### PLAYER TO WATCH

Sophomore middle blocker Alex Muff currently leads the Big 12 Conference in blocks (1.68) and is sixth in hitting percentage (.346) in league action. She has posted at least six block assists in all but one of K-State's conference matches to date. Muff earned her first Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week Award (9/20) after opening week of league play.



### FIRST SERVE

After an impressive road sweep of Texas A&M last weekend, the Kansas State Wildcats return to Ahearn Field House for a quick two-match homestand. The Wildcats take on the Oklahoma Sooners at 7 p.m. Wednesday with the match televised on Fox Sports Kansas City. This will be the second home televised match at home this season with the Wildcats defeating rival Kansas in four sets on Metro Sports in the Big 12 Conference opener.

The Wildcats dropped both matches to the Sooners last season in a pair of highly-contested battles. Oklahoma won each in four sets, but K-State kept it close with six of the eight sets decided by five or less points and three of them going to extra points.

Senior libero Lauren Mathewson has had a number of solid matches in her career, but has shined against Oklahoma. Last season, Mathewson posted 22 digs at home against the Sooners and then put up 30 on the road as she won Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week following that performance. This season Mathewson is averaging 4.43 digs a set to lead the Wildcats.

Wednesday's match will be Community Night for Tristan McCarty and Kaitlynn Pelger. Fans from Manhattan and Olathe can get into the match for just \$3 by purchasing their tickets in advance online at kstatesports.com. For more information on promotion codes call the ticket office at 800-221-CATS (2287). Youth fans who attended Wildcat Volleyball Camp this summer may get in free by wearing their camp T-shirt and contacting Sarah Laha in the Fan Experience & Sales office.

The Wildcats and Sooners also will be wearing special pink warm-ups on Wednesday as part of Breast Cancer Awareness Month. The match also has heavy Big 12 standings implications with five teams currently tied for second.

ning six of the last eight meetings sweeping the series in 2006, 2007 and 2009. Suzie Fritz is 12-6 against OU.

### THE COACHES

Kansas State: Suzie Fritz (Florida Atlantic '94) is in her 10th year as head coach of the Wildcats she is the winningest coach in the program's history in terms of wins (192) and is not far off of the best winning percentage in school history as well at .649.

Oklahoma: Santiago Restrepo (East Stroudsburg '86) is in his seventh year coaching the Sooners where he has energized the program back into an NCAA Tournament caliber team. He has taken OU to the postseason three of the last four years.

### SCOUTING THE SOONERS

Oklahoma comes into Manhattan after defeating Baylor in four sets on the road. The Sooners are part of the log jam for second place in the conference standings with two losses - both to Top 10 teams Nebraska and Iowa State. The Sooners are no longer receiving votes in this week's AVCA Coaches Top 25 Poll after their 3-1 loss to Nebraska.

The Sooners are led by junior right side hitter Suzy Boulavsky this season as she averages 3.44 kills a set. She also is hitting at a .265 clip. She is joined by Sarah Freudenrich as the one-two punch of the Sooners offense. Freudenrich is averaging 2.42 kills from her middle blocker position and is hitting an impressive .368 on the year. In conference play the pair's number drop just a bit as the two are some of Oklahoma's most consistent performers.

Sophomore libero Maria Fernanda helps the Sooners hold opponents to a .187 hitting percentage this season as she is in her second year starting for OU and is averaging 4.39 digs a set overall and 4.78 in conference play. The Sooners defense is one of the top in the conference as Oklahoma ranks second in the Big 12 in digs per set during league matches averaging 16.94 a set.

Oklahoma's block, however, is not as strong as its back row as the Sooners rank 10th in the league in blocks averaging just 1.83 per set. The Wildcats are fourth in league action averaging 2.37 blocks.

### CATCHING UP WITH THE 'CATS

Kansas State is eyeing a three-match winning streak overall and back-to-back win in conference play to enter the weekend's action with a bit of momentum. The Wildcats swept the Texas A&M Aggies on their home floor on Saturday getting a valuable road conference win and creating the five-way tie for second place in the Big 12. If A&M had won the match, the Aggies would have been alone in second place.

