PLAYER TO WATCH



Senior libero Lauren Mathewson is currently ranked fourth in career digs at Kansas State. She needs just 8 digs to become the fourth player to reach the 1,400-dig mark and 59 to surpass Laura Downey for third on the list.

FIRST SERVE

Kansas State looks to open Big 12 Conference play with back-to-back wins as the Wildcats travel to take on the Texas Tech Red Raiders at noon on Saturday. K-State hopes to ride the momentum gained from its win over in-state rival Kansas on Wednesday night into the match in Lubbock.

K-State has been steadily improving throughout the season thanks to a challenging nonconference schedule that saw the Wildcats take on five ranked opponents and six NCAA Tournament teams from a year ago. The Wildcats pushed No. 16 Kentucky and No. 17 Florida State to five sets each.

The Wildcats opened Big 12 play with a commanding 3-1 win over KU complete with a come-from-behind rally in the fourth set to energize the crowd and roll into Lubbock with a win over a quality opponent. During the trip to Lubbock, K-State will hope to keep its recent success against the Red Raiders going with the Wildcats winning 10 straight over Tech and holding a 22-6 record in the Big 12 era overall.

Saturday's match is a chance for the Wildcats to start conference action with back-to-back wins for the fifth time in the Suzie Fritz era. The last time K-State won its first two conference matches was 2007 when the Wildcats swept Kansas and Baylor to open the campaign.

ON THE AIRWAVES

Saturday's match will be tape delayed on KMAN 1350 due to coverage of K-State football but can be heard live online at kstatesports.com and 1350kman.com with Brian Smoller on the call.

THE SERIES

Kansas State has controlled the series with Texas Tech winning 24 of the 32 meetings between the Wildcats and Red Raiders. Since the inception of the Big 12 Conference, K-State is 22-6 against Tech with the last win by the Red Raiders coming in 2004 in Manhattan in five sets. Head coach Suzie Fritz has lost just twice to Texas Tech.

THE COACHES

Kansas State: Suzie Fritz (Florida Atlantic '94) is in her 10th year as head coach of the Wildcats she is the winningest coach in the program's history in terms of wins (189) and is not far off of the best winning percentage in school history as well at .649.

Texas Tech: Trish Knight (Southwest Missouri State '80) is in her second year coaching the Red Raiders. Before taking over in Lubbock, Knight saw great success on the junior college level at Missouri State-West Plains where she took her team to 10 straight NJCAA National Volleyball Championship Tournaments.

SCOUTING THE RED RAIDERS

Texas Tech has a new look this year with a number of newcomers to the roster. Five freshman and two transfers round out the recruiting class for the Red Raiders to go with some returning experience at the middle blocker positions.

Junior middle/outside hitter Amanda Dowdy leads the Red Raiders again in 2010 after being the go-to player a year ago. Dowdy currently is pounding out 3.65 kills per set while adding 2.06 digs a set to help out on defense. No other player on Tech's roster is averaging more than 2.00 kills a set, and Dowdy has more than 200 more attempts than any other player as the Raiders rely heavily on her for production. Dowdy also is one of only two players to play in every set this season for Tech.

Barbara Conceicao is another experienced player for Tech at the middle blocker position. This season Conceicao is leading the Raiders in hitting percentage at .281 and is a force at the net stuffing 1.21 blocks a set. The Red Raiders are one of the top blocking teams in the conference early in the season averaging 2.44 to stand in fourth.

In their last match, freshman setter Brandy Huskey led the Red Raiders in assists with 32 in a 3-0 loss to Missouri and posted a double-double with 11 digs seeing her first significant time at setter since Tech's opening weekend. Karlyn Meyers has been Tech's primary setter this season averaging 8.57 assists per set.

Tech is looking for its first Big 12 Conference win in more than three years. The last time the Raiders won a conference match was their Big 12 opener in 2007 - a streak of 60 matches.

