2011 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

ILLINI FIND SUCCESS AT NCAA TOURNAMENT

The Fighting Illini went 2-2 at the NCAA Fullerton Regional, dropping their initial game against No. 11 Cal State Fullerton before rebounding to eliminate Kansas State and Fullerton and advance to the championship game against No. 20 Stanford, where they fell, 14-2. The victory over the Titans broke their string of eight consecutive NCAA regional titles and was only their ninth home regional loss in school history. This marked the first time since 1998 that Illinois won at least two games in the NCAA Tournament and fifth time in the Illini's nine appearances in the event in school history.

ILLINI MAKE FIRST NCAA RUN SINCE 2000

Illinois earned the Big Ten's automatic bid to the 2011 NCAA Tournament by winning the Big Ten Tournament, earning a spot in the Fullerton Regional. The Illini scored four in the bottom of the ninth to beat fourth-seeded Ohio State on May 26 before beating No. 2 seed Michigan State in consecutive games on May 27 and 28, 4-1 and 9-1, respectively. It was Illinois' first trip to the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and ninth in school history.

FOUR ILLINI SELECTED IN MLB DRAFT

Four Fighting Illini were selected in the 2011 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft, with catcher Adam Davis being picked by the Baltimore Orioles in the 11th



round, shortstop Josh Parr being taken by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 12th round, pitcher Corey Kimes being selected by the Minnesota Twins in the 18th round and center fielder Willie Argo being taken by the Pittsburgh Pirates in the 43rd round. Davis, Parr and Kimes all signed professional contracts, while Argo returned to Illinois for his senior season. Pitcher Chris Pack also signed a professional contract with the Joliet Slammers of the Frontier League, an independent minor league.

ILLINOIS FINISHES SEASON ON FIRE

The Illini raced to the finish in 2011, winning 13 of their final 17 games, 15 of their last 20 and 18 of their last 24 after stumbling to a 12-21 record following the first game of the doubleheader against Michigan State on April 23. The Illini's string of 15 wins in their last 20 games was the team's best finish to a season since the 1947 Illini squad went 16-4 in its last 20, the 1953 team was 12-1 in its last 13 (10-3 in 2011) and the 1997 team went 14-2 in its last 16 (12-4 in 2011).

COMEBACK KIDS COME THROUGH REGULARLY

Illinois recorded comeback victories in 21 of their 30 wins, meaning the Illini trailed at some point in the game and ended up winning. The Orange and Blue also had a flair for dramatic late-inning comebacks, with six comeback wins in their last at bat and 10 wins in their last at bat in all. From May 15-26, Illinois won four of five games in its last at bat, including two walk-off home runs.

ILLINI SHARE BIG TEN TITLE

The Orange and Blue won a share of the Big Ten title with their sweep of Indiana on the last weekend of the regular season, Illinois' first Big Ten championship since winning it outright in 2005. After opening the Big Ten season 4-6, the Illini won five straight series and went 11-3 in their last 14 games to share the league championship with Michigan State. Winning five consecutive series and six Big Ten series in all both are school records. The key was in the final game of the series, as Illinois went 6-2 in Big Ten series finales in 2011.

BATS COME AROUND LATE

Illinois' offense started to click in the last 23 games, as the team batting average jumped 16 points to .282. In that span, the Illini averaged 10.6 hits and 6.6 runs per game, recording double-digit hits 13 times and double-digit runs five times. Illinois recorded nine or more hits 18 times in its last 23 games and more than six runs 14 times.



ARMS SHUT DOWN OPPONENTS

The Illini pitching staff held its own toward the end of the season as well, posting a 2.00 ERA in the Big Ten Tournament. Illinois limited opponents to four or fewer earned runs five times in the last seven games and to seven or fewer hits four times. The Illini also limited walks and increased strikeouts in the last 10 games, issuing only 35 free passes while fanning 54 and holding opponents to a .290 batting average.

DITTMAN BRINGS POWER SURGE

Senior first baseman **Matt Dittman** saved his best effort for his last game at Illinois Field, as he hit a two-out, two-run walk-off home run to clinch Illinois' series sweep over Indiana on May 21, his second homer of the weekend. At the Big Ten Tournament, he kept the power going with two homers in three games — his only two hits of the tournament — including a grand slam that gave Illinois a 5-0 lead on Michigan State in the third inning of the championship game. Dittman then homered in the NCAA Regional opener against Cal State Fullerton and finished the season by hitting five home runs in the last 10 games after hitting two in the first 47 games of 2011. Dittman finished his career on a hot streak, hitting a team-best .342 (13-for-38) with five homers, 13 RBIs, 12 runs and a .763 slugging percentage in the last 10 games.

'PISTOL PETE' BECOMES AUTOMATIC

Second baseman **Pete Cappetta** became nearly automatic at the top of the Illini order in the last half of the season, raising his average 111 points by hitting .398 in the last

24 games. He earned Big Ten Co-Player of the Week honors on May 2 after hitting .667 with a .714 on-base percentage at Northwestern and went 6-for-12 in the Purdue series. He had 12 multiple-hit games in the last 20, including a four-hit day and five three-hit games, and had a 16-game hit streak in Big Ten play from April 10-May 15 (see page 9). Cappetta finished the Big Ten season second in average in conference games at .403, second in steals (10) and OBP (.478) and 10th in slugging (.545).

JUSTIN PLAYING ABOVE PARR

Justin Parr thrived after being reinserted into the starting lineup at designated hitter against Illinois State on March 30, hitting a blistering .371 in the last 40 games with 10 doubles, two triples, 24 RBIs and 21 runs. He won the Big Ten batting title with a .411 average in conference games, ranked second in hits (39) and sixth in on-base percentage (.454). It was the first batting title for an Illinois player since Luke Simmons in 2001. Parr also was named to the All-Big Ten Tournament team after hitting .429 over the three games Illinois played.

PACK POURS IT ON

Reliever **Chris Pack** was incredibly effective late in the season, going 5-0 with a 0.87 ERA and two saves in 20 2/3 innings across 11 appearances in May and June. He allowed only 10 hits while striking out 10 and walking one in that span, posting a .143 opponent batting average. He lowered his ERA by 2.56 runs after April 24, finishing both of Illinois' wins at the Fullerton Regional.

THE SHOW GOES ON

Starting pitcher **Corey Kimes**, who teammates nicknamed "The Big Show," was an important part of Illinois' late-season surge, as he pitched well in five of his last six starts. Kimes allowed two runs in seven innings at Northwestern on May 1 and gave up three runs in seven innings against Ohio State on May 8. He then tossed a complete game in the Big Ten Tournament championship game against Michigan State, allowing one run on seven hits with a career-high seven strikeouts and no walks, and gave up only three earned runs in seven innings against No. 11 Cal State Fullerton on June 5. Illinois won his last seven starts, as he allowed 20 earned runs in 44 innings against Michigan State, Northwestern, Ohio State, Purdue, Indiana, MSU and Cal State Fullerton.

ANDERSON GOES THE DISTANCE

Senior starting pitcher **John Anderson** was excellent for most of the 2011 season, his first campaign as a starter. Anderson tossed four complete games to tie for the Big Ten lead, going the distance against Penn State, Michigan, Michigan State and Northwestern. He also ramped it up in the postseason, allowing just two earned runs over 15 1/3 innings against Michigan State and Kansas State in the Big Ten and NCAA Tournaments, respectively. He also was at his best away from Illinois Field, going 6-3 with a 2.86 ERA, three complete games and 72 1/3 innings in 11 road or neutral-site starts.
