SOFTBALL HOSTS GREEN BAY BEFORE HEADING TO OHIO FOR A THREE-GAME SERIES AGAINST YSU

OPENING HORIZON LEAGUE ACTION:

Senior Ashlee Ackerman was 4-for-9 at the plate (.444) in a three-game series against Butler last weekend. Ackerman totaled one double, two runs, two RBI and a stolen base versus the Bulldogs. Junior Sarah Clynes led off the first two games with solo home runs. Clynes posted a .333 batting average (4-for-12) with two runs, one double and two RBI.

HOT AT THE PLATE:

UIC was hot at the plate in the three-game series with six players batting over .300. In addition to Ackerman with a .444 batting average, Frydendall also recorded a .444 average in the three-game series with one double and one RBI. Freshman Alicia Abbott was 4-for-11 (.364), followed by Sarah Clynes (.333).

CLYNES NAMED PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

Sarah Clynes was named Horizon League Player of the Week after recording a 2-0 mark in UIC's opening weekend of league action against Butler in Indianapolis. The junior fanned 12 batters in 14.0 innings of work and recorded her fourth shutout of the season with two over the weekend. Clynes allowed just five hits in two complete games.

PREVIEW FOR THE WEEK:

UIC enters this week's action with an 11-21 overall record. The Flames captured a 2-1 series victory over Butler last weekend with two shutouts. Senior Ashlee Ackerman continues to lead UIC's offensive charge with a .337 batting average (34-for-101). Junior Sarah Clynes owns a team-high 19 runs scored, 15 RBI and six homers. Clynes also paces UIC in the circle with 68 strikeouts in 105.0 innings pitched.

SOLO SHOTS:

Junior Sarah Clynes has led off the last three of UIC's seven games with solo home runs. The pitcher/designated player drilled a solo shot to right center on the first pitch of the game against Louisville on March 21. Clynes then hit a homer to open up play against Butler on March 29, followed by a lead off homer in the series finale on March 30. Clynes leads the Flames with six home runs, ranking second in the league.

Junior Sarah Clynes has assumed the role of staff ace since her arrival at UIC and currently ranks in the top 10 in the UIC career record book for complete games (51/7th), innings pitched (512.1/7th) and strikeouts (352/6th).

IN THE LEAGUE:

Senior Ashlee Ackerman ranks second in the Horizon League with 34 hits, while ranking fourth in runs scored (18). Freshman Alicia Abbott leads the league with three sacrifice flies and ranks sixth with 28 hits. Senior Brittany Dixon is tied for fourth place with four sacrifice bunts.

2008 SEASON-HIGHS:

UIC totaled a season-high nine runs and nine RBI in a 9-1 victory over University of San Diego in five innings on Feb. 10. The Flames tallied 12 hits and six doubles against Colorado State on Feb. 17. UIC totaled three home runs in an 8-4 victory over Louisville on March 21.

IU CLASSIC:

The Flames picked up two impressive victories over Indiana and Louisville in day one of the IU Classic on March 21. Day two was canceled due to cold conditions. Junior Sarah Clynes drilled a solo shot to right center on the first pitch of the game to get things started for the Flames against Louisville. a grand slam in the first inning. UIC then shutout Indiana, 3-0, in the second contest of the day. Freshman Carly DeMarco tabbed her first shutout of the season with three strikeouts in 7.0 innings of work.

ROCKIN' ROBINSON:

Senior Nicole Robinson recorded a .400 batting average (2-for-5) in the IU Classic on March 21. Robinson was 2-for-3 in a 3-0 win over Indiana. The senior drove in the winning run in the top of the fourth inning. After suffering a season-ending knee injury late last season, Robinson has been inching back into her true form as the season has progressed. Robinson has pushed her way into second place with 12 RBI after leading the league and squad in 2006.

SCOUTING THE OPPONENTS:

Green Bay (6-10) - The doubleheader versus UIC is Green Bay's first Horizon League contests of the season. The Phoenix lost two straight in the Rebel Spring Games in Orlando, Florida last week to Manhattan and Siena College. The Phoenix are led by Mollie Kaebisch with a .333 batting average (14-for-24). Kaebisch has totaled a team-best 14 hits, four doubles, one triple and one home run. Vanessa Lefan owns a team-high eight RBI. Anna Bluemel paces the squad in the circle with four wins and 27 strikeouts in 38.2 innings pitched.

Youngstown State (2-14) - The Penguins were swept by Loyola in their opening weekend of Horizon League action at home on March 29 and 30. Kristen Bair leads the team with a .435 batting average (20-for-46). Bair is tied on the team with three doubles, one triple and has totaled five RBI on the season. McKenzie Bedra owns a team-best eight RBI and three home runs. Danielle Chase has picked up YSU's two victories of the season in the circle with 17 strikeouts in 38.2 innings of work.

MARINACCI NAMED HORIZON LEAGUE PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Melissa Marinacci was named Horizon League Player of the Week on March 25 after recording a .500 batting average (3-for-6) in two games against Louisville and Indiana in the IU Classic. Marinacci totaled two runs, six RBI and two home runs in Bloomington, Ind. The junior was 2-for-3 at the plate with two runs and five RBI in an 8-4 victory over Louisville on March 21. Marinacci drilled a grand slam in the first inning, followed by a solo shot to center field in the third inning. The right fielder was 1-for-3 with one RBI in a 3-0 shutout against host Indiana on March 21. On the season, Marinacci has totaled 10 runs, five doubles, 15 RBI and four home runs.
