*Quick Notes: The UIC men's basketball team plays the third game in a stretch of four games in eight days on Thursday night versus Youngstown State at the Beeghly Center...The Flames have never lost to the Penguins, owning a perfect 14-0 record in contests with YSU dating back to the 1992-93 season...UIC is 6-0 all-time at the Beeghly Center...The last four meetings between the Flames and Penguins have come down to the wire with the average margin of victory for UIC just 4.3 points...The Flames won the early meeting with YSU this season in overtime, 85-84, on Dec. 31st...UIC racked up a Horizon League season-high 26 assists in that contest with the Penguins...YSU guard Quin Humphrey leads the league in scoring (19.6 ppg) and rebounding (8.8 rpg)...The Flames counter with senior Justin Bowen, who ranks in the top 10 in the league in scoring (15.6 ppg/10th), rebounding (7.2 rpg/6th), field goal percentage (54%/5th) and free throw percentage (79%/5th)...Junior Danijel Zoric is averaging 11.7 points and 5.3 rebounds for the Flames in his last three games...The Flames return home on Saturday to take on Detroit at 3:00 p.m.

Penguin Notes: Youngstown enters Thursday's contest with a record of 7-13 and 4-6 in Horizon League play. The Penguins are fresh off an 81-67 loss at Wright State on Monday night. Youngstown State is 2-2 in its last four games with wins over Cleveland State and Butler. On the floor, the Penguins are paced by All-Horizon League guard Quin Humphrey. The 6-foot-4 junior is the league leader in scoring (19.6 ppg) and rebounding (8.8 rpg) while also averaging 2.5 assists per outing. The Penguins are a strong rebounding squad, owning a +2.5 rebounding margin and pulling down almost 13 offensive caroms per game. Head Coach Jerry Slocum is in his first season at the helm of the YSU program after spending the last nine seasons at Division II Gannon.

UIC vs. YSU - SERIES NOTES:

- * UIC is a perfect 14-0 all-time versus Youngstown State.
- * The Flames are 6-0 all-time versus the Penguins at the Beeghly Center.
- * UIC's last four wins at Youngstown State have been decided by six points or less and the last four overall meetings have been decided by an average of 4.3 points.
- * These two teams have met once in the postseason with the Flames downing the Penguins, 79-59, at the 2003 Horizon League Tournament in Milwaukee, Wis.

LAST TIME WE MET:

UIC 85, Youngstown State 84 (ot)

December 31, 2005 * UIC Pavilion

Behind five players scoring in double figures, UIC opened Horizon League play with a thrilling 85-84 overtime triumph over Youngstown State on New Year's Eve at the UIC Pavilion. Sophomore Othys Jeffers' (14 points) lay-in with :19 left proved to be the game-winner in overtime as the Penguins' Quin Humphrey, who finished with a game-high 33 points, missed a runner at the horn. Senior Justin Bowen finished with 19 points to lead UIC while Elliott Poole (13 points, 9 rebounds), Karl White (10 points, 7 assists) and Josh Mayo (10 points, 7 assists) were also in double figures for the Flames. UIC committed just 12 turnovers in the game while dishing out a season-best 26 assists.

LAST TIME WE MET AT THE BEEGHLY CENTER:

UIC 62, Youngstown State 56

January 3, 2005 * Beeghly Center

Sophomore Jovan Stefanov tallied all of his then career-high tying 16 points in the second half to help break open a tight contest and lead UIC to a 62-56 victory over Youngstown State on January 3rd at the Beeghly Center. Senior Cedrick Banks (12 points), junior Elliott Poole (11 points) and senior Armond Williams (10 points) also reached double figures for the Flames. Quin Humphrey and Zach Silverman each scored 11 points for the Penguins. The score was knotted at 27-27 at intermission, but Stefanov exploded for 11 points in the first five minutes of the second half as UIC opened up a 42-32 lead. The Penguins, who shot 52% from the field in the second half, kept the Flames within striking distance with several timely three-pointers and cut the lead to 55-53 with 2:44 left on a triple by Derrick Harris. A Banks jumper put UIC back up four and then the Flames hit 5-of-6 free throws down the stretch to seal the victory. UIC shot 57% from the floor in the second half and 51% for the game.

