SPRING SNOW SHOWERS:

With abnormally cold April temperatures across the United States last week, the UIC softball team's three-game series versus UW-Green Bay in Wisconsin was cancelled due to inclement weather on Saturday, April 7 and Sunday, April 8. The series will not be rescheduled.

QUICK NOTES:

The Flames head into a week of Horizon League play versus Butler at home and Loyola on the road. UIC is set to face the Bulldogs in a doubleheader on Thursday, April 12 at Flames Field, followed by a three-game series versus the Ramblers on Saturday, April 14 and Sunday, April 15. The Flames defeated Youngstown State in a three-game series, 2-1, during its opening conference weekend March 31 and April 1 at Flames Field. Because of the cancellation of UIC's three-game series versus UW-Green Bay, the Flames have not stepped onto the diamond for a game in nine days. Wisconsin topped the Flames, 12-1, in five innings on Tuesday, April 3.

SENIOR LEADERSHIP:

UIC senior Liz Jacoby has dominated in the last two weeks of play for the Flames. In six contests, the senior has posted a .529 batting average with five runs scored, three doubles, four RBI and one homer. Jacoby owns a .888 slugging percentage and a .579 on-base percentage. On defense, the catcher/outfielder has committed no errors and has totaled 22 putouts.

DOUBLES:

Six UIC players have notched two or more doubles in nine weeks of play. Senior Liz Jacoby leads the league and the Flames with 10 doubles. Jacoby amassed three doubles in just five games last week. Junior Nicole Robinson totals seven, while Brittany Dixon and freshman Brooke Frydendall own four each. Sophomore Sarah Clynes has tabbed three and Nikki Rogers has two doubles on the year.

IN THE CIRCLE:

Freshman Chelsea Fuemmeler was impressive in her second win in the circle for the Flames against Youngstown State on April 1. Fuemmeler totaled seven strikeouts in just five innings pitched, three coming in clutch situations that got the Flames out of the inning with the bases loaded.

LEAGUE ACTION:

The Flames opened Horizon League action at home in a three-game series versus Youngstown State on March 31 and April 1. After falling to the Penguins in game one on Saturday, UIC bounced back and grabbed the next two to win the series, 2-1. In three games, UIC posted a .284 batting average with 23 hits, six doubles, one triple, 14 RBI and three home runs. Senior Liz Jacoby continued to dominate at the plate with a .625 batting average. Jacoby totaled three runs, two doubles, two RBI and one homer against the Penguins.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Freshman Stephanie Chavez was named Horizon League Player of the Week on March 26 after belting her first two collegiate home runs at the IU Classic. Chavez posted a .364 batting average (4-for-11) with three runs scored and five RBI in five games. The catcher also posted a 1.000 fielding average with ten putouts. Chavez was 2-for-3 with one run and one RBI in an 11-1 victory in five innings over Buffalo in pool play. The freshman picked up her first collegiate home run versus Eastern Michigan on a solo shot to left field. Chavez then went 1-for-3 against Buffalo in tournament play with a three-run homer on March 25. Chavez owns a .229 batting average on the season with five runs, nine RBI and two home runs in just 16 games. The freshman ranks third on the team with a .957 fielding percentage and has totaled 37 putouts.

SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION:

BUTLER (13-12, 2-1 HL)

All-Time vs. UIC: UIC leads the series, 32-7

The Flames were 3-1 versus Butler last season. UIC swept the Bulldogs on the road in a doubleheader and fell in a single game at home. UIC shutout Butler in the first round of the 2006 Horizon League Tournament, 7-0 to advance to the quarterfinals versus UW-Green Bay. The Flames were scheduled to face the Bulldogs at the Alexis Resort Classic earlier this season, but the Bulldogs pulled out of the tournament.

LOYOLA (9-12, 5-0 HL)

All-Time vs. UIC: UIC leads the series, 55-12-1

UIC split with Loyola last season at home. The Flames fell to the Ramblers 6-3 in eight innings after a two and a half hour rain delay. The final contest of the three-game series was cancelled due to rain the following day.

JUST LOOK AT THE NUMBERS:

Despite falling in the championship game at the IU Classic, the Flames recorded a 3-3 mark and posted impressive offensive numbers. Nine of 14 UIC players owned a .300 batting average or above and 13 of 14 picked up at least one hit. The Flames committed just three errors in six games and 11 of 14 posted a 1.000 fielding percentage. Two players owned .500 batting averages and the team totaled 10 doubles, 35 RBI and five home runs in six games.

JOIN THE CLUB:

Freshman Stephanie Chavez notched her first two collegiate home runs in a Flames uniform at the IU Classic in Bloomington, Ind. Chavez belted a solo homer in a 7-1 win over Eastern Michigan, followed by a three-run blast against Buffalo.

