SETTING THE SCENE

The Hoosiers look to extend their winning streak against the Boilers this weekend. The intra-state rivalry continues for the third consecutive year with the Indiana vs. Purdue dual meet. The Hoosiers have won both the men's and women's meets the past two seasons, with the 77-59 win by the men last season the closest winning margin since the series renewed in 2010. Purdue comes to town with women's throwers Dani Buch and Terri Anderson leading the way. The two throwers for Purdue rank sixth and ninth nationally in the shot put, and Bunch ranks ninth nationally in the weight throw. The men are led by Mitch Erickson, who has a good early season clearance in the pole vault, ranking ninth in the nation.

LAST TIME OUT

Indiana track and field won 10 events at the Indiana Open. The early season meet saw Dan Galos, De'Sean Turner, Robbie Nierman and Kelsey Duerksen take the lead for the Hoosiers.

Galos took the win in the men's weight throw, posting his second-straight career best of the season. His throw of 18.83m (61-9.5). Galos ranks eighth nationally in the very young indoor season.

Nierman won the 3,000 meters in a time of 8:17.89, which leads the NCAA on the season. He destroyed his previous career best (8:48.86) by 31 seconds.

Turner won the 1,000m in 2:23.51. He bettered two post-collegiate runners for the win. He came back to run the second leg on Indiana's winning 4x400m relay, clocking a time of 3:18.20.

Duerksen won the women's 1,000m in a time of 2:50.19, squeaking it out ahead of teammate Breanne Ehrman, who was second in 2:50.37. IU went 1-2-3, with Caitlin Engel in third in 2:52.45.

Four IU alumni took wins on the day, with Aarik Wilson winning the triple jump with a mark of 16.02m (52-6.75), Vera Neuenswander (4.00m (13-1.5)) and Jeff Coover (5.36m (17-7)) winning the women's and men's pole vaults and current assistant coach Abbie Norton winning the 60m hurdles in 8.98.

Monique Riddick took second in the shot put (15.67m (51-5)) and the weight throw (17.59m (57-8.5)). Her mark in the shot put ranks sixth on the national list.

Tyler Sult took the win in the 60m, clocking a time of 7.04 seconds. Jordan Gray won the 500 meters in 1:13.93. Ryan Hinds was the collegiate winner in the men's 500 in 1:04.10, finishing .05 behind the winner, Ricardo Bell of the Indiana Invaders. Chris Vaughn was third in the 500, finishing in 1:04.97 to win his heat.

HOOSIERS EIGHTH IN PRESEASON RANKS

The USTFCCA released the preseason NCAA Division I computer rankings for indoor track and field this week, and Indiana stacks up at number eight to start the season. Without all-world high jumper Derek Drouin as he redshirts this indoor season, the Hoosiers still return enough firepower to rank among the nation's top 10. The first regular season rankings will be released by the USTFCCA on Jan. 24.

Big scorers in the computer rankings for IU include Andy Bayer, who has the top returning time in the 3,000m and the fourth-best returning time in the mile, as well as the fifth returning time in the distance medley relay. Andrew Poore and Ben Hubers rank as the eighth and ninth best returners in the 5K, and both rank among the nation's top 15 in the 3K as well. Kind Butler is the other big contributor for IU, as he ranks ninth in the 200m and 19th in the 60m.

ONE OF A KIND

Kind Butler blazed to wins in the 55 meters and 300 meters at the Hoosier Open. His time of 6.27 seconds in the 55 is the sixth fastest in school history and is the fastest 55m time in the country on the very young season. Converted to 60 meters, Butler ranks sixth on the NCAA list.

In the 300, Butler finished in a school record 33.57, to win by more than half a second. Butler bettered the previous record of 33.87 by IU legend and Olympian Albert Robinson.

Butler has a led a resurgence of the Indiana sprints program over the past two years. He won IU's first Big Ten title in the 60 meters since 1992 and became IU's first All-American in the 200 since 2004 during the 2011 indoor campaign, and then outdoors he led the Hoosiers to the first All-America finish in the 4x100 since 1971 and came within .01 seconds of the IU record in the 100 meters.