LAST TIME OUT:

Butler 67, UIC 39

January 30, 2006 * UIC Pavilion

Butler guard Bruce Horan netted seven three-pointers in the first half on Monday night as the Bulldogs opened up an early lead and never looked back in a 67-39 victory over UIC at

the Pavilion. Horan was 7-for-8 from behind the arc in the opening 20 minutes, scoring all of his game-high 21 points in the period. The Flames did not have a player reach double figures as junior Danijel Zoric led the team with eight points. Butler shot 56% from the field and 55% from three-point range in the contest while limiting UIC to a Pavilion-low 39 points on 39% shooting.

WHAT'S UP NEXT:

UIC returns home on Saturday, Feb. 4th, to take on Detroit at 3:00 p.m., in a game being broadcast nationally on ESPN2. The Flames are looking to even the season-series with the Titans after UIC dropped a 76-65 decision in the Motor City back on Jan. 21st. The contest with Detroit will conclude a stretch of four games in eight days for UIC.

JUSTIN TIME:

Senior Justin Bowen is enjoying a standout final campaign for the Flames this season, leading the team in scoring (15.6 ppg) and field goal percentage (54%), and rating second in rebounding (7.2 rpg), while rating in the top 10 in the Horizon League in each category. Bowen, who entered the year with career averages of 5.9 ppg and 4.1 rpg, has scored in double-figures in 18 of his 22 games played and has a team-best seven double-doubles this season, including a 26-point, 10-rebound effort on Jan. 28th versus UW-Green Bay.

JEFFERS MAKING A BID FOR TOP NEWCOMER HONORS:

Sophomore Othys Jeffers has had an impressive start to his UIC career as he currently leads the team in rebounding (7.4 rpg), assists (3.0 apg) and blocks (0.7 bpg) while ranking second in scoring (11.6 ppg) and field goal percentage (51%). The 6-foot-5 forward, who owns four double-doubles this season, recorded a career-best 12 rebounds, five assists and two points versus UW-Green Bay on Jan. 28th.

FOREIGN FLAVOR:

Serbia & Montenegro natives Danijel Zoric and Jovan Stefanov, both 6-foot-9 junior forwards, have provided a strong one-two punch for the Flames in their last three games, combining for 21.4 points, 9.3 rebounds and 4.3 assists per outing. Zoric has especially stepped up his game of late, averaging 11.7 points and 5.3 rebounds in his last three contests. UIC's roster features a third native of Serbia & Montenegro, Jovan Ignjatovic. The 6-foot-9 freshman is now redshirting this season after having his appendix removed in December.

CASHING IN OUR BOND:

Sophomore Kevin Bond has give UIC an offensive boost off the bench, averaging 8.3 points and shooting 60% from the field and 50% from three-point range in his last three games. The 6-foot-5 wing came up especially big in the Flames' two most recent victories, splashing in eight second-half points to help UIC erase a 15-point deficit in a win at Wright State on Jan. 25th, and then scoring a career-high 11 points in the team's Jan. 28th win over UW-Green Bay. For the season, Bond is averaging 4.3 points per game while shooting 49% from the field and 44% from three-point range.

NEW YEAR'S EVE DISHES:

UIC was in the giving mood on New Year's Eve versus Youngstown State as the Flames dished out a season-high 26 assists in their overtime triumph over the Penguins. The 26 helpers were the most dished out by any team in the Horizon League in a single game this season. Freshman Josh Mayo and sophomore Karl White each dished out seven assists to lead the team while eight different UIC players tabbed at least one assist.

NOT YOUR EVERY DAY ASSIST MAN:

Sophomore forward Othys Jeffers is not only the Flames' leading rebounder at 7.4 rpg, but also leads the team in assists at 3.0 per outing. The 6-foot-5 forward has tabbed a career-high seven assists on two occasions this season and has had five or more assists in four outings. The last player to lead UIC in both rebounding and assists in the same year was Shawn Harlan during the 1995-96 campaign.

