REDBIRDS FACE BLUEJAYS IN MVC FINAL

No. 1 Illinois State and No. 3 Creighton will square off for the 2007 MVC Women's Soccer Championship title on Sunday, Nov. 11. The game will be broadcast live on Fox Sports Net and can be seen on FSN Midwest, Fox College Sports, Comcast SportsNet Chicago and Metro Sports. Sean Wheelock and Dave Dir will provide the commentary. Illinois State and Creighton have met three time in the MVC Tournament, twice in the final. The 'Birds beat the Jays 2-1 in the regular season.

RUSS LIFTS ISU WITH TWO GOALS IN SEMIFINALS

Senior forward **Bethany Russ** scored twice, including the game-winner, to lift No. 1 ISU past No. 4 Drake, 3-2, in double overtime in a semifinal match of the 2007 State Farm MVC Championship. Russ scored the first goal for the Redbirds and netted the game-winner 57 seconds into the second overtime period. Senior midfielder **Yvonne Northover** and freshman midfielder **Bethany Brown** assisted Russ' game-winning goal. Sophomore midfielder **Ammanda Wisniewski** netted the other Redbird goal and senior defender **Amanda Lauber** and junior forward **Mel Routledge** also had assists. The second half of the game featured four goals and 17 of the game's 32 combined shots, nine by ISU and eight by Drake. The Redbirds took a 2-0 lead with a pair of goals in a three-minute span, but Drake came right back with two goals within six minutes of each other.

NORTHOVER NAMED MVC PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Senior midfielder **Yvonne Northover** was named the 2007 MVC Player of the Year at the awards banquet on Thursday, Nov. 8. Northover led the Valley in points (11) and goals (5) in conference play and scored five game-winning goals on the season, an ISU record. She became the fourth Illinois State player to received the Valley's top honor, joining Heather Forsyth, a two-time winner in 2003 and 2005, and Annie Wayland, who was the first Redbird recipient in 2001.

SEVEN REDBIRDS NAMED ALL-CONFERENCE

Seven Illinois State players earned All-Valley recognition in 2007. Senior midfielder **Yvonne Northover** and sophomore midfielder **Raquel Rattray** were both first team selections. A trio of sophomores also picked up all-conference honors with goalkeeper **Katie Grill-Donovan** and defender **Danielle Mutters** on the second team and midfielder **Ammanda Wisniewski** earning honorable mention recognition. Rounding out the ISU selections were All-Freshman team honorees midfielder **Bethany Brown** and **Alyssa Schulz**.

REDBIRDS IN THE MVC TOURNAMENT

Illinois State is 5-9-4 all-time in the MVC Tournament; 2-2-0 as the No. 1 seed. ISU is 1-5-2 all-time in the MVC Tournament against the three teams in the 2007 field. The win over Drake in the semifinals on Friday was the Redbirds' first-ever against the Bulldogs in the championship. In its four ties, ISU has advanced three times on penalty kicks.

REDBIRDS-BLUEJAYS SERIES

Illinois State leads the all-time series with Creighton, 8-5-2. The Redbirds are 3-1-2 in the last six meetings, including a 2-1 win in Normal earlier this season. The Redbirds and Bluejays have met three times in the MVC Tournament. In 1997, the Bluejays bested the Redbirds in a quarterfinal match, 2-0. In 2002, Creighton was a 1-0 winner in overtime to claim its first MVC Tournament title. The Redbirds exacted their revenge the following year by beating the Bluejays in penalty kicks, 5-4, after a scoreless game to win their first MVC Tournament crown.

NORTHOVER LEADS REDBIRDS TO VICTORY

Senior captain **Yvonne Northover** has been the catalyst for the Redbird offense all season. She has recorded a point in every Redbird win and has scored five game-winning goals, three of which came in Valley contests. She has a pair of two-goal games (at Northern Iowa, vs. Creighton) and a pair of two-assist games (vs. Central Michigan, vs. Morehead State) this season. She leads the Redbirds in points (21), goals (7) and assists (7). With her assist on the game-winning goal in the semifinal against Drake, she tied the ISU single-season record and became the third player in school history to record double-digits in goals (12) and assists (10).

