The purpose of this publication is to provide information on policies for The University of Iowa home football games at Kinnick Stadium. Our objective is to provide the best services possible for all fans and guests of the Iowa Hawkeyes.

Policies and regulations for UI home football games are designed to be the most practical and functional for the capacity crowds that have become the trademark of Iowa football.

We hope you will enjoy your visit to The University of Iowa and Kinnick Stadium.

Notice

Patrons and ticket holders are advised that state law prohibits hard liquor consumption or possession of an opened bottle of hard liquor on public property. University Police Officers will empty any opened visible bottle of hard liquor. Persons guilty of drunkenness or of possessing or drinking intoxicants in the stadium are subject to arrest and will be ejected without refund.

Only **small (8 1/2 x 11")** purses, fanny packs, binocular cases, blankets and seat cushions will be allowed into Kinnick Stadium. All items will be searched at specific entrance gates. Patrons are subject to search, and the University reserves the right to refuse entry.

The following items are **not allowed** inside the stadium: bags of any size, alcoholic beverages, botas, all coolers, canned or bottled beverages (except sealed clear plastic water bottles), thermoses, back packs, kegs, banners and signs, personal seat backs, large lens cameras, tripods, **umbrellas**, strollers, noisemakers, horns, bugles, or any other disruptive device. These items should be left in your vehicle. Admission will be denied anyone carrying any such items.

The University reserves the right to eject anyone not adhering to stadium policies.

Emergency Medical Services

Medical services are available at all UI games. If you need medical assistance, notify the nearest security officer or usher. The first aid station, staffed by a physician and nurse, is located in the middle of the south bleachers. Paramedic teams are also located in the middle of all four sides of the stadium. Patrons are reminded to dress for prevailing weather conditions and bring required prescription medication that might be needed during their visit to Kinnick Stadium.

Kinnick Stadium Smoking Policy

The University of Iowa has a policy limiting smoking in the stadium. Smoking is prohibited in seating areas, pressbox, concourses, and the rest rooms. Smoking is allowed in designated areas only (the four marked open-air corners of the stadium).

Stadium Information

Lost and Found: Located in the check rooms under the east and west stands. Lost items may be claimed by calling 335-9410 or by inquiring in person at the Athletic Department, Facility Manager's Office, 111 Carver Hawkeye Arena, Iowa City, Iowa 52242-1020.

Lost Patrons: Lost patrons and persons looking for lost patrons should contact security or ticket-taking personnel who are located throughout the stadium or go to security headquarters, which is located in the tennis center by the southwest corner of the stadium.

Public Address System: No announcements will be made over the public address system except for emergency situations. The public is asked not to request this service.

Public Pay Telephones: Located inside the east and west concourses near sections E and P. Also located outside the southeast corner of the stadium.

Rest Rooms: Men's and women's rest rooms are located throughout the stadium. Porta-potties are also located around the stadium and in the parking lots. Specially equipped rest rooms for persons with disabilities are located in the northwest corner of the north stands and in the south stands adjacent to the first aid station. **Prior to the gates opening, persons with disabilities can utilize the handicap accessible rest rooms by entering the stadium through the northwest, northeast, southeast and southwest pass gates.**

Gate Information

All entrance gates open one and one-half hours prior to kickoff.

Patrons will not be permitted to exit and re-enter Kinnick Stadium.

Student Gates: Students with a general admission ticket must enter either Gate 3 or northwest gate.

Will Call Gates

General Will Call: Tennis Center (Adjacent to SW Gate)

Press Will Call: Elevator at press box

Iowa Player Pass Gate: Gate 1 (West side of stadium)

Iowa Prospect Pass Gate: Northwest corner of stadium

Visiting Team Pass Gate: Southeast corner of stadium



Parking

Parking lots open at 7:00am day of game. **However, if game time is 5:00pm or later, lots will open at 12:30pm.** Parking for contributors to Iowa Athletics is indicated on the map inside. **For the 2003 football season, additional parking for Kinnick Society, Champions (KC) and handicap (HC) has been reserved in the lot directly northwest of Kinnick Stadium.**

