Fast Breaks

- Kansas will play the remainder of the 2011-12 season without leading scorer Carolyn Davis, who suffered a knee injury at Kansas State on Feb. 12.
- Senior Aishah Sutherland is recording 18.3 points and 12.7 rebounds per game over the last three contests.
- The next time Sutherland takes the floor, the senior will have cracked the program's top 10 for games played. Sutherland has currently appeared in 121 games for her career.
- Freshman Chelsea Gardner earned her first start at Iowa State Wednesday in the place of injured Carolyn Davis. She finished the game with eight points and four rebounds.
- Junior Angel Goodrich set an Allen Fieldhouse record with 16 assists versus Texas on Feb. 8.
- Goodrich has 191 assists so far in 2011-12 and needs 17 more to break the school's single-season assist record.
- The Jayhawks defeated Missouri 72-63 on Jan. 15 and will search for their second series sweep of 2011-12 Saturday. KU won both of its games versus Texas earlier this season.
- Kansas is just two wins shy of reaching its 100th all-time Big 12 regular-season win.
- Following its win versus Texas on Feb. 8, KU is 3-3 in Big 12 home games.
- Four of KU's eight losses have been by six points or less.
- KU ranks second in the Big 12 with a 46.7 field goal percentage on the season. Through games as of Feb. 13, the Jayhawks were eighth nationally.
- Kansas has held 24 of its 25 opponents to under 50 percent shooting from the field. Baylor was the only team to hit the 50-mark, recording a 50.0 field goal percentage on Jan. 28.
- The Jayhawks are ranked No. 35 in the latest NCAA ratings percentage index (RPI) report and are one of five Big 12 schools in the top 40. KU's strength of schedule ranks 28th.

About the Jayhawks

A loss at Iowa State Wednesday dropped Kansas to 17-8 overall, including 6-7 in Big 12 play ... KU is without leading scorer **Carolyn Davis**, who suffered a torn ACL at Kansas State on Feb. 12 and will miss the remainder of the 2011-12 season ... Without Davis in the lineup, **Aishah Sutherland** and **Angel Goodrich** are KU's top offensive threats averaging 13.3 and 12.5 ppg, respectively ... Sutherland, who also pulls down a team-high 9.5 rpg, has recorded 18.3 points and 12.7 rebounds per game over the last three contests ... Goodrich ranks as one of the best point guards in the country as her 7.6 apg rank in the top five nationally ... Freshman **Chelsea Gardner** got the starting nod in Davis' place Wednesday at Iowa State and finished with eight points and four rebounds ... Long and lean just like Davis, coach **Bonnie Henrickson** has said that Gardner's style of play reminds her a lot of Davis' style ... Kansas ranks in the top 10 nationally shooting 46.7 percent from the field and is third in the Big 12 scoring 69.8 ppg.

... The Tigers' last two losses, versus Texas A&M and at Oklahoma, were by four points each ... Christine Flores paces MU and ranks second in the Big 12 with 17.3 ppg while her 7.7 rpg are second only to BreAnna Brock's 8.0 rpg ... Brock adds 13.9 ppg as the only other Tiger averaging double-figure points ... Kyle Simmons guides the backcourt with 3.8 assists and 1.1 steals per game ... Morgan Eye is the team's top threat from long range as she owns a team-high 46 three-pointers on a 37.7 shooting percentage beyond the arc.

Series History

Kansas leads the rivalry, 44-37, including 21-11 in games played in Lawrence, following its 72-63 win in Columbia earlier this year. KU has won four of the last five meetings and five of the previous seven. In addition, the Jayhawks have won the last four meetings in Allen Fieldhouse.

Last Meeting with the Tigers

Forwards Aishah Sutherland and Carolyn Davis combined for 48 points as the duo powered Kansas to a 72-63 win at Missouri on Jan. 15. Sutherland tied a career-high as she poured in 24 points on 9-for-11 shooting from the field and was just shy of a double-double with a team-high nine rebounds. Davis added 24 tallies.

Junior Monica Engelman converted a shot as time expired in the first half to help KU to a 33-31 halftime lead. During the second frame, MU scored first to knot the game 33-33 but eight unanswered Kansas points gave the Jayhawks a lead they would never relinquish. The Jayhawks finished the contest 28-for-53 from the floor (52.8 percent) and took advantage of 22 trips to the foul line, where they sank 16 attempts.

