He has served as a teaching assistant for two courses in the W.P. Carey Entrepreneurship and Management Department. He has completed an internship with the Cordish Company, a commercial real estate development. He served in a support role for the executive management team, maintained the web site for the company's multi-billion dollar Ballpark Village development and specialized in a development role within the "Entertainment Concept Investors" program. In 2007 he was named Third Team ESPN The Magazine Academic All-American.

Michael Corbolotti – Cornell University



Cornell midfielder Michael Corbolotti has demonstrated a genuine commitment to community service and has been a leader in his team's off-the-field efforts. He is the Co-President of the 21 Run, a 5K walk/run organized each year by the members of the Cornell men's lacrosse team to benefit the Family Reading Partnership of Ithaca. Each year, the 21 Run raises approximately \$10,000 to help fight illiteracy in the local community. During the fall, Michael was heavily involved in helping to plan the Save the Day Lacrosse Tournament. The single-day event generated over \$2,000 dollars for the Dream Factory of Central New York, as they continue in their mission to grant the wishes of critically and chronically ill children. Michael has also participated in "Americans Helping Americans," a program designed to send care packages and letters to military personnel serving in Iraq.
