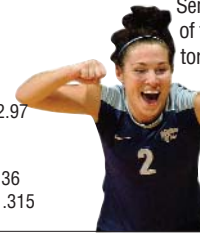

PLAYER TO WATCH



Senior libero Lauren Mathewson is now one of the most proficient liberos in Big 12 history. She is not only second in school history in career digs but is also ranked fifth in Big 12 history. Her 1,651 digs place her among elite company along with three other current liberos in the conference.

FIRST SERVE

Kansas State returns home on Saturday to take on the Baylor Bears in one of just three remaining home matches of the season at 7 p.m. The Wildcats will look to continue its strong play from the last two matches that saw a victory over Texas Tech and a tightly contested match with No. 5 Nebraska on Wednesday.

Baylor is coming into the match after falling to No. 7 Texas in four sets on the Bears' home court. Baylor claimed the first set over the Longhorns and held a large lead late in the third but could not hold on as Texas rallied for the comeback and followed with a win in the fourth.

K-State fell in straight sets to its rival Nebraska on Wednesday night in the final match played against the Cornhuskers as a conference opponent. After a disappointing first set, the Wildcats rebounded and forced extra points in the second and took the third to the limit as well losing 25-9, 27-25, 25-23.

The match will feature two of the top liberos in Big 12 history as Lauren Mathewson and Caitlyn Trice take to the floor. The two seniors both rank among the dig leaders in conference play this season. Trice is ranked 24th in the nation overall and fifth in conference play. Mathewson is second career digs in K-State history with 1,651 and is also ranked fifth in Big 12 history. She currently is averaging 5.04 digs a set in conference action.

Saturday's match will be Community Night for senior JuliAnne Chisholm and Lauren Mathewson. Fans from their hometowns of Hillsboro and Kansas City can get discounted tickets when they purchase online at kstatesports.com. THE SERIES

K-State holds the advantage in the all-time series with Baylor 21-9 with the teams meeting just once prior to the Big 12 era. Head coach Suzie Fritz is 14-5 against the Bears after the Wildcats were bested by Baylor in both matches last season and in their previous meeting this season. It marks the first time Baylor has won three straight against the Wildcats.

If the match goes the distance, the Wildcats may have the edge holding a 6-1 record against Baylor in five-set matches. The Bears have also only swept K-State twice -- their first meeting with the Wildcats and this season.

THE COACHES

Kansas State: Suzie Fritz (Florida Atlantic '94) is in her 10th year as head coach of the Wildcats she is the winningest coach in the program's history in terms of wins (193) and is not far off of the best winning percentage in school history as well at .631.

Baylor: Jim Barnes (McNeese State '94) is in his seventh year leading the Baylor Bears. Last season, he coached the Bears to their best finish in school history reaching the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament. He also saw Taylor Barnes and Anna Breyfogle become the school's first All-Americans in their senior seasons last year.

SCOUTING THE BEARS

Baylor has a tandem of middle blockers helping the Bears to 13.38 kills a set in conference play. Elizabeth Graham is averaging 3.04 kills a set in Big 12 action to lead the team and is hitting for a .326 percentage. Torri Campbell adds 2.55 kills in conference play.

Graham has emerged as one of the top defenders at the net this season in the league as well as she is averaging 1.29 blocks in conference matches and 1.36 overall to rank second. In Baylor's last match, she had four blocks in a loss to No. 7 Texas while adding 12 kills.

The Bears have senior outside hitter Ashlie Christenson back and she is again providing the team with a spark. Christenson has missed 13 sets in conference play this season and is averaging 2.72 kills. She also contributes 2.37 digs a set in conference play to make an impact on the back row. In Baylor's loss to Texas on Wednesday, Christenson posted a double-double as she led the team with 15 kills and 10 digs.

Baylor is also running a version of the 6-2 offense with two setters. Junior Brittany Ridenour and sophomore transfer Kate Harris share the duties.