A Kansas Win Would...

Give KU at least seven Big 12 wins for the first time since 1999-2000 ... Improve Kansas' record in the all-time series with MU to 45-37 ... Mark the Jayhawks' fifth-straight win over the Tigers in Lawrence ... Give Kansas its second series sweep in the last three years with Missouri ... Improve coach Bonnie Henrickson to 10-6 against Missouri, 135-116 at Kansas and 293-178 for her career ... Give Kansas a 99-154 all-time record in Big 12 play ... Make KU 732-513 all time.

A Kansas Loss Would...

Make the all-time series versus Kansas and Missouri 44-38 in favor of the Jayhawks ... Halt a four-game win streak versus the Tigers in Lawrence ... Drop KU to 13-4 at home this season, including 3-4 in Big 12 games ... Make coach Bonnie Henrickson 9-7 against Missouri, 134-117 at Kansas and 292-179 for her career ... Give Kansas a 98-155 all-time record in Big 12 play ... Make KU 731-514 all time.

Davis Suffers Season-Ending Knee Injury

Junior forward and All-America candidate Carolyn Davis will miss the remainder of the 2011-12 season after suffering a dislocated left knee and torn anterior cruciate ligament at Kansas State on Feb. 12. Named to numerous preseason award watch lists, including the Naismith, Wade Trophy and Wooden awards, Davis was Kansas' leading scorer averaging 17.5 points per game and ranked in the top five nationally with a 60.2 field goal percentage prior to the KSU contest. Through 23 games, Davis scored 20 or more points eight times and her 34 tallies in Kansas' win versus TTU on Jan. 25 are a single-game high among Big 12 players in 2011-12. Davis ranks 14th all-time at Kansas with 1,310 points in her two-plus seasons, while her 65.0 career field goal percentage is tops in Big 12 history.

Last Time Out

Senior Aishah Sutherland scored 12 of her team-high 19 points in the first half but a strong second-half push by Iowa State was too much to overcome as the Jayhawks fell 66-47. Junior Angel Goodrich was the only other Jayhawk in double figures, contributing 10 points, and dished a team-best four assists.

A 9-0 KU run helped Kansas close out the first half leading 23-21 but ISU came out of the break with a hot hand and proceeded to shoot 60.0 percent from the field in the second half, including 5-for-8 (62.5

percent) from beyond the arc. Kansas recorded a respectable 42.2 field goal percentage but the Cyclones, who were slightly better at 45.8 percent, dominated the boards holding a 38-22 rebound advantage during the contest. ISU's work on the boards helped it to 18 second-chance points.

Iowa State Leftovers

--KU led at the half by two points (23-21) for the 19th game this season, and is now 16-3 when up on its opponent after the first 20 minutes.

--Aishah Sutherland swatted a team-high four blocks to lead the Jayhawks in that category. For the season, she has four games with three or more blocks and has led the team in blocks in 15-of-25 games.

--Overall on the night, Sutherland led the Jayhawks in both points (19) and rebounds (nine), topping the categories for the fifth and 15th times this season, respectively.

--Angel Goodrich finished with double-figure points for the seventh time in the last eight games as she scored 10. She has led the team in scoring in three of the last five games.

--Chelsea Gardner made her first start in the Crimson and Blue in place of junior All-America candidate Carolyn Davis, who suffered a season-ending knee injury Sunday at Kansas State.

--Gardner scored eight points for her highest output in Big 12 Conference play. She did so in a personal-high 29 minutes of floor time.

--Natalie Knight dished out three assists, her eighth game of the season with three or more dimes in a game.

Jayhawks For a Cure

The annual Jayhawks For a Cure game has been scheduled for Saturday, Feb. 18 when Kansas welcomes rival border Missouri. One dollar for every fan in attendance will be donated to Lawrence Memorial Hospital and the KU Cancer Center. In addition, KU head coach Bonnie Henrickson will also donate \$1 for every student in attendance. Since 2008, Kansas women's basketball has raised more than \$26,000 for Jayhawks For a Cure.

Three Jayhawks Named Academic All-Big 12

Three Kansas student-athletes were named to the 2012 Academic All-Big 12 Women's Basketball Team. Junior point guard Angel Goodrich and sophomore Tania Jackson earned spots on the first team while junior Carolyn Davis grabbed a place on the second team.

