* **Quick Notes:** UIC plays at Wright State on Wednesday night in a battle for third place in the Horizon League...The Flames and Raiders are currently tied with Detroit, which hosts UW-Green Bay on Wednesday, for third in the league with 4-3 marks...This is the 28th all-time meeting in the series with UIC owning a 16-11 lead in the series...The Flames are 3-9 all-time in games with Wright State at the Nutter Center...Senior Cedrick Banks has averaged 24.7 points and has shot 63% from three-point range in his three prior trips to the Nutter Center...Junior Rocky Collum is averaging 12.3 points and 4.8 assists while shooting 53% from three-point range in his last four outings...With his two steals at UW-Green Bay on Jan. 22nd, senior Armond Williams is now the only player in school history to reach 1,000 points, 600 rebounds and 150 steals during his career...The Flames have been a second half team of late, averaging 38.3 points and shooting 55% from the field in the final 20 minutes of its last six games...UIC is 7-0 this season when holding its opponent under 60 points and 6-0 when keeping its opponents under 40% field goal shooting in a game.

RAIDER NOTES:

Wright State comes into Wednesday night's game in a three-way tie for third place in the Horizon League with UIC and Detroit at 4-3. The Raiders are 9-9 overall this season and own a 6-2 record at the Nutter Center. Wright State, most recently, snapped a two-game losing streak with a 59-54 win at Butler on Jan. 22nd. On the floor, the Raiders are led by sophomore point guard DaShaun Wood. The Detroit, Mich., native is averaging a team-high 14.7 points and 3.7 assists per game. Zakee Boyd, Drew Burluson and Zach Williams are the other Raider players averaging in double figures. Williams is the only upperclassmen in Wright State's starting lineup and he is a first-year player in the Horizon League after transferring from Ohio State. Paul Biancardi is in his second season on the sidelines at Wright State and owns a record of 23-23 with the Raiders.

UIC vs. WRIGHT STATE - SERIES NOTES:

- * Wednesday night's contest is the 28th all-time meeting between UIC and Wright State with the Flames holding a 16-11 edge in the series.
- * UIC has won four of the last six showdowns with the Raiders.
- * The Flames are just 3-9 in games versus Wright State at the Nutter Center.
- * UIC's last win at Wright State came on Jan. 29th, 2003, when Cedrick Banks' 33 points paved the way to a Flames' victory.

LAST TIME WE MET:

UIC 75, Wright State 71

February 26, 2004 * UIC Pavilion

Cedrick Banks scored 16 of his team-high 20 points in the second half to lift host UIC to the 75-71 Horizon League victory over Wright State, clinching second-place and an automatic berth in the semifinals of the conference tournament. Banks keyed a 12-0 run by UIC late in the second-half, posting a pair of treys, helping the Flames overcome a five-point deficit and put them in control of the game. UIC forward Armond Williams tallied 14 points, while teammates Aaron Carr and Elliott Poole each chipped in 12 points. Senior point guard Martell Bailey scored nine points and dished out 11 assists on the evening. Wright State senior guard Vernard Hollins posted a game-high 26 points, followed by freshman forwards Alex Kock (12 points) and Drew Burluson (10 points). Defensively, UIC forced 19 Wright State turnovers, which translated into 23 points for the Flames.

LAST TIME WE MET AT THE NUTTER CENTER:

Wright State 62, UIC 61

January 21, 2004

Rookie Alex Kock's put-back with four seconds remaining proved to be the difference as Wright State held off a UIC rally for a 61-60 victory at the Ervin J. Nutter Center. Flames senior Aaron Carr (14 points) had a three-point attempt for the win at the buzzer, but the 22-footer rimmed out. UIC was paced by senior Cedrick Banks' 16-point effort. Seth Doliboa led the Raiders with a game-high 17 points. The Flames trailed by as many as 14 points in the second half, but battled back to take a 60-59 lead in the final seconds on a steal and lay-in by Banks. Senior Martell Bailey had a chance to advance UIC's lead with 16 seconds left, but he missed the front end of a 1-and-1, setting up Wright State's final possession.

BANKS AND WRIGHT STATE:

UIC senior Cedrick Banks will take on Wright State for the seventh time in his career on Tuesday night, owning a 4-2 record in prior meetings. In those games, Banks is averaging 21.5 points and 5.3 rebounds per game while shooting 49% from the field and 52% from three-point range.

BANKS LIKES THE NUTTER CENTER

Senior Cedrick Banks has enjoyed great success offensively in his three prior trips to the Nutter Center, averaging 24.7 points per game while shooting 46% from the field and 63% from three-point range. His best effort came during the 2002-03 season when he poured in 33 points, going 13-for-18 from the field and 5-for-5 from behind the arc in his only win at the Nutter Center.

