QUICKLY -- Kansas (0-0 overall, 0-0 Big 12) will open its 121st season of college football when it hosts North Dakota State on Saturday, Sept. 4 at 6 p.m. The game will be televised on Fox College Sports.

- Kansas is opening its season at home for the eighth-straight year (6-1 in last seven home openers).
- The Jayhawks have won six straight season openers since falling at home to Northwestern to start the 2003 campaign.
- KU has outscored its opponents by an average of 40.1 to 10.0 in the last six season openers.
- KU has won 20 straight non-conference home games since losing to Northwestern to start the 2003 season.
- KU is 18-3 in its last 21 home games, but lost its last two home games against Oklahoma and Nebraska last year.
- KU is 20-2 in its last 22 games against non-Big 12 opponents, including bowl victories against Houston (2005), Virginia Tech (2007 season) and Minnesota (2008).
- KU is 3-0 all-time in games played on Sept. 4 with victories against Oregon State (1976), Western Carolina (1993) and Tulsa (2004).
- KU has won 20 straight home night games.

FIRST GAME FOR NEW COACH -- First-year head coach Turner Gill is making his Kansas coaching debut Saturday. Only one of the last seven KU head coaches won their first game (Terry Allen beat UAB in 1997) and only one in the last seven has produced a winning season in their first year (Bud Moore was 7-5 in 1975). Here is a look at how recent KU coaches have fared in their first games and seasons:

That group includes linemen Tanner Hawkinson, Sal Capra, Trevor Marrongelli and Brad Thorson, as well as TE Tim Biere, WR Johnathan Wilson, DE Jake Laptad, LB Drew Dudley and CB Chris Harris. In addition, both PK Jacob Branstetter and P Alonso Rojas were starters in last year's finale.

DID YOU KNOW? -- Both KU head coach Turner Gill and offensive coordinator Chuck Long were Heisman Trophy finalists during their playing days. Gill was fourth in the 1983 balloting behind teammate and winner Mike Rozier, runner-up Steve Young and third-place finisher Doug Flutie. Long was the runner-up to Bo Jackson in 1985. Both later coached Heisman Trophy winners and finalists (Gill coached 1995 runner-up Tommie Frazier and 2001 winner Eric Crouch, while Long mentored 2000 runner-up Josh Heupel and 2003 winner and 2004 finalist Jason White).

DID YOU KNOW? -- The 10 full-time coaches at Kansas have a combined 187 seasons of coaching experience with 77 bowl appearances.

Head Coach Turner Gill

Turner Gill (North Texas, 1990) is in his first year as the head coach at Kansas after being hired on Dec. 13, 2009. Gill came to Lawrence after spending the previous four seasons as the head coach at Buffalo (2006-09) where he turned a down program into a conference champion in his third year. Gill was a highly successful player and assistant coach at Nebraska for a combined 18 seasons before spending one year with the Green Bay Packers and then taking over at Buffalo.

GILL HIGHLIGHTS

At Buffalo (Head Coach)

- * Coached Buffalo to its first winning record in 12 years with an 8-6 record in his third season at the school in 2008.
- * Produced 13 wins combined in 2007 (5-7) and 2008 (8-6) for a program which had won just 12 games in the previous eight seasons combined.
- * Led Buffalo to consecutive Mid-American Conference East Division titles with a share in 2007 and an outright title in 2008.
- * Buffalo won its first MAC Championship in school history and advanced to its first bowl game ever, playing in the International Bowl to conclude the 2008 season.
- * Named 2008 MAC Coach of the Year by *The Sporting News*.
- * Was a finalist for the Bear Bryant National College Football Coach of the Year in 2008.
- * Had eight players named all-MAC in 2008 after Buffalo had just seven players named in the first eight years the program was in the conference.
- * In 2008 produced Buffalo's first home field winning record since moving up to the FBS level ahead of the 1999 season.
- * Coached individual school record holders for passing, rushing and receiving yards.
- * Buffalo scored a school-record 424 points and threw for another school mark 3,326 yards in 2008 with Gill handling the play calling.

