Assistant Football Coach – 3 positions (including Offensive Coordinator)

The University of Iowa Athletics Department seeks applications for the position of Football Assistant Coach. This is a full-time, 12-month position and includes full University benefits.

Responsibilities: NCAA Countable Assistant Coach-Position coaching responsibilities TBD. Recruiting-including determining eligibility of prospective student-athletes and coordinating on-campus visits, assist in development of game plan for each opponent, assist in the development of playbook materials, handle personal counseling needs of players directly supervised, public speaking and promotion, other duties as assigned by head coach.

Qualifications: Bachelor's degree (or international equivalent) required. **Other required qualifications:** Excellent technical and tactical knowledge of the sport of football. Ability to recruit national caliber student-athletes. Demonstrated knowledge of the NCAA rules and a commitment to adhere to all rules and regulations of the University of Iowa, the Big Ten Conference and the NCAA. Demonstrated experience working effectively in a diverse environment. Excellent written and verbal communication skills, computer software knowledge, effective organization and administrative skills.

Preferred qualifications: Five years of successful Intercollegiate or Professional Football coaching and/or NCAA FBS/NFL playing experience (or combined equivalent). Demonstrated knowledge and/or experience working with defensive or offensive strategies and/or positions. Preference will be given to candidates that most effectively meet the development and recruiting needs of the University of Iowa football program. Successful coaching experience at a B.C.S.A.Q. conference institution is highly desirable.

Salary: Commensurate with qualifications and experience.
