\*Quick Notes: The UIC men's basketball team opens a brief two-game road trip on Wednesday night at UW-Green Bay...The Phoenix is the Flames' longest standing rival as the two squads have met every year since the 1970-71 season...This is the 70th all-time meeting between UIC and UW-Green Bay with the Phoenix owning a 38-31 advantage in the series...UW-Green Bay swept the season series from UIC last year, but UIC had won six straight in the series prior to 2004-05 and is 2-1 all-time at the Resch Center...The Phoenix are 5-1 at the Resch Center this season with the lone loss coming at the hands of Michigan State...UIC has been led this season by senior standout Justin Bowen, who leads the team in scoring (15.9 ppg) and rebounding (7.5 rpg)...Sophomore Othyus Jeffers is making a bid for top newcomer honors in the Horizon League this season, averaging 12.7 points and 7.1 rebounds per contest in his rookie campaign...The Flames have used eight different starting lineups in their 15 games this year...UIC continues on the road this Sunday, heading just up the road to take on Loyola at the Gentile Center.

#### PHOENIX NOTES:

UW-Green Bay enters Wednesday night's tilt with UIC eyeing its first Horizon League victory of the season. The Phoenix is 0-3 in league action this year with losses to UW-Milwaukee, Detroit and Youngstown State. All three defeats came on the road, though, as UWGB will now play its next four league games in the friendly confines of the Resch Center, where the Phoenix is 5-1 this season. UW-Green Bay features a young lineup with three freshman (Terry Evans, Tyler Tillema, Mark Schachtner) combining for over 26 points and 13 rebounds per contest. Junior Ryan Evanochko paced the Phoenix offense, averaging 14.3 points per game. He is the lone Phoenix player to average in double figures while six players average six or more per outing. Tod Kowalczyk is in his fourth season as head coach at UW-Green Bay and owns a 50-51 record with the Phoenix.

#### UIC vs. UW-GREEN BAY - SERIES NOTES:

- \* UW-Green Bay is UIC's longest-standing rival as the two teams have met at least once every season since the 1970-71 campaign.
- \* UIC has won six of the last eight meetings with UW-Green Bay and is 2-1 all-time at the Resch Center
- \* The Phoenix, which won the first 16 games in the series and both games last season, is 38-31 all-time versus the Flames.
- \* Head Coach Jimmy Collins is 11-7 all-time versus the Phoenix and 4-2 versus UWGB Head Coach Tod Kowalczyk.

#### LAST TIME WE MET:

##### UW-Green Bay 78, UIC 66

##### February 14, 2005 \* UIC Pavilion

Behind senior Javier Mendiburu's 12 points, 13 assists and seven rebounds, UW-Green Bay humbled UIC, 78-66, on Valentines Day at the UIC Pavilion. Benito Flores led all scorers with 22 points for the Phoenix, which shot 50% in the ball game. Senior Cedrick Banks tabbed 20 points to lead UIC and Karl White netted a career-high 17, but it was not enough to help erase a 12-point halftime deficit.

#### WHITE WAS JUST RIGHT LAST TIME VERSUS UW-GREEN BAY:

UIC sophomore Karl White had his best career scoring night in the Flames' last meeting with UW-Green Bay. The Omaha, Neb., native converted 7-of-12 shots from the field en route to 17 points in a losing effort to the Phoenix on Feb. 14<sup>th</sup>. 2005.

#### LAST TIME OUT:

##### UW-Milwaukee 68, UIC 45

##### January 5, 2006 \* UIC Pavilion

On the tail end of a stretch of four games in eight days, UIC was unable to match pre-season Horizon League favorite UW-Milwaukee's energy as the Panthers picked up a 68-45 road victory over the Flames. UW-Milwaukee jumped out to a 12-point lead midway through the opening half and then never let UIC back within single digits. Senior Joah Tucker paced the Panthers with a game-high 20 points while senior Boo Davis chipped in with 10 points and seven rebounds. The Flames were led by Justin Bowen's 10 points and nine rebounds. Othys Jeffers added 11 points and six boards. Junior Jovan Stefanov pulled down a career-high tying 11 rebounds to go with nine points. The 48 points scored was a season-low for UIC.

