- Johns Hopkins and Syracuse are meeting for the 45th time with Johns Hopkins holding a 26-17-1 advantage. Johns Hopkins has won five of the last seven and seven of the last 10 in the series.
- One-goal games have been the norm in the series of late. Five of the last 10, six of the last 12 and nine of the last 17 have been decided by one goal. Syracuse has won five of the last nine one-goal games.
- Six of the last seven meetings at the Carrier Dome have all been decided by one goal.
- 11 of the last 17 games between JHU and SU have been decided by two goals or less.
- The teams have met 11 times in the NCAA Tournament with Syracuse winning seven of the 11.
- One of the two teams has been ranked number one in the nation 17 times since the meeting in the 1983 NCAA title game.
- Johns Hopkins is 5-2 all-time against Syracuse when entering the game as the top-ranked or top-seeded team in the nation. SU has never beaten JHU during the regular season when the Blue Jays have been ranked number one.
- Johns Hopkins and Syracuse met in the NCAA Tournament seven times between 1980 and 1992 with SU winning 4-of-7. The teams didn't meet again in the NCAAs until 2000 but have met four times since 2000 and three times since 2003 in the NCAA Tournament.
- Since 1980, there have been 19 instances where both teams entered the game ranked in the top five in the nation (including this week's game). Nine meetings during that time have seen both teams ranked in the top three.
