Sophomore middle blocker Alex Muff currently leads the Big 12 Conference in blocks (1.92) and is second in hitting percentage (.567) in league action. She received her first Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week award on Monday for her commanding performances against Kansas and Texas Tech to open Big 12 competition.



FIRST SERVE

The Kansas State Wildcats have a showdown with conference foe Missouri at 7 p.m. Saturday in Ahearn Field House as K-State is looking to get back in the win column after a five-set loss at Colorado on Wednesday. The Tigers come into the contest following back-to-back losses to two of the conference's top teams in No. 11 Iowa State and No. 12 Texas.

Missouri will be the strongest team to face K-State at home this season with the Tigers receiving votes in this week's AVCA Coaches Poll. The Wildcats are undefeated at home this season winning all five matches at Ahearn so far.

K-State's offense showed balance in its loss to Colorado with four Wildcats posting 10 or more kills for the match. The list included career-highs for Kaitlynn Pelger (16) and Dakota Kaufman (14). The pair of freshmen also posted impressive hitting percentages with Kaufman hitting .303 and Pelger posting .500.

Saturday's match will be part of a Wildcat Weekend with K-State hosting Central Florida in football at 11:30 a.m. at Bill Snyder Family Stadium. Fans can get into the volleyball match for just \$3 with their ticket stub from football. It also is the beginning of the Community Day promotions as fans from the hometowns of Taylor Johnson (Grand Island, Neb.), Audrey Horton (Topeka) and Dakota Kaufman (Hillsboro) can receive discounted tickets as well by purchasing tickets in advance. This will be K-State's last conference match before taking a break from Big 12 action for a mid-week game against UMKC on Tuesday night before heading south to College Station, Texas, to take on Texas A&M next Saturday.

THE SERIES

Kansas State has controlled the series with Missouri since Suzie Fritz took over the program in 2001. The Wildcats lead the all-time series 40-31, and Fritz is 13-5 against the Tigers. In the Big 12 era, the Wildcats are 22-6 against Missouri and lost at home just twice in the time.

THE COACHES

Kansas State: Suzie Fritz (Florida Atlantic '94) is in her 10th year as head coach of the Wildcats she is the winningest coach in the program's history in terms of wins (190) and is not far off of the best winning percentage in school history as well at .648.

Missouri: Wayne Kreklow (Drake '80) is in his 11th year at Missouri and sixth as the head coach. He and his wife Susan have served as head coaches at Missouri since 2000 and averaged 20 wins a season in that time.

SCOUTING THE TIGERS

Missouri returns a number of key players from last year's squad and welcome one of the top high school recruits at the setter position as well. Senior outside hitter Julianna Klein has been one of Missouri's top players her whole career and is moving up the record books at the school. Paola Ampudia made an immediate impact for the team last year as a junior college transfer and has continued her strong play for the Tigers this year, and senior libero Caitlyn Vann has been a consistent contributor on the back row for Missouri entering the season with a chance to break the school's career digs record.

Molly Kreklow, niece of coach Wayne Kreklow, was one of the nation's top recruits and earned the starting setter position. She was selected as the Big 12 Preseason Freshman of the Year. Kreklow currently leads the conference in assists per set averaging 11.66 to guide Missouri's offense.

Kreklow is not the only Tiger among the conference leaders. Ampudia ranks third in kills averaging 3.77 per set and Brittney Brimmage is among the leaders in hitting percentage. Vann is currently third in digs averaging 4.68 per set.

The Tigers enter Saturday's contest after losing two straight matches, but those came against two of the top teams in the conference falling to No. 11 Iowa State and No. 12 Texas both in four sets. Against Texas, the Tigers won the opening set at home and kept the remaining three tight but could not hand the Longhorns a road loss. Missouri's offense struggled against Iowa State as the Cyclones held the Tigers to a .113 hitting percentage thanks in part to 12 blocks in the match.

CATCHING UP WITH THE 'CATS

The Kansas State Wildcats opened Big 12 play with back-to-back wins for the first time since 2007 defeating in-state rival Kansas and Texas Tech. K-State could not make it three in a row for the first time since 1999, however, as the Wildcats fell to Colorado in five sets on the road Wednesday night.

In the loss to Colorado, the Wildcats saw strong showings from a pair of freshmen who continue to make improvements. Dakota Kaufman posted a career-high 14 kills and hit .303 giving her back-to-back matches with hitting percentages over .300. Kaitlynn Pelger also had a career-high in kills with 16 while also hitting .500.