At Nebraska (Coach)

- * On coaching staff of three national championship teams at Nebraska in 1994, 1995 and 1997.
- * Was the position coach for Heisman winner quarterback Eric Crouch (2001) and Johnny Unitas Golden Arm Award winner and Heisman runner-up Tommie Frazier (1995).

At Nebraska (Player)

- * Named Big Eight Conference All-Decade Team Quarterback for the 1980s and was inducted into the Nebraska Football Hall of Fame and the Orange Bowl Hall of Fame.
- * Was a three-time All-Big Eight Conference honoree, an All-America second-team selection and a Heisman Trophy finalist.
- * Nebraska posted a 28-2 record with Gill as the starting quarterback, including a perfect 20-0 mark in conference games.
- * Led Nebraska to three straight Orange Bowls.
- * Played one season of baseball at Nebraska and earned all-Big Eight conference honors.
- * Spent three seasons playing minor league baseball before getting into coaching football at the college level.

This Week's Game

KU-NDSU SERIES -- Kansas and North Dakota State will be meeting for the first time on the football field. Kansas is 9-0 all-time against current members of the Missouri Valley Football Conference. The Jayhawks are 3-0 vs. Southern Illinois, 2-0 vs. Indiana State and Missouri State and 1-0 vs. Illinois State and South Dakota State. The last time KU played a MVC football team was its 44-24 victory against Missouri State in 2002.

KU-NDSU CONNECTIONS -- KU head coach Turner Gill and NDSU head coach Craig Bohl both played college football at Nebraska as Bohl was a defensive back from 1977-79 and Gill was a quarterback from 1980-83... NDSU DB coach Brian Ward spent the last three seasons as the head coach at his alma mater of McPherson (Kan.) College... Kansas backup QB Quinn Mecham and NDSU LB Chad Wilson were teammates at Snow (Utah) Junior College the last two seasons... KU secondary football contact Mike Cummings is from Fargo, N.D.

THINGS TO LOOK FOR AGAINST NORTH DAKOTA STATE:

- CB Chris Harris is expected to make his team-best 30th career start.
- Four players expected to start Saturday who started all 12 games a year ago and have current 12-game consecutive start streaks include CB Chris Harris, and offensive linemen Tanner Hawkinson, Brad Thorson and Sal Capra.
- OL Jeremiah Hatch owns the team's longest consecutive start streak at 24 games, but he is listed as the backup offensive center heading into game week.
- RB Angus Quigley should get his first rushing attempts since 2008 when he ran 59 times for 309 yards (he was moved to linebacker in 2009).
- PK Jacob Branstetter has made five of his last six field goal attempts, including five straight inside 50 yards (missed a 50-yarder at Texas in the 11th game of 2009).
- QB Kale Pick should attempt his first pass since going one of two for six yards at Texas Tech in the eighth game of 2009.
- WR Johnathan Wilson (81 receptions for 1,074 yards in his career) needs six catches to tie for 19th on the KU career receptions list (87 by Bob Johnson and John Mosier) and 155 yards to tie for 20th on the KU career receiving yards list (1,229 by Clark Green).

STARTING QUARTERBACK DEBUT -- Sophomore Kale Pick is expected to make his starting debut at the quarterback position Saturday. It will mark the first time someone other than Todd Reesing has taken the first snap in a game since Kerry Meier started the 2006 finale against Missouri (Reesing started 38 straight games in the last three years). Pick saw limited playing time in seven games in 2009, completing four of five passes for 22 yards and rushing 14 times for 167 yards. POTENTIAL FIRST-TIME STARTERS -- According to the depth chart several Jayhawks could make their first career starts Saturday. Among them are LG Duane Zlatnik, H-Back AJ Steward, FB Steven Foster, QB Kale Pick, DE Tyrone Sellers or Kevin Young or Quintin Woods, LB Steven Johnson, NB Tyler Patmon and S Olaitan Oguntodu.