GOING THE DISTANCE

Since his arrival in Bloomington in 2007, Ron Helmer has turned Indiana's distance program into a powerhouse. IU's men's distance runners have played prominent roles in four NCAA top-10 finishes in the past two seasons. The men's cross country team finished seventh at NCAAs in both 2010 and 2011, and the distance crew helped the Hoosiers to sixth at NCAAs during the 2010 and 2011 indoor seasons.

When it comes to success on the track, Indiana enters the indoor campaign with perhaps the most depth in the country in distance events. IU's men return four distance runners with Big Ten titles on their resumés, and two of those runners have won a pair of conference crowns. The 2012 Hoosier squad returns six All-American distance runners, who have combined to collect 21 All-America certificates. Indiana's depth is evident if you look at the team's career bests, as six Hoosiers have PR's in the mile better than 4:05 and 10 Hoosiers have gone under 4:10 in their collegiate careers.

ONCE THE ROOKIE, NOW THE VETERAN

Kelsie Ahbe came to Indiana in 2009-10 as a two-time state champion pole vaulter from Ohio, but with a pair of NCAA Championship-tested jumpers (Vera Neuenswander and Stephanie Chin) in the program to train with and learn from. Two years later, she is the returning All-American, and four freshmen will look to her for the lead on the pole vault runway. Indiana has had great successes in the women's pole vault since Jake Wiseman took over the group in 2005.

Ahbe took second at Big Tens during the indoor and outdoor seasons and added a sixth place finish outdoors for her first All-America certificate. She and Vera Neuenswander went 1-2 at the outdoor Big Ten meet. This after she took 14th at the NCAA Outdoor Championships and second at Big Tens as a freshman in 2010.

This season, four freshmen enter the program in the women's pole vault, and they are a heralded group. All four jumpers cleared 3.81m (12-6) or better in high school, a mark that was Ahbe's PR when she arrived in Bloomington. It should be an intriguing season on the pole vault runway for IU.

CHRONICLES OF RIDDICK

Monique Riddick had a breakout year in 2011, but unless you were a hardcore fan of the throws, you might not have noticed. Overshadowed by Faith Sherrill's standout senior season, Riddick posted similar numbers in the shot put in her junior season to what Sherrill did in her junior season, making Riddick an under the radar performer this year with the potential to surprise people in 2012.

Riddick, a transfer to Indiana in 2010 from Montclair State, won three NCAA Division III titles in the shot put before arriving in Bloomington. Riddick posted an indoor best of 16.66m (54-8) in 2011 and advanced to the NCAA Championships during the indoor and outdoor campaigns. In comparison, Sherrill finished her junior indoor season at 16.80m (55-1.5).

A standout at Bishop Ahr in New Jersey, Riddick wasn't heavily recruited out of high school, mostly because of her height. The senior has proved people wrong as a collegiate thrower, and with her work ethic and strong finish to throws, she has blossomed under Indiana's throws coach Jermaine Jones. After winning her third NCAA title at Montclair State, head coach Aubrey Lewis told Riddick that she should look to transfer if she wanted to reach her full potential as a thrower. In the recruiting process, Riddick chose Indiana because of Jones's successes with another short thrower, Tiffany Howard. Howard was an All-American and Big Ten Champion at Indiana.

BREAKOUT FOR BAILEY?

Aireonna Bailey took wins in the 55m and 300m at the Hoosier Open, posting a time of 7.13 seconds in the 55 to move past IU legend and Olympian DeDee Nathan for ninth in IU history. Converted to 60 meters, Bailey's time is 7.65, which is .02 better than her career best. In the 300, Bailey clocked a time of 39.31 to win by just under two seconds.

After a breakout season in 2011, Bailey is poised for a breakout campaign in 2012. The junior posted a third place finish in the 200m at Big Tens in 2011 and scored in the 100m at the conference meet as well. The Zion, Ill., native was one race away from a trip to Des Moines during the outdoor campaign last year, advancing to the quarterfinals at the NCAA East Preliminary Round.