#### WHAT'S UP NEXT:

UIC will stay on the road but will not have to travel far this weekend as the Flames square

off with city-rival Loyola at the Gentile Center on Sunday. The game will be played at 3:00 p.m. and broadcast live on ESPNU. UIC will be looking for a little payback when they venture to Rogers Park as the Ramblers eliminated the Flames from the Horizon League Tournament last season with a 87-81 overtime triumph in the quarterfinal round. UIC has enjoyed success of late at the Gentile Center, winning in four of its last five games in the arena, including a 64-58 triumph last season.

**POOLE CLOSED FOR THE SEASON**

UIC senior Elliott Poole was declared academically ineligible for the remainder of the 2005-06 season on Friday, January 6<sup>th</sup>. The 6-foot-7 forward was averaging 7.3 points and 4.4 rebounds for the Flames this year, earning the starting nod on eight occasions. Poole, whose best moment came when he scored the game-winning bucket in UIC's Horizon League Tournament championship game triumph over UW-Milwaukee in 2004, has exhausted all of eligibility thus ending his playing career at UIC.

**JOVAN STEPPING UP IN LEAGUE PLAY:**

Junior Jovan Stefanov has elevated his game in Horizon League action this season, averaging 9.3 points and 7.3 rebounds per game. The 6-foot-9 forward, who tied his career-high with 11 rebounds versus UW-Milwaukee on Jan. 5<sup>th</sup>, is also shooting 43% from three-point range in league play after converting on just 1-of-16 attempts in non-conference action.

**PAINT PRODUCTION:**

UIC has been effective scoring down low this season with 46% of its total points being scored in the paint. The Flames, who average 67.2 points per game, are scoring 30.9 per outing in the paint. UIC has scored at least 32 points in the paint in eight of its last nine games and tabbed a season-best 50 points in the paint versus Chicago State on Dec. 4<sup>th</sup>.

**A PRETTY TALENTED BENCH:**

UIC's talent runs deep as is evident by the production the Flames have gotten off the bench this season. Through the first 15 games, UIC is averaging 19.3 points per game off the bench, roughly 29% of the team's scoring average per outing.

**FINDING THE RIGHT ROTATION:**

Through its first 15 games this season, UIC has used eight different starting lineups. The group of Josh Mayo, Othys Jeffers, Elliott Poole, Justin Bowen and Jovan Stefanov had the best results, going a perfect 3-0 as the first five on the floor. Jeffers is the only Flame to start in all 15 games this season.

**A SENIOR SENSATION:**

Senior Justin Bowen is enjoying a standout final campaign for the Flames this season, leading the team in scoring (15.9 ppg) and rebounding (7.5 rpg) while rating in the Top 10 in the Horizon League in each category. Bowen, who entered the year with career averages of 5.9 ppg and 4.1 rpg, has scored in double-figures in 14 of his 15 games played and has a team- and Horizon League-best five double-doubles this season, including a 21-point, 11-rebound effort at Syracuse on Dec. 21<sup>st</sup>.

**JEFFERS MAKING A BID FOR TOP NEWCOMER HONORS:**

Sophomore Othys Jeffers has enjoyed an impressive start to his UIC career as he currently rates second on the team in scoring (12.7 ppg), rebounding (7.1 rpg) and assists (2.4 apg) while leading the team in blocks (0.8 bpg) and field goal percentage (55%). The 6-foot-5 forward, who owns three double-doubles this season, including a 16-point, 10-rebound performance at Syracuse on Dec. 21<sup>st</sup>, leads the Flames in scoring in Horizon League games, averaging 13.0 ppg.