POTENTIAL FRESHMEN STARTERS -- A couple of redshirt freshmen have the potential to start the season opener in either DE Tyrone Sellers or Kevin Young and/or NB Tyler Patmon.

A CLOSER LOOK AT THE DEPTH CHART -- Here are a couple of notes about the depth chart, which includes 13 offensive positions and 12 defensive positions:

- Among the 25 starters KU lists nine seniors, eight juniors, six sophomores and two freshmen.
- Of the top 50 players on the two-deep, 13 are seniors, 15 juniors, eight sophomores and 14 freshmen.
- Twenty-one of the 50 have earned at least two letters at KU, while 18 have never earned a letter.

Kansas Team Notes

LAST YEAR'S LEADERS -- Here is a look at some of last year's statistical leaders:

RUSHING - Toben Oporum (554 yards in 2009), who last year became the first freshman to lead the team in rushing since 2002, is back as a sophomore, but has been moved to linebacker. Jake Sharp (429 yards) graduated so that leaves Kale Pick (167) as the team's leading returning rusher.

PASSING - The graduated Todd Reesing threw for 3,616 yards last season and finished his KU career as the school's all-time leading passer with 11,194 yards. Current KU QB Kale Pick completed four of five attempts for 22 yards a year ago.

RECEIVING - KU lost its top two receivers in Kerry Meier (102 receptions for 985 yards in 2009) and Dezmon Briscoe (84 for 1,337) to the NFL. The duo finished their KU careers first and second on both the school's career receiving yards (Briscoe - 3,240 and Meier - 2,309) and career receptions (Meier - 226 and Briscoe - 219) lists. Johnathan Wilson pulled in 35 balls for 449 yards last year, while Bradley McDougald had 33 for 318.

TACKLES - Last year's leader, Darrell Stuckey, had 93 tackles, but is with the San Diego Chargers this year. However, Drew Dudley (88) and Chris Harris (84) are back.

POSITION CHANGES -- A number of position changes have occurred since Turner Gill took over the program. Here is a look:

OFFENSIVE NOTES -- The Kansas offense is under the direction of first-year coordinator Chuck Long... The last three seasons KU has averaged at least 400 yards of total offense per game including 479 in 2007, 432 in 2008 and 422 in 2009... KU has scored in double figures in 55 of its last 56 games... KU ranked seventh in the NCAA in passing yards per game (310) last year and 25th in total offense (422)... Kale Pick led the Jayhawks in runs of 20 or more yards last season with three (20, 32 and 55 yards) as the rest of the team combined for five such runs... Pick's 32 and 55-yard runs were the longest of the season for KU.

DEFENSIVE NOTES -- In the first two games combined of each of the last three seasons, KU has allowed a total of just 27 points (KU allowed a combined seven in the first two games of 2007, 10 in 2008 and 10 last year)... The KU defense has five players who have earned three letters in their careers in DE Jake Laptad, LBs Drew Dudley and Justin Springer and DBs Chris Harris and Phillip Strozier.

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES -- KU boasts two senior specialists in P Alonso Rojas and PK Jacob Branstetter, who have both handled their respective duties for the previous two seasons... KU is breaking in a new LS after Kayl Anderson handled both long and short snapping duties for the previous four seasons before graduating... Daymond Patterson and Bradley McDougald return as punt and kickoff returners respectively, after fielding the most of those kicks last year. They will be joined by Isiah Barfield on punt returns and D.J. Beshears on kickoff returns.

