2002 JOHNS HOPKINS BASEBALL NCAA TOURNAMENT NOTES

Recent Results: The Blue Jays sport a 34-7 record after concluding the regular season with five wins in their last six games and 22 wins in the last 25 games. After earning the top seed in the Centennial Conference (CC) with a 16-2 CC mark, Hopkins defeated Muhlenberg in consecutive games for the team's second straight conference title and fifth overall. JHU was defeated by 27th-ranked York, 9-6, in the final game of the regular season.

The Coach: Bob Babb is in his 23rd season as head coach of the Blue Jay baseball. Babb, who is the all-time winningest men's baseball coach in JHU history, sports a 614-238-8 (.719) record. Babb became the 14th active Division III head coach with 600 wins as Hopkins defeated Franklin & Marshall, 4-1, April 6. Under Babb's guidance, the Blue Jays have captured 10 Middle Atlantic Conference Southeast League titles, seven UAA titles, five Centennial Conference Championships, and are making their 10th appearance in the NCAA Division III Tournament.

Team & Player Notes

• 30-Win Plateau: Hopkins defeated Muhlenberg, 14-3, April 27 to reach the 30-win mark for the second straight year and the eighth time in school history. JHU's 34 wins are just two shy of the school-record set by the 1998 squad, which posted a 36-4 mark. The Blue Jays also extended their streak of consecutive 25-win seasons to 11. • Babb Reaches 600 Wins: Head coach **Bob Babb** picked up his 600th and 601st career victories as JHU swept a doubleheader against Franklin & Marshall April 6. He became the 14th active Division III head coach to win 600 games and currently sports a 614-238-8 (.719) career record in 23 seasons at Hopkins. Babb's milestone victories:

• Strength in Numbers: A strength for Hopkins all season has been its depth. In all, 25 players have seen action in the field and another 12 have taken the mound.

For the season, 23 players have scored a run, 22 have recorded a hit, and 21 have driven in at least one run. Fifteen players have driven in 10 or more runs, while 13 players have scored 10 or more runs. Eight pitchers have started at least two games, while 11 pitchers have seen action in six or more games.

• Power Surge: Sophomore **Sven Stafford** belted two home runs, his fourth and fifth of the year, in the season finale against York to give Hopkins a school-record 57 in 41 games. The Blue Jays averaged 1.39 home runs per game to shatter the school-record of 45 set during the 1998 season. Eighteen players have hit a home run and 11 have smashed three or more round-trippers. **Ben Taylor** leads the team with six homers, while **Stafford**, **Joe Urban**, **Jay Cieri**, and **Carl Ippolito** have each belted five home runs.

• Scoring in Bunches: The Blue Jays have scored 388 runs in 41 games for an average of 9.46 runs per game. Hopkins has scored 10 or more runs in 16 games and scored four or more runs in an inning 25 times. JHU scored a season-high 27 runs against Robert Morris, the most since a 30-0 win over Dickinson in 1987, and also scored 20 or more runs versus Dickinson (20-2) and Gettysburg (22-4). Last season, the Blue Jays averaged 7.02 runs per game for a total of 330 runs.

• Centennial Champions: After posting a 16-2 Centennial record and earning the top seed in the conference tournament, the Blue Jays defeated Muhlenberg twice for JHU's second straight CC Championship and fifth overall. Hopkins also won the Centennial during the 1994, 1997, 1998, and 2001 seasons. Overall, JHU sports a 125-36 (.776) all-time record in Centennial Conference games to rank first in the league. • Home Sweet Home: JHU finished the regular season with an 18-3 record at home, including a 10-0 mark against Centennial Conference teams. The Blue Jays went 12-2 at home last year. Over the last five seasons, Hopkins has posted a 64-16 (.800) when playing at home.

• Sineath Swipes Records: Senior second baseman **Karl Sineath** led Hopkins with 42 runs scored and 18 stolen bases during the regular season to become JHU's all-time leader in both categories. Sineath scored three runs against Gettysburg April 24 to break the previous mark of 163 held by John Christ and currently has 168 for his career. He then stole one base versus Neumann College to set the stolen base record with 96 for his career, breaking Tom Finegan's school-record of 95. Sineath is also fourth in school history with 178 career hits and needs eight hits to move into second place.