Offense Goes Through Goodrich

So far this season junior Angel Goodrich has tallied 313 points. The point guard also owns 191 assists. By calculating two points for every assist, Goodrich is in turn directly responsible for a total of 695 of Kansas' points in 2011-12, which comes out to 39.8 percent of the Jayhawks' scoring.

Goodrich Breaks Fieldhouse Record

One of the best distributors in the country, Angel Goodrich had a historic night versus Texas on Feb. 8 as the point guard set an Allen Fieldhouse record, for men and women, with 16 assists. Goodrich, who dished out 10 assists in the first half alone, broke her own AFH record of 15 dimes, which she recorded on Feb. 9, 2011. The junior's handouts were also just one shy of the Big 12 record.

National Ranking

Kansas women's basketball earned its first top 25 ranking since the 2009-10 season when it came in at No. 25 in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches poll for the week of Jan. 31. The Jayhawks last appeared in the polls on Jan. 4, 2010 when they were No. 24 in the Associated Press poll.

Block Party

Senior Aishah Sutherland collected six blocks versus Texas Tech on Jan. 25 for the most rejections by a Jayhawk since Tamara Ransburg had six against Western Illinois on Dec. 7, 2002. Sutherland's mark also tied for the fourth-most blocks ever in Allen Fieldhouse. The 6-foot-3 forward has led KU in blocks 15 times in 2011-12.

Sutherland Has Historic Night on the Boards

The team's top rebounder, senior Aishah Sutherland, pulled down an incredible 22 rebounds at Oklahoma State on Jan. 18. It was the most rebounds by a Jayhawk since Tracey Claxton recorded 28 boards versus Pacific Christian on Nov. 21, 1981. Sutherland also tied the ninth-best mark in Big 12 history and had the league's most single-game rebounds since 2008.

Davis, Sutherland Reach Milestones

In the team's contest with Texas A&M on Jan. 21, Aishah Sutherland became the 24th Jayhawk in program history to amass 1,000 career points, while teammate Carolyn Davis achieved the feat earlier in the season on Nov. 27 versus FAU. The duo is also the 14th and 15th KU women's basketball players to collect 1,000 points and 500 rebounds in their careers.

Hitting the Hardwood

Since the start of conference play, KU's starting lineup has seen extended floor time as Aishah Sutherland, Angel Goodrich, Monica Engelman and Natalie Knight average more than 32 minutes per outing. Goodrich leads the group, and the Big 12, with 39.7 minutes per outing during conference games.

Goodrich Achieves Rare Feat

Only four other Jayhawks in program history have achieved this milestone and now Angel Goodrich can add her name to the elite group. With her six assists at Missouri on Jan. 15, Goodrich became the fifth Kansas women's basketball player to record at least 400 assists in her career. She did it faster than any other Jayhawk, amassing her 400 dimes in 58 games.

In Case You Forgot

- The Jayhawks' double overtime win over Iowa State on Jan. 11 was their first double OT victory since 2006-07. Under coach Bonnie Henrickson, Kansas is 11-3 in overtime games.
- Kansas knocked off No. 23 Texas on Jan. 4 for its first conference-opening victory since 2005-06. It was also KU's first road win over a ranked foe since overcoming No. 10 Iowa State back on Feb. 16, 2000 in Ames.
- KU had just six turnovers versus Wisconsin on Dec. 8 which was one shy of the school record. The team's six miscues were its fewest since turning the ball over six times against New Orleans on Dec. 3, 2005.
- Angel Goodrich averaged 13.0 points and 9.0 assists during the Basketball Travelers Classic, Nov. 25-27, to earn Most Valuable Player of the tournament. She was joined on the all-tournament team by Aishah Sutherland (13.3 ppg, 9.7 rpg) and Carolyn Davis (15.0 ppg, 3.7 rpg).

Non-Conference Success

The Jayhawks compiled another impressive non-conference record this season going 11-1 to improve to 315-146 (.681 winning percentage) all-time versus non-conference opponents. The Jayhawks' best non-conference record came during the 2005-06 season when they posted a perfect 11-0 mark during the regular season and then later added another out-of-conference win during the 2006 WNIT. KU is 56-9 (.862 winning percentage) in non-conference games since the 2007-08 season.

