NOTES

- Jollette Law guided the Illini to a 20-15 record in her first season as head coach, marking Illinois' first 20-win season since 1999-2000.
- Jenna Smith is the top returning scorer (18.3 ppg) and second returning rebounder (9.4 rpg) in the Big Ten. Smith had a breakout sophomore season, recording 16 double-doubles and scoring in double figures in 34 of 35 games on the season, including a string of 28 straight. She was rewarded by being named an honorable mention All-American by the *Associated Press* and also earning first team All-Big Ten honors.
- The Illini made a historic run in the Big Ten Tournament as the No. 9 seed, becoming the lowest seeded team to advance to the championship. Illinois lost the title game to Purdue on a buzzer-beater.
- Illinois' selection to the 2008 WNIT marked its fourth consecutive postseason appearance and it's 11th in the last 12 years. The Illini have advanced to the NCAA Tournament five times during the streak and to the WNIT the other six.
- Illinois led the Big Ten and set a new school record for fewest turnovers per game (15.3). In the Feb. 21 victory over Penn State, the Illini established a new school record for least number of turnovers in a game with just five.
- Smith set the single-season Illinois blocks record at 59, while the Illini broke the team record of blocked shots with 156.
