QUICK NOTES:

UIC softball heads into its final two weeks of regular-season action before squaring off at the 2007 Horizon League Tournament in Cleveland, Ohio, May 10-13. The Flames are tied for second place with Butler with a 6-3 league record. UIC is coming off a three-game sweep over Detroit at home last weekend. The Flames posted a .424 batting average (39-for-92) with 32 runs scored, 15 doubles, 30 RBI and two homers in three games. Sophomore Sarah Clynes (12-13) owned a 1.50 ERA in two complete games with 11 strikeouts in 14.0 innings pitched. Freshman Chelsea Fuemmeler (3-12) picked up her third win in the circle after guiding the Flames 14-4 triumph over the Titans in six innings in game two. Fuemmeler fanned six batters in six innings pitched. Junior Ashlee Ackerman led the squad with a .700 batting average (7-for-10). Freshman Brooke Frydendall was hot at the plate with a .636 batting average (7-for-11) and a team-best seven RBI. Clynes was 8-for-13 with two home runs, while junior Brittany Dixon totaled a team-high seven runs scored and four doubles in the series.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

UIC sophomore Sarah Clynes earned her first Horizon League Player of the Week honors, announced by the league office on Monday. Clynes already has notched two Pitcher of the Week honors from the conference this season. The sophomore posted a .529 batting average in five games for the Flames last week. Clynes was 9-for-17 with eight runs scored, three doubles, six RBI and two home runs. The pitcher/designated player owned a 1.059 slugging percentage and a .619 on-base percentage in UIC's 3-2 week. Clynes was 1-for-3 with one run scored versus Wisconsin on April 17. In a three-game series sweep over Detroit last weekend, Clynes was 3-for-5 with two runs in game one. In game two of the doubleheader on Saturday, the sophomore totaled three hits, two runs, four RBI and a three-run homer against the Titans. Clynes capped the series with two hits, two runs, two RBI and a solo blast to center field.

DOUBLE IT UP:

The UIC softball team totaled 17 doubles in five games last week. Junior Brittany Dixon led the team with four doubles, while freshman Brooke Frydendall, sophomore Sarah Clynes and junior Nicole Robinson each tabbed three doubles. Junior Ashlee Ackerman totaled two doubles and sophomore Melissa Marinacci and senior Liz Jacoby notched one apiece.

SARAH LIKES SHUTOUTS:

Sophomore Sarah Clynes extended the gap between herself and Loyola's Krista Crosson for the league lead in shutouts with her fourth shutout versus the Ramblers in the finale of the three-game series on April 15.

2007 HORIZON LEAGUE TOURNAMENT:

The 2007 Horizon League Tournament is just around the corner. With only two more weeks left in regular season action, UIC faces Cleveland State this weekend at home in a three-game series, followed by three-game series at Wright State on May 5 and 6. The Flames step out of conference play three times in the next two weeks when they battle Notre Dame, nationally-ranked DePaul and Western Illinois on Senior Day. The tournament, hosted by Cleveland State, is set for May 10-

SECOND WEEK IN A ROW:

Sophomore Sarah Clynes has been hot at the plate with three home runs in the last eight days. Clynes tabbed her fourth and fifth homers in last weekend's three-game series versus Detroit. The sophomore belted a three-run blast in UIC's 14-4 victory over the Ttians, followed by a solo shot to center field in the series finale that completed the sweep.

TURNING UP THE HEAT:

Freshman Brooke Frydendall posted a .533 batting average in five games for the Flames last week. Frydendall was 8-for-15 with four runs scored, three doubles and a team-best eight RBI. The second baseman owned a .733 slugging percentage and a .563 on-base percentage. In Saturday's doubleheader versus Detroit, Frydendall notched three doubles on the day with one in the first contest and two in the nightcap.

IN THE LEAGUE:

Sophomore Sarah Clynes ranks first on the team and third in the league with 46 hits on the season. Clynes also ranks third in the conference with 4.16 strikeouts per game. The sophomore leads the league in shutouts (4), innings pitched (158.0) and appearances (31). Junior Ashlee Ackerman is tied for sixth place with 38 hits and senior Liz Jacoby is tied for fifth place with 12 doubles on the season.

SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION:

NOTRE DAME (24-18, 9-5 BIG EAST)

All-Time vs. UIC: The Fighting Irish lead the series, 18-9

Notre Dame is coming off two losses to South Florida in a doubleheader on April 22 in South Bend. On the season, Stephanie Brown leads the team with a .433 batting average. Brown has totaled a team-high 35 runs and 52 hits on the year. Brittany Bargar (16-9) owns a team-best 1.98 ERA with 170 strikeouts in 173.1 innings pitched.

CLEVELAND STATE (19-12, 2-6 HL)

All-Time vs. UIC: The Flames lead the series, 32-8

Cleveland State is set to face Youngstown State in a doubleheader on April 25 at home, followed by a doubleheader at Toledo on April 26 before the Vikings face the Flames in the three-game series this weekend.