The Bears also boast one of the better defenses in the nation this season averaging 18.72 digs a set heading into action this week. That mark ranks third in the nation trailing just Yale and Valparaiso. Senior libero Caitlyn Trice is averaging 5.25 digs a set this season to rank 24th in the nation and lead the Big 12. In conference play, she is averaging 4.79 to rank fourth just behind K-State's Lauren Mathewson.

CATCHING UP WITH THE 'CATS

Kansas State recently snapped an eight-match losing streak defeating Texas Tech (11/3) in four sets. The Wildcats' last win prior came at Texas A&M on October 2 when K-State swept the Aggies off their home floor in Reid Arena. All eight of those losses in the drought were sweeps as well.

In their last match, the Wildcats fell to rival Nebraska on the road in the final time the two teams will meet as conference foes with Nebraska joining the Big Ten Conference next year. The Cornhuskers got the sweep, but the Wildcats made it an exciting match worthy of the long rivalry's history. K-State forced extra points in the second set falling 27-25 and fought off three match points before dropping the third 25-23.

MATHEWSON CRACKS BIG 12 CAREER LIST

Senior libero Lauren Mathewson has put her name in the record book a number of times during her career at K-State, and she now has solidified her place in Big 12 Conference history. Mathewson's 1,651 career digs rank second in K-State history and she is now fifth in Big 12 history.

With four current liberos in the conference starting for three and some four years at their respective schools the career Top 10 list in the Big 12 had quite a bit of shuffling this season. Iowa State's Ashley Mass surpassed K-State's Angie Lastra for first on the list, and Missouri's Caitlyn Vann stands fourth with 1,834. Mathewson is fifth, and Nebraska's Kayla Banwarth is sixth with 1,601.

Mathewson posted her sixth 20-dig match of the season against Texas Tech (11/3) to tie her for 10th in a single season in school history in the category. It also gives her 21 for her career to tie for second with Laura Downey. She also has had four matches with 19 digs -- all of which came in three-set matches. Mathewson currently ranks fifth in the conference averaging 4.79 digs a set and has 436 digs on the year to rank ninth in school history for a single season.

ACADEMIC ALL-DISTRICT

The Kansas State volleyball team has a long history of combining success on the court with success in the classroom. This year's senior captains JuliAnne Chisholm and Lauren Mathewson added to that list of classroom achievements as they were each selected to the CoSIDA/ESPN Academic All-District VII Team.

Chisholm was named to the first team for the second consecutive year making her eligible for Academic All-America voting. She currently has a cumulative GPA of 3.97 in athletic training/pre-med and life sciences with a secondary major in gerontology.

Mathewson was voted to the third team for her first Academic All-District honor of her career. She holds a 3.84 GPA majoring in business administration and will graduate in December. Mathewson also has a pair of Academic All-Big 12 First Team awards on her list of academic accolades receiving the award each year she has been eligible.

The Wildcats have now had 16 Academic All-District selections under head coach Suzie Fritz in her 10 seasons leading the program.

"POR"ING IT ON

Freshman outside hitter Lilla Porubek has emerged as a go-to player for the Wildcats late this season. Her kill production has seen significant improvement, and she recently pounded out a new career-high nine kills at No. 5 Nebraska on Wednesday. In the loss to Nebraska, Porubek had nine kills and led the team with 27 attempts. She has posted six or more kills in three of K-State's last four matches with seven against No. 12 Iowa State (10/27) and six in the win over Texas Tech (11/3).

The native of Budapest, Hungary, missed the first two weeks of the season to represent her country on the Hungarian Junior National Team at the 2010 European Championships.

WILDCAT WALL

Kansas State has traditionally been one of the better blocking teams in the Big 12 Conference. After falling from the top four in the league the last two seasons, K-State is back near the top averaging 2.41 blocks a set to rank third the Big 12 and 41st in the nation. The Wildcats have posted 10 or more blocks in eight matches this season, including 13 at No. 5 Hawaii and 15 against 2009 NCAA Tournament team Georgia Tech.