CATCHING UP WITH THE 'CATS

The Kansas State Wildcats opened Big 12 play with a win over in-state rival Kansas on Wednesday. The Wildcats had three players tally double digits in kills and in digs to keep the Jayhawks at bay. K-State's offense was rolling early in the match hitting over .200 in each of the first two sets while the defense stifled KU into hitting negative as a team to open the match and below .100 in the second thanks in part to solid blocking by the Wildcats.

K-State dominated at the net with 12 blocks in the match compared to KU's four. The Wildcats were averaging nearly four blocks a set in the match before only tallying one in the fourth set, which came in dramatic fashion as it was on match point to put the final nail in the coffin and send KU home with the loss.

Senior JuliAnne Chisholm posted her fourth double-double of the season with 15 kills and 10 digs while sophomore setter Caitlyn Donahue contributed a double-double as well with 12 digs and a career-high 45 assists. Both middle blockers shined on the night for the Wildcats as sophomore Alex Muff had career highs in both kills (12) and blocks (9) while hitting .500 to lead the team. Freshman Kaitlynn Pelger had 10 kills and was just one dig shy of a double-double herself. Pelger also had two aces and was at the line during one of K-State's crucial comeback runs in the fourth set when her serving helped the Wildcats score six straight points.

The Wildcats trailed 18-8 in the fourth set to KU before the rally started with Pelger at service. K-State would make another late charge and eventually fight off four set points for the Jayhawks to extend the set before finally getting the win 31-29 by outscoring KU 23-11 down the stretch.

PACKED WITH PURPLE

Ahearn Field House has been rocking this season with an average attendance of nearly 2,000 fans. After recent renovations to the seating were completed, the fans have come to watch the Wildcats play in droves with all but one home match reaching 1,300 in attendance. In the Big 12 Conference opener against Kansas, the Wildcat faithful fill the rafters with 3,160 fans to cheer the team to victory.

K-State fans have always been loyal to their Wildcats when it comes to volleyball with the fans ranking in the Top 30 in national attendance regularly. This season K-State is currently 16th in the nation in attendance and fourth in the Big 12 Conference behind only Nebraska (1), Texas (10) and Iowa State (15) as of matches played through September 12.

WILDCAT WALL

Kansas State has traditionally been one of the better blocking teams in the Big 12 Conference. After falling from the top four in the league the last two seasons, K-State is back near the top averaging 2.85 blocks a set to rank second the Big 12 and 10th in the nation. The Wildcats have posted 10 or more blocks in seven of 11 matches so far this season, including 13 at No. 5 Hawaii and 15 against 2009 NCAA Tournament team Georgia Tech.

The Wildcats are holding opponents to a hitting percentage of .157 thanks in part to the wall put up at the net by the young team. K-State's top four blockers include two sophomores and two true freshmen.

MATTIE MAGIC

Senior libero Lauren Mathewson has picked up 2010 where she left off 2009 averaging 4.43 digs a set through 11 matches. After a slow start in Hawaii, Mathewson posted four 20-dig matches in the last seven contests and was one shy in another. She is currently ranked fourth in the conference in digs per set.

She earned her second All-Tournament team honor of the season following the UK Invitational where she outshone liberos from two of the nation's top teams. Against No. 17 Florida State, Mathewson posted 26 digs while Florida State libero Jenna Romanelli had 23. Then, against No. 16 Kentucky the 5-6 senior again put up 22 digs. Mathewson led the tournament in digs for the weekend earning her the libero spot on the All-Tournament Team.

Her two 20-dig performances in Kentucky also pushed her closer to Laura Downey for second most 20-dig matches in a career. Mathewson now has 19 and needs just two more to tie Downey. Mathewson also is inching closer to Downey in career digs as the senior now stands in fourth with 1,392 and needs just 59 to move past Downey on that list as well.

Last season, Mathewson broke the school record for digs in a five-set match posting an impressive 41 in a win over No. 23 Texas A&M. Her defense helped guide K-State to its first win over a ranked opponent since opening weekend of 2007 when the Wildcats defeated Cal Poly. The 41 digs were also one dig shy of the Big 12 Conference record set just a week earlier by Iowa State's Ashley Mass against Baylor.

