UIC FACES TWO NATIONALLY-RANKED TEAMS BEFORE ITS FINAL LEAGUE ROAD SERIES AGAINST DETROIT

STELLAR WEEK:

Sophomore Brooke Frydendall was hot at the plate in four Horizon League contests last week with a .462 batting average (6-for-13). The shortstop totaled four hits, two runs and one RBI. Frydendall recorded a .333 slugging percentage and a .462 on-base percentage. The scrappy infielder ranks first in league games with seven doubles after totaling four last week.

NATIONALLY-RANKED:

UIC is tied for 26th in the nation with 1.43 doubles per game. The Flames have totaled 63 on the season.

GOING, GOING, GONE:

Junior Sarah Clynes is making a run for 2007 Horizon League Player of the Year with a .519 league batting average. Clynes has drilled 27 hits with 16 runs, five doubles, 17 RBI and five home runs in 15 league contests. The junior hurler may also be in the running for Horizon League Pitcher of the Year with 6-3 record in the circle. Clynes (2.36 ERA) has fanned 43 batters in 56.1 innings and totaled three shutouts in six complete games.

LEAD OFF HOME RUNS:

Sarah Clynes has totaled 11 home runs on the season. The junior totaled five homers each in 2006 and 2007. The St. Louis native now owns eighth place in the UIC single season record book with 11 home runs and eighth in the career record book with 21 after a stellar performance at the plate against Loyola and Cleveland State last week. Four of those 11 homers have been leadoff home runs in the first inning. Clynes' solo shot against Louisville on March 21 was on the first pitch of the game.

ROAD SUCCESS:

UIC is 6-2 in Horizon League road games. The Flames' two losses came to Butler on March 29 and Loyola on April 16. UIC has outscored its opponents, 42-15. The Flames (.307) own a .116 higher batting average than their foes (.191). UIC has totaled 36 more hits (74-38), 24 more doubles (39-15) and 12 more triples (17-5) than its road opponents.

HORIZON LEAGUE TOURNAMENT:

The Horizon League Tournament is less than three weeks away. This year's tournament is hosted by Loyola University in Rogers Park from May 8-10. A final game at Loyola Softball Park will be played on May 11 if necessary. The Flames enter this week's action tied with Wright State in fourth place. The Flames and Raiders don't meet until the final week of regular season action.

ACKERMAN HITS WHEN IT COUNTS:

Senior Ashlee Ackerman not only ranks in the top three on the squad in batting (.331), but the centerfielder also hits when it counts. Ackerman owns a .403 (31-for-77) batting average when runners are on base for the Flames. She is 12-for-27 (.444) as the leadoff batter and 17-for-40 (.425) with runners are in scoring position. Ackerman owns a .343 batting average (12-for-35) with two outs and has a 52.4 percent success rate in advancing runners.

THE RETURN OF ROBINSON:

Since Robinson suffered a knee injury late her junior year, she has been inching her back to the RBI-leading sophomore from 2006. Robinson is tied for third on the team with 18

IN THE LEAGUE:

Junior Sarah Clynes ranks in eight Horizon League batting categories. The junior leads in league contests in hits (27), total bases (53) and home runs (7). Clynes ranks second in batting average (.519), runs (16), slugging percentage (1.019), at bats (52) and on-base percentage (.576). Brooke Frydendall owns fifth with a .417 batting average and leads the league with seven doubles. Frydendall also ranks in total bases (7th-25), slugging percentage (7th-.694), hits (9th-15) and on-base percentage (10th-.436). Freshman Alicia Abbott is tied for fifth in doubles with four and tied for ninth with 15 hits.

LAST TIME OUT:

UIC's contest that was scheduled on April 11, 2006 against Northwestern was canceled due to inclement weather. The Flames fell in both contests against DePaul last season. UIC swept Detroit at home on April 21 and 22, outscoring the Titans, 32-11.

PITCHING SCHOOL RECORDS:

Junior Sarah Clynes currently ranks in the top 10 in the UIC career record book for complete games (53/7th), innings pitched (542/6th) and strikeouts (374/6th). Clynes also ranks third this season in Horizon League games in innings pitched (56.1) The junior is tied for second in batters striking out looking (14) and wins (6). Clynes is tied for fourth in strikeouts (43).

UP NEXT:

UIC returns to Flames Field to host nationally-ranked DePaul for the second time on two weeks on Wed., April 30, followed by a three-game series versus Wright State at home to open the month of May before Horizon League Tournament action.

MAKING A MARK:

The Flames tied the school record with seven doubles on April 2 against Green Bay at home. The previous record was set last season versus Detroit on April 24. Clynes broke the school record with five hits versus Youngstown State in the series finale on April 6. The previous record was held by numerous players with four hits.

CLYNES NAMED PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

Sarah Clynes was named Horizon League Player of the Week after recording a 2-0 mark in UIC's opening weekend of league action against Butler in Indianapolis on March 31. The junior fanned 12 batters in 14.0 innings of work and recorded her fourth shutout of the season with two over the weekend. Clynes allowed just five hits in two complete games.

SCOUTING THE OPPONENTS:

No. 12 Northwestern (28-10) - The Wildcats are coming off five straight wins. Their only loss in the last 16 games came from the hands of Iowa on April 13. Northwestern is led by Tammy Williams with a .527 batting average. Williams has totaled 36 runs and 33 RBI. Lauren DeLaney guides the squad in the circle with a 1.64 ERA. DeLaney has totaled 315 strikeouts in 209.0 innings pitched.

No. 23 DePaul (32-14) - DePaul is scheduled to play a doubleheader against Illinois on April 22 and a single contest versus Loyola on April 23 before hosting UIC. The Blue Demons are paced by Amber Patton with a .393 batting average. Becca Heteniak leads the team in the circle with a 17-6 record.

Detroit (10-20, 4-7 HL) - Detroit enters the weekend after a three-game series sweep over Green Bay on March 19 and 20. Courtney Gill leads the Titans with a .425 batting average with 16 runs, 22 RBI and five home runs. Kelli Short (5-10) has totaled 75 strikeouts in 90.2 innings of work in the circle.