The Wildcats top four blockers include two sophomores and two true freshmen. One of those blockers ranks among the national leaders as well with sophomore Alex Muff standing 34th (1.25).

PACKED WITH PURPLE

Ahearn Field House has been rocking this season with an average attendance of more than 2,100 fans. K-State fans have always been loyal to their Wildcats when it comes to volleyball with the fans ranking in the Top 30 in national attendance regularly. This season K-State is currently 14th in the nation in attendance and third in the Big 12 Conference behind only Nebraska (2) and Texas (9). Missouri (17), Iowa State (20), Texas A&M (21), Oklahoma (41), Kansas (44) and Baylor (46) all rank among the schools averaging more than 800 in attendance as of matches played through November 7 as tracked by Diane Nordstrom of Wisconsin.

After recent renovations to the seating were completed, the fans have come to watch the Wildcats play in droves with all but one home match reaching 1,300 in attendance. In the Big 12 Conference opener against Kansas, the Wildcat faithful filled the rafters with 3,160 fans to cheer the team to victory. K-Staters then packed 3,695 fans into Ahearn for the match against Missouri (9/25). That is the third largest attendance for a home match since the 2003 season and is among the most attended matches in the nation to date this season.

HOT HAND

Freshman middle blocker Kaitlynn Pelger has turned up the heat on opposing defenses in late September. From September 22 at Colorado to October 13 at Iowa State Pelger averaged an impressive 3.35 kills a set over those seven matches. Perhaps more impressive was her ability to kill at an efficient rate. Her hitting percentage is .398 combined in those matches including two five-set matches with her hitting .500 or better.

The recent hot streak is nothing new for Pelger as she started her career strong. In her first action at the Chevron

Rainbow Wahine Invitational she posted five kills and two digs against No. 16 UCLA. She then put on a performance that would highlight her selection to the All-Tournament Team against host No. 5 Hawaii with 10 block assists against the host team.

The Olathe South product put together a complete match for the Wildcats in their road sweep of Texas A&M (10/2) when she pounded out 12 kills on a .370 hitting clip to go with six digs, three blocks and an ace. She has posted some of the top performances in the conference so far this season at the net averaging 0.91 blocks. Pelger has also proven to be one of the team's top servers as she posted four aces at No. 16 Kentucky and leads the team with 23 for the season.

SENSATIONAL SOUTHPAW

Sophomore opposite Kathleen Ludwig has been one of the more consistent performers for the Wildcats as of late this season contributing in a number of different categories. The lefty has provided five or more kills in all but seven of K-State's 25 matches. Her defensive production remains strong with Ludwig posting an average of 1.95 digs a set this season.

Ludwig posted her first double-double of the season with an all-around effort during the sweep at Texas A&M (10/2). The sophomore lefty posted 10 kills and 10 digs while hitting an impressive .421. Ludwig pounded out six of those kills in the third set alone when she hit .500 on 10 swings in the set. She also had three service aces to keep the Aggies out of system offensively and reassert herself as one of the top servers on the team. In the loss to Missouri (10/30), Ludwig led the team with eight kills while hitting .227 and was strong defensively with five digs and three blocks.

YOUNG GUNS

The Wildcats have a total of 10 newcomers on the squad this season with just two seniors and no juniors on the roster as well. The youth of the program is making a large impact on the court as well with six underclassmen among the regular starters (Donahue; Kaufman/McCarty; Ludwig; Muff; Pelger).

Donahue has amassed four double-doubles this season at the setter position making a major contribution on defense for the Wildcats, and the combination of Kaufman, Ludwig, Muff and Pelger at the net has helped the Wildcats become one of the nation's top blocking teams.

Offensively, Pelger is averaging 2.80 kills a set. Muff adds 1.85 kills a set overall. Kaufman and Ludwig make an impact on offense as well at 1.70 and 1.59 respectively.

Pelger (25) and Donahue (21) combine to be the best two servers on the team for the Wildcats, and Ludwig has added 20 aces to K-State's strong serving.