LAST TIME OUT FOR THE FLAMES:

UW-Green Bay 76, UIC 72

January 22, 2005 * Resch Center

The UIC men's basketball team came up just a little short on Saturday night in its show-down at UW-Green Bay for second place in the Horizon League as the Phoenix edged the Flames, 76-72, in front of 4,790 at the Resch Center. The loss snapped UIC's five-game winning streak. UW-Green Bay (12-5, 5-2), meanwhile, posted its first win over UIC since the 2000-01 season. Senior Cedrick Banks led the Flames with a game-high 23 points while adding a career-best tying six assists and five rebounds. Rocky Collum (13 points, 6 assists), Armond Williams (10 points, 9 rebounds) and Jovan Stefanov (10 points, 6 rebounds) also reached double figures for UIC, which shot 51% from the field in the game. The Phoenix, which shot 54% from the floor, used a total team effort to slip past the Flames, with five players in double figures. Senior Javier Mendiburu paced the UWGB attack, just missing a triple-double with 12 points, 11 assists and nine rebounds.

FAMILIAR TERRITORY WITH 10 GAMES TO PLAY:

UIC finds itself in familiar territory with 10 games to play during the regular season. Last year, the Flames were coming off a heart-breaking loss at Wright State and were 3-4 in Horizon League play with 10 regular-season games left. That squad went on to win all 10 of those remaining games, finished second in the league with a 12-4 mark and eventually captured the Horizon League Tournament crown. This season is quite similar for the Flames, who are coming off a heart-breaking loss at UW-Green Bay on Saturday and sit at 4-3 in the league with 10 regular-season games left on the slate.

BANKS PUTTING UP STRONG ALL-AROUND NUMBERS:

Senior Cedrick Banks has not only found his shooting touch in the last four games, but has put together strong all-around numbers for the Flames. During his recent surge, Banks is averaging 21.3 points, 4.8 rebounds and 4.5 assists per game while shooting 51% from the field.

A ROCK AT POINT GUARD:

Junior point guard Rocky Collum, who missed the first six weeks of the season with a torn left MCL, has started to find his niche in the Flames' offense. Over the last four games, Collum is averaging 12.3 points and 4.8 assists per outing while netting 53% of his three-point attempts. The Racine, Wis., native has recorded back-to-back career-high 13-point outings and dished out a personal-best six assists at UW-Green Bay on Jan. 22nd. All in all, UIC is 6-2 since Collum's return from injury.

ARMOND MAKES HISTORY:

Senior forward Armond Williams etched out his own spot in the UIC record books on Jan. 22nd at UW-Green Bay. With his two steals versus the Phoenix, Williams is now the only player in school history to have reached or surpassed 1,000 points, 600 rebounds and 150 steals in a career. In 108 games, Williams now owns 1,111 points, 628 rebounds and 150 steals.

50% STREAK SNAPPED:

UIC shot 51% from the field on Jan. 22nd at UW-Green Bay in a losing effort, snapping the Flames' 31-game winning streak when shooting 50% or better from the floor. The last time

A SECOND HALF TEAM:

The Flames have proven to be a second-half shooting team during its last six games in which they have gone 5-1. In the opening stanza in its last six games, UIC is averaging just 27.0 points and shooting 38% from the field. The Flames then turn things around after intermission, averaging 38.3 points and shooting 55% from the floor in the second half.

GETTING JOVAN IN DOUBLE FIGURES:

Sophomore Jovan Stefanov reaching double figures in scoring means good things for UIC as the Flames are 5-2 this year when he scores 10 or more points. For the year, the 6-foot-9 forward is now averaging single-season bests of 9.7 points and 5.2 rebounds per game.

COLLINS UIC'S CAREER COACHING LEADER:

UIC headmaster Jimmy Collins became the program's all-time winningest coach on Sunday, Dec. 12th, with the Flames' 76-67 victory at UNC Wilmington. It was career win No. 134 for Collins, pushing him past Bob Hallberg (1987-96). In his ninth season as head coach, Collins now owns an overall record of 140-116.

ALL ABOUT THE STARTING FIVE:

UIC's starting five accounted for all 74 points in the Flames' win over Cleveland State on Jan. 15th with each of the five reaching double figures. It was the first time in 466 games that UIC did not produce a point off the bench with the last scoreless night from the reserves coming in a 72-62 loss at Western Illinois on Jan. 25, 1988.

SCORING CHAMP:

Senior Cedrick Banks has his eye on leaving UIC as the school's all-time scoring leader. The 6-foot-2 guard moved into third place on the scoring list on Dec. 14th with his 12-point effort at #7 Duke. He is 192 points behind all-time scoring leader Kenny Williams (2,025).

Banks would need to average over 19.2 points per game during UIC's 10 remaining regular-season games to pass Williams.

JOINING THE 1,000-POINT CLUB:

Senior Armond Williams became the 17th player in UIC history to join the 1,000-point club with his eight points in the Flames' win at UNC Wilmington on Dec. 12th. Williams now has 1,111 points for his career, good for 13th place on the UIC all-time scoring list. Teammate Cedrick Banks was the last to join the 1,000-point club, doing so back on Nov. 17th, 2003 versus Mercer.

HIS HALFS MAKE A WHOLE:

Many players never reach 20 points in a game during a season. But with his 23-point second half versus Detroit on Dec. 30th, UIC senior guard Cedrick Banks has now scored 20 or more points in a single half on 11 occasions during his career.

