Titan Notes: Detroit is 5-18 overall and just 1-12 in Horizon League play coming into Thursday's game against UIC. The Titans have lost three in a row and 16 of their last 17 after beginning the year 4-2. Detroit's last three losses have come by an average margin of defeat of just 4.3 points. Senior guard Jon Goode is the Horizon League's leading scorer at 19.4 ppg; Goode scores an average of 21.4 ppg in Horizon League contests. He scored 35 points in the Titans' earlier meeting against the Flames this season. Local products Chris Hayes (Mount Carmel) and Michael Harrington (Rich Central) have been starting for Detroit. Kevin Mondro is in his 10th game as interim head coach after longtime Detroit mentor Perry Watson took a leave of absence for health reasons on Jan. 7.

UIC AND DETROIT, THE SERIES:

UIC is 10-19 all-time against Detroit. The Flames have won four of the last six games in the series. UIC is just 3-10 against Detroit on the Titans' home floor. A UIC win would mark the Flames' first regular season series sweep over Detroit.

LAST TIME WE MET:**UIC 75, Detroit 65 – Jan. 19, 2008 (UIC Pavilion)**

UIC trailed visiting Detroit by as many as 11 in the first half, but the Flames clamped down on defense after intermission and outscored the Titans 14-3 in the final five minutes of the contest to rally for a 75-65 victory at the UIC Pavilion. Robert Bush and Robert Kreps scored 17 points apiece to lead a quintet of Flames in double-digit scoring. The Flames allowed Detroit to shoot just 31.3 percent (10-for-32) in the game's final 20 minutes after the Titans hit from the field at a rate of 50 percent (15-for-30) prior to intermission. Jon Goode, who scored a career-high 35 points for Detroit, had the hot hand in the opening 20 minutes as the Titan senior put up 20 first-half points on 8-for-12 shooting from the field to help the visitors jet out to an early lead. Bush kept UIC within striking distance with his long-range shooting. The senior guard hit four of six three-point attempts in the inaugural half. The Titans would use a 13-4 run over a span of three minutes and 26 seconds late in the first period to lead by as many as 11. A pair of Boyd free throws and a late Kreps trey trimmed the Flames' deficit to six heading into the locker room for the half. Mayo opened the second half with two consecutive three-pointers in an early 45-second span to even the game at 39-39. Detroit would fight back and regain the lead, holding the advantage for most of the first 10 minutes of the half. After the lead changed seven times, Kreps hit a pair of free throws at the 4:50 mark to give UIC the lead and spur a 14-3 Flames run that put the game away. Scott VanderMeer scored 13 and pulled down 10 rebounds for his fourth double-double of the year and third double-dip in the last five games. Tori Boyd scored a career-best 12 points off the bench, while Josh Mayo scored all 11 of his points in the second half. Kreps dished out a career-high seven assists as the Flames had 17 helpers on 22 field goals.

LAST TIME WE MET AT CALIHAN HALL:**UIC 75, Detroit 67 – Feb. 10, 2007 (Detroit, Mich.)**

UIC had five players score in double figures and shot 54 percent from the field in the second half to earn a 75-67 victory at Detroit. The win snapped a seven-game losing streak for the Flames and marked UIC's first win at Calihan Hall since the 2002-03 season. The score was tied 57-57 with six minutes left when an 11-4 run by the Flames, paced by six points from Othys Jeffers, gave UIC a seven-point cushion with 1:52 left. The Flames would convert 7-of-8 free throws down the stretch to preserve the win. Jeffers led the Flames with 20 points, going 8-for-9 from the field, while adding eight rebounds. Josh Mayo scored 15 points and dished out four assists. Robert Bush (13 points), T.J. Gray (12 points) and Jovan Stefanov (11 points) also scored in double figures for UIC. The Titans led 30-28 at halftime after shooting 52 percent from the field in the first 20 minutes. The Flames' defense stiffened in the second stanza, limiting Detroit to just 36 percent shooting from the floor in the second half.