The Wildcats offense rolled in College Station on Saturday as freshman Kaitlynn Pelger led the way with 12 kills and a .370 hitting percentage. Sophomore opposite Kathleen Ludwig posted a double-double as she found her swing on offense with 10 kills, 10 digs and a .421 hitting percentage. The Wildcats hit .220 as a team and held A&M to just .126 limiting A&M's go-to player Kelsey Black to a .000 hitting percentage with 10 kills and 10 errors.

Senior libero Lauren Mathewson just missed out on another 20-dig match as she posted 19 in the win over Texas A&M. She continued to move closer to second in career digs with the effort as she now is just 97 digs behind Kim

Zschau on the career digs list at K-State. Mathewson is averaging 4.43 digs a set this season.

Head Coach Suzie Fritz is also approaching a milestone. The 10th year coach needs just eight wins to reach the 200 plateau. The Wildcats have averaged 20.33 wins a season under Fritz as she entered the year 17 wins shy of the 200 mark. She already has the most wins in school history and is just a few percentage points behind for highest winning percentage in school history as well.

**WILDCAT WALL**

Kansas State has traditionally been one of the better blocking teams in the Big 12 Conference. After falling from the top four in the league the last two seasons, K-State is back near the top averaging 2.72 blocks a set to rank second the Big 12 and 19th in the nation. The Wildcats have posted 10 or more blocks in eight of 16 matches so far this season, including 13 at No. 5 Hawaii and 15 against 2009 NCAA Tournament team Georgia Tech.

The Wildcats are holding opponents to a hitting percentage of .167 thanks in part to the wall put up at the net by the young team. K-State's top four blockers include two sophomores and two true freshmen. Two of those blockers rank among the national leaders as well with sophomore Alex Muff standing 17th (.133).

**PACKED WITH PURPLE**

Ahearn Field House has been rocking this season with an average attendance of more than 2,100 fans. K-State fans have always been loyal to their Wildcats when it comes to volleyball with the fans ranking in the Top 30 in national attendance regularly. This season K-State is currently 11th in the nation in attendance and third in the Big 12 Conference behind only Nebraska (2) and Texas (10). Missouri (17), Iowa State (21), Texas A&M (22), Baylor (40) and Oklahoma (43) all rank among the schools averaging more than 800 in attendance as of matches played through September 26 as track by Diane Nordstrom of Wisconsin.

After recent renovations to the seating were completed, the fans have come to watch the Wildcats play in droves with all but one home match reaching 1,300 in attendance. In the Big 12 Conference opener against Kansas, the Wildcat faithful fill the rafters with 3,160 fans to cheer the team to victory. K-Staters then packed 3,695 fans into Ahearn for the last match against Missouri on Saturday. That is the third largest attendance for a home match since the 2003 season. It also was the 35th most attended game in the nation to date this season.

**PELTING PELGER**

Freshman middle blocker Kaitlynn Pelger has started her career strong and continues to get better as the season progresses. In her first action at the Chevron Rainbow Wahine Invitational she posted five kills and two digs against No. 16 UCLA. She then put on a performance that would highlight her selection to the All-Tournament Team against host No. 5 Hawaii.

The Olathe South product has tallied double digit kills in each of the last four matches while also hitting .370 or higher in each of those performances. Two of those matches were five-set affairs that saw Pelger hit .500 or better -- a 16-kill showing at Colorado and a career-best 17 kills Tuesday against UMKC.

Pelger put together a complete match for the Wildcats in their road sweep of Texas A&M on Saturday when she pounded out 12 kills on a .370 hitting clip to go with six digs, three blocks and an ace. She has been consistent for the Wildcats as the team's No. 2 blocker averaging 1.08 a set to rank ninth in the Big 12. She has posted five or more blocks almost half of K-State's matches and has some of the top performances in the conference so far this season at the net. Pelger has also proven to be one of the team's top servers as she posted four aces at No. 16 Kentucky and is tied with Caitlyn Donahue with 18 for the team lead.