• Rosenberg Sets Strikeout Mark: With nine strikeouts against Muhlenberg April 27, senior **Yani Rosenberg** became the school's all-time strikeout leader.

breaking the mark of 241 set by Steve Hand. He currently has 259 strikeouts for his career, just the third player in JHU history to strikeout over 200 hitters, and has posted three of the top eight single-season strikeout totals in school history. This season, Rosenberg has totaled 71 strikeouts in 64 innings en route to a 9-0 record and a 0.84 ERA. He has won his last 17 decisions dating back to last year and is currently second at Hopkins with 28 career wins. Rosenberg's 17-game winning streak is the second longest in school history behind Scott Orlovsky, who won 19 straight decisions during the 1997 and 1998 seasons. He also ranks second at JHU in career winning percentage (.903, 28-3).

• Setty Sets Career-High for Wins: With five strong innings against Neumann April 29, senior **Jason Setty** improved to 6-0 on the year and 18-2 (.900) for his career. He allowed just one run on four hits while striking out five batters. Setty's six wins are a career-high and he has totaled a career-high 23 strikeouts against just five walks.

• Taylor Reaches 100, Twice: Senior **Ben Taylor** has totaled 27 RBIs and a career-high 39 runs scored this season to pass the 100-mark in both categories for his career. He is the 10th player in school history to total over 100 career runs and RBIs and currently has 104 runs and 106 RBIs for his career. Taylor leads the team with six home runs and ranks eighth at Hopkins with 16 career round-trippers.

• Catching Duo Excels At/Behind Plate: After batting a combined .209 (26-for-124) during the 2001 season, the catching duo of senior **Tom Prevas** and sophomore **Doug Hitchner** has posted a major turnaround this season. Prevas is currently batting .339 (19-for-56) and Hitchner has hit .387 (24-for-62) for a combined average of .364 (43-for-118). The two have also combined for just one error in 247 total chances.

• Ippolito & Cetta Have Breakout Years: Sophomores **Carl Ippolito** and **Craig Cetta** have been two of JHU's top players all year long. Ippolito started the year with a bang as he batted .442 (19-for-43) in his first 11 games with 16 runs and 17 runs batted in. He continued to play well and led the team with 11 multiple-RBI games and added 10 multi-hit games. Ippolito finished second on the team in hits (40) and runs batted in (34), third in runs scored (36), while adding eight doubles and five home runs.

Cetta led the club with 39 RBIs and 44 hits, while placing sixth on the team with 29 runs scored. He also added nine doubles, four home runs, and nine stolen bases. Cetta was tops on the team with 12 multiple-hit games and second with 10 multiple-RBI contests.

• Urban Having Another Solid Season: Junior **Joe Urban**, in his second year as a starter, is having another solid campaign in right field. He is hitting .376 (38-for-101), is third on the team in RBIs (30), fourth in runs (35), and has added eight doubles and five home runs. Last season, Urban led the team with a .384 average while adding 29 runs, 35 runs batted in, and seven home runs. He is a .375 hitter for his career and boasts a career slugging percentage of .616.

• Several Players Key to JHU's Depth: A number of players combined to give Hopkins quality depth and solid production throughout the season. Freshman **Mike Durgala**, who made 18 starts at third base and as the designated hitter, led the Blue Jays in hitting for most of the season before finishing second on the team with a .412

average. He also added 15 runs, four home runs, and 21 runs batted in. Sophomore **Brian Morley** hit .388 (19-for-49) with 14 runs, four home runs, and 13 RBIs, while sophomore **Sven Stafford** belted five home runs and added 15 RBIs.

Sophomore **Tim Casale** made 14 starts in the infield and totaled 21 runs and 10 RBIs, while placing second on the team with 10 stolen bases. Sophomore **Rob Morrison** batted .295 (18-for-61) with 24 runs scored, three home runs, nine runs batted in, and three stolen bases.