KU NOTES -- Kansas is making its third appearance on Fox College Sports Television (2008 vs. Sam Houston State and 2009 at UTEP)... KU will appear on FCS again against New Mexico State on Sept. 25... The NDSU game will mark the 16th straight TV appearance for Kansas, as well as the 24th in its last 25 games (the 2008 Nebraska game was on pay per view)... KU is not ranked in the national polls for its season opener for the first time since the 2007 season opener (No. 14 in 2008 and No. 25 last year)... As mentioned, KU has won six straight season openers... The Jayhawks are 63-50-7 all-time in season lid-lifters, including a 47-22-2 mark when the first game is at home.

KALE PICK - Saw limited playing time in seven games as a redshirt freshman in 2009... Hit four of five passes for 22 yards while rushing 14 times for 167 yards last season... Replaces Todd Reesing, who started the previous 38 games the last three years... The last QB to start at KU not named Reesing was Kerry Meier in 2006.

JORDAN WEBB - A redshirt freshman who battled Pick for the starting position this year... Threw for 3,100 yards and rushed for 1,024 more as a high school senior in 2008.

QUINN MECHAM - A junior college transfer who threw for 3,091 yards and 40 touchdowns as a sophomore at Snow (Utah) JC last year.

RUNNING BACKS

ANGUS QUIGLEY - Returned to RB after spending last year as a backup LB... Should make third career start at RB (Sam Houston State and Iowa State in 2008)... Is in his sixth year in the program having missed 2005 and 2006 due to injuries... Has rushed for 407 yards in his career (98 in 2007 and 309 in 2008)... One of KU's five team captains.

DESHAUN SANDS - Redshirt freshman was team's offensive scout player of the year in 2009... Father Tony ran for a school record 396 yards vs. Missouri in 1991 and is KU's second-leading career rusher with 3,788 yards.

BRANDON BOURBON - True freshman ran for 2,531 yards and 34 touchdowns as a prep senior, while earning Missouri 3A Player of the Year honors last season.

JAMES SIMS - True freshman ran for 1,762 yards and 20 touchdowns as prep senior and was his district's offensive player of the year in Texas.

WIDE RECEIVERS

JOHNATHAN WILSON - Enters 2010 with 81 career receptions for 1,074 yards... Had recorded at least two pass receptions in 16 consecutive games before getting shut out in last year's season finale against Missouri... Can enter KU's career top 20 in receptions (needs six) and receiving yards (needs 155 yards).

BRADLEY McDUGALD - Started six games as a true freshman in 2009 when KU went to a four wideout set on the first play... Caught at least two passes in nine of 12 games last year... Pulled in 33 receptions for 318 yards in 2009... Also saw time on special teams, leading the team with 21 kickoff returns (for 395 yards) and had three punt returns for three yards... Saw some time on defense and recorded an interception at Texas Tech.

DAYMOND PATTERSON - Has returned to wide receiver where he played the first four games of his KU career as a true freshman in 2008 (was moved to cornerback where he spent the last season and one half)... In those four contests he had 14 receptions for 154 yards and two touchdowns... Started the first six games of last year at CB and had 31 tackles and five PBU on the season.

CHRISTIAN MATTHEWS - Redshirt freshman was moved to WR in the spring after coming to KU as a QB.

ERICK McGRIFF - Redshirt freshman who is the son of former Major League Baseball standout Fred McGriff.

D.J. BESHEARS - Converted CB (started three games on defense in 2009) who was moved to WR in the spring... Only played four games last year due to injury, but recorded 17 tackles in that span, including seven against Oklahoma.

CHRIS OMIGIE - Redshirt freshman.

TIGHT ENDS/H-BACKS

TIM BIERE - Will be starting tight end for the third straight season... Is on the Mackey Award Watch List... Pulled in 14 catches for 183 yards in 10 games last year... Had four multiple-catch games last season.

BRADLEY DEDEAUX - Known for his blocking, he has three career catches, all against FIU in two separate games.

AJ STEWARD - Originally came to KU as a QB and has spent time as a backup WR/TE in his career... Has one career catch (six yards vs. Colorado in 2008).
