The UIC soccer team will seek a return to the Round of 16 as the Flames tangle with 12th-seeded Notre Dame in the second round of the 2006 NCAA Division I Men's Soccer Championship at Alumni Field on Wednesday night. The winner will advance to face the winner of the St. John's/Maryland match this weekend. This is the third all-time meeting between UIC and Notre Dame and the first in 12 years.



UIC SOCCER QUICK KICKS

- UIC is making its third all-time appearance in the NCAA Tournament and first since 2000.

- UIC won the 2006 Horizon League regular season championship, the third all-time regular season conference crown in school history and first since 2000.

- This year's bid is the first at-large berth into the NCAA Tournament in UIC men's soccer history.

- UIC owns a school-record 13 shutouts this season.

- The Flames have allowed just seven goals in 20 matches this year.

- UIC's team goals against average is 0.33, the second-lowest GAA in the nation.

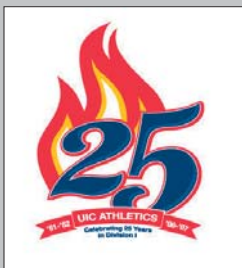

FLAMES FACTS

ONE OF NATION'S BEST LINES OF DEFENSE:

UIC remains one of the top defensive teams in NCAA Division I play according to this week's national statistical rankings. The Flames are second in team goals against average (0.33) and tops in save percentage (.910).

JOVAN A NATIONAL TREASURE:

So far goalkeeper **Jovan Bubonja** has been stellar in his debut season. The Horizon League's Goalkeeper of the Year enters Wednesday's tilt ranked third nationally in both goals against average (0.34) and save percentage (.907). His 10 shutouts this year have set a new UIC single-season record for clean sheets while putting him in fourth place on the UIC career shutout list. His GAA is currently the best single-season mark in UIC history.

SUPER SKROCE:

Forward **Tonci Skroce** has been UIC's go-to guy the last two seasons. The 2006 Horizon League Player of the Year has 10 game-winning goals in that span, with five match-notching scores in both 2005 and 2006.

THE BEST PLAYER YOU'VE NEVER HEARD OF:

While he doesn't get the recognition that star players at traditional power schools receive, UIC junior midfielder **Pavle Dundjer** is still the real deal. A three-time All-Horizon League First Team selection and a 2005 NSCAA/adidas All-Midwest Region Second Team honoree, Dundjer posted a career-high eight goals in 2006. Dundjer now has 19 career goals, 10 career assists and 48 career points.

A FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING:

UIC's berth into the 2006 NCAA Division I Men's Soccer Tournament is the first at-large bid into the dance in the program's history. The Flames received an automatic berth in their two prior trips to NCAA postseason play by way of conference tournament victories.

BRINGING THE "D":

The trademark of the 2006 UIC men's soccer team is defense. In addition to the team's high national statistical rankings on defense, UIC has posted 13 shutouts and allowed just seven goals all season, the second-fewest total in the nation. Only twice have the Flames allowed a goal after intermission. UIC has gone the last 473 minutes of play without giving up a goal, a span of five games that includes four shutouts.

KEEPING UP WITH JAY



Former UIC standout Jay DeMerit is currently playing his first season in the English Premier League with Watford FC. DeMerit, who was recently named a captain, and the Hornets face Premiership foe Portsmouth this Saturday, November 18th.

LAST TIME WE MET:

Notre Dame went up in the 14th minute and never looked back in a 3-0 victory in South Bend on October 7, 1994. UIC goalkeeper **Tony Moreno** made 10 saves against the Irish.

HOME SWEET HOME:

UIC went 7-0-3 at Flames Field this season. In 11 seasons on the pitch the Flames have posted a 65-17-9 home record.

WORKING OVERTIME:

UIC is undefeated in overtime this year. The Flames are 2-0-5 in extra-period play this season. UIC is 6-1-7 in overtime since the arrival of head coach **John Trask** in 2005.

IT STARTS AT THE TOP:

With a 23-7-7 record in two seasons at the helm of the UIC soccer program, **John Trask** owns the best two-year start by a head coach in school history. His two-season winning percentage of .622 is the best career winning percentage ever for a UIC head coach.

CERVANTES SERVES UP GOALS:

Eric Cervantes continued his fine campaign with his seventh goal of 2006 on Saturday, giving him a new career-high for single-season goals.

A LITTLE BIT ALIKE:

This year's UIC men's soccer team has many things in common with the famed 2000 squad that made a Sweet 16 run in the NCAA Tournament. Here are just a few:

- UIC's 5-1-1 Horizon League record is the Flames' best loop mark since 2000.

