ENROLLMENT: Upon receipt of your deposit, a confirmation letter concerning registration times, locations, suggested clothing and equipment needed, and general camp information will be sent to you.

RULES: This camp is an extension of the University of Kansas baseball program and all campers are a part of this image. Anyone not meeting the standards of our program is subject to dismissal from camp. These rules apply to all camp sessions and include any activities in the dormitory.

INSURANCE AND MEDICAL CARE: A member of the KU Sports Medicine staff will be on hand to care for any first-aid situations or administer any needed treatments. Each camper will be covered by a secondary group accident insurance policy for any cost not covered by the family's insurance. The term of the secondary insurance benefits runs for only 52 weeks from the date of injury.

FACILITIES: Hoglund Ballpark and the Anschutz Pavilion provide a wealth of facilities to allow for a full schedule of camp activities, rain or shine.

REFUND POLICY: Any refund request must be received in writing seven (7) days prior to the first day of the scheduled camp session. All cancellations, including those related to injury, will have an administrative fee of \$25.00. No refunds will be made for camps already in session.

ADA: Any individual needing reasonable ADA accommodations should contact the camp office 60 days in advance of the camp session.

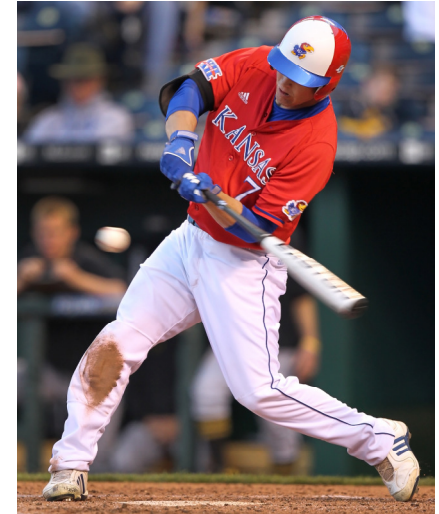

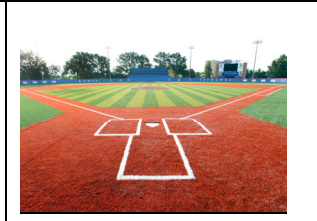
Ages 9-12

Ritch Price

Head Coach, University of Kansas 10th Year

Ritch Price has enjoyed a very successful ten seasons as the head coach at the University of Kansas. One accomplishment of note is the seven 30-win seasons recorded during Price's regime. While the Jayhawks have qualified for five Big 12 Tournaments during Price's tenure, they won the championship in 2006. 2009 marked the 2nd NCAA appearance in four years for the Jayhawks. During the summer of 2008, Price served on the coaching staff of the USA Collegiate Team which won the gold medal in the FISU World Championship. Price's teams are recognized by their enthusiastic play, steady defense and winning attitude

Phil Thompson

Assistant Coach, University of Kansas 2nd Year

In his second season as an assistant coach for the Jayhawks, Thompson has been serving as camp director since January 2010. No stranger to Price's system, Thompson played for Coaches Price and Graves at Cal-Poly from 2000-2001. After college, Thompson continued his career in the Independent League playing for 4 years. During the summers of 2006 and 2007, he served as hitting coach for the San Diego Waves in the summer collegiate league, while serving as manager in 2008.

Ryan Graves

Assistant Coach, University of Kansas 10th Year

Graves is serving his seventh season as pitching coach. He coached Don Cxyz, 2006 NCBWA Stopper of the Year and 1st Team All-American. Coach Graves came to KU after serving as the pitching coach for Coach Price at Cal Poly the previous three years. Ryan played his collegiate baseball at Oklahoma State and Loyola Marymount University. His 1996 Oklahoma State team advanced to the College World Series. Ryan finished his playing career in the Chicago Cubs organization.

Ritchie Price, Jr.

Assistant Coach, University of Kansas 1st Year

Price was a member of the Jayhawk team from 2003-2006. Holding many offensive records, he also was a vital member of the 2006 Big 12 Championship and 2006 NCAA Regional team. After graduating from KU and playing 2 season of professional baseball, Price served at South Dakota State University, as assistant coach for one season, and head coach for three seasons. His teams competed consistently at the top of the Summit League.
