- Johns Hopkins and Duke have met 14 times in a series that dates to a 22-0 Hopkins victory in 1942. The Blue Jays lead the all-time series 11-3 after the teams split a pair of games last season.
- The teams met seven times between 1942 and 1951, but then didn't meet again until Duke knocked off Hopkins, 12-11, in overtime in the 1997 NCAA Quarterfinals.
- The regular-season series resumed in 2003 and the Blue Jays won all four meetings before Duke prevailed, 11-9, last season.
- The last five games between Johns Hopkins and Duke have been decided by a total of six goals with four of the five being decided by just one goal.
- Johns Hopkins and Duke have met three times in the NCAA Tournament and all three have been decided by one goal. Duke defeated JHU, 12-11, in overtime in the 1997 NCAA Quarterfinals and the Blue Jays slipped past Duke in the 2005 (9-8) and 2007 (12-11) NCAA title games.