• All-Centennial Team: Eight Blue Jays were honored as the Centennial Conference (CC) released the 2002 All-Centennial Conference baseball teams. Senior **Yani Rosenberg** highlighted the group as he was named the CC Pitcher of the Year for the second consecutive season. The Blue Jays, winners of their fifth Centennial Conference Championship, placed four players on the first team, two on the second team, and two were named honorable mention.

Rosenberg became the fourth JHU pitcher to win Pitcher of the Year honors in the Centennial Conference in the last six seasons. The last four Centennial Pitchers of the Year have won back-to-back awards, including former Hopkins pitcher Scott Orlovsky in 1997 and 1998. Rosenberg finished the regular season with a team-leading 9-0 record and a career-best 0.84 ERA. He led the team in starts (9), complete games (4), innings pitched (64.0), and strikeouts (71). In addition, Rosenberg allowed just 37 hits and 11 walks, while holding opponents to a .163 batting average.

Joining Rosenberg on the first team were seniors **Karl Sineath** and **Mike DePalma**, and sophomore **Carl Ippolito**. Sineath earned first team honors for the second straight season after earning second team honors his sophomore season. He led the club and tied his career-high with 42 runs scored, while also leading the team with 18 stolen bases. In the process, Sineath became JHU's all-time leader in runs scored with 168 and stolen bases with 96.

DePalma earned Centennial honors for the third time in his career after being named to the second team in 2000 and honorable mention last year. Despite missing some time due to injury, DePalma led the team in batting (.442) and totaled 34 hits and 26 runs scored. He added 17 runs batted in and reached the 90-run mark for his career. Ippolito, in his first year as a starter, excelled at shortstop as he batted .351 and was second on the team with 40 hits in 114 at-bats. He also led the squad in triples (3), was second with 34 RBIs, third in runs scored (36), and added eight doubles and five home runs.

Sophomore **Craig Cetta** and junior **Jay Cieri** both

earned Centennial honors for the first time as they were named to the second team. Cetta batted .367 and led the team with 44 hits, 39 runs batted in, and nine doubles. He also finished sixth on the team with 29 runs scored and added four home runs and nine stolen bases. Cieri batted .363 and was fifth on the team in runs scored (34) and RBIs (23). He added a team-leading 29 walks, led the club with a .516 on-base percentage, and added nine doubles and five home runs.

Senior **John Krivonak** and sophomore **Doug Hitchner** were each named honorable mention following productive seasons. Krivonak totaled career-highs in batting average (.363), hits (33), and runs batted in (19). He added 17 runs, six doubles, and posted a .474 on-base percentage. Hitchner was fourth on team in batting (.387) and tied for sixth in runs batted in (21). He also totaled four home runs, two doubles, and did not commit an error in 96 chances behind the plate.

The Blue Jays, 125-36 (.776) all-time in Centennial Conference games, have had 30 first-team All-Centennial selections over the last nine seasons, including eight in the last two years.

• **Blue Jay Quick Notes:**

~ Since the start of the 1990 season, Hopkins has posted a 374-142-1 (.724) record. Entering the season, the Blue Jays ranked 17th in Division III for the most wins since 1990, and 14th in winning percentage.

~ JHU sports a 125-36 (.776) all-time record in Centennial Conference games to rank first in the league.

~ Hopkins is hitting .346 (192-for-555) with runners in scoring position and .432 (19-for-44) with the bases loaded. ~ JHU has scored 124 runs with two outs compared to 54 for the opponents. Sophomore **Craig Cetta** leads the club with 15 two-out RBIs, while senior **Ben Taylor** and sophomore **Doug Hitchner** have both totaled 11 two-out RBIs and junior **Jay Cieri** has added 10.

~ During his current team-high five-game hitting streak, **Mike DePalma** has batted .578 (11-for-19) with eight runs and four RBIs. DePalma has raised his average to a team-best .442 and has totaled three or more hits in five games this year. He has 91 career runs and needs just five RBIs to reach 90 for his career.

