THE WEEK AHEAD:

FLAMES FALL IN SEASON OPENER:

It was a tough start for the University of Illinois at Chicago women's gymnastics team, who were upended in the season opener by Northern Illinois by a close 191.925-190.325 margin in DeKalb, Ill., this past Sunday. The Flames actually posted top team scores on the vault with a 48.225 (compared to NIU's 48.150) and a 47.450 on beam, which was a trouble spot at times last year for the Flames, compared to the Huskies' 46.450. But sub-48 scores on bars and floor, a strong point in recent years for UIC, did the Flames in during their first meet of the year.

JENNY FROM THE BLOCK:

Junior **Jennifer O'Neil's (Hull, Quebec, Canada/Secondaire de l'ile)** block is north of the United States border, but co-head coaches **Peter** and **Mary Jansson** are sure glad to have Jenn in Chicago. Already established as a vital all-around performer for the Flames during her first two seasons, O'Neil posted a solid all-around showing of 37.775 to lead UIC and take third overall.

JESSIE AND STACEY TAKE BEAM:

It's no secret that the specialty of sophomore **Jessie Jaworowicz (Roscoe, Ill./Keith School)** is on the balance beam. The youngest Jaworowicz on the team fought off some sickness over the weekend to get 2005 off to a hot start with a beam title she shared with senior **Stacey Magiera (Carpentersville, Ill./Barrington H.S.)**, a former uneven bars and beam specialist looking to expand her game as an all-arounder, as both posted a 9.8 on the apparatus.

V IS FOR VAULT:

UIC vault record-holder **Veronique Meunier (Hull, Quebec, Canada/Secondaire de l'ile)** started off 2005 in style with a convincing vault win at 9.850.

FRESHMAN FACE FIRST TIME:

UIC's freshmen did a pretty good job in their debut meet this past Sunday, as **Jamie Buckley (Schaumburg, Ill./Conant H.S.)** and **Ashley Howe (Tinley Park, Ill./Andrew H.S.)** put up some nice performances. Buckley finished the vault tied for third overall with a 9.700, while Howe vaulted to a score of 9.250.

ALY NOT ALL THE WAY AROUND YET:

Senior **Alyson Cacciatore (Glenview, Ill./Glenbrook South H.S.)** is still working her way back from injury this offseason. Cacciatore, who led UIC last year with five all-around crowns, put up a team-best 9.7 on uneven bars at Northern Illinois and did a good job on floor with a 9.675. She also competed on vault and beam in exhibition performances, posting a 9.150 on vault and a 9.025 on beam.

BACK TO TUCSON:

UIC heads back to Tucson, Arizona this weekend after competing there this past April in the NCAA South Central Regional. The Flames take on host Arizona with Missouri and Michigan State this Friday at 7:30 p.m.