RUSS MAKES LAST SEASON COUNT

Senior forward **Bethany Russ** has already put together a stellar career at Illinois State, but she is making the best of her final season as a Redbird. Russ leads the team in goals (9) and is second in points (20). This season, she has surpassed the goal totals and tied the point total she accumulated in her first three seasons. She is tied for second in career points (40) and tied for third in career goals (16) in Illinois State history.

FITTING RIGHT IN

Coming into the season, perhaps the biggest question facing new head coach **Drew Roff** was who his starting goalkeeper would be. With the graduation of Andrea Shaw, a three-year starter who ranks in the top-three in many statistical categories of the school record book, Roff was left with a sophomore with little collegiate experience and a true freshman. Fortunately, the sophomore is turning out to be a solid replacement. Sophomore goalkeeper **Katie Grill-Donovan** earned the starting position after summer training and isn't showing any signs of faltering. This season, Grill-Donovan has posted 10 wins, six by shutout, and is in the top-five in the MVC in saves, saves per game, goals against average, save percentage and shutouts. She also ranks in the top-10 on the ISU single-season lists in all of those categories. Grill-Donovan was a huge reason why the Redbirds went unblemished through the conference season as she allowed just three goals and had an .889 save percentage in MVC games. In the MVC semifinal against Drake, Grill-Donovan tied her career-high with eight saves.

SPARK UP TOP

Seniors **Shannon Duggan** and **Amanda Lauber** entered the season as ISU's most experienced defenders, but they are making an impact on the offensive side of the ball lately. After a four-game stretch when ISU was held to one goal or less three times, Duggan and Lauber started seeing time as forwards to utilize their speed and skill sets. The move worked as the duo has combined for eight points with a goal and six assists over the last 10 games. Duggan, who has started the last 11 games, assisted Lauber's goal against Loyola and assisted the game-winner in the following game against Indiana State.

HATS OFF TO RUSS AND WISNIEWSKI

One of the rarest and most recognizable feats in all of soccer has occurred twice in the past two games at Adelaide Street Field. Senior **Bethany Russ** and sophomore **Ammanda Wisniewski** each recorded hat tricks to lead ISU to wins in consecutive home games. Wisniewski provided all the scoring in a 3-0 win over Central Michigan and Russ netted three second half goals in a 4-0 triumph against Morehead State. Both performances tied the school records for goals (three) and points (six) in a single game, and were the first multi-goal games of each player's career.

HEAD COACH DREW ROFF

Drew Roff begins his coaching tenure at Illinois State in 2007. Roff has enjoyed a highly successful coaching and playing career throughout the Midwest that has led him to his first Division I coaching position at Illinois State. An experienced teacher of the game at the high school, club and college levels, Roff has moved quickly through the coaching ranks.



- **University of Indianapolis (2005-06):** Roff compiled a 26-14-1 record in his two years. In 2006, Roff led the Greyhounds to a 17-5-1 record, setting the school record for wins and shutouts (12). Indianapolis won the Great Lakes Valley Tournament and advanced to the Division II NCAA Tournament, both firsts in the program's history. The Greyhounds beat Mercyhurst in the first round, 2-1, before losing to Grand Valley State, the eventual national runner-up.

- **Dynamo FC (2003-06):** Roff served as the head coach of the club team in Indianapolis for four seasons. In 2004, he was named Indiana Youth Soccer Association District 6 Girls Coach of the year after he led the '89 girls to the Indiana State Cup championship, the regional semifinals and a No. 17 national ranking. In 2006, he guided the '89 girls to the Midwest Premier league title and another regional semifinal trip.

- **Roncalli High School (2002-03), Dowagiac High School (1998-02):** Roff's coaching career began at the high school level. He coached at two different institutions over the span of five years. At Dowagiac, Roff taught physical education and coached both the boys and girls varsity teams. He was named district coach of the year in 2001. At Roncalli, Roff won sectional titles in both of his seasons as head coach.

- **Playing Career:** Roff's success and experience as a coach comes from years as a standout player. He played collegiately at Michigan State from 1991-94, where he was a four-year starter at forward for the Spartans. He garnered second-team All-Big Ten and regional All-America honors in 1994 after leading the Spartans with 22 points on six goals and 10 assists. Roff then played in the United Soccer League's Professional Development League from 1997-2001. He was a member of the Mid-Michigan Bucks from 1997-98 and was a player/coach for the Indiana Invaders from 1999-2001.
