UIC opens play in the 2008 Horizon League Men's Basketball Championship this Tuesday night with an opening round contest against Youngstown State at the UIC Pavilion...The Flames clinched the fourth seed and a first-round home game with a win over Milwaukee this past Saturday night, while the Penguins completed their regular season with the ninth seed in the league standings...This is the first time UIC enters its conference tournament as the fourth seed...UIC is 11-2 at home this season...The Flames' last four games against conference opponents were decided by an average margin of 4.3 points...Junior guard Josh Mayo (17.6 ppg, 48.6% 3PT FG) was selected to the All-Horizon League First Team...Junior center Scott VanderMeer (7.4 rpg, 2.7 bpg) was named to the league's All-Defensive Team for the second straight season...A win on Tuesday will send the Flames to Indianapolis for the Horizon League quarterfinals on Friday to face the winner of Tuesday's Loyola/Milwaukee first round game.

Penguin Notes: Youngstown State has lost five of its last six games and is just 2-11 since Jan. 17. The Penguins closed the regular season with a 65-58 loss to Cleveland State on March 1 in Youngstown. Byron Davis is the Penguins' leading scorer at 15.3 points per game, while Horizon League All-Newcomer Team selection Vytas Sulskis averages 9.1 ppg and shoots a team-best 39.1 percent from downtown. Sulskis is averaging 22.0 points per game in two meetings against UIC this season. John Barber is leading the team in rebounding at 7.0 caroms per contest, good for fourth in the Horizon League's rebounding rankings.

UIC AND YOUNGSTOWN STATE, THE SERIES:

UIC leads the all-time series against Youngstown State with a 17-2 record against the Penguins in 19 meetings. The Flames are a perfect 9-0 against the Penguins at the Pavilion. Tuesday's game will be the second time that UIC and Youngstown State meet in the Horizon League Tournament; their only other postseason meeting came in the 2003 Horizon League Tournament quarterfinals on March 7, 2003 in Milwaukee, Wis. The Flames earned a 79-59 victory over Youngstown State at U.S. Cellular Arena in that tournament matchup.

LAST TIME WE MET:

UIC 86, Youngstown State 72 – Feb. 2, 2008 (UIC Pavilion)

Five players scored in double figures for UIC in an 86-72 victory over Youngstown State at the UIC Pavilion. Josh Mayo scored a game-high 21 points for the Flames. Scott VanderMeer came off the bench to tab a double-double of 10 points and 10 rebounds, while Robert Kreps (15 points), Karl White Jr. (11 points) and Robert Bush (10 points) also added double-digit scoring. After Mikko Niemi hit a three in the opening seconds of the contest for Youngstown State, UIC tallied eight straight points to take a lead it would never relinquish. The Flames would go up by as many as 18 in the first half and led 42-28 at halftime. The Penguins would get within six in the middle of the final stanza, but another 8-0 spurt, keyed by back-to-back three-pointers off the fingertips of Mayo, put the Flames back ahead by double digits. That's how the UIC lead would stay the rest of the way. Spencer Stewart handed out a career-high nine assists as UIC accumulated 21 helpers on 31 field goals.

OUR OTHER MEETING OF THE YEAR:

Youngstown State 80, UIC 68 – Jan. 3, 2008 (Youngstown, Ohio)

UIC fell for the first time in Horizon League play this season after an 80-68 loss to Youngstown State at the Beeghly Center. UIC was led by Karl White Jr.'s 21 points, surpassing his career-high point output for the second time in the Flames' last three games. Scott VanderMeer had a double-double of 10 points and 11 rebounds. Josh Mayo chipped in 17 points and five assists. Youngstown State was paced by 24 points and 15 rebounds from John Barber and 26 points from Vytas Sulskis. The Penguins were hot from the start, shooting 61 percent (20-for-33) from the field in the first half. A 6-0 run by the hosts in the final two minutes of the opening stanza created an 11-point deficit for the Flames at halftime. UIC was unable to dig out of the early hole, shooting just 27 percent (7-for-26) in the game's final 20 minutes.

A QUICK LOOK BACK:

UIC 63, Milwaukee 55 - Mar. 1, 2008 (Milwaukee, Wis.)

