Despite falling in both games this weekend in Horizon League play, sophomore Briana Hinkle recorded a stellar performance against Youngstown State and Cleveland State. Hinkle averaged 16.5 points and 2.5 rebounds per game. The guard added six assists, one steal and shot 48.3 percent from the field and 71.4 percent from the free throw line. Hinkle led the squad with 14 points versus YSU on Jan. 3. Hinkle shot 50 percent from the field (6-for-12) and hit both free throws against the Penguins.

IMPRESSIVE WEEKEND:

Sophomore Cassie Johnson averaged 10.0 points, 7.5 rebounds and shot 43.8 percent from the field in her first two Horizon League games last weekend. Johnson led the Flames with 12 total rebounds and five blocks.

LEAGUE OPPONENTS:

After two conference contests, UIC is averaging 3.0 more rebounds per game than its Horizon League opponents.

POSTIN' PETRINEC:

In just nine minutes of action against Cleveland State on Jan. 5, freshman center Kristin Petrinec drained two shot, including her first collegiate three-pointer. Petrinec pulled down a season-high four rebounds and added a block and steal against the Vikings.

BLOCKIN' BUDDIES:

Sophomore Cassie Johnson and junior Nikki Grobbecker lead the Flames this season in total blocks. Johnson paces UIC with 13 on the season, while Grobbecker is close behind in second place with 11. Grobbecker picked up a career-high three blocks versus Bradley on Nov. 17. Johnson tied her career-high four blocks versus Cleveland State on Jan. 5.

SWEET START:

Sophomore Jessie Miller made an impression the first time she stepped onto the court on Nov. 11, 2006 against Western Michigan when she scored 21 points and totaled six rebounds in her collegiate debut. After suffering a concussion on Nov. 14, 2006 against Illinois, Miller has started in 39 of 43 games for the Flames, including all 13 contests this season.

JUMPIN' JOHNSON:

Johnson tabbed a season-high and tied the team-best with 14 points in UIC's

GAME 14 - THURS., JAN. 10 - 7:00 P.M.

Horizon League opener on Jan. 3 against Youngstown State on the road. Johnson also pulled down six rebounds and added one block on the night.

VERSUS CSU:

Although UIC fell to Cleveland State (66-58) on Jan. 5, the Flames outrebounded the Vikings 45-43. UIC also had 12 more bench points than CSU (24). UIC totaled five more blocks (8) and owned a higher field goal percentage.

IN THE LEAGUE:

Sophomore Jessie Miller ranks 14th in the league with 12.3 points per game, while Hinkle owns 15th with 11.4 points per game. Hinkle also ranks fourth with 2.15 steals per game. Miller ranks fifth in assists (3.46 apg) and owns 12th in steals per game (1.54) and 13th in three-point field goals made (1.54). Sophomore Cassie Johnson continues to climb the ladder in blocks after moving from ninth to sixth place (1.00).

DEFENSIVE WEAPON:

UIC has proven that they can defend amongst the best in the league, ranking second in field goal percentage defense and three-point field goal percentage defense. The Flames also lead the league in defensive rebounds (26.69) and ranks third in blocked shots (3.46).

DOUBLE-DIGITS:

Junior Nikki Grobbeck continues to be strong defensively for the Flames this season with four double-digit rebound contests this season. Only 13 games into the season, Grobbeck is only two rebounds from surpassing her career record of five

double-figure rebounds contests in 2006-07. The junior ranks fourth in the league with 6.6 boards per game. Grobbeck also ranks sixth in defensive rebounds (4.7) and eighth in offensive boards (1.9) The center tied her career-high 14 rebounds in a victory over Eastern Illinois on Nov. 20.

ON HER WAY:

Lisa Ryckbosch (82-78) is just eight wins away from becoming UIC's winningest coach in school history. Ryckbosch trails eight-year head coach Eileen McMahon, who owned an 89-135 overall record when she coached from 1990-1998. Ryckbosch already owns the Flames' second-best all-time winning percentage (.512).

NOT SO FAST:

In the team's second regular-season victory (68-54) over Cleveland State at Henry J. Goodman Arena on Feb. 3, 2007, UIC ended an NCAA record for the Vikings. It was the first time in 408 consecutive games that CSU was unable to connect from three-point land. The streak started in 1992.

THE BENCH:

The bench has scored 222 of 718 points (31 percent) for the Flames this season. In two games at the 2007 Caribbean Classic, the bench scored 45 percent of UIC's 99 points against LSU and Southern Miss.

QUICK HITS:

The Flames are 3-0 when leading at the half and 4-1 with leading with five minutes remaining. UIC is 3-1 when holding its opponents to less than 60 points.

