KANSAS AT K-STATE BY THE NUMBERS

53,439 - Attendance Saturday at Bill Snyder Family Stadium, the third largest crowd in school history and the 20th consecutive sellout.

53,081 - Average home attendance for Kansas State this season, breaking the school record set last season.

5,332 - Career passing yards by **Jake Waters** as he moved into third place in school history on Saturday.

3,584 - Career receiving yards by **Tyler Lockett**, extending his own school record and moving into third place in Big 12 history.

3,303 - Season total offensive yards by **Jake Waters** as he became the seventh player in school history to top the 3,000-yard barrier.

1,193 - Season receiving yards by **Tyler Lockett**, which ranks fourth in school history.

227 - Number of consecutive games Kansas State has scored, which extends K-State's school record streak and improves the 11th-longest streak in the nation.

222 - Career receptions **Tyler Lockett**, breaking the Kansas State record.

209 - Season completions by **Jake Waters** as he moved into third place in school history.

69 - Temperature at kickoff which was 38 degrees warmer than K-State's last game at West Virginia on Nov. 20 (31°).

47 - Consecutive games K-State has won when leading at halftime, the second-longest active streak in the nation.

24 - Consecutive games **Curry Sexton** has recorded at least one catch.

22 - Seniors that played in their final contest at Bill Snyder Family Stadium Saturday afternoon.

15 - Career 100-yard receiving games by **Tyler Lockett**, extending his school record.

12 - Consecutive games **Jake Waters** has thrown for at least 200 yards, the longest streak by a **Bill Snyder**-coached quarterback.

POSTGAME NOTES

- Saturday's Sunflower Showdown was the 112th meeting between Kansas State and Kansas with the Jayhawks holding a 64-41-2 advantage, but K-State has won 19 of the 23 matchups under head coach **Bill Snyder**, including 18 of the last 19 under the legendary coach and each of the last five since Snyder's return in 2009... In addition, the Wildcats recorded their 13th nine-win season under Snyder, while the Wildcats recorded their 11th season with six or more home victories... Kansas State is now 503-622-41 in program history, including a 187-92-1 mark under Snyder... Snyder moved into a sole possession of 32nd place in wins all-time among FBS coaches.
- A sold-out crowd of 53,439 fans attended Saturday's game, the third largest crowd in school history... It gave K-State its 20th consecutive sellout dating back to the 2012 season... In addition, the Wildcats' average home crowd of 53,081 fans broke the school record of 52,887 fans in 2013.
- K-State extended its scoring streak to 227 consecutive games on a 1-yard touchdown run by **Jake Waters**... It is the 11th-longest active streak in the nation and the second-longest in the Big 12... The streak has now endured 150 conference games... The Wildcats have not been held off the scoreboard since a 12-0 loss at Colorado in 1996, while they have not been held scoreless in 155 consecutive home games dating back to 1991.
- With two interceptions today, Kansas State has six interceptions against the Jayhawks over the last two years... **Dante Barnett**, who had one pick this afternoon has three of those interceptions.
- Kansas State improved in the record book in several key offensive categories... The 2014 Wildcats are now fourth in completions (218), third in passing yardage (3,098), tied for eighth in passing touchdowns (19) and 10th in total offensive yardage (4,709).
- The Wildcats took a 31-6 lead into the locker room at halftime... K-State pushed their streak of consecutive games won when leading at the half to 47, which is the second-longest active streak in the nation entering play this week (Oklahoma, 47)... Kansas State's 17 first-quarter points are its most for a first quarter since also scoring 17 against Texas A&M on October 17, 2009.
- Senior quarterback **Jake Waters** made his 24th career start under center for the Wildcats, improving to 17-7... He finished the contest going 21-of-27 through the air for 294 yards and four touchdown(s)... He has thrown for at least 200 yards in each of the last 11 games, the longest by a **Bill Snyder**-coached quarterback and the longest streak since **Josh Freeman** also had a 12-game streak split between the 2007 and 2008 seasons... His four passing touchdowns tied a career high (two times) and a school record (15 times).
- Waters improved in several season and career categories in K-State history... After the game, he now ranks third in season completions (209), third in season passing yards (2,863), third in career passing yards (5,038), tied for sixth in season passing touchdowns (18), tied for third in career passing touchdowns (36), sixth in season total offensive yards (3,303) and fourth in career total offensive yards (6,084)... He became the seventh player in school history with 3,000 offensive yards in a season.
- Senior wide receiver **Tyler Lockett** hauled in nine passes for 119 yards and two touchdowns... He broke the school career record for receptions at 222, passing his father, **Kevin**, who had 217 catches from 1993-96... His two touchdown catches gave him 26 for his career, which tied the school record, which was also held by Kevin... Lockett extended his own school record for career receiving yards, a mark that now stands at 3,388, while he moved up the Big 12 chart to sixth... Lockett now has 1,193 yards this season, a mark that ranks fourth... He carded his 15th career 100-yard receiving game, extending his own school record... Lockett also improved to third in season receptions (79)... He also improved to fifth in Big 12 history in career all-purpose yards (6,157), while he became the second player in school history to top the 6,000-yard mark in career all-purpose yards (**Darren Sproles**, 2001-04: 6,812)... He also has 1,867 all-purpose yards this season to rank fourth in school history.
- Senior wide receiver **Curry Sexton** hauled in nine passes for 141 yards and one touchdown... He pushed his season total of 940 yards and is 60 yards away from a 1,000-yard season... He teamed with Lockett for the third 100-yard game this season and the fourth time in their careers... Of the 12 double 100-yard games in school history, four have come from Lockett and Sexton.
- Place kicker **Matthew McCrane** connected on 2-of-2 field goals from distances of 41 and 52... His 52-yarder is tied for the 14th longest in school history, while he is the first K-State kicker since **Jeff Snodgrass** to hit two 50-yarders in a season (53 vs. Nebraska and 52 vs. Illinois State)... He moved into the single-season top-10 list at K-State with 14 field goals this year, while he extended his school record for points by a freshman to 77.
