CAMP MISSION

Fourteenth-year head coach Ray Bechard is the director of the Kansas Volleyball Camps. The purpose of the overnight skills camp is to develop the fundamental skills of volleyball, as well as the strategies for offense and defense. The purpose of the one-day clinics is to give you an opportunity to train specifically in a position.

SKILLS CAMP

June 3-5 or July 20-22

The emphasis of the individual overnight skills camp is to teach and develop the fundamental techniques of volleyball, as well as game strategies. Basic skills are stressed in drills, while team play is incorporated to teach how all the fundamentals fit in the game. Campers will be evaluated in all skills and receive a camp notebook detailing the camp's training methods. This camp is open to athletes entering grades 6-12 in the of Fall 2012. Campers will compete in the equivalent of 10 league and tournament matches. Each league team will be assigned a camp staff member to help facilitate all the skills learned throughout the camp.

Campers stay overnight in Naismith Hall, a dorm located on campus just 100 yards from HFAC. Athletes are allowed to pick their own roommates so encourage friends to sign up for camp!

NECESSARY EQUIPMENT

T-shirts, shorts, gym shoes, socks, knee pads, towels, twin bedding, toiletry items and a water bottle are all necessary items. We will have small pizzas available as a night snack for \$5. We will also have KU volleyball merchandise for sale at the camp store. Campers must manage their own money.

CAMP RULES

Campers are not allowed to be off campus unless with an organized and supervised camp group. Early departures must furnish written parental notice to the Camp Director at camp check-in. Campers will be supervised by coaches at all times. Failure to comply with these rules will result in immediate dismissal from camp without a refund. Naismith Hall is a 24-hour, secure, air-conditioned residence hall, and will have female staff members residing on each floor.

We are extending an invitation for position-specific clinics. Athletes entering grades 6-12 in the Fall of 2012 will receive instruction and training for one entire day. The clinic will run from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. with one hour allotted for lunch. Please bring your own lunch.



ARRIVALS/DEPARTURES

Setter, Hitter and DS camp registration begins at 8:30am on the day of camp. Registration for Skills Camp will be from 11:30 a.m. - 1:30 p.m. on the opening day of each camp. Registration for Skill Camps will be at the Horejsi Family Athletic Center located on the Southwest corner of Allen Fieldhouse on the KU campus. The athletes will finish the camp with a closing ceremony in the Horejsi Family Athletic Center that will begin at approximately 7:45 p.m., following the final session that starts at 6:00 p.m. Parents are welcome to attend. Campers will be dismissed from the main floor of Naismith Hall at 11:30 a.m. on the last day of camp. A schedule for commuter campers will be available for parents at camp registration.



Ray Bechard recently completed his 14th season as the head coach of the Kansas Jayhawks. His overall record of 938 wins and 262 losses includes 13 years at Barton Community College and 14 years at the University of Kansas.

"I encourage you to participate in the Jayhawk Volleyball camp experience. It will allow you to make gains not only in your

technical skills, but will also expose you to many other important aspects of becoming the best student-athlete you can be. We limit the number of participants so our staff can help you on an individual basis to reach your goals. I'll see you at camp."

BECHARD'S POLICIES

Each camper will be partially covered by a group accident insurance policy. Please send a photocopy of your insurance card with the registration. An athletic trainer will be on duty at all times. (Please bring your own tape and other supplies if you need to be taped.) Each applicant must have passed a physical examination by a medical doctor within the last year. Please send a photocopy of this year's school physical with your registration as well as a copy of the liability waiver, which can be found on the Kansas volleyball homepage website at KUAthletics.com/volleyball. Allow 30 days for confirmations.

The cost of the one day clinics is \$90. The cost for an overnight camper is \$320, which includes eight sessions of instruction, room, board, partial medical insurance, camp t-shirt and a camp notebook. Day Camper cost is \$275, which includes eight sessions of instruction, partial medical insurance, camp t-shirt, camp notebook, lunch and dinner each day (breakfast and board not included). A \$90 specialty camp payment and/or a **\$100** deposit is due with the registration form. (The full amount can be sent.) The balance is due the first day of camp at check-in. Note that **\$50 of the deposit is non refundable.** The remainder is refundable up to 14 days before camp starts. No refunds will be given within 14 days of camp except in cases of serious injury. Refund requests must be made in writing and be confirmed by the attending physician. There will be no refunds after camp begins.