CROWN JULES

JuliAnne Chisholm opened Big 12 Conference play with a sensational performance. Her 19-kills at Texas Tech (9/18) was a season-high for the senior despite the match lasting only three sets. That performance helped her earn her first career Big 12 Offensive Player of the Week award.

The senior outside hitter has embraced her new role as a team captain and currently leads the team in kills averaging 2.98 kills per set. Chisholm has posted five double-doubles this season as she is averaging 2.13 digs a set.

Chisholm was named MVP of the Varney's Kansas State Invitational after putting together three straight strong matches to help the Wildcats sweep the tournament. She posted 17 kills against Oral Roberts followed by 12 against Georgia Tech to go with her 12 digs for a double-double en route to winning the tournament.

The 2009 Academic All-American also leads the team off the court as she holds a 3.97 GPA with four degrees soon to be on her shelf in life sciences, kinesiology, pre-med and gerontology.

MUFF STUFFS TOUGH

Sophomore middle blocker Alex Muff has increased her offensive and defensive production in 2010 after emerging midway through the season last year. Her 11-kill and .435 hitting percentage against Colorado last year has become a more familiar site as she has posted 12 matches of at least a .300 hitting percentage and surpassed five blocks in 10 contests. Her 1.25 blocks per set this season rank 34th in the nation, and she currently is third the Big 12 in blocks during league action stuffing 1.30 per set.

Her performances against Kansas and Texas Tech earned Muff her first Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week award (9/20). In the Big 12 opener against Kansas she notched a career-high in blocks in the win over the Jay-hawks as she was in on nine stuffs to narrowly miss a rare double-double for a middle blocker as she pounded out 12 kills. Muff hit .500 in the contest to lead the Wildcats. Against Tech, Muff was nearly perfect on the attack posting eight kills on 12 swings without an error. She also assisted on seven blocks while the team's only other block was a solo stuff by JuliAnne Chisholm.

Muff earned All-Tournament honors for her showing at the Varney's Kansas State Invitational. Over the three matches, Muff averaged 2.11 blocks while hitting .391 and posting 2.44 kills. This season muff has hit .316 or higher in five of seven matches and posted at least five blocks in five matches as well. At the UK Invitational she hit .500 in a sweep over VCU on 10 swings and posted her first 10-kill match of the season against No. 16 Ken-

CHISHOLM, MUFF NAMED BIG 12 PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Senior JuliAnne Chisholm and sophomore Alex Muff both were honored for their performances against Kansas and Texas Tech to open Big 12 Conference action being selected as Big 12 Players of the Week (9/20).

Chisholm led the conference in kills (4.86) and points (5.36) for the week, and Muff led all players in hitting percentage (.567) and blocks (2.29) through the first two conference matches. The two combined to lead the Wildcats over rival KU in four sets, including a dramatic comeback in the fourth set after trailing 18-8, and a dominating sweep over the Red Raiders.

This was the first Big 12 Player of the Week award of their careers for both Chisholm and Muff.

K-STATE FAMILY BUSINESS

The Kansas State volleyball team has been run like a family under the direction of Suzie Fritz, and now there is a K-State family connection on the roster. Sophomore middle blocker Alex Muff is a second generation Wildcat student-athlete as her father Kevin played basketball at K-State. Freshman outside hitter Courtney Traxson also is a Wildcat legacy. Her aunt Helen Bundy-Buchanan lettered for the K-State volleyball team in the mid-1980s and her older brother Cameron threw javelin for the Wildcat track and field team.

Senior JuliAnne Chisholm also gets to play with her cousin this season with freshman outside hitter Dakota Kaufman joining the team. The two paired up at Hillsboro High School for one season.

CHRISTMAS IN SEPTEMBER?

Kansas State head coach Suzie Fritz has compared it to Christmas and her birthday. She's talking about the upgrades to Ahearn Field House for the 2010 season.