General public parking is available in lots and ramps located east of Hawkins Drive (east of Kinnick Stadium) as well as south Finkbine and the Finkbine commuter lot. Public parking for motor homes is available in the south Finkbine lot and Finkbine commuter lot. Additional parking for persons with disabilities is available in Public Ramp #2. The cost in general public lots will be **\$10 per car, \$20 per motor home, and \$30 per bus.**

Tents, tarps, or canopies **are not** permitted if they impede foot or vehicular traffic or if they extend into additional parking space. Violators of this policy will be asked by University Police Officers to dismantle the tent, tarp, or canopy. **Double-deck trailers and buses will not be permitted in parking lots.**

For your personal safety, the UI Athletic Department and Department of Public Safety are requesting that all beverages consumed in the parking lots be in paper or plastic drinking cups.

Game Programs, Concessions, Novelties

Game programs will be sold at numerous locations outside Kinnick Stadium. Concession stands are located throughout the stadium. Novelty items may be purchased at the Iowa Hawk Shop located on the west side of the stadium or at portable stands in various locations outside Kinnick Stadium.

General Ticket Information

All persons must have a ticket. This includes infants in arms.

The University of Iowa Athletic Department reserves the right to revoke tickets.

Holders of tickets to UI athletic events agree to abide by stadium and University policies.

The University of Iowa Athletic Department is not responsible for lost or stolen tickets. Tickets are issued and sold only by the Athletic Ticket Office or authorized ticket outlets of The University of Iowa. Persons buying tickets from sources other than the Athletic Ticket Office do so at their own risk.

Duplicate Ticket Policy

The Athletic Ticket Office will charge full price for all duplicate tickets issued. This includes tickets that are lost, stolen, or left at home. If original tickets are returned to the Athletic Ticket Office, a refund will be made. This service is available only to general public and faculty and/or staff season ticket holders. Washed tickets for general public, faculty and/or staff and students will be replaced without charge if the remainder is recognizable as a football ticket and the seat location can be identified.