A QUICK LOOK BACK:

UIC 77, Valparaiso 53 - Feb. 11, 2008 (UIC Pavilion)

An overwhelming second-half effort lifted UIC to a 77-53 victory over visiting Valparaiso at the UIC Pavilion on Monday night. Josh Mayo scored 18 points to lead the Flames to their fourth consecutive victory. Scott VanderMeer added 13 points, a game-high eight rebounds and five blocks. UIC used an 11-0 run over a span of just under two minutes to turn a two-point lead into a 13-point advantage at the 14:59 mark of the final stanza. That spurt was the beginning of a 33-7 second-period burst by the hosts that put the contest out of reach for the Crusaders. The Flames hit their first six three-point attempts of the second half to ignite the charge. Spencer Stewart, who scored 11 points and handed out six assists, and Mayo each nailed three treys during that stretch of perfection from downtown. UIC held Valparaiso, the Horizon League's top offensive team coming into Monday's game, to its season-low point output. It was also the second straight game that the Flames held an opponent under 56 points. The Flames shot 53.8 percent (28-for-52) from the floor, the ninth time in 12 home games and fourth straight Pavilion outing that UIC has hit 50 percent or better from the field as a team.

WHAT'S UP NEXT:

UIC will head to Dayton, Ohio to face Wright State at the Nutter Center this Saturday, Feb. 16 at 6 p.m. Central.

CAN'T HOLD THE MAYO:

Most of the summer publicity about UIC centered on junior guard Josh Mayo, a preseason All-Horizon League selection. The third-year Flames standout has showed this season that he is more than capable of handling the high expectations as he leads the team in scoring (18.5 ppg) and three-point shooting (54.2 percent). His scoring average is the second-best in the Horizon League, while his three-point shooting is the best in the nation.

ONE OF THE BEST BEYOND THE ARC:

The most recent NCAA Division I statistical rankings released on Monday, Feb. 11, revealed that UIC is still one of the nation's most accurate three-point shooting teams. The Flames owned the country's fifth-best percentage from behind the three-point line at 42.1 percent (180-for-428) prior to Monday's game against Valpo. UIC is now shooting 42.4 percent (191-for-451) from downtown following Monday's 11-for-23 three-point showing.

JOSH IS NUMBER ONE:

UIC's main deep threat is junior guard Josh Mayo. For the fifth week in a row Mayo is leading NCAA Division I in individual three-point field goal percentage, standing atop the rankings this week at 54.2 percent (77-for-142). In 13 Horizon League games Mayo is hitting from downtown at a rate of 54.8 percent (46-for-84). At home his three-point accuracy is more impressive; Mayo has missed just 18 of his 72 three-point attempts at the UIC Pavilion, good for a success rate of 63.2 percent from behind the Pavilion's arcs.

THE THREE-BALL A GOOD GAUGE FOR SUCCESS:

Much of UIC's success in the win-loss column has been contingent on its success shooting the basketball from beyond the three-point arc. In 14 wins the Flames have shot 48.2 percent (124-for-257) from behind the three-point line, while UIC has posted a 34.5 (67-for-194) three-point field goal percentage in 10 defeats.

MAYO MAKES MANY FROM LONG RANGE:

Josh Mayo is averaging 3.21 successful three-point attempts per contest to lead the Horizon League in the category and rank 30th nationally in treys made per game. He has made three or more three-point baskets in a game on 16 different occasions this year, including a five-game stretch with four treys or more from Dec. 6 through Dec. 22. Mayo has canned at least three treys in his last five games.

KARL POURING IN THE POINTS OF LATE:

Senior guard Karl White Jr. entered the 2007-08 season with a career-high point output of 17 that was set as a rookie in the 2004-05 campaign. White had only scored in double figures on 12 occasions in 70 games prior to this year. Through 22 games this season White has already scored in double figures 10 times, including five of his last nine games, and has posted 19 or more points on four occasions.

WELCOME TO THE CLUB:

Josh Mayo became the 19th member of UIC's 1,000 career point club after hitting a jumper at the 15:56 mark of the first half in UIC's win over Cleveland State on Jan. 31. The third-year guard now stands at 1,087 career points to sit in sole possession of 15th place on UIC's all-time scoring list.

SCOTT'S NEW YEAR'S RESOLUTION:

Scott VanderMeer's number have jumped up since the calendar switched over to 2008. In 11 games since the new year began, VanderMeer is averaging 9.6 points, 10.2 rebounds and 3.1 blocks per game. During that span he has four double-doubles, six double-digit rebound games and six double-figure scoring performances. Prior to the new year VanderMeer was averaging 9.2 points, 5.8 rebounds and 2.8 blocks per game in 13 contests.