Sophomore setter Caitlyn Donahue continues to show her athleticism at the position with her fourth double-double of the season at Colorado. Donahue had a career-high 55 assists and also added 15 digs. JuliAnne Chisholm added 17 kills in the loss to Colorado. The Wildcats again had more than 10 blocks in a match against the Buffaloes stuffing 12. That performance was aided by sophomore Alex Muff and Kathleen Ludwig who each had one solo block and six block assists.

WILDCAT WALL

Kansas State has traditionally been one of the better blocking teams in the Big 12 Conference. After falling from

the top four in the league the last two seasons, K-State is back near the top averaging 2.80 blocks a set to rank second the Big 12 and 11th in the nation. The Wildcats have posted 10 or more blocks in eight of 13 matches so far this season, including 13 at No. 5 Hawaii and 15 against 2009 NCAA Tournament team Georgia Tech.

The Wildcats are holding opponents to a hitting percentage of .169 thanks in part to the wall put up at the net by the young team. K-State's top four blockers include two sophomores and two true freshmen. Two of those blockers rank among the national leaders as well with sophomore Alex Muff standing 29th (1.30) and freshman Kaitlynn Pelger is 48th (1.23).

YOUNG GUNS

The Wildcats have a total of 10 newcomers on the squad this season with just two seniors and no juniors on the roster as well. The youth of the program is making a large impact on the court as well with six underclassmen among the regular starters (Donahue; Kaufman/McCarty; Ludwig; Muff; Pelger).

Donahue has amassed four double-doubles this season at the setter position making a major contribution on defense for the Wildcats, and the combination of Kaufman, Ludwig, Muff and Pelger at the net has helped the Wildcats become one of the nation's top blocking teams. Pelger is averaging 2.56 kills a set, and Muff adds 2.15. Kaufman and Ludwig make an impact on offense as well.

Pelger and Donahue combine to be the best two servers on the team for the Wildcats as Pelger has 14 aces thus far, and Donahue has posted 15 unreturnable serves.

CHISHOLM, MUFF NAMED BIG 12 PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Senior JuliAnne Chisholm and sophomore Alex Muff both were honored for their performances against Kansas and Texas Tech to open Big 12 Conference action being selected as Big 12 Players of the Week (9/20).

Chisholm led the conference in kills (4.86) and points (5.36) for the week, and Muff led all players in hitting percentage (.567) and blocks (2.29) through the first two conference matches. The two combined to lead the Wildcats over rival KU in four sets, including a dramatic comeback in the fourth set after trailing 18-8, and a dominating sweep over the Red Raiders.

This was the first Big 12 Player of the Week award of their careers for both Chisholm and Muff.

KILLER KAUFMAN

Freshman outside hitter Dakota Kaufman has been in the starting rotation for the Wildcats since the season opener against No. 16 UCLA in Hawaii and has proven why with her play -- especially in Big 12 action.

Through the first three matches of conference play, Kaufman is averaging 2.33 kills per set and hitting .253. In the Big 12 opener against Kansas, Kaufman struggled with a hitting percentage below .100 but has since found her stroke and pounded out kills at a high rate. At Texas Tech, she posted eight kills without an error to hit .421. Kaufman followed that up with a career-high 14 kills at Colorado and hit .303 over the five sets.

MUFF STUFFS TOUGH

Sophomore middle blocker Alex Muff has increased her offensive and defensive production in 2010 after emerging midway through the season last year. Her 11-kill and .435 hitting percentage against Colorado last year has become a more familiar site as she has posted nine matches of at least a .300 hitting percentage and surpassed five blocks in seven contests. Her 1.31 blocks per set this season rank 29th in the nation, and she currently leads the Big 12 in blocks during league action stuffing 1.92 per set.

Recently, her performances against Kansas and Texas Tech earned Muff her first Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week award. In the Big 12 opener against Kansas she notched a career-high in blocks in the win over the Jay-

hawks as she was in on nine stuffs to narrowly miss a rare double-double for a middle blocker as she pounded out 12 kills. Muff hit .500 in the contest to lead the Wildcats. Against Tech, Muff was nearly perfect on the attack posting eight kills on 12 swings without an error. She also assisted on seven blocks while the team's only other block was a solo stuff by JuliAnne Chisholm.

Muff earned All-Tournament honors for her showing at the Varney's Kansas State Invitational. Over the three matches, Muff averaged 2.11 blocks while hitting .391 and posting 2.44 kills. This season muff has hit .316 or higher in five of seven matches and posted at least five blocks in five matches as well. At the UK Invitational she hit .500 in a sweep over VCU on 10 swings and posted her first 10-kill match of the season against No. 16 Kentucky as she pounded out 10 kills on a .364 hitting clip and added four blocks.