## MAYO SETTLING INTO HIS ROLE AT THE POINT:

Freshman Josh Mayo seems to be settling into his role as the team's starting point guard. In his last five outings, Mayo has dished out 18 assists (3.6 apg) while committing just five turnovers. His best effort came when he handed out a career-high seven helpers in the Flames' 85-84 overtime win over Youngstown State on Dec. 31st. For the season, Mayo is now the team leader in assists at 2.8 apg.

## PLENTY OF CLOSE GAMES:

UIC has had more than its fair share of nail-biters this season. UIC has already played three overtime games, had four contests decided by a single point and six decisions by five points or less. The Flames, who are 3-3 in games decided by five points or less, have come out on the winning end of their last two thrillers, winning 85-84 in overtime on Dec. 31st versus Youngstown State and edging out Northern Illinois, 55-54, back on Dec. 17th with a last second put-back. Three times this season, though, UIC has fallen after missing a game-winning shot at the end of regulation.

## PASSING THEIR BOARDS:

UIC has hit the boards hard thus far in 2005-06, pulling down 38.2 rebounds per game while owning a +5.1 rebounding margin. The Flames have out-rebounded their opponent in 12 of their 15 games this year and have snagged at least 15 offensive caroms in seven outings. Senior Justin Bowen leads the team in rebounding at 7.5 per game and ranks fifth in the Horizon League in the category. Sophomore Othyus Jeffers, who is UIC's second-leading rebounder (7.2 rpg), is also right behind Bowen with his sixth-best league ranking.

## A SUCCESSFUL NON-CONFERENCE RUN:

UIC endured a rigorous non-league slate this season with contests against teams from the BIG EAST, Big Ten, ACC and SEC. The Flames opened the year with five games in 10 days, starting in Fairbanks, Alaska for the BP Top of the World Classic and finishing with a trip through Georgia to take on Georgia Tech and Georgia Southern. UIC is fresh off its first-ever victory over an SEC school with its win over Mississippi on Dec. 10th, and a Big Ten road triumph at Northwestern. The Flames also bested preseason favorites from the Big Sky (Montana State), Mountain West (San Diego State) and Southern Conference (Davidson) during non-league play.

## ACC...CHECK...SEC...CHECK...BIG TEN...CHECK:

UIC recorded a pair of firsts already this season with the program's first-ever wins over an Atlantic Coast Conference and Southeastern Conference opponent. The Flames disposed of Georgia Tech in Atlanta, 73-51, back on Nov. 25th and then rallied past Mississippi in overtime, 87-75, on Dec. 10th. UIC added another impressive win to its resume on Dec. 14th with a 71-62 triumph at Northwestern. The Flames are the only team in the country that can boast non-conference wins over teams from the ACC, SEC and Big Ten this season.

## OUR MAYO IS ON A ROLL:

UIC freshman Josh Mayo has played beyond his years to start his collegiate career. The Flames' point guard currently rates third on the team in scoring at 8.2 points per game and is tops on the team lead in assists (2.8 apg). Two of Mayo's best performances have come in two of UIC's biggest wins this season as he recorded 21 points and four assists in the team's win at Georgia Tech and then netted 11 of his 16 points in the final minute of regulation and overtime in UIC's triumph over Ole Miss.

## NO TROUBLE TABBING DOUBLE-DOUBLES:

UIC forwards Justin Bowen and Othyus Jeffers have combined for eight double-doubles through the first 15 games of the 2005-06 season. Bowen leads the Horizon League with five this season while Jeffers has tabbed three double-dips. The Flames totaled 12 double-doubles all of last season with Armond Williams leading the squad with four.

### DISHING IT OUT ON NEW YEAR'S EVE:

UIC was in the giving mood on New Year's Eve versus Youngstown State as the Flames dished out a season-high 26 assists in their overtime triumph over the Penguins. Freshman Josh Mayo and sophomore Karl White each dished out seven assists to lead the team while eight different UIC players tabbed at least one assist.

