SETTING THE SCENE:

The UIC women's basketball team heads to the Klotsche Center on Saturday looking to remain in fourth place in the league standings as it continues to jockey for position in the race for a home game in the quarterfinals of next month's Horizon League Tournament...The Flames are currently tied for fourth with Valparaiso and a game and a half ahead of both Milwaukee and Wright State for sixth place...UIC has won the last three games in the series against Milwaukee, including a 62-59 win at the Klotsche Center last season...Jessie Miller, who is averaging 17.4 ppg in her career against the Panthers, tallied a career-high 27 points in last year's meeting in Milwaukee...Miller needs just seven points on Saturday to become the 14th UIC player, and just the third junior, to reach 1,000 career points...UIC and Milwaukee are two of the Horizon League's top rebounding teams as the Flames enter as the leader in total rebounds per game at 39.5 while the Panthers top the league leaders in rebounding margin at +4.1...Sophomore Shanice Sadler gave UIC a spark off the bench in the Flames' outing at Green Bay on Thursday, totaling 11 points and six rebounds...UIC returns home next week for its final two home dates with both of its contests being played in its practice facility, the Flames Athletic Center, due to an event conflict at the UIC Pavilion.

Panther Notes: Milwaukee, which plays its final regular season home game on Saturday, enters the contest on the heels of a 70-66 loss to Loyola on Thursday night at the Klotsche Center. The Panthers are currently in sixth place in the Horizon League standings, two games back of both UIC and Valparaiso in the loss column for fourth place. Milwaukee has not won or lost back-to-back games in the last month, a stretch of nine games. Senior Traci Edwards, who totaled 34 points and 14 rebounds against the Ramblers, is the Panthers' go-to performer. She has led the team in scoring in every game but three and is third among active Division I scorers with over 2,000 career points. Milwaukee is a strong team on the boards with a +4.1 rebounding margin paced by Edwards' 8.8 rpg. Edwards is the only Panther player scoring in double figures on the year.

GAME NOTES:

UIC vs. MILWAUKEE, THE SERIES:

Saturday marks the 36th career meeting between UIC and Milwaukee with the Panthers owning a 24-11 lead in the all-time series. The Flames have won the last three meetings, including a 71-57 decision back on Jan. 22 at the Pavilion. The two team's most memorable meeting came in the championships game of the 2006 Horizon League Tournament with Milwaukee prevailing on its home floor, 71-63.

LAST TIME WE MET:

UIC 71, Milwaukee 57
January 22, 2009 (UIC Pavilion)

All five of UIC's starters scored in double figures and the Flames limited Milwaukee's leading scorer Traci Edwards to just 14 points in a 71-57 victory at the UIC Pavilion. Junior Jessie Miller led the way for the Flames with 15 points, while freshman Jasmine Bailey added 13 points and a team-high eight rebounds. Cassie Johnson, Meghan Hutchens and Shameia Green each totaled 10 points for UIC. It was a two-possession game with just under eight minutes left in regulation when the Flames scored on five straight trips to build a double-digit lead they would not relinquish.

MILLER AND THE PANTHERS:

Junior Jessie Miller has enjoyed success during her career against Milwaukee. In five all-time games against the Panthers, Miller is averaging 17.4 points, 3.6 rebounds and 3.2 assists while shooting 54 percent from the field and 50 percent from three-point range. Her best effort in the series came last season at the Klotsche Center as she poured in a career-high 27 points, including a 5-for-8 clip from three-point range.

BOARD WAR:

Saturday's game pits two of the top two rebounding teams in the Horizon League against each other. UIC leads the league in total rebounds at 39.5 rpg, while Milwaukee leads the league in rebounding margin at +4.1.

LAST TIME OUT:

Green Bay 73, UIC 52
February 19, 2009 (UIC Pavilion)

The UIC women's basketball team was unable to solve one of the nation's top defensive squads on Thursday night as host Green Bay posted a 73-52 victory over the Flames in front of 2,327 at the Kress Center. The Phoenix, which entered the contest as the nation's leader in scoring defense (50.3 ppg) and 11th in steals (12.2 spg), backed up its defensive billing, forcing UIC into a season-high 28 turnovers while scoring 34 points off of those miscues. Jasmine Bailey and Shanice Sadler each totaled 11 points and six rebounds to lead the Flames. Shameia Green added 10 points for UIC. Lavesa Glover scored 13 of her game-high 19 points in the second half to pace Green Bay to its 14th straight victory. UIC trailed 42-29 at the half and would cut Green Bay's lead to just seven, 46-39, with an offensive surge in the opening moments of the second period. The Phoenix would turn up its defensive pressure, though, and in turn spark its offense, going on a 23-3 run over the next 12 minutes to build a 69-42 advantage with 3:23 remaining.