- The Flames' 13 total victories are the most since a school-record 18 wins in 2000.

- So far the Flames have just two losses, the first time UIC has had fewer than five losses since the 2000 team suffered just four defeats.

- UIC established a new shutout record of 13 clean sheets, breaking the original mark of 10 set by the 2000 squad.

- Both teams featured the league's Player of the Year (Tonci Skroce, 2006; Eric Lukin, 2000).

- Both teams advanced to the NCAA Tournament second round.

- This year UIC earned its first Horizon League regular season championship

FAB FIVE:

All 30 of UIC's goals this season have been accounted for by five players: **Tonci Skroce** (7), **Pavle Dundjer** (8), **Eric Cervantes** (7), **Cesar Zambrano** (5) and **Brodey Simkins** (3). On the other hand, 12 players have had a share in UIC's 22 assists, led by Skroce's seven helpers.

A UNITED FRONT:

Eight flags hang above the bleachers at Flames Field, representing the national origins of numerous UIC players. Here's a rundown of seven of those nations (not including the United States) and the UIC regulars that hail from them:

LOCAL FLAVOR:

This year's UIC men's soccer team also features a lineup full of Chicago area flavor. 17 UIC players hail from the Chicagoland area.

TACKLING TOP COMPETITION:

UIC is 6-0-0 against Top 25 foes and 2005 NCAA Tournament teams over the past two seasons. All four wins against ranked opponents have occurred on the road:

- September 2, 2005 – UIC 2, at No. 24 Loyola Marymount 0

- October 5, 2005 – UIC 2, at No. 25 Creighton 1*

- August 26, 2006 – UIC 1, at No. 25 Saint Louis 0

LOSING IS NOT AN OPTION:

The Flames rarely experienced the agony of defeat this season. As of press time UIC was one of just six Division I teams with two losses or fewer, joining the likes of SMU, Wake Forest, Lehigh, Towson and Oneonta State in that category. The school record for fewest losses is three, set in 1998.

PLAYING WITH FIRE:

UIC has many ties to Chicago's Major League Soccer team, the Chicago Fire. Freshman midfielder **Ian Sarachan** is the son of Fire head coach **Dave Sarachan**, while Fire back **C.J. Brown** serves as a volunteer assistant coach for the Flames.

THE OPPOSITION: NOTRE DAME

The Irish are making their sixth straight appearance in the NCAA Tournament and third as a seed. Notre Dame went 13-5-2 overall and 8-4-0 in the BIG EAST. M.A.C. Hermann Trophy candidate Joseph Lapira leads the nation in goals (20) and points (45) for the Irish. Bobby Clark is in his sixth campaign as head coach of Notre Dame. The Irish went to the Sweet 16 last season.

THE HISTORY BETWEEN THE FLAMES AND THE IRISH:

UIC is 0-2 all-time against Notre Dame. In the teams' first meeting, a five-goal outburst in the second period helped the Irish take a 7-0 win on September 11, 1992. In the last meeting between UIC and Notre Dame, the Flames fell by a 3-0 score on October 7, 1994. ND head coach Bobby Clark faced the Flames in the 2000 NCAA Tournament as Stanford's head coach.

IRON MAN:

Senior back **Derek Kosek** will start his 57th consecutive game for the Flames this Wednesday. He is UIC's active leader in games played with 76 matches.

AGAINST THIS YEAR'S CROP:

UIC went 3-0-2 in the regular season against teams who appeared in this year's NCAA Tournament. The Flames own victories over UC Santa Barbara, Saint Louis and Northwestern and two draws against Loyola.

UIC NCAA TOURNAMENT NOTABLES

- **Eric Lukin** is UIC's all-time NCAA Tournament scorer with two goals and five points. Lukin is also UIC's single-game point leader in NCAA Tournament play with three against Fairleigh Dickinson.

- **Stein Garcia** and **Ranko Tutulugdzija** lead UIC with two career NCAA Tournament assists. Tutulugdzija tabbed both of his assists in UIC's win over Fairleigh Dickinson in 2000.

- All four of UIC's NCAA Tournament wins are shutouts.

- UIC is 3-0 in NCAA Tournament games at Flames Field and 1-2 in the NCAA Tournament away from home.

PLAY-IN GAME - 11/13/99

UIC 1, FAIRFIELD 0

John Collins' goal from 20 yards out in the sixth minute of the contest was all the Flames needed, as UIC's NCAA postseason debut was a successful one following a 1-0 win over Fairfield in a play-in game at Flames Field.