O Captain, My Captain

For the second-straight season, juniors Carolyn Davis, Monica Engelman and Angel Goodrich will serve as team captains for the Jayhawks in 2011-12.

The Schedule

More than half of Kansas' opponents in 2011-12 made a postseason appearance last year, including defending national champion Texas A&M and Sweet 16 participants Baylor and Oklahoma. In all, the Jayhawks will play 19 contests versus teams that advanced to the postseason a year ago. Additionally, KU will play 19 of its 30 games in historic Allen Fieldhouse.

International Flavor

Kansas basketball spent 10 days playing and exploring all over Italy in August 2011, getting a taste of international play and culture. The Jayhawks especially benefitted from the opportunity to bring their five new freshmen: Asia Boyd, Donielle Breaux, Chelsea Gardner, Natalie Knight and Catherine "Bunny" Williams- on the trip as they gained valuable playing experience prior to the regular season.

Jayhawks Tabled Seventh in Preseason Big 12 Poll

In the Preseason Big 12 Women's Basketball poll released Oct. 12, Kansas was picked to finish seventh in a vote of the league's head coaches. The Jayhawks received 35 votes and finished ahead of Oklahoma State (30), Kansas State (23) and Missouri (10). Baylor was chosen to win the Big 12 Conference for the third consecutive year.

Future Jayhawks

A pair of standout guards have signed National Letters of Intent to join the University of Kansas women's basketball team beginning in the 2012-13 academic year as head coach Bonnie Henrickson announced the signing of Lamaria Cole and Markisha Hawkins on Nov. 16. Ranked No. 24 among 2012 guards, Cole is a 5-foot-9 guard from Rudder High School in Bryan, Texas. A 5-foot-9 guard out of Little Rock, Ark., Hawkins is currently in her second season at nationally-ranked Tyler Junior College in Tyler, Texas.

Up Next

The Jayhawks have another quick turnaround with just two days to prepare for Texas Tech. Kansas travels to Lubbock on Tuesday, Feb. 21 to take on the Red Raiders in a 7 p.m. game.

HEAD COACH BONNIE HENRICKSON



Despite Kansas being a program rich with history and tradition, Henrickson accepted the task of taking over a program coming off its fourth-consecutive losing season when she arrived in Lawrence in 2004. In her seven years at the helm of the Kansas program, Henrickson has taken the Jayhawk program from the cellar of the Big 12 Conference to the middle of the pack and it is steadily climbing. In addition, KU has advanced to postseason play in five of her seven seasons, including in each of the last four years.

But more than just putting wins back on the record, Henrickson has produced a program Jayhawk fans have come to embrace. A Big 12 single-game attendance record was set when Kansas hosted South Florida in the 2009 WNIT Championship game, as 16,113 fans supported the KU women's basketball program in historic Allen Fieldhouse. KU finished the 2008-09 season ranked in the Top 25 on the NCAA attendance chart and ranked fourth in the country in attendance increase.

KU advanced to postseason play for the fourth-straight season and fifth time overall under Henrickson in 2010-11, as the Jayhawks advanced to the second round of the Women's NIT before falling to Duquesne. KU posted its second 20-win season under Henrickson and recorded 20 or more wins for the second time in the last three seasons as the Jayhawks concluded the 2010-11 season with a 21-13 overall record.

Kansas saw much of its success through sophomore forward Carolyn Davis who averaged a team-leading 19.0 points, 7.4 rebounds and 1.4 blocks per game on her way to First Team All-Big 12 accolades. Davis led the Big 12 and ranked second nationally shooting 66.0 percent from the field. Additionally, KU saw the return from injury of outstanding point guard Angel Goodrich who averaged 7.5 points, 6.3 assists and 1.7 steals per game on her way to being named a finalist for the V Foundation Comeback Award.

In 2009-10, Henrickson guided the Jayhawks to their first national ranking in a decade. Kansas appeared in the Associated Press Poll for nine-consecutive weeks to open the season, ranking as high as No. 18. Jayhawk senior guard Danielle McCray was named to the 2009 Preseason Big 12 Player of the Year and was well on her way to All-America honors prior to suffering a season-ending knee injury in early February. The injury did not keep McCray from being drafted as she was the seventh overall selection in the 2010 WNBA Draft, becoming the first Kansas player to be taken in the draft under Henrickson. In addition, Davis was named a Freshman All-American and to the Big 12 All-Freshman Team.