ANOTHER DOUBLE DIP FOR BOWEN:

Senior Justin Bowen showed no ill effects from the turf toe injury that limited him at Wright State on Jan. 25th, recording his seventh double-double of the season on Jan. 28th versus UW-Green Bay with a career-high tying 26 points and 10 rebounds. The 6-foot-7 forward was 10-for-14 from the field in the contest while also blocking two shots. Bowen's

seven double-doubles is the second-most in the Horizon League this season.

COMEBACK KIDS:

UIC's comeback from 15 points down in the second half in its victory over Wright State on Jan. 25th was the largest deficit overcome by the Flames in a win this season. UIC came from 16 down in the second half to send its game at UW-Green Bay into overtime, only to fall to the Phoenix, 90-84. The Flames' prior top comeback was against Ole Miss, when UIC erased a 12-point deficit in the second half en route to an 87-75 overtime triumph over the Rebels.

ROCKY ON THE ROAD BACK:

After overcoming numerous setbacks due to injury and illness, senior Rocky Collum is beginning to make his way back into the Flames' rotation. The 5-foot-10 guard, who averaged 8.7 ppg last year, played a season-high 13 minutes on Monday versus Butler and tabbed two points and an assist off the bench. In five appearances this season, Collum is averaging 2.4 ppg with all of but one of his made field goals coming from behind the three-point arc.

FAB FROSH:

UIC freshman Josh Mayo has played beyond his years to start his collegiate career. The Merrillville, Ind., native took over the starting spot at point guard 18 games ago and hasn't looked back. Mayo currently rates third on the team in scoring at 8.8 points per game and is second on the team in assists (2.7 apg). Mayo also ranks first on the team in free throw shooting at 84% while he tops the squad in three-pointers made with 30. Two of Mayo's best performances have come in two of UIC's biggest wins this season as he recorded 21 points and four assists in the team's win at Georgia Tech and then netted 11 of his 16 points in the final minute of regulation and overtime in UIC's triumph over Ole Miss.

TAKING CARE OF THE BASKETBALL:

UIC did a great job of taking care of the basketball on Jan. 28th versus UW-Green Bay, committing a season-low six turnovers while dishing out 16 assists. The Flames are now 7-1 when committing fewer turnovers than their opponents this year.

PLENTY OF CLOSE GAMES:

UIC has had more than its fair share of nail-biters this season. UIC has already played four overtime games, had four contests decided by a single point and eight decisions by five points or less after a 62-57 win over Wright State on Jan. 25th. The Flames are 2-2 in overtime games and 4-4 in games decided by five points or less.

PASSING THEIR BOARDS:

UIC has hit the boards hard thus far in 2005-06, pulling down 36.5 rebounds per game while owning a +3.7 rebounding margin. The Flames have out-rebounded their opponent in 16 of their 22 games this year and have snagged at least 15 offensive caroms in 10 outings. Sophomore Othyus Jeffers leads the team in rebounding at 7.4 rpg while senior Justin Bowen is right behind him at 7.2 rpg.

DID YOU KNOW:

UIC has 10 wins this season, but has only been in the lead with 5:00 left in the game on three occasions. The Flames have been tied at the five-minute mark four times, winning all four, and have erased a deficit in the final five minutes on four occasions as well. UIC is 2-1 when leading with five minutes remaining.

FINDING THE RIGHT ROTATION:

Through its 22 games this season, UIC has used eight different starting lineups. UIC has used its most recent starting lineup (Mayo, Jeffers, Bowen, Stefanov, Zoric) in four games with the group going 2-2. Sophomore Othyus Jeffers is the only Flame to start in all 22 games this season.

A SUCCESSFUL NON-CONFERENCE RUN:

UIC endured a rigorous non-league slate this season with contests against teams from the BIG EAST, Big Ten, ACC and SEC. The Flames opened the year with five games in 10 days, starting in Fairbanks, Alaska for the BP Top of the World Classic and finishing with a trip through Georgia to take on Georgia Tech and Georgia Southern. UIC is fresh off its first-ever victory over an SEC school with its win over Mississippi on Dec. 10th, and a Big Ten road triumph at Northwestern. The Flames also bested preseason favorites from the Big

Sky (Montana State), Mountain West (San Diego State) and Southern Conference (Davidson) during non-league play.