Pelger's All-Tournament selection in Hawaii came at the heels of her stuffing attack after attack against the Rainbow Wahine. She totaled 10 block assists, which ties for second in school history for a three-set match. She also posted four kills against Hawaii. Then, in the final match of the tournament against No. 22 San Diego, Pelger's offense came to form with 13 kills and a .329 hitting percentage. She also added a solo block, three more block assists, two digs and an ace.

## SENSATIONAL SOUTHPAW

Sophomore opposite Kathleen Ludwig has been one of the more consistent performers for the Wildcats as of late this season contributing in a number of different categories. The lefty has provided five or more kills in 12 of the last 13 matches. Her hitting percentage has dropped since the start of Big 12 play, but her defensive production remains strong with Ludwig posting seven or more digs in each of the last nine matches.

Ludwig recently posted her first double-double of the season with an all-around effort during the sweep at Texas A&M. The sophomore lefty posted 10 kills and 10 digs while hitting an impressive .421. Ludwig pounded out six of those kills in the third set alone when she hit .500 on 10 swings in the set. She also had three service aces to keep the Aggies out of system offensively and reassert herself as one of the top servers on the team.

## YOUNG GUNS

The Wildcats have a total of 10 newcomers on the squad this season with just two seniors and no juniors on the roster as well. The youth of the program is making a large impact on the court as well with six underclassmen among the regular starters (Donahue; Kaufman/McCarty; Ludwig; Muff; Pelger).

Donahue has amassed four double-doubles this season at the setter position making a major contribution on defense for the Wildcats, and the combination of Kaufman, Ludwig, Muff and Pelger at the net has helped the Wildcats become one of the nation's top blocking teams. Pelger is averaging 2.72 kills a set, and Muff adds 1.98. Kaufman and Ludwig make an impact on offense as well at 1.72 and 1.48 respectively.

Pelger and Donahue combine to be the best two servers on the team for the Wildcats as each has 18 aces to date for the season. Ludwig has added 15 aces to K-State's strong serving.

**MUFF STUFFS TOUGH**

Sophomore middle blocker Alex Muff has increased her offensive and defensive production in 2010 after emerging midway through the season last year. Her 11-kill and .435 hitting percentage against Colorado last year has become a more familiar site as she has posted 10 matches of at least a .300 hitting percentage and surpassed five blocks in eight contests. Her 1.33 blocks per set this season rank 17th in the nation, and she currently leads the Big 12 in blocks during league action stuffing 1.68 per set.

Her performances against Kansas and Texas Tech earned Muff her first Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week award (9/20). In the Big 12 opener against Kansas she notched a career-high in blocks in the win over the Jayhawks as she was in on nine stuffs to narrowly miss a rare double-double for a middle blocker as she pounded out 12 kills. Muff hit .500 in the contest to lead the Wildcats. Against Tech, Muff was nearly perfect on the attack posting eight kills on 12 swings without an error. She also assisted on seven blocks while the team's only other block was a solo stuff by JuliAnne Chisholm.

Muff earned All-Tournament honors for her showing at the Varney's Kansas State Invitational. Over the three matches, Muff averaged 2.11 blocks while hitting .391 and posting 2.44 kills. This season muff has hit .316 or higher in five of seven matches and posted at least five blocks in five matches as well. At the UK Invitational she hit .500 in a sweep over VCU on 10 swings and posted her first 10-kill match of the season against No. 16 Kentucky as she pounded out 10 kills on a .364 hitting clip and added four blocks.

**KILLER KAUFMAN**

Freshman outside hitter Dakota Kaufman has been in the starting rotation for the Wildcats since the season opener against No. 16 UCLA in Hawaii and has proven why with her play -- especially in Big 12 action.

