play for the first time since the 1991-92 season.

**WHAT'S UP NEXT:**

The Flames return home for three consecutive contests at the UIC Pavilion, where they are 6-0 this season. UIC will begin the homestand against city rival Loyola next Saturday, Jan. 12, at 7:00 p.m.

**INJURY UPDATE:**

Sophomore point guard Spencer Stewart suffered a spiral fracture to the fourth metacarpal in his left (non-shooting) hand on Dec. 23 and will miss 4-6 weeks.

**CAN'T HOLD THE MAYO:**

Most of the summer publicity about UIC centered on junior guard Josh Mayo, a preseason All-Horizon League selection. The third-year Flames standout has showed this season that he is more than capable of handling the high expectations as he leads the team in scoring (18.4 ppg) and three-point shooting (57.7 percent) while ranking second on the team in assists (3.7 apg) and third in field goal percentage (52.7 percent).

**MORE MAYO:**

- \* In UIC's opener versus Bradley on Nov. 10, the Merrillville, Ind., native scored a career-best 34 points, eight better than his previous single-game high, to key the Flames' 84-75 win.
- \* Mayo's 34-point performance is the highest point production in a single game by any Horizon League player so far this season.
- \* Mayo scored 29 points in just 27 minutes against Milwaukee on Dec. 6. He shot 10-for-12 from the field, including 5-for-6 from beyond the arc, and tallied 16 of those points in 13 second-half minutes.
- \* The junior guard followed up his 29-point performance against Milwaukee with a 32-point surge against Green Bay two days later. He scored 20 of his 32 points in the first half, propelled by 6-for-7 shooting from downtown in the opening stanza. The six treys in the first half were the most Mayo has ever hit in one period.
- \* Mayo scored 16 of his game-high 22 points in the second half to rally UIC from a seven-point halftime deficit to defeat Toledo, 66-56, on Dec. 19.
- \* In six home games this season Mayo is averaging 24.7 points per game. At the Pavilion in 2007-08 he is shooting 64.9 percent (48-for-74) from the field and 67.6 percent (25-for-37) from three-point land.
- \* In 14 games this season Mayo has scored in double-figures in all but one.
- \* UIC's leading scorer in seven of its 14 games has been Mayo.
- \* Mayo has drained at least one three-pointer in every game this season. He has made a three-point field goal in 15 consecutive contests dating back to last season.
- \* Mayo is already a two-time Horizon League Player of the Week after just eight weeks.
- \* Mayo can also distribute the ball well; he has four games with six-plus assists.
- \* In three Horizon League games Mayo is averaging 26.0 ppg.

**TWO STRAIGHT CAREER GAMES FOR KARL:**

In his last two games senior Karl White Jr. has flashed proficiency in the scoring department. He surpassed his previous career-high point output of 17 (set as a freshman in 2004-05) with 20 points against Howard on Dec. 22. After missing the Flames' Dec. 29 game at Akron due to a sprained right ankle, White showed no ill effects of the injury in his next outing against Youngstown State on Jan. 3 with a new career high of 21 points. He is shooting 60.7 percent (17-for-28) from the field during his recent two-game team-leading scoring stretch.

**ROBO NOT PLAYING LIKE A ROOKIE:**

True freshman Robert Kreps has not looked like a first-year player, showing poise and efficiency throughout his inaugural campaign. "Robo" had scored in double figures in seven consecutive games prior to this Thursday's game in Youngstown, reaching a career-high 19 points twice and averaging 14.4 ppg on 58.1 percent (36-for-62) shooting during that span. Kreps is averaging 13.0 ppg in eight games since Dec. 1.

**HOME SWEET HOME:**

In six games at home this season UIC has shot 54.1 percent (180-for-333) from the field and 54.6 percent (65-for-119) from behind the three-point line. UIC has shot 50 percent or better from the field in five of its six home games, including a 60 percent performance against Milwaukee on Dec. 6. The only game the Flames did not finish with 50 percent shooting from the field at home this year was against Green Bay on Dec. 8, a contest in which they shot 49 percent from the floor.