ACC...CHECK...SEC...CHECK...BIG TEN...CHECK:

UIC recorded a pair of firsts already this season with the program's first-ever wins over an Atlantic Coast Conference and Southeastern Conference opponent. The Flames disposed of Georgia Tech in Atlanta, 73-51, back on Nov. 25th and then rallied past Mississippi in overtime, 87-75, on Dec. 10th. UIC added another impressive win to its resume on Dec. 14th with a 71-62 triumph at Northwestern. The Flames are the only team in the country that can boast non-conference wins over teams from the ACC, SEC and Big Ten this season.

FLAMES SIGN A PAIR FOR 2006-07:

UIC inked a pair of players this fall for the 2006-07 season as Edwardsville, Ill., guard Spencer Stewart and Houston-area forward Jonathan Blake signed National Letters of Intent with the Flames. Stewart, 6-foot-4, garnered All-State honors last season at Edwardsville High School, averaging 9.4 points, 9.1 assists, 7.8 rebounds and 3.8 steals per game for the Tigers. Blake, 6-foot-5, was an All-District performer at Cypress Springs High School, totaling 13.6 points and 6.0 rebounds per contest.

JEFFERS COMES WITH A UIC PEDIGREE:

Newcomer Othys Jeffers, who sat out last season while attending UIC after playing one year of junior college basketball, has a family legacy with the Flames basketball program, as he is the cousin of former standout Mark Miller. With his permission, Jeffers will don Miller's No. 12 jersey, which was retired by UIC in 2000. UIC HEAD COACH Jimmy Collins (156-135, 10th season)

Head Coach Jimmy Collins is in his 10th season at the helm of the UIC men's basketball program. The veteran mentor is not only the winningest coach in school history with 156 career wins, but is also now the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois. He has captured a conference regular season title (1998) and two league tournament crowns (2002, 2004) during his tenure, and has guided the Flames to three 20-win seasons in the last four years, including a school-record 24 victories in 2003-04.

Named co-conference coach of the year after his first season with the Flames, Collins has also guided UIC to its only three NCAA Tournament appearances in school history, taking the team to the Big Dance in 1998, 2002 and 2004. He also guided the Flames to their first-ever NIT bid in 2003.

Collins, who served as an assistant coach at Illinois for 13 years prior to his arrival at UIC, earned All-American honors as a player at New Mexico State, averaging 20.1 ppg while leading the Aggies to the Final Four during his senior season.

JIMMY COLLINS FAST FACTS

- * Jimmy Collins was introduced as the ninth head coach in UIC history on March 27, 1996.
- * In the midst of his 10th season with UIC, Collins is the longest tenured Division I men's basketball head coach in the state of Illinois.
- * Collins has propelled UIC to its first three NCAA Tournament bids (1998, 2002, 2004) and first NIT berth (2003) in school history.
- * Collins has led UIC to four 20-win seasons in his eight years on the sidelines: 22 (1997-98); 20 (2001-02); 21 (2002-03); 24 (2003-04).
- * Collins is the program's all-time winningest coach with 156 career victories.
- * Collins has guided UIC to a league regular-season (1998) and two league tournament titles (2002, 2004) during his tenure.
- * Collins is the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois and the second-longest tenured coach in the Horizon League behind Perry Watson of Detroit.
- * Collins was an assistant coach at the University of Illinois under Lou Henson for 13 years, including the 1989 season in which the Fighting Illini advanced to the Final Four.
- * As Illinois' top recruiter, Collins' high-profile Illini signees included: Kendall Gill, Nick Anderson, Marcus Liberty, Deon Thomas, Kiwane Garris and Lowell Hamilton.
- * Collins is the co-chairman of the Chicago Special Olympics.
- * Collins, as well as the rest of his 1970 New Mexico State Final Four squad, were inducted into the school's Hall of Fame on Feb. 7th, 2004.
- * Collins is a former first-round draft pick of the Chicago Bulls (1970).
- * Collins served as a hearing officer for the Cook County Probation Department prior to his appointment as an assistant coach at Illinois.