CROWN JULES

Senior outside hitter JuliAnne Chisholm has embraced her new role as a team captain and currently leads the team in kills averaging 3.53 kills per set. Chisholm has already posted four double-doubles this season as she is averaging 2.15 digs a set.

Chisholm has posted double digits in kills in all but two matches this season and is currently on a streak of six straight. Five of those matches she has posted 15 or more to lead the Wildcats offense.

Chisholm was named MVP of the Varney's Kansas State Invitational after putting together three straight strong matches to help the Wildcats sweep the tournament. She posted 17 kills against Oral Roberts followed by 12

against Georgia Tech to go with her 12 digs for a double-double en route to winning the tournament.

The 2009 Academic All-American also leads the team off the court as she holds a 3.97 GPA with four degrees soon to be on her shelf in life sciences, kinesiology, pre-med and gerontology.

KILLER KAITLYNN

Freshman middle blocker Kaitlynn Pelger has started her career strong and continues to get better as the season progresses. In her first action at the Chevron Rainbow Wahine Invitational she posted five kills and two digs against No. 16 UCLA. She then put on a performance that would highlight her selection to the All-Tournament Team against host No. 5 Hawaii.

Pelger was a wall against the Rainbows stuffing attack after attack. She totaled 10 block assists, which ties for second in school history for a three-set match. She also posted four kills against Hawaii. Then, in the final match of the tournament against No. 22 San Diego, Pelger's offense came to form with 13 kills and a .329 hitting percentage. She also added a solo block, three more block assists, two digs and an ace.

Pelger backed up her performance in Hawaii with a stellar home debut as she posted 15 kills on South Dakota hitting at a .364 clip and added four more blocks to her stat line. She has been one of the team's better servers so far through the season as well posting two aces against South Dakota.

She has continued to stay strong as the team's top blocker averaging 1.33 a set to rank third in the Big 12 and 19th in the nation. She has posted five or more blocks in half of K-State's matches and has some of the top performances in the conference so far this season at the net. Pelger has also proven to be one of the team's top servers as she posted four aces at No. 16 Kentucky. She leads the team in aces with 13 and posted two or more in three straight matches.

SENSATIONAL SOUTHPAW

Sophomore opposite Kathleen Ludwig has been one of the more consistent performers for the Wildcats this season contributing in a number of different categories. The lefty has provided five or more kills in each of the last eight matches, including five with a hitting percentage of .333 or better.

In the Big 12 opener against KU, Ludwig was stellar with eight kills and one error for a hitting percentage of .438 while adding seven digs and three blocks to the winning effort. Her serving has kept opponents off balance as she has posted nine aces on the year. Ludwig also has been one of the team's top passers posting three 10-dig matches thus far and adding two more with nine. Ludwig has twice been on the cusp of a double-double needing one kills or one dig to reach the mark.

MUFF STUFFS TOUGH

Sophomore middle blocker Alex Muff has increased her offensive and defensive production in 2010 after emerging midway through the season last year. Her 11-kill and .435 hitting percentage against Colorado last year has become a more familiar site as she has posted eight matches of at least a .300 hitting percentage and surpassed five blocks in five contests - matching her total from last season.

Muff has also had back-to-back matches of 10 or more kills, including a career-high 12 in the Big 12 opener against Kansas. She also notched a career-high in blocks as well in the win over the Jayhawks as she was in on nine stuffs to narrowly miss a rare double-double for a middle blocker. Muff hit .500 in the contest to lead the Wildcats and pull her hitting percentage for the year up to .348 ranking eighth in the Big 12.

She earned All-Tournament honors for her showing at the Varney's Kansas State Invitational. Over the three matches, Muff averaged 2.11 blocks while hitting .391 and posting 2.44 kills. This season muff has hit .316 or higher in five of seven matches and posted at least five blocks in five matches as well. At the UK Invitational she hit .500 in a sweep over VCU on 10 swings and posted her first 10-kill match of the season against No. 16 Kentucky as she pounded out 10 kills on a .364 hitting clip and added four blocks.