**BUSH SHINES IN HIS START OF 07-08:**

With Karl White Jr. nursing a sprained right ankle that kept him out of last Saturday's Akron game, senior guard Robert Bush stepped into a starting role for the first time this year and scored a season-high 19 points on 7-for-11 shooting against the Zips.

**A GOOD DAILEY START:**

After earning his first start of the season against Central Michigan on Nov. 28 and getting seven more starting nods since, senior Jermaine Dailey has averaged 5.3 points, 5.1 rebounds and 1.8 blocks per game in which he is among the first five on the floor. He is averaging 5.8 rebounds in UIC's last six games in 20.5 minutes per game.

**DOWNTOWN - WHERE EVERYTHING'S WAITING FOR UIC:**

Much of UIC's success this season has come from its outside shooting. UIC is hitting three-pointers at a Horizon League-leading clip of 44.2 percent (117-for-265). The Flames are averaging 8.36 successful treys per game this season, with Josh Mayo leading the way with an average of 3.21 successful three-point attempts and a 57.7 percent (45-for-78) showing from behind the arc this season. UIC is 77-for-150 (51.3 percent) from downtown in eight wins and just 40-for-115 (34.8 percent) from behind the arc in six losses.

**VANDERMEER DOUBLE-DIPS AGAINST PENGUINS:**

Junior center Scott VanderMeer collected his second double-double of the season with 10 points and 11 rebounds against Youngstown State on Jan. 3. It was VanderMeer's fourth career double-double.

**THE MORE POINTS, THE BETTER:**

UIC seems to do much better when the scoring gets higher. Six of the Flames' eight wins have featured UIC outputs of 76 points or more, while four of UIC's six losses have featured final outputs of 63 points or lower by the Flames. UIC has scored 65 points or more in all eight of its wins. In terms of averages, UIC is scoring 80.6 points per game in victories while scoring nearly 20 points less on average (61.5) in losses.

**INTERMISSION INDICATOR:**

The Flames' status at halftime has been a pretty good indicator of the final outcome of the game. UIC has led heading into intermission in seven of its eight wins, while the Flames have went into the break trailing or tied in all six of their defeats. The only time UIC trailed at halftime and went on to win the game was a 66-56 come-from-behind win over Toledo on Dec. 19.

**A POTENT TRIO ON THE BOARDS:**

The frontcourt tandem of Jermaine Dailey, Scott VanderMeer and Jeremy Buttell have been cleaning the glass well of late. In the last five games the trio is averaging a total of 31.0 rpg. Here's a breakdown of the strong rebounding effort of the three UIC big men in the last quintet of contests:

## 2007-08 UIC FLAMES MEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

### MAYO TAKES ADVANTAGE OF THE CHARITY STRIPE:

Josh Mayo set the school record for consecutive free throws made when he hit 38 in a row from the line until a miss against Winthrop on Nov. 16. Mayo went 20 for his last 20 from the foul line in 2006-07 and began this season 18-for-18 until missing his final attempt against the Eagles. The streak lasted a span of seven games. Mayo also had a streak of 24 straight converted free throws this season before a miss at Akron on Dec. 29.

### UIC SIGNS POSTON, NEELY:

The first two official additions to the 2008-09 UIC men's basketball team have been announced as 6-foot-7 forward Jelani Poston (Chicago, Ill./Harmony Community School [Cincinnati]) and 6-foot-1 guard Zavion Neely (Chicago, Ill./John Hope College Prep) signed National Letters of Intent to play for the Flames beginning next year. Poston averaged 18 points and 11 rebounds per game as a junior at Chicago's Boys to Men Academy in 2006-07 and is considered by Rivals.com as the Horizon League's top power forward prospect. Neely is a highly-acclaimed combo guard at Hope, where he is considered one of the best players in the Chicago Public League's competitive Red Central.