Through the first five matches of conference play, Kaufman averaged 2.17 kills per set and hitting .227. In the Big 12 opener against Kansas, Kaufman struggled with a hitting percentage below .100 but then found her stroke and pounded out kills at a high rate in three of the next four matches. At Texas Tech, she posted eight kills without an

error to hit .421. Kaufman followed that up with a career-high 14 kills at Colorado and hit .303 over the five sets. She only posted two kills and against, but responded with nine at Texas A&M with a .300 percentage.

## CHISHOLM, MUFF NAMED BIG 12 PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Senior JuliAnne Chisholm and sophomore Alex Muff both were honored for their performances against Kansas and Texas Tech to open Big 12 Conference action being selected as Big 12 Players of the Week (9/20).

Chisholm led the conference in kills (4.86) and points (5.36) for the week, and Muff led all players in hitting percentage (.567) and blocks (2.29) through the first two conference matches. The two combined to lead the Wildcats over rival KU in four sets, including a dramatic comeback in the fourth set after trailing 18-8, and a dominating sweep over the Red Raiders.

This was the first Big 12 Player of the Week award of their careers for both Chisholm and Muff.

## CROWN JULES

JuliAnne Chisholm has been on a roll for the Wildcats with seven matches of 15 or more kills in the last nine. Her 19-kill performance at Texas Tech (9/18) was a season-high for the senior despite the match lasting only three sets. That performance helped her earn her first career Big 12 Offensive Player of the Week award.

The senior outside hitter has embraced her new role as a team captain and currently leads the team in kills averaging 3.40 kills per set. Chisholm has already posted five double-doubles this season as she is averaging 2.05 digs a set. Chisholm has posted double digits in kills in all but three matches this season.

Chisholm was named MVP of the Varney's Kansas State Invitational after putting together three straight strong matches to help the Wildcats sweep the tournament. She posted 17 kills against Oral Roberts followed by 12 against Georgia Tech to go with her 12 digs for a double-double en route to winning the tournament.

The 2009 Academic All-American also leads the team off the court as she holds a 3.97 GPA with four degrees soon to be on her shelf in life sciences, kinesiology, pre-med and gerontology.

## MATTIE MAGIC

Senior libero Lauren Mathewson has picked up 2010 where she left off 2009 averaging 4.43 digs a set through 16 matches. Mathewson has posted five 20-dig matches and was one shy in two. She is currently ranked fourth in the conference in digs per set.

She earned her second All-Tournament team honor of the season following the UK Invitational where she outshined liberos from two of the nation's top teams. Against No. 17 Florida State, Mathewson posted 26 digs while Florida State libero Jenna Romanelli had 23. Then, against No. 16 Kentucky the 5-6 senior again put up 22 digs. Mathewson led the tournament in digs for the weekend earning her the libero spot on the All-Tournament Team.

Her two 20-dig performances in Kentucky also pushed her closer to Laura Downey for second most 20-dig matches in a career. Mathewson now has 20 after the Missouri match two weeks ago and needs just two more to move past Downey. Mathewson recently moved past Downey in career digs as the senior now stands in third with 1,481 and needs 98 to pass Kim Zschau for second all-time.

## K-STATE FAMILY BUSINESS

The Kansas State volleyball team has been run like a family under the direction of Suzie Fritz, and now there is a K-State family connection on the roster. Sophomore middle blocker Alex Muff is a second generation Wildcat student-athlete as her father Kevin played basketball at K-State. Freshman outside hitter Courtney Traxson also is a

***CHRISTMAS IN SEPTEMBER?***

Kansas State head coach Suzie Fritz has compared it to Christmas and her birthday. She's talking about the upgrades to Ahearn Field House for the 2010 season.

While in Hawaii, new chairback seats were installed on the south side of the court for season ticket holders, and new purple bleachers installed on the north side for students and more season ticket holders. The players and coaches got their first look at them at their first practice back from Hawaii on August 31.