K-STATE FAMILY BUSINESS

The Kansas State volleyball team has been run like a family under the direction of Suzie Fritz, and now there is a K-State family connection on the roster. Sophomore middle blocker Alex Muff is a second generation Wildcat student-athlete as her father Kevin played basketball at K-State. Freshman outside hitter Courtney Traxson also is a Wildcat legacy. Her aunt Helen Bundy-Buchanan lettered for the K-State volleyball team in the mid-1980s and her older brother Cameron threw javelin for the Wildcat track and field team.

Senior JuliAnne Chisholm also gets to play with her cousin this season with freshman outside hitter Dakota Kaufman joining the team. The two paired up at Hillsboro High School for one season.

CHISHOLM MAKES THE GRADE

Outside hitter JuliAnne Chisholm became the school's fourth Academic All-American being selected to the 2009 CoSIDA/ESPN the Magazine Academic All-America Volleyball Team. She was chosen on the third team and held a perfect 4.0 GPA in athletic training/pre-medicine.

Chisholm was eligible for the Academic All-America Team after her selection to the first team of the CoSIDA/ESPN the Magazine Academic All-District Team where she was joined by teammate Kelsey Chipman. The pair also made Academic All-Big 12 First Team along with Abby Fay and Lauren Mathewson.

K-STATE PICKED NINTH IN BIG 12

After finishing ninth in the Big 12 Conference in 2009, the Wildcats were picked to finish in the exact same spot this year. K-State received 37 points in the poll and was just one point behind in-state rival Kansas.

Nebraska was the preseason favorite receiving eight of nine first-place votes. Texas received the remaining two first-place votes and is picked to finish second. After a deep run in the NCAA Tournament, Iowa State returns some of its key players from a year ago and is picked to finish third again. Oklahoma and Missouri round out the top five.

K-STATE TRAVELS TO EUROPE

This May the Kansas State volleyball team had the exciting opportunity to play in Europe on a foreign tour thanks to the generosity of USA Athletes International. The Wildcats traveled to Budapest, Hungary; Ljubljana, Slovenia and Venice, Italy, and competed in five matches over the week.

The trip to Europe provided the Wildcats with the chance to play a different styles than the American game and grow both on the court and off it as teammates. Some highlights from the trip included a guided tour of Budapest as the players learned about the rich history and political changes of the city and Hungary since its founding in 958 A.D. The sights included, Hungarian Parliament, Fisherman's Bastion and Mathias Church, Chain Bridge and Heroes' Square.

While in Hungary, the Wildcats took on the Hungarian National Team and saw a familiar face on the other side of the net. Prior to the match, former Wildcat, Rita Liliom went through her team initiation as she wore her National Team uniform for the first time against her former team after recently being added to the Hungarian National Team. The Wildcats also saw Vali Hejjas while in Budapest. Hejjas was K-State's first Hungarian player and earned All-America status in 2004 and helped K-State to the Big 12 title in 2003.

In Slovenia, the Wildcats toured the largest cave in Europe and visited the capital city of Ljubljana - The Dragon City. In Ljubljana, the Wildcats saw St. Peter's Church where the Pope visited in the 1990's. The church is estimated to be more than 1,000 years old as it was built during the Middle Ages. As a true testament to how small the world can be, the Wildcats ran into a K-State alumnus on the streets of Ljubljana. The Dragon City was full of fun facts as well where the mayor accepts his monthly salary based on his approval rating.

While in Italy, the players experienced real Italian cuisine, learned of the long tradition of glass factories and absorbed the rich history of another amazing city on their tour. The Wildcats toured one of the glass factories on the island of Murano, went on a traditional gondola ride through the Grand Canal and saw the amazing Piazza San Marco.

The trip was made possible by USA Athletes International. The group is a non-profit organization that takes student-athletes from across the nation to create teams for international play in a number of different sports.