~ **Craig Cetta** has over half of his team-leading 44 hits with runners in scoring position. He is 6-for-6 with the bases loaded and is batting .418 (23-for-55) with runners in scoring position. He led the team with 22 hits and 21 RBIs in Centennial games.

~ The Blue Jays have outscored opponents in every inning, with the largest margins in the first (67-19), third (69-26), and sixth (75-28) innings. Hopkins has outscored opponents 388-to-174 for the season, or an average of 5.22 runs per game.

~ In 20.1 career innings pitched, sophomore **Sven Stafford** has allowed just two earned runs and nine hits

while striking out 20. This season, Stafford boasts a 0.59 ERA in 15.1 innings and has added five home runs and 15 RBIs in just 41 at-bats.

~ Senior **John Krivonak** is batting a career-best .363 with a career-high 33 hits and 19 runs batted in. Krivonak has nine multiple-hit games and is fourth on the team in on-base percentage (.474).

~ With eight hits in his last 10 at-bats, freshman **Paul Winterling** raised his average to .378 (14-for-37). He has also scored four runs and added six RBIs over his last six games.

~ JHU has tied the school-record for being hit by a pitch as Blue Jay batters have been plunked 44 times. **John Krivonak** has been hit a team-high 10 times, while **Ben Taylor** has been hit six times.

~ Blue Jay pitchers have combined for 272 strikeouts in 330 innings and need 18 strikeouts to tie the school-record of 290 set last season in 373.2 innings. JHU pitchers have just 13 less strikeouts (272) than hits allowed (285). Pitchers who have totaled more strikeouts than hits allowed:

~ The Blue Jays have failed to score in double digits in the last five games, which is the longest drought of the season. JHU has scored 24 runs in the last five games for an average of 4.8, yet has held opponents to 16 runs or 3.2 per game.

~ Hopkins is 10-1 in games decided by two runs or less and 20-2 in games decided by five runs or more. The Blue Jays have won 13 games by eight runs or more. JHU was 4-0 in Centennial games decided by two runs or less and 6-0 against conference competition in contests decided by more than eight runs. Games decided by two runs or less:

REGIONAL OPPONENTS

• #2 *Kean University (33-10)*: Kean, winners of the 2002 New Jersey Athletic Conference (NJAC) Championship for the first-time in school history, is making just the third appearance in the tournament since first appearing in 1988. The Cougars also earned a bid in 1998 and have gone 0-4 in two previous trips to the regionals. JHU and Kean met three times from 1997 through 1999 with the Cougars winning all three meetings.

• #3 *DeSales University (30-8)*: The Bulldogs are making their third straight appearance in the NCAA Tournament and their fifth trip in the last six years after winning the Middle Atlantic Corporation. DeSales tied the school single-season record with 30 wins this season. The Bulldogs sport a 3-8 overall record in five previous trips to the NCAA Tournament. DeSales defeated JHU 12-2 in the only meeting between the schools in 1998.

• #4 *Worcester State College (33-7)*: Worcester State, winner of the Massachusetts State College Athletic Conference, first appeared in the NCAA Tournament in 1983 and went 0-2 in the regionals that year. Hopkins has not faced Worcester State.

• #5 *Alvernia College (33-8)*: Alvernia, the winner of the Pennsylvania Athletic Conference, is making its second appearance in the tournament after first appearing in 1995. The Crusaders are 33-8 on the year and have an 0-2 mark in the NCAA tournament. The Blue Jays defeated Alvernia, 7-1, in the only meeting between the schools during the 1997 season.

• #6 *College of New Jersey (30-12)*: TCNJ is making its 14th appearance in the NCAA Division III Championships and has compiled a 29-25 mark in 13 previous appearances. TCNJ's last appearance in the NCAA tournament was in 2000 after the Lions won the NJAC tournament and earned an automatic bid to the tournament. That year, the Lions finished as the Mid-Atlantic Regional Runner-up to Montclair State University after falling to 5-3 in the finals. The Lions and Blue Jays have played eight times with TCNJ holding a 5-3 advantage in the series.



The winners of the eight regionals will advance to the 2002 Division III College Baseball World Series beginning on Friday, May 24.