36 YEARS AND STILL GOIN' STRONG:

UIC is in its 36th year of Division I basketball. The Flames enter the contest against Valparaiso with a 376-557 (.403) overall record.

2007 HL NOTES:

Last season's Horizon League schedule brought UIC an 11-game winning streak that broke the previous record of nine straight victories in 1979-80. UIC tallied 52 more steals, 17 more assists and 40 more offensive rebounds than its Horizon League opponents that year.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE:

UIC has one of its most challenging schedules in school history with two teams currently in the AP Top 25 Poll, along with three 2007 NCAA Tournament participants.

FRESHMAN FLASH:

Freshman Ashley Tomzick tied her season-high eight points in UIC's fourth straight home victory on Dec. 28 against Bucknell. Tomzick added two assists and two steals in a season-best 30 minutes of action. The freshman guard first scored eight points versus No. 8 LSU on Dec. 18 at the 2007 Caribbean Classic on Cancun, Mexico. The guard was 3-for-3 from the field and 2-for-2 from the three-point line against the Lady Tigers.

BUCKED BUCKNELL:

UIC proved to be too strong defensively for Bucknell in the first meeting in school history on Dec. 28. The Flames held Bucknell to a .292 field goal percentage and forced the team to commit 16 turnovers. The Flames also tabbed two more blocks (9) than their opponent.

TOP PERFORMERS:

Junior Ashley Hluska and sophomore Cassie Johnson also picked up strong performances in Cancun. Hluska tied her career-high of 12 points against Southern Miss on Dec. 19. Hluska was 6-for-9 from the field with one steal versus the Golden Eagles. Johnson tabbed a season-best 11 points versus USM. Johnson was 4-for-5 from the field and 3-for-6 from the line.

FLAMES RECORDS:

Nicole Rinaldi and Ashley Hluska rank fifth (.495) and 10th (.478) in career field goal percentage. Rinaldi also ranks seventh with 67 career blocked shots.

2007 CARIBBEAN CHALLENGE:

Despite falling on both games at the 2007 Caribbean Classic in Cancun to LSU and Southern Miss, the UIC women's basketball team still showed signs of improvement and promise for the remainder of the season. The Flames totaled three more steals (9) than Southern Miss (6). UIC also forced the Golden Eagles to commit three more turnovers (19-16). The Flames also notched eight more assists than Southern Miss (21-13).

OUT OF THE SADDLE:

Freshman Shanice Sadler recorded an impressive showing in just 13 minutes of play against Western Michigan on Dec. 8. Despite falling to the Broncos, Sadler stepped off the bench and contributed a season-high eight points and five rebounds. Sadler was 4-for-7 from the field.

RINALDI STEALS THE SHOW:

Senior Nicole Rinaldi tied her career-high four steals against Western Michigan on Dec. 8. Rinaldi set her career record against Mt. Saint Mary's (MD) in the Fun In The Sun Shootout in December of 2005 in Cancun, Mexico.

OTHER NOTABLE NOTES:

Freshman Ashley Tomzick played in her first college basketball game on Nov. 17 against Bradley. Tomzick broke her nose in October and was forced to be sidelined as it healed. Sporting a face mask, Tomzick picked up six points against the Braves. After injuring her foot in pre-season, freshman Shameia Green made her collegiate debut against Northwestern on Nov. 14.

HL PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

UIC sophomore Jessie Miller was named Horizon League Player of the Week after averaging 16.5 points and 5.0 rebounds in two games for the Flames on Nov. 14 and 17. Miller shot 77.8 percent from the free throw line (14-for-18) and drained a team-best three three-pointers. The guard totaled three assists and a team-high five steals. The sophomore helped guide UIC to its first win over Northwestern since the 2004 season with 13 points on Nov. 14. Miller was 6-for-8 from the line and added four boards, two assists and two steals in the win.

2007-08 HL PRESEASON POLL:

The UIC women's basketball team was selected to finish fourth in the Horizon League Preseason Poll for the third straight year. The voting panel is made up of select media members, sports information directors and Horizon League coaches. The Flames return two starters, including Horizon League All-Newcomer Team recipient Jessie Miller. The sophomore averaged 8.8 points, 4.3 rebounds and 1.3 steals per game as a rookie. Milwaukee was picked to repeat last year's success and capture the Horizon League regular season title with 253 total points and 13 first-place votes. 2007 conference tournament champion Green Bay earned a second-place nod with 244 points and nine first-place votes, followed by Butler (238) and UIC (176). Butler picked up five first-place votes, while the Flames earned the final first-place nod in the poll. League newcomer Valparaiso (152) was tabbed for fifth, while Youngstown State (118) was pegged for sixth. Cleveland State (102), Detroit (78) and Loyola rounded out this year's poll.