While in Hawaii, new chairback seats were installed on the south side of the court for season ticket holders, and new purple bleachers installed on the north side for students and more season ticket holders. The players and coaches got their first look at them at their first practice back from Hawaii on August 31.

A day later, the project was completed when a large purple banner proudly baring a Powercat logo was hung above the bleachers adding to the atmosphere. The upgrades were made possible through a one-time donation by the Student Government Association and generous donations from supporters of K-State Volleyball.

CHISHOLM MAKES THE GRADE

Outside hitter JuliAnne Chisholm became the school's fourth Academic All-American being selected to the 2009 CoSIDA/ESPN the Magazine Academic All-America Volleyball Team. She was chosen on the third team and held a perfect 4.0 GPA in athletic training/pre-medicine.

Chisholm was eligible for the Academic All-America Team after her selection to the first team of the CoSIDA/ESPN the Magazine Academic All-District Team where she was joined by teammate Kelsey Chipman. The pair also made Academic All-Big 12 First Team along with Abby Fay and Lauren Mathewson.

K-STATE PICKED NINTH IN BIG 12

After finishing ninth in the Big 12 Conference in 2009, the Wildcats were picked to finish in the exact same spot this year. K-State received 37 points in the poll and was just one point behind in-state rival Kansas.

Nebraska was the preseason favorite receiving eight of nine first-place votes. Texas received the remaining two first-place votes and is picked to finish second. After a deep run in the NCAA Tournament, Iowa State returns

K-STATE TRAVELS TO EUROPE

This May the Kansas State volleyball team had the exciting opportunity to play in Europe on a foreign tour thanks to the generosity of USA Athletes International. The Wildcats traveled to Budapest, Hungary; Ljubljana, Slovenia and Venice, Italy, and competed in five matches over the week.

The trip to Europe provided the Wildcats with the chance to play a different styles than the American game and grow both on the court and off it as teammates. Some highlights from the trip included a guided tour of Budapest as the players learned about the rich history and political changes of the city and Hungary since its founding in 958 A.D. The sights included, Hungarian Parliament, Fisherman's Bastion and Mathias Church, Chain Bridge and Heroes' Square.

While in Hungary, the Wildcats took on the Hungarian National Team and saw a familiar face on the other side of the net. Prior to the match, former Wildcat, Rita Liliom went through her team initiation as she wore her National Team uniform for the first time against her former team after recently being added to the Hungarian National Team. The Wildcats also saw Vali Hejjas while in Budapest. Hejjas was K-State's first Hungarian player and earned All-America status in 2004 and helped K-State to the Big 12 title in 2003.

In Slovenia, the Wildcats toured the largest cave in Europe and visited the capital city of Ljubljana - The Dragon City. In Ljubljana, the Wildcats saw St. Peter's Church where the Pope visited in the 1990's. The church is estimated to be more than 1,000 years old as it was built during the Middle Ages. As a true testament to how small the world can be, the Wildcats ran into a K-State alumnus on the streets of Ljubljana. The Dragon City was full of fun facts as well where the mayor accepts his monthly salary based on his approval rating.

While in Italy, the players experienced real Italian cuisine, learned of the long tradition of glass factories and absorbed the rich history of another amazing city on their tour. The Wildcats toured one of the glass factories on the island of Murano, went on a traditional gondola ride through the Grand Canal and saw the amazing Piazza San Marco.

The trip was made possible by USA Athletes International. The group is a non-profit organization that takes student-athletes from across the nation to create teams for international play in a number of different sports. USA Athletes International donated the trip to Kansas State Volleyball after seeing the team featured on *ESPN Outside the Lines* for a story about a cancelled trip to China in 2008. That trip was cancelled just days prior to departure after the trip organizer filed bankruptcy.

K-State Volleyball would again like to thank Darrell Phipps and William Edington from USA Athletes International for making the trip possible. A special thanks also goes out to trip director Petra Lehrner and bus driver Sorin. The Wildcats also wish to say thank you and good luck to their new friends with the Hungarian National Team, Vasas Sport Club, OK Vital and Cus Venezia.