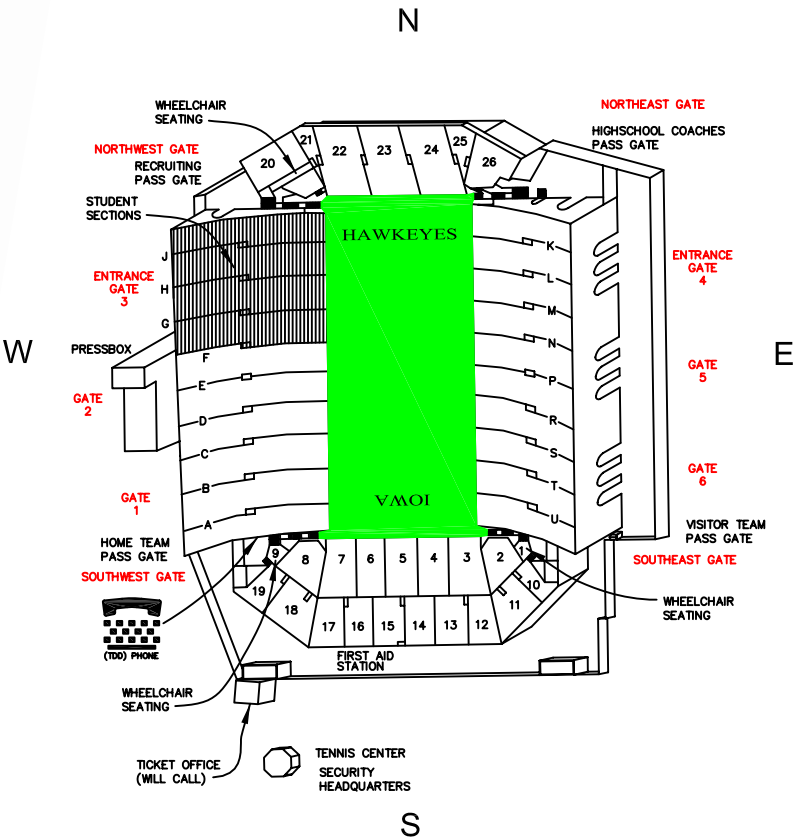
Disability Seating

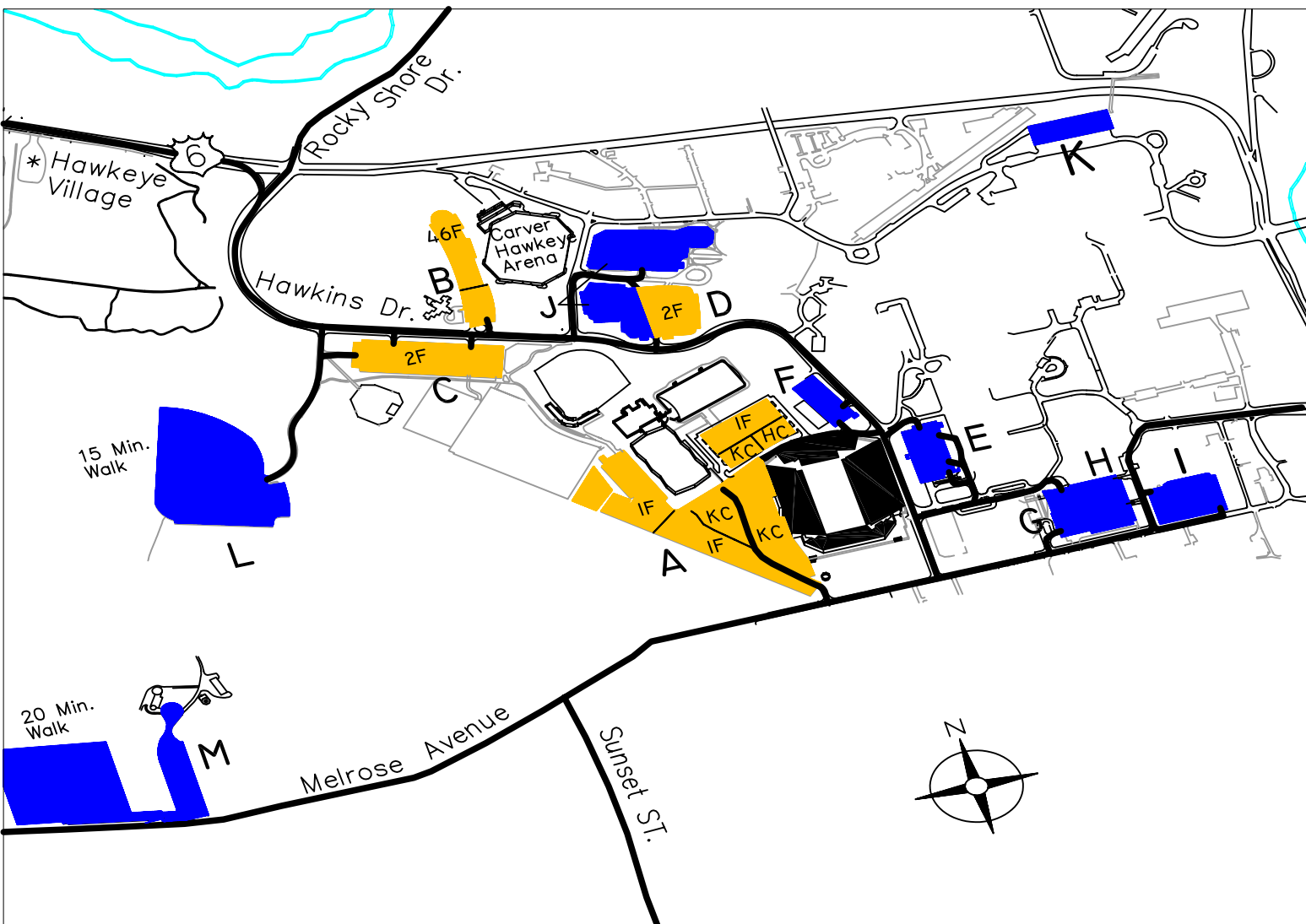