SHUTOUTS:

Sophomore Sarah Clynes continues to in the circle for the Flames. Clynes picked up her third shutout of the season versus Buffalo (13-0) to help the Flames advance to the championship game at the IU Classic. Clynes notched her first two of the season at the UTC Frost

2006 HORIZON LEAGUE TOURNAMENT CHAMPION: Youngstown State

Classic against Tennessee Chattanooga and at the USF Adidas Invitational versus regional foe Indiana. Freshman Chelsea Fuemmeler picked up her first collegiate shutout at the UTC Frost Tournament. Fuemmeler guided the team to a 1-0 win over UT-Martin on March 2.

IN THE LEAGUE:

Sophomore Sarah Clynes ranks first on the team and third in the league with 33 hits on the season. Clynes also ranks second in the conference with 4.20 strikeouts per game. The sophomore leads the league in shutouts (3), innings pitched (120.0) and appearances (25). Junior Ashlee Ackerman is tied for eighth place with 27 hits and senior Liz Jacoby is tied for fifth place with four homers on the season. Jacoby leads the league with 10 doubles, tied for sixth in runs scored (17) and is tied for third in RBI (20).

UIC STINGS YELLOW JACKETS:

Junior Nikki Rogers ripped a single up the middle to drive in the winning run against No. 20 Georgia Tech on March 10 at the USF Adidas Invitational, 4-3. Junior Brittany Dixon was 2-for-4 for the Flames with two runs scored and a two-run homer. Junior Ashlee Ackerman was 1-for-3 with two runs. In addition to Rogers, juniors Nicole Robinson and Lauren Brennan each picked up a hit against the Yellow Jackets.

SEEING DOUBLE:

UIC sophomore Sarah Clynes notched her second Horizon League Pitcher of the Week honor on March 8. The 2006 Horizon League Newcomer of the Year was 1-2 last weekend at the UTC Frost Classic in Chattanooga, Tenn., March 2-4. Clynes posted a 1.82 ERA and recorded her first complete-game shutout of the season against host Tennessee-Chattanooga. In UIC's 1-0 victory over UTC, Clynes fanned five batters in six innings. In three appearances, the sophomore totaled 15 strikeouts in 19.0 innings pitched. Clynes was named the first Horizon League Pitcher of the Week of the 2007 season on February 20. Clynes posted a 2-1 record in the Flames' opening weekend at the Alexis Resort Classic, Feb. 9-11. Clynes fanned 12 batters in 17.1 innings. The sophomore took a no-hitter into the seventh inning against Tulsa on Feb. 10. Clynes tabbed wins in the circle against the Golden Hurricane and Nicholls State. The sophomore also led the team with a .333 batting average (5-for-15), totaling two runs scored in five innings. On the season, Clynes owns a 3-6 record in the circle with 43 strikeouts in 49.2 innings pitched.

STELLAR PERFORMANCE:

Sarah Clynes not only posted a perfect 3-0 record in the circle for the Flames in the USF Adidas Classic, but the sophomore also led the team with a .389 batting average. Clynes was 7-for-18 at the plate with three RBI and two runs scored. In the circle, the sophomore owned a 1.22 ERA with one shutout and 16 strikeouts in 28.2 innings pitched. Clynes owns a team-best 3.15 ERA and a .309 batting average on the season.

FRYDENDALL'S BIG DEBUT:

Freshman second baseman Brooke Frydendall posted a stellar performance in her collegiate debut at the Alexis Resort Classic. With the game tied at 2-2 in the bottom of the seventh against Tulsa, Frydendall jacked a three-run walk-off homer to win the game for the Flames. The freshman then notched her second homer of the day against Pacific to put UIC on the scoreboard. Frydendall totaled four runs scored, four RBI and recorded her first two UIC home runs.

FIRST PLACE IN PRESEASON POLL:

With 11 regular season titles under its belt, the UIC softball team was picked to finish first in the 2007 Horizon League preseason poll, voted on by the league's head coaches. The Flames received six of the eight first place votes. UIC clinched the 2006 regular season championship before falling to Youngstown State in the tournament title game. The Flames totaled 48 points. Loyola followed with 40 points and 2007 conference tournament champion Youngstown State tallied 34 points for third place. 2006 Player of the Year Kaleigh Rafter and the Detroit Titans edged out Cleveland State (25 points) for fourth place with 26 points, while UW-Green Bay was close behind with 24 points (sixth place). Wright State earned the seventh-place spot (20) and the Butler Bulldogs rounded out the eight teams with seven points.