HEAD COACH LISA RYCKBOSCH:

There seems to be a few common traits that tie together those people who call themselves Chicagoans; a blue-collar work ethic, a family orientated attitude and a passion for the city's sports teams. It's these traits that have made Chicago such a destination for people looking to find a new place to call home. And it's these same traits that are the reason why many Chicago natives never want to leave. For UIC Head Women's Basketball Coach Lisa Ryckbosch, who was born in this city, grew up in this city and has over 20 years of basketball coaching experience in this city, Chicago has always been her kind of town.

The UIC women's basketball program has been the benefactor of Ryckbosch's hometown tutelage, as the Flames have made huge strides as a program under her direction since she was hired on April 25, 2002.

In just five short years, Ryckbosch is just 12 wins away from becoming the winningest coach in school history (78-69/.569). She has produced 78 wins and guided the squad to their highest-ever Horizon League finish (2nd - 2003, 2006). Ryckbosch has also steered the Flames to their first-ever Horizon League Tournament title game (2005) and first-ever postseason season appearance at the WNIT last season.

She has developed 11 all-league performers during her tenure those players helping UIC set single-season team records in most points scored (2,184, 2006-07), three-pointers made (200, 2005-06), most steals (344, 2002-03) most assists (492, 2006-07) and consecutive victories (11, 2006-07).

The Flames also broke the school record of most wins in a season (19, 2006-07), while also receiving their first-ever vote in the Associated Press Top 25 poll (Nov. 2002) during her tenure. Last season, Ryckbosch watched her hard work pay off as seniors LaShonda Grant, Krystal Hugelier and Jacquay Holmes each hit the 1,000 career-point plateau. Ryckbosch has built UIC into a successful program by attracting top student-athletes.

Her extensive knowledge of the 'Windy' City, has allowed her to lay down the recruiting groundwork to keep the top recruits from the talent-rich Chicagoland area close to home.

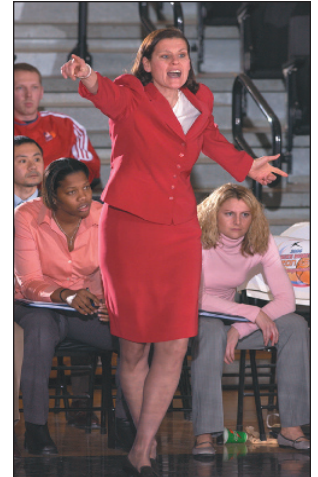
Ryckbosch enjoyed a great start to her UIC head coaching career as the Flames posted 17 wins in 2002-03, which was the second-most in school history and the most victories since the 1995-96 campaign. The team also tied the school-record for Horizon League wins with 11 during her rookie campaign, on the way to the Flames' first-ever, second-place conference finish in 2002-03.

Ryckbosch came to UIC after spending 11 seasons on the coaching staff at DePaul University, where she served most recently as associate head coach under Doug Bruno. She had been instrumental in bringing top Chicagoland and national talent to the Blue Demons' successful women's basketball program, including five players that competed in the WNBA. While at DePaul, Ryckbosch helped guide the Blue Demons to five NCAA Tournament appearances and three WNIT berths. DePaul owned a record of 186-140 during her tenure, while winning a pair of Great Midwest Conference titles (1989; 1991) and the first-ever Conference USA regular-season championship in 1996.

Prior to her stint with the Blue Demons, Ryckbosch, ironically, got her collegiate coaching start as a member of the UIC staff in 1990-91, serving under then-head coach Eileen McMahan. Ryckbosch began her coaching career at Hillcrest High School in Country Club Hills, Ill., where she served as the Head Girls' Varsity Basketball Coach and Math teacher for three years.

Ryckbosch enjoyed a standout collegiate career at Loyola (Ill.). She was a four-year starter and two-time team captain for the Ramblers from 1980-84 and still ranks sixth on the school's all-time scoring (1,296) and third on the rebounding (765) charts.

She played an instrumental role in leading Loyola to a school-record 23 wins and the inaugural North Star Championship - now the Horizon League - in 1984. Ryckbosch was inducted into the Loyola University Athletics Hall of Fame in 2006 and the Girls Catholic Athletic Conference (GCAC) Hall of Fame in 2007. Ryckbosch is married with two children. Her husband Bart, a native of Belgium, is the Archivist at the Art Institute of Chicago. Ryckbosch's oldest son, Steven, is a freshman at Georgetown University, while Peter is an eighth grader. The Ryckbosch family makes their residence in the Old Irving neighborhood on Chicago's Northside.