FLAMES LOVE HOME COOKIN':

There's been something about the UIC Pavilion that has brought out the best in its occupant this season. The Flames are a 11-1 at home in 2007-08 and have won 14 of their last 15 at the Pavilion dating back to last year. UIC is shooting 51.4 percent (340-for-661) from the field as a team at home and 50.4 percent (118-for-234) from beyond the Pavilion's three-point arcs. The Flames are averaging nine more points at home (80.0) than their season average (71.0) and outscore opponents at the Pavilion by a 14.5-point margin. UIC has shot 50 percent or better at home on nine occasions this year.

THE MORE POINTS, THE BETTER:

UIC seems to do much better when the scoring gets higher. UIC is 6-0 when scoring 80-plus points. The cut-off so far has been 75 points; when UIC scores over 75, it is 10-0, while the Flames are just 4-10 when scoring 75 points or less.

DEFENSE DOING THE TRICK:

One of the keys to the Flames' recent success has been their improved defensive numbers. During their four-game winning streak UIC has allowed foes to score just 62.0 points per game, as opposed to the 68.1 ppg UIC was allowing prior to the streak. The Flames have also forced their last four foes to shoot just 25.6 percent (22-for-86) from three-point range after allowing a 36.5 three-point clip (141-for-386) to opponents in 20 previous outings. UIC's last two games bring to light even better defensive stats; the Flames have given up just 54.0 ppg while making its last two opponents shoot a combined 42-for-120 (35.0 percent) from the floor.

FLAMES LIKE TO TOPPLE TITANS IN SECOND HALF:

In the last two meetings between UIC and Detroit, the Titans come out hot in the first half and the Flames cool them off after intermission. Detroit has shot 50 percent or better from the floor during the opening period in the last two meetings, going 12-for-23 (52.2 percent) on Feb. 10, 2007 and shooting 15-for-30 (50 percent) on Jan. 19, 2008. In the second half of the Feb. 10, 2007 game, Detroit mustered a 36.4 percent (12-for-33) performance, while this year's earlier meeting saw the Titans shoot just 31.3 percent (10-for-32) following halftime.

SCOTT A BARRIER TO THE BASKET FOR OPPONENTS:

Scott VanderMeer is one of the nation's leading shot-blockers with 70 swats in 24 games for a Horizon League-leading average of 2.9 bpg. VanderMeer entered the week ranked 12th in the country in blocks per game and has recorded seven games with five blocked shots this season. He has totaled 33 blocks in UIC's last 10 games. VanderMeer holds UIC's single-season (111 blocks in 2006-07) and career (181) records for blocked shots.

A BANNER NIGHT ON THE BOARDS:

Scott VanderMeer's 21-rebound night at Valparaiso on Jan. 24 marked many a milestone. The career-high performance for the Flames' junior center matched Chuck Lambert's 21-rebound game against Northeastern Illinois on Dec. 6, 1974 for the third-most rebounds in a single game by a UIC player. It was also the most in a single game by a Horizon League player this season and the second-best amount all-time by a league player during a league game. VanderMeer's 21 rebounds was also the second-most in a conference game by any Division I player this season according to ESPN.com's Around the Rim. Only Indiana's D.J. White's 22-rebound performance at Michigan on Jan. 8 was better. The showing is tied for the fourth-most rebounds all-time in a single game (league or non-conference) by a player in the Horizon League.

ROBO NOT PLAYING LIKE A ROOKIE:

True freshman Robert Kreps has not looked like a first-year player, with plenty of notable performances to prove it. "Robo" scored in double figures in seven consecutive games from Dec. 1 through Dec. 29, reaching a career-high 19 points twice and averaging 14.4 ppg on 58.1 percent (36-for-62) shooting during that span.

APPROACHING 200:

UIC head coach Jimmy Collins secured career win No. 190 in Monday's 77-53 win over Valpo. If the Flames run the table and win the 2008 Horizon League Championship without having one of the tournament's top two seeds, Collins can actually get victory No. 200 by March 11 of this year.

2007-08 UIC FLAMES MEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

UIC SIGNS POSTON, NEELY:

The first two official additions to the 2008-09 UIC men's basketball team have been announced as 6-foot-7 forward Jelani Poston (Chicago, Ill./Harmony Community School [Cincinnati]) and 6-foot-1 guard Zavion Neely (Chicago, Ill./John Hope College Prep) signed National Letters of Intent to play for the Flames beginning next year. Poston averaged 18 points and 11 rebounds per game as a junior at Chicago's Boys to Men Academy in 2006-07 and is considered by Rivals.com as the Horizon League's top power forward prospect. Neely is a highly-acclaimed combo guard at Hope, where he is considered one of the best players in the Chicago Public League's competitive Red Central.