FIRST ROUND - 11/21/99

SAINT LOUIS 3, UIC 2

UIC went ahead twice before two unanswered Billiken goals would give Saint Louis a 3-2 victory at Hermann Stadium. **Eric Lukin** scored in the 30th minute before an SLU goal tied the match 45 seconds later. **Ryan Lindgren** would put UIC back up less than two minutes after intermission, but the host Billikens scored twice within a four-minute span in the middle of the period to eliminate the Flames.

2000

PLAY-IN GAME - 11/11/00

UIC 2, FAIRLEIGH DICKINSON 0

Eric Lukin put UIC ahead in the 23rd minute, and **Greg Chrisman** added an insurance tally in the 66th minute to help UIC defeat Fairleigh Dickinson, 2-0, at Flames Field.

FIRST ROUND - 11/19/00

UIC 1, No. 24 BRADLEY 0

Pablo Melgar scored on a free kick from 18 yards out with six minutes remaining in regulation to propel UIC to a 1-0 victory over 24th-ranked Bradley in Peoria and help the Flames advance to the second round for the first time in school history. **Chris Jamal** made seven saves, while the Flames posted four team saves.

SECOND ROUND - 11/25/99

STANFORD 6, UIC 0

UIC could not withstand a Cardinal offensive onslaught as Stanford eliminated the Flames in a 6-0 decision in Stanford, Calif. After holding Stanford scoreless in the first half, UIC was unable to contain the Cardinal after intermission by allowing six unanswered goals in the final frame.

FIRST ROUND - 11/11/06

UIC 3, WESTERN ILLINOIS 0

Goals from **Cesar Zambrano**, **Eric Cervantes** and **Pavle Dundjer** made UIC's first NCAA Tournament match in six years a memorable one in the Flames' 3-0 victory over Western Illinois at Flames Field. Goalkeeper **Jovan Bubonja** and the UIC defense held one of the nation's top offenses in check to register the Flames' 13th clean sheet of the year.

UIC HEAD COACH JOHN TRASK

SECOND SEASON

When John Trask was named the fourth head men's soccer coach in UIC's Division I history on January 17, 2005, a new standard of excellence was immediately established for the program.

Trask has quickly turned around a team that was 5-12-2 when he inherited it. In two short years the Flames have posted a winning percentage of .622 and earned the program's first NCAA Tournament berth since 2000.

UIC was one of the Cinderella stories of college soccer this season. The Flames opened the season with a 1-0 win over 25th-ranked Saint Louis at Hermann Stadium, helping UIC appear in the national rankings for the first time since 2001.

Along with a 2-1 road victory at No. 7 UC Santa Barbara, the highest-ranked opponent that UIC has beaten in school history, and wins over powers such as Northwestern and Bradley, the Flames have stayed in the national rankings for a school-record 10 consecutive weeks while claiming the top spot in the Great Lakes Region Rankings on multiple occasions. Under Trask's watch, the Flames became a consensus Top 10 team in the national rankings for the first time in school history on September 26, 2006.

UIC has been near the top of the NCAA's statistical rankings all season long in 2006, cementing a Top 5 ranking in team goals against average and save percentage for most of the year.

In his first year at the helm, Trask took a team that went 5-12-2 in the fall prior to his arrival and guided it to a fantastic 10-5-2 campaign in 2005. By doubling their win total and losing seven fewer matches in Trask's first season, UIC posted the nation's sixth-best turnaround.

The Flames have stepped up their level of play against top competition under Trask. With two wins this year against ranked foes and road victories over Top 25 teams Loyola Marymount and Creighton last season, the Flames improved to 4-0 against Top 25 teams on the road in the last two seasons.

Along with stellar showings against some of the nation's best teams, UIC has also proved to be a club with better preparation and fitness under Trask's watch. The team's 6-1-7 record in overtime matches during the last two seasons proves such a statement.

Trask began his coaching career at Indiana, serving as an assistant for nearly a decade at his alma mater under the legendary Jerry Yeagley. Trask helped build a dynasty that saw the Hoosiers amass eight Big Ten titles, reach five College Cups and earn back-to-back National Championships in 1998 and 1999.

Prior to arriving at UIC, Trask spent five seasons as an assistant coach in Major League Soccer with the Miami Fusion, D.C. United and the Dallas Burn/FC Dallas. In MLS Trask trained the likes of Preki, Eddie Johnson and other superstars.

Trask has also spent significant time working with youth national teams for the United States Soccer Federation. Freddy Adu, Landon Donovan and numerous other internationally-known phenoms have trained under Trask.