Henrickson's 2008-09 squad had a "break-out"

performance of sorts. KU opened the season strong, compiling an 11-2 non-conference mark. The Jayhawks struggled early in Big 12 Conference play, opening with a 2-9 mark versus league opponents, before turning the corner. KU closed conference action winning four of its last five games, including wins over ranked teams No. 21 Iowa State and No. 5 Baylor.

The Jayhawks advanced to the WNIT for the second-consecutive season and third time under Henrickson, only this time they were more determined than ever to make all of their hard work pay off. KU reeled off four-straight wins, including a hard-fought win at New Mexico, one of the most notoriously tough places to play in all of the NCAA. Despite falling to South Florida in the title game, Kansas still finished the 2008-09 season with a 22-14 overall mark, giving the Jayhawks their most wins since the 1998-99 season.

In addition to the team having a break-through season, McCray burst onto the national scene with an eye-popping season of her own. McCray, who was named First Team All-Big 12, became the first Jayhawk since Lynn Pride in 1999 to earn All-America Honorable Mention honors as she was feted by both the Associated Press and State Farm. Following the season, McCray was invited to try out for USA Basketball's World University Games Team. After becoming one of 12 players chosen for the team, she traveled to Belgrade, Serbia for the 2009 World University Games where she helped lead the US to the gold medal.

Henrickson's 2007-08 squad posted a winning record (17-16), while two players were honored by the league coaches with McCray being tabbed All-Big 12 Honorable Mention and center Krysten Boogaard appearing on the Big 12 All-Rookie Team. The Jayhawks advanced to postseason play for the second time in Henrickson's first four seasons with a trip to the WNIT.

Henrickson's young Jayhawk squad in 2006-07, consisting of seven freshmen and just two seniors, came on strong at the end of the year, winning five of their last seven games.

A resurgence in Jayhawks' women's basketball was quite evident throughout the 2005-06 season as Henrickson's second campaign was capped off with a berth to the WNIT - KU's first postseason appearance since 2000. Under Henrickson's guidance that season, Kansas finished 17-13 to mark its first winning season in six years. Along the way, KU recorded 12-straight victories to open the season and snapped a 36-game drought against ranked opponents by defeating No. 23 Texas.

Using the qualities that earned her the 2005 Carol Eckman Award -- an award given by the WBCA which recognizes a coach who exemplifies spirit, integrity and character through sportsmanship, commitment to the student-athlete, honesty, ethical behavior, courage and dedication to purpose -- Henrickson developed Crystal Kemp and Erica Hallman into All-Big 12 selections for the second-straight year.

In 2004-05, Kansas posted its most wins (12) and conference wins (five) in four seasons, and placed eighth in the Big 12 Conference -- the highest Jayhawk finish in five years. In the process, Henrickson developed Kemp and Hallman into KU's first two All-Big 12 selections since 2000-01.

Henrickson and her staff have not only guided their athletes to victories on the court, but many have achieved tremendous accomplishments in the class-

room at KU. Under Henrickson, the overall team GPA has steadily risen since she arrived in Lawrence and during the 2007-08 school year the Jayhawks achieved a team-record 3.11 GPA. In her seven seasons, the Jayhawks have earned 24 Academic All-Big 12 Team appointments.

Henrickson arrived at KU after establishing herself as one of the nation's brightest young coaches at Virginia Tech, where she was head coach for seven seasons and guided the Hokies to a record of 158-62 and seven postseason appearances. Under her leadership, Virginia Tech reached the NCAA tournament five times, the WNIT twice and won 20 or more games every season.

Henrickson, a Willmar, Minn., native, graduated from St. Cloud State University in 1986. As a player, she helped SCSU win three Northern Sun Conference championships and advance to three NCAA Division II quarterfinals. In her four years as a player, SCSU compiled a 97-25 overall record, including a 31-4 mark in her sophomore season. She still ranks among the school leaders in points (4th - 1,731), rebounds (3rd - 995), free throws (1st - 507) and free throw percentage (4th - .790). She also was named to the all-conference team three times. Henrickson served as team captain her junior and senior years.

She earned her master's degree in physical education in 1988 from Western Illinois University while serving as a graduate assistant coach with the women's basketball team.