### JOSH HELPING OUT WITH SPENCE INJURED:

With starting point guard Spencer Stewart out with a broken left hand, Josh Mayo has summoned his previous experience as a point guard with the Flames to make up for the absence. Mayo is averaging a team-high 5.5 assists per game in the two ballgames that Stewart has missed since suffering the injury. The junior combo guard had played the point guard spot extensively during his first two years at UIC.

### EFFICIENT BACKCOURT:

Most would not expect to find a team's highest field goal percentages put up by perimeter players. But that is the case with UIC, with two of the team's top three shooting clips belonging to guards Josh Mayo and Robert Kreps. Kreps is second on the squad with a 53.3 (49-for-92) shooting percentage, while Mayo is third with a field goal percentage of 52.7 (79-for-150).

### BLOCK PARTY:

Junior center Scott VanderMeer leads the Flames' top-ranked team effort in blocks. VanderMeer, who set a school- and league-record with 111 swatted shots last season, is blocking 2.6 shots per game while helping UIC turn away 68 total shots through 14 games. That is more than double the amount of blocks that the Flames' opponents have had (31). The Flames averaged 4.4 bpg compared to their opponents' 2.2 bpg.

**UIC HEAD COACH**  
**Jimmy Collins**  
**(184-162, 12th season)**

Head Coach Jimmy Collins enters his 12th season at the helm of the UIC men's basketball program. The veteran mentor is not only the winningest coach in school history with 184 career wins, but is also the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois. He has captured a conference regular season title (1998) and two league tournament crowns (2002, 2004) during his tenure, and has guided the Flames to three 20-win seasons in the last five years, including a school-record 24 victories in 2003-04.

Named co-conference coach of the year after his first season with the Flames, Collins has also guided UIC to its only three NCAA Tournament appearances in school history, taking the team to the Big Dance in 1998, 2002 and 2004. He also guided the Flames to their first-ever NIT bid in 2003.

Collins, who served as an assistant coach at Illinois for 13 years prior to his arrival at UIC, earned All-American honors as a player at New Mexico State, averaging 20.1 ppg while leading the Aggies to the Final Four during his senior season.

**JIMMY COLLINS FAST FACTS**

- \* Jimmy Collins was introduced as the ninth head coach in UIC history on March 27, 1996.
- \* Collins has propelled UIC to its first three NCAA Tournament bids (1998, 2002, 2004) and first NIT berth (2003) in school history.
- \* Collins has led UIC to four 20-win seasons in his 11-plus years on the sidelines: 22 (1997-98); 20 (2001-02); 21 (2002-03); 24 (2003-04).
- \* Collins is the program's all-time winningest coach with 184 career victories.
- \* Collins has guided UIC to a league regular-season (1998) and two league tournament titles (2002, 2004) during his tenure.
- \* Collins is the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois and the second-longest tenured coach in the Horizon League behind Perry Watson of Detroit.
- \* Collins was an assistant coach at the University of Illinois under Lou Henson for 13 years, including the 1989 season in which the Fighting Illini advanced to the Final Four.
- \* As Illinois' top recruiter, Collins' high-profile Illini signees included: Kendall Gill, Nick Anderson, Marcus Liberty, Deon Thomas, Kiwane Garris and Lowell Hamilton.
- \* Collins is the co-chairman of the Chicago Special Olympics.
- \* Collins and his family are heavily involved with the Lupus Foundation of America Illinois Chapter. His daughter, Erica, serves on the Board of Directors for the Illinois Chapter.
- \* Collins, as well as the rest of his 1970 New Mexico State Final Four squad, were inducted into the school's Hall of Fame on Feb. 7th, 2004.
- \* Collins is a former first-round draft pick of the Chicago Bulls (1970).
- \* Collins served as a hearing officer for the Cook County Probation Department prior to his appointment as an assistant coach at Illinois.