Bailey should benefit from the addition of two new training partners, freshmen Shawntanay Johnson and La Toya Williams. Both of the freshmen come to Indiana with impressive high school accolades. Johnson was a Missouri state runner up in the 100 in 2009, and Williams was all-state in the 100m and 200m at the always impressive California State meet.

FOURTH YEAR AS INDIANA DIRECTOR AND HEAD COACH • FOURTH YEAR AT INDIANA • 11TH YEAR AS HEAD COACH

Ron Helmer is in his fifth season as the Indiana Director and Head Coach of Men's and Women's Track and Field and Cross Country after being named to the position on May 25, 2007.

The fourth year of the Ron Helmer era, the 2010-11 season was a historic one for the Hoosiers program. The season included two top-10 NCAA finishes, two Big Ten runner-up finishes, 26 All-Americans, one NCAA Individual Championship and four Big Ten records. Helmer was awarded USTFCCA Great Lakes Region Coach of the Year honors for the Indoor season. At the season's conclusion, five Hoosiers were honored with the distinguished Academic All-America award. Andy Bayer became the first male track athlete in school history to be honored and was joined by Chelsea Blanchard, Vera Neuenswander, Sarah Pease and Faith Sherrill.

The men's cross country team got things started, taking seventh at NCAAs and second at Big Tens, with Andrew Poore finishing as an All-American and Andy Bayer placing second at the Big Ten meet.

Indoors, the IU men were again runners-up behind Big Ten Champions Kind Butler (60m), Derek Drouin (High Jump) and Poore (5,000m). Faith Sherrill won the Big Ten shot put crown for the women. At NCAAs, the Hoosiers finished sixth with Drouin winning his third NCAA high jump crown with a Big Ten and Canadian national record clearance of 2.33m (7-7.75) en route to USTFCCA Field Athlete of the Year honors and Bayer highlighting nine other All-Americans for IU at the meet. Bayer took third in the 3,000m and led the Hoosiers to second in the DMR, clocking the fastest anchor leg ever recorded, splitting 3:53. Sherrill broke the all-time Big Ten record by 2 feet and 6.5 inches in the shot put with her first throw of the season. Travelling 18.00m (59-0.75), Sherrill has the 10th-best collegiate throw all-time and the eighth-best collegiate throw ever by an American. Bayer, Drouin and Sherrill each garnered Big Ten Athlete of the Year honors and Great Lakes Region Athlete of the year honors for the indoor season.

Outdoors, injuries to Drouin and Bayer slowed down the Hoosiers, but not much, as the women took third at Big Tens and 23rd at NCAAs and the men took fourth at Big Tens and 20th at NCAAs. Ben Hubers (1,500m), Vera Neuenswander (pole vault), Sarah Pease (steeplechase), Faith Sherrill (shot put) and De'Sean Turner (steeplechase) claimed Big Ten titles and 12 Hoosiers earned All-America honors. Neuenswander tied the Big Ten record in the pole vault to win at Big Tens, clearing 4.36m (14-3.5) to put the exclamation point on a 1-2 finish with teammate Kelsie Ahbe. Neuenswander and Ahbe went on to All-American finishes at NCAAs. Sherrill broke the Big Ten outdoor record in the shot put, launching a 17.64m (57-10.5) bomb to win at Penn Relays. Pease won her first Big Ten crown in the steeple, joining Turner in leading what was dubbed the "sweepchase", as IU had three of the top four finishers in both the men's and women's races at Big Tens. At NCAAs, Andrew Poore led the way, taking third in the steeplechase. It was a historic season in the 4x100m relay for the Hoosiers, as the men's relay of Tyler Sult, Kind Butler, Chris Vaughn and Devin Pipkin became the first All-American relay for IU in 30 years. At Penn Relays, Indiana was the only school from the North to qualify for the 4x100 and 4x200 Championship of America finals at Penn Relays.

