Entry Information

This meet is open to all athletes, including high school athletes and younger, club teams and open runners. Please complete entries online at www.directathletics.com by 12 Noon (CST) on Thursday, January 17. Entry fee is \$10 per athlete. Please direct all online entry questions to support@directathletics.com. A final entry list will be posted on www.kuathletics.com by 5pm (CST) January 16th. There are no entry standards, so please be honest with seed marks so that flights and sections can be put together fairly. Prelims will be run in the 60m dash and the 60m hurdles only. The top 8 preliminary times will make the final. All other events are timed section finals. Please make entry fee checks payable to "Jayhawk Track." Entry fees must be paid at the time of packet pickup. Club entries are welcome, as are individual and unattached athletes.

Packet Pick up

Packet pick up begins at 11am on Sunday, January 27th at the meet headquarters area, which is by the starting line on the West side of the track.

Check In

Track Athletes must check in with the clerk of the course at the starting line of their event 20 minutes prior to their event. Each Field event area will have its own Head Official. Field event athletes will need to check in with the head official of their event, at the event area, 20 minutes prior to the start of their event. Weigh-in for the shot put is two hours before the competition at the competition site.

Results

Rules

NFHS rules will be used unless otherwise noted. This is not a NFHS sanctioned event; you may not compete in high school uniform or under your high school's name. Please do not use spikes longer than ¼ inch. Boys will throw the 12lb shot and girls will use the 4kg shot. Athletes will throw from a 40 degree sector. Pole vault weight verification forms are required for all vaulters.

Awards

Jayhawk medals will be awarded to the top three finishers in each event. Awards can be picked up at the meet information table near the finish line on the West side of the Track.