FIRST FRESHMAN ON SQUAD TO BE HONORED BY LEAGUE:

Freshman Stephanie Chavez was named Horizon League Player of the Week on March 26 after belting her first two collegiate home runs at the IU Classic. Chavez posted a .364 batting average (4-for-11) with three runs scored and five RBI in five games. The catcher also posted a 1.000 fielding average with ten putouts. Chavez was 2-for-3 with one run and one RBI in an 11-1 victory in five innings over Buffalo in pool play. The freshman picked up her first collegiate home run versus Eastern Michigan on a solo shot to left field. Chavez then went 1-for-3 against Buffalo in tournament play with a three-run homer on March 25.

2006 HORIZON LEAGUE TOURNAMENT CHAMPION: Youngstown State

Chavez owns a .233 batting average on the season with seven runs scored, three doubles, nine RBI and two homers in just 29 games. The freshman ranks third on the team with a .972 fielding percentage and has totaled 57 putouts.

JUST LOOK AT THE NUMBERS:

Despite falling in the championship game at the IU Classic, the Flames recorded a 3-3 mark and posted impressive offensive numbers. Nine of 14 UIC players owned a .300 batting average or above and 13 of 14 picked up at least one hit. The Flames committed just three errors in six games and 11 of 14 posted a 1.000 fielding percentage. Two players owned .500 batting averages and the team totaled 10 doubles, 35 RBI and five home runs in six games.

JOIN THE CLUB:

Freshman Stephanie Chavez notched her first two collegiate home runs in a Flames uniform at the IU Classic in Bloomington, Ind. Chavez belted a solo homer in a 7-1 win over Eastern Michigan, followed by a three-run blast against Buffalo.

UIC STINGS YELLOW JACKETS:

Junior Nikki Rogers ripped a single up the middle to drive in the winning run against No. 20 Georgia Tech on March 10 at the USF Adidas Invitational, 4-3. Junior Brittany Dixon was 2-for-4 for the Flames with two runs scored and a two-run homer. Junior Ashlee Ackerman was 1-for-3 with two runs. In addition to Rogers, juniors Nicole Robinson and Lauren Brennan each picked up a hit against the Yellow Jackets.

SEEING DOUBLE:

UIC sophomore Sarah Clynes notched her second Horizon League Pitcher of the Week honor on March 8. The 2006 Horizon League Newcomer of the Year was 1-2 last weekend at the UTC Frost Classic in Chattanooga, Tenn., March 2-4. Clynes posted a 1.82 ERA and recorded her first complete-game shutout of the season against host Tennessee-Chattanooga. In UIC's 1-0 victory over UTC, Clynes fanned five batters in six innings. In three appearances, the sophomore totaled 15 strikeouts in 19.0 innings pitched. Clynes was named the first Horizon League Pitcher of the Week of the 2007 season on February 20. Clynes posted a 2-1 record in the Flames' opening weekend at the Alexis Resort Classic, Feb. 9-11. Clynes fanned 12 batters in 17.1 innings. The sophomore took a no-hitter into the seventh inning against Tulsa on Feb. 10. Clynes tabbed wins in the circle against the Golden Hurricane and Nicholls State. The sophomore also led the team with a .333 batting average (5-for-15), totaling two runs scored in five innings. On the season, Clynes owns a 12-13 record in the circle with 102 strikeouts in 164.0 innings pitched.

STELLAR PERFORMANCE:

Sarah Clynes not only posted a perfect 3-0 record in the circle for the Flames in the USF Adidas Classic, but the sophomore also led the team with a .389 batting average. Clynes was 7-for-18 at the plate with three RBI and two runs scored. In the circle, the sophomore owned a 1.22 ERA with one shutout and 16 strikeouts in 28.2 innings pitched. Clynes owns a team-best 3.29 ERA and a .377 batting average on the season.

FIRST PLACE IN PRESEASON POLL:

With 11 regular season titles under its belt, the UIC softball team was picked to finish first in the 2007 Horizon League preseason poll, voted on by the league's head coaches. The Flames received six of the eight first place votes. UIC clinched the 2006 regular season championship before falling to Youngstown State in the tournament title game. The Flames totaled 48 points. Loyola followed with 40 points and 2007 conference tournament champion Youngstown State tallied 34 points for third place. 2006 Player of the Year Kaleigh Rafter and the Detroit Titans edged out Cleveland State (25 points) for fourth place with 26 points, while UW-Green Bay was close behind with 24 points (sixth place). Wright State earned the seventh-place spot (20) and the Butler Bulldogs rounded out the eight teams with seven points.

UP NEXT:

UIC heads north to Lincoln Park to face DePaul for the second time this season on Tuesday, May 1. The Flames then host Western Illinois on Thursday, May 3 where the team will honor senior Liz Jacoby and Becky Moran.