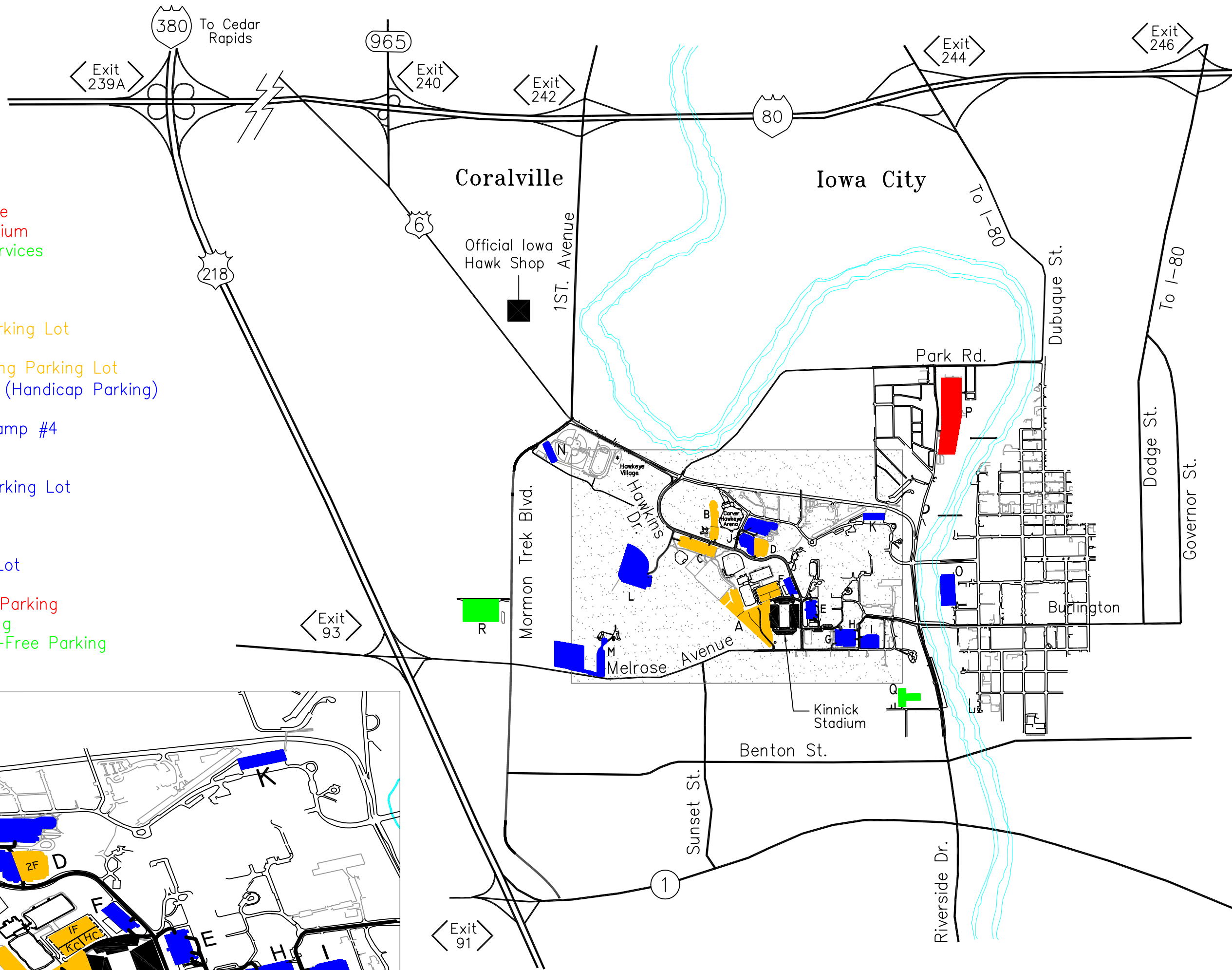




PARKING AREA KEY