UIC clinched the fourth seed and a first-round home game in the Horizon League Tournament with a 63-55 victory over Milwaukee at U.S. Cellular Arena on Saturday night. Scott VanderMeer registered his sixth double-double of the year with game-highs of 17 points and 13 rebounds to lead the Flames. Following an even opening period that ended in a 24-24 tie at intermission, UIC opened the second period on a 9-1 run to take a 33-25 lead. Milwaukee went on an 11-1 run of its own to go up by two, but that was the only lead the hosts would have after that spurt.

Karl White Jr. answered the Panthers' run by himself in scoring eight unanswered points during a three-minute span to put UIC ahead by six. UIC used the free throw line to cement the victory, converting 23 of its 33 foul shots in the final stanza and nine free throws in the final 1:14. White scored all 14 of his points in the second half, hitting eight of 11 attempts from the charity stripe. The Flames limited Milwaukee to just 25.8 percent (8-for-31) shooting from the floor after halftime. Saturday's win marked the first time UIC has swept the regular season series over Milwaukee since 1997-98.

WHAT'S UP NEXT:

A win over Youngstown State would send UIC to Indianapolis for the Horizon League Tournament quarterfinals to face the winner of the Loyola/Milwaukee first round game. The Flames would face either the Ramblers or the Panthers inside Hinkle Fieldhouse this Friday (Mar. 7) at 7 p.m. Central.

MAYO AN ALL-HORIZON LEAGUE FIRST TEAMER:

It was no surprise that junior guard Josh Mayo was chosen for the All-Horizon League First Team that was unveiled on Monday, Mar. 3. The UIC standout has been one of the Horizon League's best players all season long, scoring 17.6 points per game to rank second on the league's scoring charts and hitting 48.6 percent of his three-point field goal attempts to stand fifth in the country in three-point accuracy. He is also fifth in the league in assists per game (3.4 apg), eighth in steals (1.27 spg) and third in free throw percentage (84.6 percent).

VANDERMEER IS VERY DEFENSIVE:

For the second straight season junior center Scott VanderMeer was named to the Horizon League's All-Defensive Team. Last year VanderMeer set the school and league records for blocked shots with 111 swatted attempts, and this year the 7-footer continued his ways of rejection with 80 blocks in 30 games. He is averaging a league-leading 2.7 blocked shots per game.

ONE OF THE BEST BEYOND THE ARC:

UIC remains one of the nation's most accurate three-point shooting teams according to the most recent NCAA Division I statistical rankings released on Monday, Mar. 3. The Flames own the country's 12th-best percentage from behind the three-point line at 40.1 percent (223-for-556).

JOSH NEAR THE TOP OF THE NATIONAL CHARTS:

UIC's main deep threat is junior guard Josh Mayo. Mayo currently ranks fifth among all NCAA Division I players in individual three-point field goal percentage, making 48.6 percent (90-for-185) of his attempts from downtown. Mayo led the nation in three-point accuracy for six straight weeks from Jan. 10 until Feb. 21.

THE THREE-BALL A GOOD GAUGE FOR SUCCESS:

Much of UIC's success in the win-loss column has been contingent on its success shooting the basketball from beyond the three-point arc. In 16 wins the Flames have shot 46.8 percent (133-for-284) from behind the three-point line, while UIC has posted a 33.1 (90-for-272) three-point field goal percentage in 14 defeats.

SCOTT A DOUBLE DIPPER:

Scott VanderMeer has dabbled in the art of the double-double this season. On Saturday the junior center registered his sixth double-double of the season with 17 points and 13 rebounds against Milwaukee. One of his double-doubles came against Youngstown State in the two teams' meeting on Jan. 3, when VanderMeer scored 10 points and grabbed 11 rebounds. VanderMeer is averaging 10.5 rebounds in two games against the Penguins this year.

WHITE A SECOND-HALF HERO:

Senior guard Karl White Jr. gave big offensive performances after intermission in both of the Flames' last two games. Against Green Bay on Feb. 28, White scored 11 of his 13 total points in the second half, including five in the final 18 seconds of the game to help the Flames erase a seven-point deficit with under a minute remaining. On Mar. 1 at Milwaukee, White tallied all 14 of his points in the final stanza. Of the 13.5 ppg he averaged in UIC's last pair of contests, White averaged 12.5 of those points in the game's final 20 minutes.