Helmer's third year at Indiana proved to be record-setting. The Indiana women advanced to the NCAA Championships in cross country for the first time since 2004. With 13 indoor All-Americans, Helmer's squads produced more All-America certificates than any other indoor season in IU history. The IU men finished sixth overall at the NCAA Indoor Championships, marking the best performance by an IU team since Aarik Wilson won two NCAA crowns at the 2005 meet.

Not to be outdone, the Hoosier women posted a 16th-place finish at the NCAA outdoor meet, while the men took 20th. Indiana finished the year with 18 All-Americans, nine Big Ten champions and three Big Ten Athlete of the Year Awards.

The biggest highlight of the year for Indiana in 2010

was Derek Drouin. The sophomore won NCAA titles during the indoor and outdoor seasons in the high jump. He was named Big Ten Field Athlete of the Year for both seasons as well. The NCAA crowns are the fifth and sixth by a Helmer pupil. Drouin also added the Canadian National Championship to his credit on the season.

On the women's side, Molly Beckwith highlighted the season with a second-place finish at the NCAA Outdoor Championships in the 800m. Beckwith followed her NCAA performance with a tour of Europe, where she finished an 800m race in 1:59.83. That performance merited a professional contract with Saucony.

Andy Bayer had a remarkable indoor campaign, breaking four minutes in the mile and eight minutes in the 3,000m, and then taking third at NCAAs in the 3,000m a day after posting an astonishing comeback for seventh place in the distance medley relay after dropping the baton. He was joined by Andrew Poore as an All-American in the 3,000m. Also earning All-America honors in the distance medley relay were De'Sean Turner, Kind Butler and Danny Stockberger. Turner added All-America honors to his resume in the steeplechase.

Juniors Faith Sherrill and Sarah Pease had breakout seasons in 2010. Sherrill was the Big Ten Field Athlete of the Year after smashing three IU records in the throws and earning three All-America certificates. She also took two Big Ten titles, indoors in the weight throw and outdoors in the shot put. Pease made a name for herself in the 3,000m steeplechase, taking fourth at both the NCAA Championships and the USA Championships. Ashley Rhoades earned All-America honors at the NCAA indoor meet in the high jump.

Indiana track and field showed itself as a program on the rise in 2009, registering eight All-Americans across all three seasons. During the cross country season, Helmer had two of his pupils earn All-Big Ten honors, in Timothy McLeod and Wendi Robinson. Robinson later qualified for the NCAA Championships, where she earned All-America honors in 28th-place.

During the indoor season, Helmer saw Big Ten title wins from Tiffany Howard (shot put) and Jeff Coover (pole vault). He also saw Molly Beckwith and Derek Drouin earn All-Big Ten honors. Coover was named Great Lakes Region Field Athlete of the Year and went on to earn All-America honors for a fourth-place finish in the pole vault. Drouin went on to finish as the NCAA runner-up in the high jump, and Vera Neuenswander and the team's distance medley relay foursome each claimed All-America honors. In total, nine Hoosiers made the trip to the NCAA Indoor Championships in College Station, Texas.

The outdoor slate saw the Hoosiers claim three more All-America certificates and three more Big Ten titles. Drouin (high jump), Kiwan Lawson (long jump) and Ashley Rhoades (high jump) all won Big Ten crowns, and three more IU athletes earned All-Big Ten honors. Drouin was named Big Ten Freshman of the Year and went on to claim Great Lakes Region Athlete of the Year. Twenty-three Hoosiers made the trip to the Midwest Regional and seven advanced to the NCAA Championships. Neuenswander and Drouin each won the regional. At the NCAA Championships in Fayetteville Ark., Tiffany Howard, Sarah Pease and Vera Neuenswander claimed All-America honors. Neuenswander finished second in the pole vault. Neuenswander went on to garner ESPN the Magazine Academic All-America honors.