WILLIAMS ALSO JOINS ALL-TIME REBOUNDING TOP 10:

Forward Armond Williams double-dipped his career accomplishments on Dec. 12th versus UNC Wilmington as his nine caroms vaulted him into the top 10 on the UIC career rebounding list. Williams owns 628 career rebounds, good for ninth place, and is just the seventh player in school history to reach 1,000 points and 550 rebounds in a career.

NO THREES FOR UIC:

After a streak of 172 straight games with a three-pointer made, UIC has now gone triple-free twice this season, most recently at Youngstown State on Jan. 3rd. The Flames also failed to net a three-pointer on Nov. 24th at Bowling Green. The last time the Flames went triple-less prior to that was on Dec. 28th, 1998 in a loss to Montana at the Pavilion.

**UIC HEAD COACH
Jimmy Collins
(140-116, 9th season)**

Head Coach Jimmy Collins is in his ninth season at the helm of the UIC men's basketball program. The veteran mentor has compiled a current record of 140-116, making him the program's all-time winningest coach. Collins collected career win No. 134, which pushed him past former headmaster Bob Hallberg (1987-96) for the top spot, on Dec. 12th at UNC Wilmington.

He has captured a conference regular season title (1998) and two league tournament crowns (2002, 2004) during his tenure, and has guided the Flames to three straight 20-win seasons, including a school record 24 victories last year.

Named co-conference coach of the year after his first season with the Flames, Collins has also guided UIC to its only three NCAA Tournament appearances in school history, taking the team to the Big Dance in 1998, 2002 and 2004. He also guided the Flames to their first-ever NIT bid in 2003.

Collins, who served as an assistant coach at Illinois for 13 years prior to his arrival at UIC, earned All-American honors as a player at New Mexico State, averaging 20.1 ppg while leading the Aggies to the Final Four during his senior season.

JIMMY COLLINS FAST FACTS

- * Jimmy Collins was introduced as the ninth head coach in UIC history on March 27, 1996.
- * Collins has propelled UIC to its first three NCAA Tournament bids (1998, 2002, 2004) and first NIT berth (2003) in school history.
- * Collins has led UIC to four 20-win seasons in his eight years on the sidelines: 22 (1997-98); 20 (2001-02); 21 (2002-03); 24 (2003-04).
- * Collins is the program's all-time winningest coach with 140 career victories.
- * Collins has guided UIC to a league regular-season (1998) and two league tournament titles (2002, 2004) during his tenure.
- * Collins is the second-longest tenured coach in the Horizon League behind Perry Watson of Detroit.
- * Collins has posted a record of 82-31 (.726) at home during his career at UIC.
- * Collins was an assistant coach at the University of Illinois under Lou Henson for 13 years, including the 1989 season in which the Fighting Illini advanced to the Final Four.
- * As Illinois' top recruiter, Collins' high-profile Illini signees included: Kendall Gill, Nick Anderson, Marcus Liberty, Deon Thomas, Kiwane Garris and Lowell Hamilton.
- * Collins is the co-chairman of the Chicago Special Olympics.
- * Collins, as well as the rest of his 1970 New Mexico State Final Four squad, were inducted into the school's Hall of Fame on Feb. 7th, 2004.
- * Collins is a former first-round draft pick of the Chicago Bulls (1970).
- * Collins served as a hearing officer for the Cook County Probation Department prior to his appointment as an assistant coach at Illinois.

Green Bay, Wis. - The UIC men's basketball team came up just a little short on Saturday night in its showdown at UW-Green Bay for second place in the Horizon League as the Phoenix edged the Flames, 76-72, in front of 4,790 at the Resch Center.

The loss snapped UIC's (9-8, 4-3) five-game winning streak and dropped the Flames into a three-way tie for third in the league with Detroit and Wright State. UW-Green Bay (12-5, 5-2), meanwhile, posted its first win over UIC since the 2000-01 season and now sits alone in second place in the Horizon League, behind UW-Milwaukee (12-4, 8-1).

Senior Cedrick Banks led the Flames with a game-high 23 points while adding a career-best tying six assists and five rebounds.

Rocky Collum (13 points, 6 assists), Armond Williams (10 points, 9 rebounds) and Jovan Stefanov (10 points, 6 rebounds) also reached double figures for UIC, which shot 51% from the field in the game.

The Phoenix, which shot 54% from the floor, used a total team effort to slip past the Flames, with five players in double figures. Senior Javier Mendiburu paced the UWGB attack, just missing a triple-double with 12 points, 11 assists and nine rebounds.

The lead had see-sawed back and forth for most of the game, before an 11-1 Phoenix surge staked UW-Green Bay to a 69-60 lead with 3:57 left. It was the largest advantage for either team during the contest.

UIC clawed back, though, and eventually pulled within one, 71-70, with 1:28 remaining on a three-pointer by Collum.

The Flames would then get the ball back with under a minute left after a turnover by Josh Lawrence, but freshman Karl White would miss a baseline jumper giving the ball back to the Phoenix.

UW-Green Bay senior Matt Rohde provided the back-breaking blow with a three-pointer from the right wing with 16 seconds left for a four-point lead.