MAYO MARCHES OVER THE PENGUINS:

Josh Mayo has had plenty of success in six career games against Youngstown State. Mayo averages 14.7 points per game, 5.2 assists per game, shoots 62.2 percent (28-for-45) from the field and hits 56.3 percent (18-for-32) of his three-point attempts against the Penguins. He has scored at least 10 points in each of those six meetings.

THREE YEARS OF DOUBLE-DIGIT PRODUCTION IN ONE SEASON:

Karl White Jr. entered the 2007-08 season with a career-high point output of 17 that was set as a rookie in the 2004-05 campaign. White had only scored in double figures on 12 occasions in 70 games prior to this year. He has already scored in double figures 12 times through 28 games this season, including nine times in his last 18 appearances, and has posted 19 or more points on four occasions.

FIRST ROUND SUCCESS:

UIC is undefeated in opening round games in the Horizon League Tournament since the inception of first round contests in 2003. The Flames are 3-0 in first round matchups; all three that UIC has played in have taken place at the UIC Pavilion. UIC defeated Cleveland State (84-65) in 2005, Wright State (77-64) in 2006 and Milwaukee (83-77) last season in its three prior appearances in the tourney's opening round.

FLAMES IN CONFERENCE TOURNAMENTS:

UIC is 24-21 all-time in conference tournament play and 13-11 all-time in the Horizon League Tournament.

MAYO CLIMBING UIC'S CAREER SCORING LIST:

Josh Mayo became the 19th member of UIC's 1,000 career point club after hitting a jumper at the 15:56 mark of the first half in UIC's win over Cleveland State on Jan. 31. The third-year guard now stands at 1,172 career points, good for 13th place in school history.

JOSH ON A DOUBLE-DIGIT STREAK:

Josh Mayo has scored in double figures in 25 consecutive games, the longest active streak in the Horizon League and the longest stretch of double-digit scoring performances in his career. He has scored in double figures in all but one game this season.

DAILEY IMPACT:

Jermaine Dailey is unleashing his best for last as his college career winds down. Since reclaiming a spot in the starting lineup six games ago, Dailey is averaging 8.0 points, 5.7 rebounds and 75.9 percent (22-for-29) shooting from the floor in UIC's last half-dozen contests.

IF WE MAKE HALF OF OUR SHOTS, WE WIN:

The formula for success has been pretty simple for UIC this season: shooting 50 percent or better from the field equals a victory. The Flames are a perfect 11-0 when hitting at a clip of 50 percent or better from the floor.

SCOTT'S NEW YEAR'S REBOUNDING RESOLUTION:

Scott VanderMeer's rebounding numbers have jumped since the start of the new year. In 17 games since the calendar switched to 2008, VanderMeer is averaging 8.6 rebounds per game with seven double-digit rebounding games under his belt during that span. In 13 games this season that took place at the end of the calendar year 2007, the junior center was pulling down just 5.8 rebounds per contest and rebounded in double figures just once.

FLAMES LIKE THE PAVILION ARCS:

The Flames have shot lights-out from long range in 13 home games this season. UIC is shooting a collective 48.4 percent (120-for-248) from three-point land at the UIC Pavilion in 2007-08, led by Josh Mayo's clip of 58.8 percent (50-for-85), Spencer Stewart's 53.8 percent (14-for-26) and Robert Kreps' 51.4 percent (19-for-37). Shooting from inside the Pavilion arcs has also gone well; UIC is hitting from the field at a rate of 50.1 percent (358-for-715). The Flames have shot 50 percent or better from the field at home nine times and 45 percent or better from three-point range at the Pavilion eight times.

SPENCER LENDS A HELPING HAND (WHETHER IT WAS BROKEN OR NOT):

Spencer Stewart has helped ignite the Flames' offense since returning from a six-game hiatus on Jan. 24 after recovering from a broken left hand. Since handing out a career-high nine helpers against Youngstown State on Feb. 2, Stewart has averaged 5.33 apg in the last nine games. In UIC's last seven games Stewart has had no less than four assists. The second-year point man has an assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.31 during the Flames' last seven contests.

ROBO NOT PLAYING LIKE A ROOKIE:

True freshman Robert Kreps has not looked like a first-year player, with plenty of notable performances to prove it. "Robo" scored in double figures in seven consecutive games from Dec. 1 through Dec. 29, reaching a career-high 19 points twice and averaging 14.4 ppg on 58.1 percent (36-for-62) shooting during that span.

