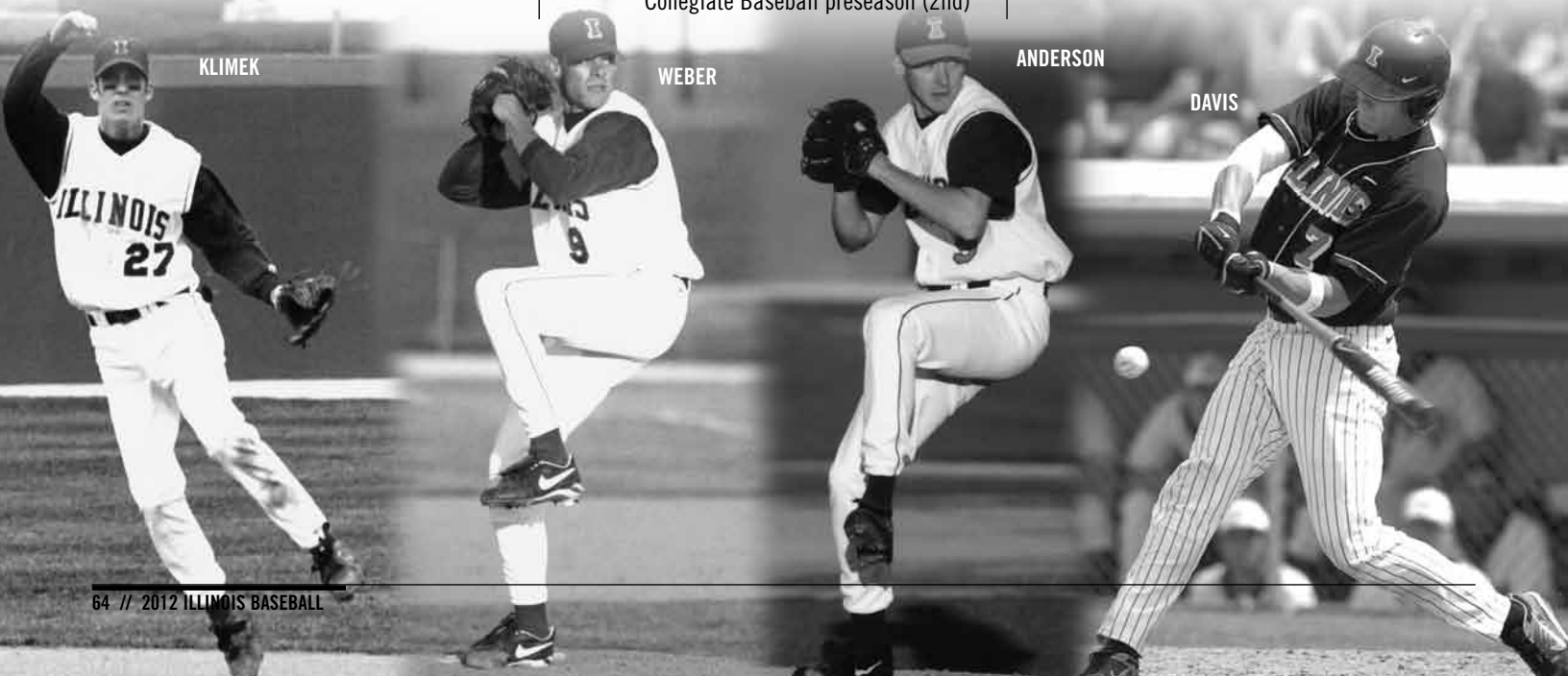

ILLINI GREAT LOU BOUDREAU

The University of Illinois Division of Intercollegiate Athletics retired the Illinois baseball jersey worn by former Fighting Illini baseball and basketball legend Lou Boudreau April 18, 1992, on "Lou Boudreau Day." No. 5, which was worn by Boudreau throughout his collegiate and professional careers, was officially retired between games of the Illinois-Minnesota Big Ten doubleheader.

