- Johns Hopkins leads the all-time series, 55-25-1. The 81 games the Blue Jays have played against Navy are the second most in JHU history (Maryland / 104).
- Despite the long history between the two programs, this will be the first-ever meeting between the two schools in the NCAA Tournament.
- Johns Hopkins has currently won 34 straight games against the Midshipmen. This is the longest winning streak for Johns Hopkins over any opponent in its history.
- Johns Hopkins has won 19 straight games against Navy at Homewood Field. Ironically, prior to the current run the Blue Jays had won just once against Navy in the previous six meetings at Homewood Field (covering a span from 1959 through 1969).
- In the last 15 meetings there have been five blowouts and eight one-goal affairs. JHU has won by seven or more goals five times since 1994, while picking up eight, one-goal wins (1994, 1998, 2000, 2002, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007) during that time as well.
- Johns Hopkins has held Navy to less than 10 goals in 21 of the last 29 meetings. Included is a streak of seven straight games in which the Midshipmen have scored nine goals or less against JHU.
- The teams have met eight times with both teams have been ranked in the top five at the time of the game (rankings first available in 1973). The 2004 matchup was the first that featured the top two ranked teams in the nation.
- The 2004 game between the two teams at Navy may have been the game-of-the-year as the Blue Jays erased a 9-7 deficit in the last five minutes and won, 10-9, in overtime. The crowd of 18,694 that day ranks as the fourth-largest regular season crowd in college lacrosse history.
- Johns Hopkins is 12-0 all-time against Navy when entering the game ranked number one in the nation.
- Both teams have been ranked in the top 10 in the nation at the time of the game 23 times since 1973 (including this year's game).