2007-08 UIC FLAMES MEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

FLASHING THE "D" DURING THE STRETCH RUN:

UIC has allowed an average of 58.5 points per game in eight contests since giving up 72 points to Youngstown State on Feb. 2. The Flames gave up 70-plus points just once during that recent eight-game stretch. In the Flames' previous 22 outings, UIC gave up an average of 68.2 points per contest. UIC's opponents were also cooled from the field by the Flames' "D" during the last eight games, as UIC's last eight opponents shot just 38.4 percent (167-for-435). Compare that to the 43.0 percent UIC allowed opponents to shoot prior to that stretch.

A CHARITY CASE:

The Flames have been making more frequent trips to the free throw line lately. In the last two games UIC has made a combined 50 attempts from the charity stripe, averaging 25 foul shots a game and shooting 70.0 percent (35-for-50) from the line. UIC averaged 16.4 free throw shots per contest before the surge that occurred in the regular season's final two games. 41 of UIC's 50 free throws in the last two games were taken in the second half.

HOME AND AWAY LIKE NIGHT AND DAY:

It seems like there have been two UIC teams in 2007-08: a nearly invincible home team and an unpredictable squad on the road. Here are UIC's numbers in 13 home games, 14 true road games and 17 games away from the Pavilion (12 road games and three neutral site contests):

THE SCOREBOARD DOESN'T REST WHEN FLAMES MEET THE PENGUINS:

Games between UIC and Youngstown State have traditionally been high-scoring affairs. The Flames have averaged 77.4 ppg in 19 meetings against the Penguins, while Youngstown State posts 68.0 ppg against UIC in those 19 meetings. UIC averages 81.1 ppg against Youngstown State in nine games inside the Pavilion.

SCOTT A BARRIER TO THE BASKET FOR OPPONENTS:

Scott VanderMeer is one of the nation's leading shot-blockers with 80 swats in 30 games for a Horizon League-leading average of 2.7 bpg. VanderMeer entered the weekend ranked 18th in the country in blocks per game and has recorded seven games with five blocked shots this season. VanderMeer holds UIC's single-season (111 blocks in 2006-07) and career (191) records for blocked shots, establishing the career mark in less than two seasons.

A BANNER NIGHT ON THE BOARDS:

Scott VanderMeer's 21-rebound night at Valparaiso on Jan. 24 marked many a milestone. The career-high performance for the Flames' junior center matched Chuck Lambert's 21-rebound game against Northeastern Illinois on Dec. 6, 1974 for the third-most rebounds in a single game by a UIC player. It was also the most in a single game by a Horizon League player this season and the second-best amount all-time by a league player during a league game. The showing is tied for the fourth-most rebounds all-time in a single game (league or non-conference) by a player in the Horizon League.

UIC SIGNS POSTON, NEELY:

The first two official additions to the 2008-09 UIC men's basketball team have been announced as 6-foot-7 forward Jelani Poston (Chicago, Ill./Harmony Community School [Cincinnati]) and 6-foot-1 guard Zavion Neely (Chicago, Ill./John Hope College Prep) signed National Letters of Intent to play for the Flames beginning next year. Poston averaged 18 points and 11 rebounds per game as a junior at Chicago's Boys to Men Academy in 2006-07 and is considered by Rivals.com as the Horizon League's top power forward prospect. Neely is a highly-acclaimed combo guard at Hope, where he is considered one of the best players coming out of the Chicago Public League's competitive Red Central.

BUSH BREAKS OUT IN BRACKETBUSTER AGAINST NORTHERN IOWA:

After a fine 11-game stretch from Dec. 22 through Feb. 2 in which he averaged 10.1 ppg and 4.1 rpg while shooting 40.7 percent (22-for-54) from three-point range, senior Robert Bush had recently suffered through a five-game slump in which the senior forward averaged 3.4 points, 3.2 rebounds and shot 21.4 percent (3-for-14) from downtown. However, Bush broke out of his dry spell in the early moments of UIC's game at Northern Iowa on Feb. 23, scoring 13 of his team-high 16 points in the first half on 4-for-5 shooting from the field and 3-for-3 shooting from beyond the arc in the game's first 20 minutes. Since the BracketBuster game Bush is averaging 11.0 points and has hit six of his last 11 three-point attempts during UIC's last three contests.