JOSH RAISES HIS SIGHTS AGAINST LEAGUE FOES:

Josh Mayo's numbers against Horizon League foes so far this season are pretty impressive. He is averaging 20.4 points per league game, shooting 49.7 percent (82-for-165) from the floor and 54.8 percent (46-for-84) from downtown in 13 conference contests and while scoring 16 or more points in all but two of those games.

VANDERMEER REBOUNDS BETTER ON THE ROAD:

In 12 games away from the Pavilion, Scott VanderMeer is averaging 9.0 rpg. Compare that to his home average of 6.6 rpg in 12 home contests.

SPENCE = WINNING:

The Flames are better with point guard Spencer Stewart in the starting lineup. UIC is 12-4 this year with Stewart among the first five on the floor, as opposed to 2-4 without his services at all and 0-2 with him coming off the bench. The Flame have won nine consecutive games with Stewart as a starter and are 18-10 the past two seasons when Stewart starts. All three of UIC's winning streaks this year have involved Stewart starting each game during the Flames' respective runs of victory.

BENCH PRODUCTION:

The Flames have received increased offense from the bench in their last three games, as UIC's reserves have outscored opposing reserves 89-56. Karl White Jr. has led the bench charge with 10.0 ppg in that span, while Jovan Ignjatovic is averaging 5.0 ppg in the last three games, making 7-of-9 field goal attempts and five in a row heading into Thursday's game.

UIC HEAD COACH
Jimmy Collins
(190-166, 12th season)

Head Coach Jimmy Collins enters his 12th season at the helm of the UIC men's basketball program. The veteran mentor is not only the winningest coach in school history with 190 career wins, but is also the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois. He has captured a conference regular season title (1998) and two league tournament crowns (2002, 2004) during his tenure, and has guided the Flames to three 20-win seasons in the last five years, including a school-record 24 victories in 2003-04.

Named co-conference coach of the year after his first season with the Flames, Collins has also guided UIC to its only three NCAA Tournament appearances in school history, taking the team to the Big Dance in 1998, 2002 and 2004. He also guided the Flames to their first-ever NIT bid in 2003.

Collins, who served as an assistant coach at Illinois for 13 years prior to his arrival at UIC, earned All-American honors as a player at New Mexico State, averaging 20.1 ppg while leading the Aggies to the Final Four during his senior season.

JIMMY COLLINS FAST FACTS

- * Jimmy Collins was introduced as the ninth head coach in UIC history on March 27, 1996.
- * Collins has propelled UIC to its first three NCAA Tournament bids (1998, 2002, 2004) and first NIT berth (2003) in school history.
- * Collins has led UIC to four 20-win seasons in his 11-plus years on the sidelines: 22 (1997-98); 20 (2001-02); 21 (2002-03); 24 (2003-04).
- * Collins is the program's all-time winningest coach with 190 career victories.
- * Collins has guided UIC to a league regular-season (1998) and two league tournament titles (2002, 2004) during his tenure.
- * Collins is the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois and the second-longest tenured coach in the Horizon League behind Perry Watson of Detroit.
- * Collins was an assistant coach at the University of Illinois under Lou Henson for 13 years, including the 1989 season in which the Fighting Illini advanced to the Final Four.
- * As Illinois' top recruiter, Collins' high-profile Illini signees included: Kendall Gill, Nick Anderson, Marcus Liberty, Deon Thomas, Kiwane Garris and Lowell Hamilton.
- * Collins is the co-chairman of the Chicago Special Olympics.
- * Collins and his family are heavily involved with the Lupus Foundation of America Illinois Chapter. His daughter, Erica, serves on the Board of Directors for the Illinois Chapter.
- * Collins, as well as the rest of his 1970 New Mexico State Final Four squad, were inducted into the school's Hall of Fame on Feb. 7th, 2004.
- * Collins is a former first-round draft pick of the Chicago Bulls (1970).
- * Collins served as a hearing officer for the Cook County Probation Department prior to his appointment as an assistant coach at Illinois.