In his first season at the helm of the Hoosiers, Helmer guided the men's and women's track and field teams to improvements during the indoor and outdoor seasons. The indoor portion of the year was highlighted by a Big Ten individual championship for Audrey Smoot in the 600-meter run and a Big Ten runner-up honor from Kyle Jenkins in the triple jump. The indoor season culminated in a trio of Hoosiers representing the women's team at the NCAA Indoor Championships in Robinson, Molly Beckwith and Stephanie Chin.

Helmer's first outdoor season at IU also proved successful as Indiana posted 10 medalists, including two Big Ten individual champions with Jenkins in the triple jump and Lawson in the long jump. The success from

the Big Ten Championships led to the NCAA Midwest Region Championships as 23 Hoosiers made the trip to Fayetteville, resulting in seven student-athletes from Indiana competing in the NCAA Outdoor Championships. The Hoosiers produced two All-Americans in Lawson and Coover.

Helmer also helped two young cross country squads to new heights with fresh faces on the staff and on the roster. In just her first year of cross country, Pease took the leadership role for the women's squad finishing as the top Hoosier in every meet for IU. On the men's side, Helmer led Indiana to its first team appearance in the NCAA Championships since 2005 with a group that included three true freshmen. IU, led by junior McLeod, placed 28th overall as a team after a fourth place finish at the NCAA Great Lakes Regional.

Prior to coming to IU, Helmer served as the director and head coach at Georgetown University for eight years. He was promoted to director in July 1999 after serving as associate head coach with the Hoyas for seven seasons and assistant coach the five years prior. During his tenure, 120 of his student-athletes earned a total of 342 All-America recognitions, including 41 student-athletes receiving 96 certificates since becoming director in 1999. In addition, 219 student-athletes captured BIG EAST individual titles, including 67 after he became director.

At the NCAA Championships, he guided 27 athletes or relay teams to a top-three finish, highlighted by four national champions - Joline Staeheli (mile, 1996), Miesha Marzell (1500m, 1996) and two distance medley relay champions (1997, 1999). He also saw his teams earn 22 top-10 finishes in NCAA Championship action, including a streak of 15 straight at the cross country championships that ended in 2003. Among the top-10 finishes were seven top-four trophy finishes, including a third at the 1998 NCAA Indoor Championships and a fourth-place finish at the 2002 NCAA Cross Country Championships.

Helmer led Hoya teams to the Championship of America relay titles at the Penn Relays, the latest being the 2004 men's 4x800m squad with a time of 7:13.75, the seventh-fastest time in collegiate history. He was part of 37 BIG EAST Championship teams and his student-athletes were honored 11 times as the Robert A. Duffey Scholar-Athlete award winner, given to the student-athlete who best embodies academic and athletic excellence.

In January 2006, Helmer was the recipient of the Coaches Achievement Program award presented by Oppenheimer Funds, Inc. The Coaches Achievement Program honors coaches at select BIG EAST member institutions for excellence in coaching, mentoring and community service.

Helmer came to Georgetown from Woodbridge High School in Virginia, where he served as head coach for four years. Prior to that, he was the head coach at Virginia High School in Bristol, Va., for eight years.

He was named Virginia Cross Country Coach of the Year in 1980 and 1983, along with being selected as the Virginia Girls' Track Coach of the Year in 1981. Topping off the honors, Helmer was selected as the Boys' Cross Country Coach of the Decade in Virginia. During his career, Helmer's teams won 45 district, 35 regional and 10 state championships. Individually, he produced nine high school All-Americans and 13 Foot Locker National Cross Country qualifiers.

Helmer is a graduate of Southwestern College located in Winfield, Kan., where he received a bachelor of arts degree in math. In October 2004, he was inducted into the Southwestern College Athletic Hall of Fame. He continued his education at East Tennessee State University, where he earned his master's degree in physical education, with a focus in biomechanics and human kinetics.

Helmer's wife, Mary, is a seventh-grade teacher. They have three children, Tori, a high school math teacher and track coach, Justin, a high school business teacher and basketball and track coach, and Kari, a recent graduate of IU, and a granddaughter - Rylee and a grandson - Brody.