A BANNER SCORING SEASON:

Josh Mayo can continue to cement his name among UIC's all-time greatest scorers. Mayo needs just 12 points to post the most points in a Flames uniform in a single season since Cedrick Banks put up 541 in 2004-05.

AN ELITE GROUP:

Josh Mayo is approaching a unique milestone at UIC as he enters Tuesday's game with 1,172 career points, 265 career assists and 105 career steals. The only Flames to ever score over 1,000 points, hand out over 300 assists and pilfer at least 100 steals are Craig Lathen (1981-85) and Kenny Williams (1990-94).

ALL-LEAGUE STREAK:

With Josh Mayo's All-Horizon League First Team selection this season, UIC has now had at least one player on an all-conference first or second team for seven consecutive seasons since 2000-01.

COLLINS IN CONFERENCE TOURNAMENTS:

UIC is 11-8 in league tournaments with Jimmy Collins on the bench.

IF THE FLAMES WIN:

If UIC can defeat Youngstown State on Tuesday night, the Flames will face the winner of Tuesday's Loyola/Milwaukee first round contest in the Horizon League Tournament quarterfinals at Hinkle Fieldhouse in Indianapolis, Ind. on Friday at 7 p.m. Central/8 p.m. Eastern. UIC swept the regular season series against both the Ramblers and the Panthers and faced both of those teams in last year's Horizon League Tournament. A win in the quarterfinals would set up a semifinal showdown with top-seeded Butler on Saturday.

UIC HEAD COACH
Jimmy Collins
(192-170, 12th season)

Head Coach Jimmy Collins is in his 12th season at the helm of the UIC men's basketball program. The veteran mentor is not only the winningest coach in school history with 192 career wins, but is also the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois. He has captured a conference regular season title (1998) and two league tournament crowns (2002, 2004) during his tenure, and has guided the Flames to three 20-win seasons in the last five years, including a school-record 24 victories in 2003-04.

Named co-conference coach of the year after his first season with the Flames, Collins has also guided UIC to its only three NCAA Tournament appearances in school history, taking the team to the Big Dance in 1998, 2002 and 2004. He also guided the Flames to their first-ever NIT bid in 2003.

Collins, who served as an assistant coach at Illinois for 13 years prior to his arrival at UIC, earned All-American honors as a player at New Mexico State, averaging 20.1 ppg while leading the Aggies to the Final Four during his senior season.

JIMMY COLLINS FAST FACTS

- * Jimmy Collins was introduced as the ninth head coach in UIC history on March 27, 1996.
- * Collins has propelled UIC to its first three NCAA Tournament bids (1998, 2002, 2004) and first NIT berth (2003) in school history.
- * Collins has led UIC to four 20-win seasons in his 11-plus years on the sidelines: 22 (1997-98); 20 (2001-02); 21 (2002-03); 24 (2003-04).
- * Collins is the program's all-time winningest coach with 192 career victories.
- * Collins has guided UIC to a league regular-season (1998) and two league tournament titles (2002, 2004) during his tenure.
- * Collins is the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois and the second-longest tenured coach in the Horizon League behind Perry Watson of Detroit.
- * Collins was an assistant coach at the University of Illinois under Lou Henson for 13 years, including the 1989 season in which the Fighting Illini advanced to the Final Four.
- * As Illinois' top recruiter, Collins' high-profile Illini signees included: Kendall Gill, Nick Anderson, Marcus Liberty, Deon Thomas, Kiwane Garris and Lowell Hamilton.
- * Collins is the co-chairman of the Chicago Special Olympics.
- * Collins and his family are heavily involved with the Lupus Foundation of America Illinois Chapter. His daughter, Erica, serves on the Board of Directors for the Illinois Chapter.
- * Collins, as well as the rest of his 1970 New Mexico State Final Four squad, were inducted into the school's Hall of Fame on Feb. 7th, 2004.
- * Collins is a former first-round draft pick of the Chicago Bulls (1970).
- * Collins served as a hearing officer for the Cook County Probation Department prior to his appointment as an assistant coach at Illinois.