A day later, the project was completed when a large purple banner proudly baring a Powercat logo was hung above the bleachers adding to the atmosphere. The upgrades were made possible through a one-time donation by the Student Government Association and generous donations from supporters of K-State Volleyball.

***CHISHOLM MAKES THE GRADE***

Outside hitter JuliAnne Chisholm became the school's fourth Academic All-American being selected to the 2009 CoSIDA/ESPN the Magazine Academic All-America Volleyball Team. She was chosen on the third team and held a perfect 4.0 GPA in athletic training/pre-medicine.

Chisholm was eligible for the Academic All-America Team after her selection to the first team of the CoSIDA/ESPN the Magazine Academic All-District Team where she was joined by teammate Kelsey Chipman. The pair also made Academic All-Big 12 First Team along with Abby Fay and Lauren Mathewson.

***K-STATE PICKED NINTH IN BIG 12***

After finishing ninth in the Big 12 Conference in 2009, the Wildcats were picked to finish in the exact same spot this year. K-State received 37 points in the poll and was just one point behind in-state rival Kansas.

Nebraska was the preseason favorite receiving eight of nine first-place votes. Texas received the remaining two first-place votes and is picked to finish second. After a deep run in the NCAA Tournament, Iowa State returns some of its key players from a year ago and is picked to finish third again. Oklahoma and Missouri round out the top five.

**K-STATE TRAVELS TO EUROPE**

This May the Kansas State volleyball team had the exciting opportunity to play in Europe on a foreign tour thanks to the generosity of USA Athletes International. The Wildcats traveled to Budapest, Hungary; Ljubljana, Slovenia and Venice, Italy, and competed in five matches over the week.

The trip to Europe provided the Wildcats with the chance to play a different styles than the American game and grow both on the court and off it as teammates. Some highlights from the trip included a guided tour of Budapest as the players learned about the rich history and political changes of the city and Hungary since its founding in 958 A.D. The sights included, Hungarian Parliament, Fisherman's Bastion and Mathias Church, Chain Bridge and Heroes' Square.

While in Hungary, the Wildcats took on the Hungarian National Team and saw a familiar face on the other side of the net. Prior to the match, former Wildcat, Rita Liliom went through her team initiation as she wore her National Team uniform for the first time against her former team after recently being added to the Hungarian National Team. The Wildcats also saw Vali Hejjas while in Budapest. Hejjas was K-State's first Hungarian player and earned All-America status in 2004 and helped K-State to the Big 12 title in 2003.

In Slovenia, the Wildcats toured the largest cave in Europe and visited the capital city of Ljubljana - The Dragon City. In Ljubljana, the Wildcats saw St. Peter's Church where the Pope visited in the 1990's. The church is estimated to be more than 1,000 years old as it was built during the Middle Ages. As a true testament to how small the world can be, the Wildcats ran into a K-State alumnus on the streets of Ljubljana. The Dragon City was full of fun facts as well where the mayor accepts his monthly salary based on his approval rating.

While in Italy, the players experienced real Italian cuisine, learned of the long tradition of glass factories and absorbed the rich history of another amazing city on their tour. The Wildcats toured one of the glass factories on the island of Murano, went on a traditional gondola ride through the Grand Canal and saw the amazing Piazza San Marco.

The trip was made possible by USA Athletes International. The group is a non-profit organization that takes student-athletes from across the nation to create teams for international play in a number of different sports. USA Athletes International donated the trip to Kansas State Volleyball after seeing the team featured on *ESPN Outside the Lines* for a story about a cancelled trip to China in 2008. That trip was cancelled just days prior to departure after the trip organizer filed bankruptcy.

K-State Volleyball would again like to thank Darrell Phipps and William Edington from USA Athletes International for making the trip possible. A special thanks also goes out to trip director Petra Lehrner and bus driver Sorin. The Wildcats also wish to say thank you and good luck to their new friends with the Hungarian National Team, Vasas Sport Club, OK Vital and Cus Venezia.