THE RACE FOR A HOME DATE:

With five games left for UIC in the regular season, the Flames currently find themselves in a tie with Valparaiso for fourth place and the final spot for a coveted home game in the quarterfinals of next month's

Horizon League Tournament. UIC is two games back of Cleveland State for third and a game and a half ahead of both Milwaukee and Wright State for sixth place. The quarterfinals of the Horizon League Tournament take place on March 11. The semifinals and championship game are then held on March 13 and 15 at the home arena of the highest remaining seed after the opening round.

CLOSING IN ON 1,000:

Junior Jessie Miller heads into Saturday's contest at Milwaukee needing just seven points to become the 14th player in UIC history to score 1,000 career points. She is on pace to become just the third player in school history to reach the 1,000-point plateau during her junior season, joining all-time leading scorer Joanne McCarthy and Penny Armstrong. She would also be the seventh player under head coach Lisa Ryckbosch to reach the milestone with 50 percent of all the 1,000-point scorers in school history being mentored for at least one season by the team's current headmaster.

GROBBECKER JOINS REBOUNDING RECORD BOOK:

Senior Nikki Grobbecker cracked the top 10 on the UIC career rebounding list on Thursday night at Green Bay as her five rebounds pushed her past Tracy Manuel (1982-84) and Joanne McCarthy (1992-97) and into ninth place with 557 career boards. She is now 23 rebounds shy of reaching eighth place, held by Jasmine Strange (1992-96) with 580 caroms.

SADLER STRONG OFF THE BENCH:

Sophomore Shanice Sadler had a strong effort off the bench on Thursday night, totaling 11 points and a team-high six rebounds in just 21 minutes at Green Bay. It was the third time Sadler has scored in double figures this season and first since totaling a season-high 12 points at San Diego on Dec. 28. For the season, Sadler is averaging 4.2 ppg.

POINT FORWARD:

Senior forward Meghan Hutchens is the Horizon League's best when it comes to distributing the basketball with precision as she leads the league with a 3.1-to-1 assist-to-turnover ratio with 58 assists and just 19 turnovers on the year.

GROBBECKER GOING TO THE GLASS:

Senior Nikki Grobbecker has been a force on the boards off the bench of late for UIC. In just under 16 minutes of action per contest, the 6-foot-2 center is averaging a team-best 6.9 rebounds in her last 10 games. Grobbecker's prowess on the glass has moved her into a tie with Cassie Johnson for second on the team in rebounding this season at 5.3 rpg.

GREEN STEPPING IN AND STEPPING UP:

Redshirt freshman Shameia Green was thrust into a more prominent role with the Flames when junior point guard Briana Hinkle was lost for the season to injury in the team's seventh game of the year. Green has flourished in her new role averaging 10.4 points and 3.4 assists per outing since Hinkle's injury.

HINKLE LOST FOR THE SEASON:

UIC is without junior guard Briana Hinkle, who suffered a season-ending knee injury against Cal Poly on Dec. 18. Hinkle was averaging 10.7 ppg, 4.3 rpg and 3.0 apg per game prior to her injury.

A WINNER OF THE SIDELINES:

UIC head coach Lisa Ryckbosch added another milestone to her already impressive resume on Feb. 7, collecting career victory No. 100 in the Flames' triumph over Loyola. Ryckbosch is already the program's all-time leader in victories and in winning percentage (.502). She is also the first-ever coach to guide UIC into postseason play when she directed the 2006-07 squad to a berth in the WNIT.

UP NEXT:

UIC heads back to the Windy City for its final two regular season home dates next week. Its contests versus Cleveland State on Thursday and Youngstown State on Saturday will take place at the team's practice facility, the Flames Athletic Center, due to an event conflict at the UIC Pavilion. The Flames are 2-0 all-time in regular season games played at FAC.