### COACH COLLINS IS NO. 1:

Headmaster Jimmy Collins continues to add to his record as UIC's all-time winningest men's basketball coach in his 10th season with the Flames as he now boasts 154 career victories after the team's triumph over Youngstown State on Dec. 31st. Collins, who has guided UIC to its only three NCAA Tournament appearances during his tenure, became the program's all-time leader in wins last season with career victory No. 134 in a road triumph at UNC Wilmington on Dec. 12th. He garnered career win No. 150 on Dec. 10, 2005 versus Mississippi.

### FLAMES SIGN A PAIR FOR 2006-07:

UIC inked a pair of players this fall for the 2006-07 season as Edwardsville, Ill., guard Spencer Stewart and Houston-area forward Jonathan Blake signed National Letters of Intent with the Flames. Stewart, 6-foot-4, garnered All-State honors last season at Edwardsville High School, averaging 9.4 points, 9.1 assists, 7.8 rebounds and 3.8 steals per game for the Tigers. Blake, 6-foot-5, was an All-District performer at Cypress Springs High School, totaling 13.6 points and 6.0 rebounds per contest.

### JEFFERS COMES WITH A UIC PEDIGREE:

Newcomer Othyus Jeffers, who sat out last season while attending UIC after playing one year of junior college basketball, has a family legacy with the Flames basketball program, as he is the cousin of former standout Mark Miller. With his permission, Jeffers will don Miller's No. 12 jersey, which was retired by UIC in 2000. Jeffers is a product of Hubbard High School and averaged 22.3 points and 10.8 rebounds per contest back in 2003-04 at Los Angeles Southwest Community College.

## UIC HEAD COACH Jimmy Collins (154-130, 10th season)

Head Coach Jimmy Collins is in his 10th season at the helm of the UIC men's basketball program. The veteran mentor is not only the winningest coach in school history with 154 career wins, but is also now the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois. He has captured a conference regular season title (1998) and two league tournament crowns (2002, 2004) during his tenure, and has guided the Flames to three 20-win seasons in the last four years, including a school-record 24 victories in 2003-04.

Named co-conference coach of the year after his first season with the Flames, Collins has also guided UIC to its only three NCAA Tournament appearances in school history, taking the team to the Big Dance in 1998, 2002 and 2004. He also guided the Flames to their first-ever NIT bid in 2003.

Collins, who served as an assistant coach at Illinois for 13 years prior to his arrival at UIC, earned All-American honors as a player at New Mexico State, averaging 20.1 ppg while leading the Aggies to the Final Four during his senior season.

### JIMMY COLLINS FAST FACTS

- \* Jimmy Collins was introduced as the ninth head coach in UIC history on March 27, 1996.
- \* In the midst of his 10th season with UIC, Collins is the longest tenured Division I men's basketball head coach in the state of Illinois.
- \* Collins has propelled UIC to its first three NCAA Tournament bids (1998, 2002, 2004) and first NIT berth (2003) in school history.
- \* Collins has led UIC to four 20-win seasons in his eight years on the sidelines: 22 (1997-98); 20 (2001-02); 21 (2002-03); 24 (2003-04).
- \* Collins is the program's all-time winningest coach with 154 career victories.
- \* Collins has guided UIC to a league regular-season (1998) and two league tournament titles (2002, 2004) during his tenure.
- \* Collins is the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois and the second-longest tenured coach in the Horizon League behind Perry Watson of Detroit.
- \* Collins was an assistant coach at the University of Illinois under Lou Henson for 13 years, including the 1989 season in which the Fighting Illini advanced to the Final Four.
- \* As Illinois' top recruiter, Collins' high-profile Illini signees included: Kendall Gill, Nick Anderson, Marcus Liberty, Deon Thomas, Kiwane Garris and Lowell Hamilton.
- \* Collins is the co-chairman of the Chicago Special Olympics.
- \* Collins, as well as the rest of his 1970 New Mexico State Final Four squad, were inducted into the school's Hall of Fame on Feb. 7th, 2004.
- \* Collins is a former first-round draft pick of the Chicago Bulls (1970).
- \* Collins served as a hearing officer for the Cook County Probation Department prior to his appointment as an assistant coach at Illinois.