Boudreau led Illinois to Big Ten titles in basketball and baseball in 1937, earning All-America honors in basketball in 1938 before embarking on a 50-year career in professional baseball.

He joined Illinois football legends Red Grange (#77) and Dick Butkus (#50) as the only athletes in Illinois history to have their jersey numbers retired.

Boudreau joined the Cleveland Indians in the spring of 1938. Four years later at age 24, he was named player-manager of the Indians. In 1948, Boudreau led the Indians to a world championship, hitting .355 with 18 homers and 106 RBI and earning *The Sporting News* Major League Player of the Year and American League Most Valuable Player honors.

In his 15-year major league playing career, Boudreau hit .295 with 68 homers and 789 RBI.

Boudreau played for Cleveland from 1938-1950 and finished his career with the Boston Red Sox from 1950-51.

One of the great fielding shortstops of his era, Boudreau led the league in fielding eight times and in double plays five times. He still holds the major league record for doubles in a game (four) set in 1946.

Boudreau managed four major league teams: Cleveland, Boston (1952-54), the Kansas City Athletics (1955-57) and the Chicago Cubs (1960). He served as a television and radio announcer for the Cubs for more than 20 years and was inducted into the Major League Baseball Hall of Fame in 1970.

As an Illinois sophomore third baseman in 1937, Boudreau hit .347 with 25 hits and four triples to lead the Illini to the Big Ten championship.

A few months earlier, Boudreau had helped lead the basketball squad to the Big Ten title. He also was captain of the 1937-38 squad as a junior.

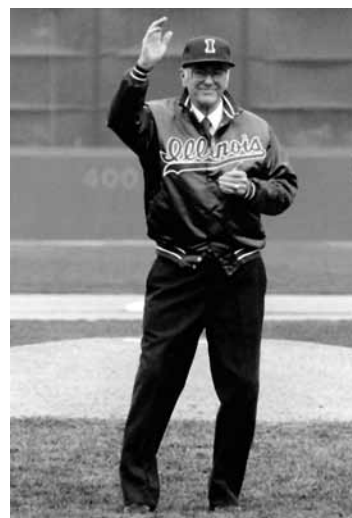
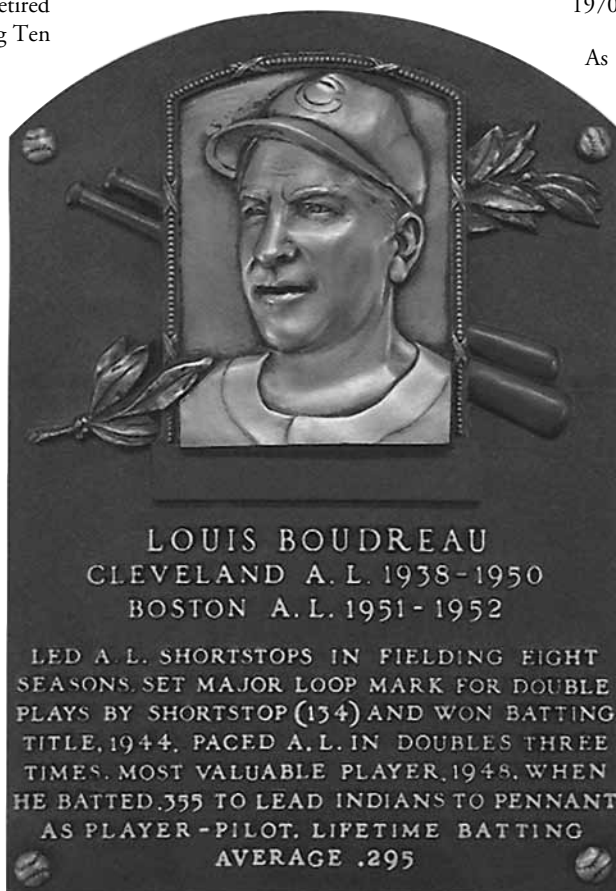
Despite missing the last third of the 1938 basketball season, Boudreau was named an All-American by the Associated Press.