PACKED WITH PURPLE

Ahearn Field House has been rocking this season with an average attendance of nearly 2,000 fans. After recent renovations to the seating were completed, the fans have come to watch the Wildcats play in droves with all but one home match reaching 1,300 in attendance. In the Big 12 Conference opener against Kansas, the Wildcat faithful fill the rafters with 3,160 fans to cheer the team to victory.

K-State fans have always been loyal to their Wildcats when it comes to volleyball with the fans ranking in the Top 30 in national attendance regularly. This season K-State is currently 16th in the nation in attendance and fourth in the Big 12 Conference behind only Nebraska (1), Texas (10) and Iowa State (15) as of matches played through September 12.

CROWN JULES

JuliAnne Chisholm has been on a roll for the Wildcats with seven straight matches of 15 or more kills. Her 19-kill performance at Texas Tech (9/18) was a season-high for the senior despite the match lasting only three sets. That performance helped her earn her first career Big 12 Offensive Player of the Week award.

The senior outside hitter has embraced her new role as a team captain and currently leads the team in kills averaging 3.69 kills per set. Chisholm has already posted four double-doubles this season as she is averaging 2.06 digs a set. Chisholm has posted double digits in kills in all but two matches this season and is currently on a streak of eight straight.

Chisholm was named MVP of the Varney's Kansas State Invitational after putting together three straight strong matches to help the Wildcats sweep the tournament. She posted 17 kills against Oral Roberts followed by 12 against Georgia Tech to go with her 12 digs for a double-double en route to winning the tournament.

The 2009 Academic All-American also leads the team off the court as she holds a 3.97 GPA with four degrees soon to be on her shelf in life sciences, kinesiology, pre-med and gerontology.

MATTIE MAGIC

Senior libero Lauren Mathewson has picked up 2010 where she left off 2009 averaging 4.38 digs a set through 13 matches. After a slow start in Hawaii, Mathewson posted four 20-dig matches in the last eight contests and was one shy in another. She is currently ranked fifth in the conference in digs per set.

She earned her second All-Tournament team honor of the season following the UK Invitational where she outshined liberos from two of the nation's top teams. Against No. 17 Florida State, Mathewson posted 26 digs while Florida State libero Jenna Romanelli had 23. Then, against No. 16 Kentucky the 5-6 senior again put up 22 digs. Mathewson led the tournament in digs for the weekend earning her the libero spot on the All-Tournament Team.

Her two 20-dig performances in Kentucky also pushed her closer to Laura Downey for second most 20-dig matches in a career. Mathewson now has 19 and needs just two more to tie Downey. Mathewson also is inching closer to Downey in career digs as the senior now stands in fourth with 1,425 and needs just 26 to move past Downey on that list as well.

PELTING PELGER

Freshman middle blocker Kaitlynn Pelger has started her career strong and continues to get better as the season progresses. In her first action at the Chevron Rainbow Wahine Invitational she posted five kills and two digs against No. 16 UCLA. She then put on a performance that would highlight her selection to the All-Tournament Team against host No. 5 Hawaii.

She has continued to stay strong as the team's No. 2 blocker averaging 1.23 a set to rank sixth in the Big 12 and 48th in the nation. She has posted five or more blocks almost half of K-State's matches and has some of the top performances in the conference so far this season at the net. Pelger has also proven to be one of the team's top servers as she posted four aces at No. 16 Kentucky. She leads the team in aces with 14 and posted two or more in three of the last four matches.

Pelger's All-Tournament selection in Hawaii came at the heels of her stuffing attack after attack against the Rainbow Wahine. She totaled 10 block assists, which ties for second in school history for a three-set match. She also posted four kills against Hawaii. Then, in the final match of the tournament against No. 22 San Diego, Pelger's offense came to form with 13 kills and a .329 hitting percentage. She also added a solo block, three more block assists, two digs and an ace.

Pelger backed up her performance in Hawaii with a stellar home debut as she posted 15 kills on South Dakota hitting at a .364 clip and added four more blocks to her stat line. She has been one of the team's better servers so far through the season as well posting two aces against South Dakota.

SENSATIONAL SOUTHPAW

Sophomore opposite Kathleen Ludwig has been one of the more consistent performers for the Wildcats as of late this season contributing in a number of different categories. The lefty has provided five or more kills in seven of the last eight matches, including five with a hitting percentage of .333 or better.

In the Big 12 opener against KU, Ludwig was stellar with eight kills and one error for a hitting percentage of .438 while adding seven digs and three blocks to the winning effort. Her serving has kept opponents off balance as she has posted nine aces on the year. Ludwig also has been one of the team's top passers posting three 10-dig matches thus far and adding two more with nine. Ludwig has twice been on the cusp of a double-double needing one kills or one dig to reach the mark.

