HEAD COACH KIT GROVE enters his fifth season as head golf coach at Kansas. As a student-athlete, Grove played three years for the Jayhawks (1995-97). During his first season with KU, Grove competed in both the NCAA Central Regional and the NCAA Championship. He was a volunteer student assistant coach for the Jayhawks during the 1997-98 season. After graduating from the University of Kansas, Grove traveled the world as a professional player and golf instructor. After a quick stop in Bend, Ore., as an instructor at a local course, Grove settled in Phoenix, Ariz., at the 500 Golf Club where he served as both an instructor and assistant golf professional. In 2001, Grove began his professional career on the Arizona Professional Tour prior to dabbling on the DP Tour in Atlanta, Ga. In 2002, Grove took his game to the international level when he traveled to South Africa to compete on the Sunshine Tour. He spent one year on the Sunshine Tour before coming back to the U.S. to compete on the Grey Goose Gateway Tour. Grove competed on this tour for four years prior to coming to Kansas.



BRIAN McCANTS joined the Kansas men's golf program as an assistant coach Sept. 21, 2011, after six successful seasons as the head men's golf coach at Newberry College where he led the Wolves to three South Atlantic Conference Championships and claimed the South Atlantic Conference Coach of the Year honor four-straight years.

Among other duties, McCants helps organize and run practices, recruits, and monitors and updates the recruiting database for the Kansas men's golf team. Prior to KU, McCants spent seven years on the men's golf coaching staff at Newberry College in Newberry, S.C., serving as the head coach for the final six. During that time, McCants guided Newberry to the NCAA Division II National Championship quarterfinals in 2011, making Newberry College the first South Atlantic Conference team in history to qualify for the NCAA Division II Men's Golf National Championship twice after they also made it in 2008.



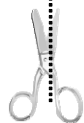

ELIGIBLE CAMPERS

Jayhawk Golf Camp is open to all boys ages 10-18. Camps are limited to 50 campers and admittance will be on a first-come, first-serve basis.

GROUP DISCOUNTS

For groups of 4-6 campers, there is a discount of \$25 per person. For groups of 7-9, the discount is \$50 per person. And for groups of 10 or more campers, the discount is \$100 per person. If you plan to form a group, please notify Coach Brian McCants by e-mail (bmccants@ku.edu) with the names of all campers in the group.

WHERE

The camp will be held at Alvamar Golf Club (www.alvamar.com) in Lawrence, KS. We will also utilize the Knapheide Practice Facility that is equipped with V1 multi-camera video system and a Trackman Dopplar Radar System. LODGING

All campers will be housed at Naismith Hall (www.livenaismith.com). Breakfast and dinner will be served at the dorm and lunch will be served at Alvamar.

REGISTRATION

Registration will be from 3-5 p.m. at Naismith Hall on the first day of the camp.

TYPES OF INSTRUCTION

Campers are placed in groups based on ability level. Instruction encompasses full swing, pitching, chipping, putting, bunker play, and basic rules/etiquette of the game of golf.

FIRST AID

An athletic trainer is on duty to administer to all minor injuries and illness and to monitor hydration.

INSURANCE AND MEDICAL

A medical form and an insurance form will be sent to you with confirmation of your acceptance. [These forms must be completed and signed by a parent and a physician prior to the start of camp.](#) We make every effort to protect the health and safety of all campers.

AIRPORT SHUTTLE

A shuttle from the Kansas City Airport (MCI) is available for a \$25 fee.

DEPOSIT

A \$250 non-refundable deposit (applied to camp fee) must accompany each application. The remaining balance, if any, will be due May 15, 2012. Upon receipt of application and deposit, a confirmation packet with all necessary forms will be sent via e-mail. Any application received after May 15, 2012 must include full payment.

WHAT TO BRING

Campers should bring proper golf attire (no jeans, cut-offs, or tank tops), golf clubs, golf balls, golf glove, golf/tennis shoes (golf shoes must have soft spikes), sunblock, hat/visor, water bottle, umbrella, bed linens (long twin sheets), blanket/sleeping bag, pillow, towel, toiletries, alarm clock, swim suit, and spending money (\$25-\$50 should be sufficient).

ACTIVITIES

- Daily instruction sessions;
- Bowling and Arcade nights;
- Evening question and answer sessions with the instructors;
- Final day tournament and skills, with trophies and prizes.