In June 1990, *Collegiate Baseball* named Boudreau to its all-time college baseball "Dream Team."

Boudreau's involvement at Illinois did not end when he joined the Indians in 1938. He returned to coach the freshman basketball team in 1939 and 1940.

In 1987, Boudreau was named Varsity "I" Man of the Year for his more than 50 years of loyal service to the University.

Boudreau passed away Aug. 10, 2001, at St. James Hospital in Olympia Fields, Ill. He had lived with his family in Dolton, Ill., since his retirement.

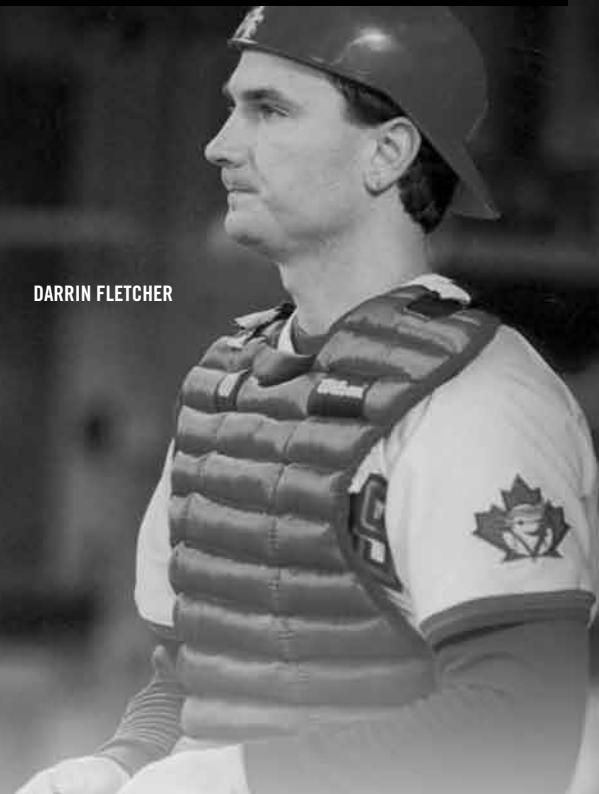

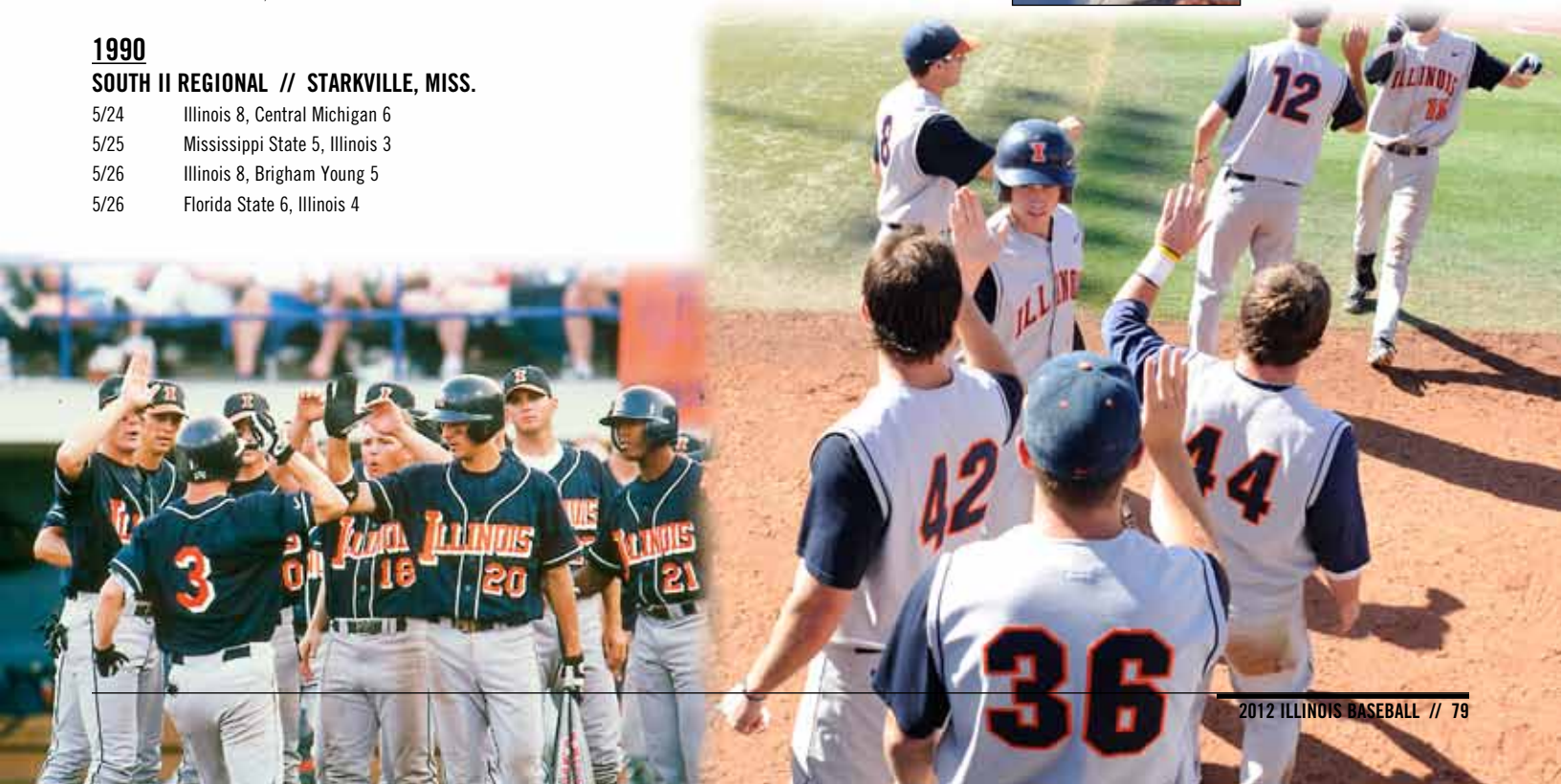

BIG TEN MEDAL OF HONOR

First awarded in 1914, the Big Ten endowed a Medal of Honor to be given annually to a student in the graduating class of each university that demonstrated proficiency in scholarship and athletics.

In 1982, the Medal of Honor was expanded to include a senior woman athlete from each institution. Since the introduction of the Big Ten Medal of Honor, more than 1,070 student-athletes have been awarded the honor.

Andy Schutzenhofer was among the winners of the 2003 Big Ten Conference Medal of Honor, becoming the 15th Illinois baseball player to earn the Medal of Honor and the first since Forry Wells in 1994.

RICHARD C. "ITCH" JONES BASEBALL SCHOLARSHIP

In 2008, the Richard C. "Itch" Jones Baseball Scholarship at the University of Illinois was established by Thomas F. Meagher Jr., and his son, former Illini T.F. Meagher III, to provide scholarship assistance to student-athletes who are members of the Illinois varsity baseball team.

The Jones Baseball Scholarship is in the name of former Illini head coach Richard "Itch" Jones, who led the Orange and Blue from 1991-2005. Jones won two Big Ten titles and one Big Ten Tournament championship and 474 games during his time at Illinois and retired as the 13th-winningest coach in NCAA Division I baseball history with his 1,242 career victories.

T.F. was a three-year letterman from 2001-03, starting 167 games during that time. After starting 102 games at shortstop in 2001-02, Meagher moved to second base in 2003 and started all but eight games there that season. He ranks third on the Illinois career hit by pitch list, having been hit 38 times, and his 14 HBP in both 2001 and 2002 rank eighth on the single-season list.