K-STATE FAMILY BUSINESS

The Kansas State volleyball team has been run like a family under the direction of Suzie Fritz, and now there is a K-State family connection on the roster. Sophomore middle blocker Alex Muff is a second generation Wildcat student-athlete as her father Kevin played basketball at K-State. Freshman outside hitter Courtney Traxson also is a Wildcat legacy. Her aunt Helen Bundy-Buchanan lettered for the K-State volleyball team in the mid-1980s and her older brother Cameron threw javelin for the Wildcat track and field team.

Senior JuliAnne Chisholm also gets to play with her cousin this season with freshman outside hitter Dakota Kaufman joining the team. The two paired up at Hillsboro High School for one season.

CHRISTMAS IN SEPTEMBER?

Kansas State head coach Suzie Fritz has compared it to Christmas and her birthday. She's talking about the upgrades to Ahearn Field House for the 2010 season.

While in Hawaii, new chairback seats were installed on the south side of the court for season ticket holders, and new purple bleachers installed on the north side for students and more season ticket holders. The players and coaches got their first look at them at their first practice back from Hawaii on August 31.

A day later, the project was completed when a large purple banner proudly bearing a Powercat logo was hung above the bleachers adding to the atmosphere. The upgrades were made possible through a one-time donation by the Student Government Association and generous donations from supporters of K-State Volleyball.

CHISHOLM MAKES THE GRADE

Outside hitter JuliAnne Chisholm became the school's fourth Academic All-American being selected to the 2009 CoSIDA/ESPN the Magazine Academic All-America Volleyball Team. She was chosen on the third team and held a

K-STATE PICKED NINTH IN BIG 12

After finishing ninth in the Big 12 Conference in 2009, the Wildcats were picked to finish in the exact same spot this year. K-State received 37 points in the poll and was just one point behind in-state rival Kansas.

Nebraska was the preseason favorite receiving eight of nine first-place votes. Texas received the remaining two first-place votes and is picked to finish second. After a deep run in the NCAA Tournament, Iowa State returns some of its key players from a year ago and is picked to finish third again. Oklahoma and Missouri round out the top five.



K-STATE TRAVELS TO EUROPE

This May the Kansas State volleyball team had the exciting opportunity to play in Europe on a foreign tour thanks to the generosity of USA Athletes International. The Wildcats traveled to Budapest, Hungary; Ljubljana, Slovenia and Venice, Italy, and competed in five matches over the week.

The trip to Europe provided the Wildcats with the chance to play a different styles than the American game and grow both on the court and off it as teammates. Some highlights from the trip included a guided tour of Budapest as the players learned about the rich history and political changes of the city and Hungary since its founding in 958 A.D. The sights included, Hungarian Parliament, Fisherman's Bastion and Mathias Church, Chain Bridge and Heroes' Square.

While in Hungary, the Wildcats took on the Hungarian National Team and saw a familiar face on the other side of the net. Prior to the match, former Wildcat, Rita Liliom went through her team initiation as she wore her National Team uniform for the first time against her former team after recently being added to the Hungarian National Team. The Wildcats also saw Vali Hejjas while in Budapest. Hejjas was K-State's first Hungarian player and earned All-America status in 2004 and helped K-State to the Big 12 title in 2003.

In Slovenia, the Wildcats toured the largest cave in Europe and visited the capital city of Ljubljana - The Dragon City. In Ljubljana, the Wildcats saw St. Peter's Church where the Pope visited in the 1990's. The church is estimated to be more than 1,000 years old as it was built during the Middle Ages. As a true testament to how small the world can be, the Wildcats ran into a K-State alumnus on the streets of Ljubljana. The Dragon City was full of fun facts as well where the mayor accepts his monthly salary based on his approval rating.

While in Italy, the players experienced real Italian cuisine, learned of the long tradition of glass factories and absorbed the rich history of another amazing city on their tour. The Wildcats toured one of the glass factories on the island of Murano, went on a traditional gondola ride through the Grand Canal and saw the amazing Piazza San Marco.

The trip was made possible by USA Athletes International. The group is a non-profit organization that takes student-athletes from across the nation to create teams for international play in a number of different sports. USA Athletes International donated the trip to Kansas State Volleyball after seeing the team featured on *ESPN Outside the Lines* for a story about a cancelled trip to China in 2008. That trip was cancelled just days prior to departure after the trip organizer filed bankruptcy.

K-State Volleyball would again like to thank Darrell Phipps and William Edington from USA Athletes International for making the trip possible. A special thanks also goes out to trip director Petra Lehrner and bus driver Sorin. The Wildcats also wish to say thank you and good luck to their new friends with the Hungarian National Team, Vasas Sport Club, OK Vital and Cus Venezia.
