FIRST SERVE

The Wildcat volleyball team hosts its annual Varney's Kansas State Invitational this weekend at Ahearn Field House as the team continues its strong nonconference schedule in preparation for Big 12 Conference action. K-State will take on Georgia Tech, Loyola Marymount and Oral Roberts in the round-robin tournament.

K-State takes on Loyola Marymount from the deep West Coast Conference at 12:30 p.m. Friday to close the morning session of the tournament and then play Oral Roberts at 7:30 Friday night. The Wildcats close the tournament with the Georgia Tech Yellow Jackets, who are looking to return to the NCAA Tournament after losing in the first round a year ago.

The Wildcats will also be welcoming a number of former players as part of the K-State Volleyball Reunion this weekend. Last season, the Athletics Department began an initiative to host reunions for two to three teams each year to bring former Wildcats back to campus to see today's student-athletes in action. The reunion will begin with a welcome reception at the Alumni Center at 5 p.m. Friday.

Tickets are available for the tournament this weekend through the K-State Ticket Office with individual tickets on sale for \$7 for adults and \$4 for seniors and youth tickets. Saturday's match against Georgia Tech will be part of a Wildcat Weekend special as fans can get into the match for just \$3 with their ticket stub from Saturday's football game against UCLA.

ON THE AIRWAVES

K-State's matches this weekend can be heard on KMAN1350 with Brian Smoller calling the action and Rob Voelker assisting with color commentary. They can also be heard on the station's Web site www.kman1350.com. The pregame show starts 30 minutes prior to first serve. Friday night's match against Oral Roberts will be tape delayed live on the air due to other live coverage, but will be live online at kstatesports.com.

ONLINE

Live stats will be available through kstatesports.com for fans wanting to track the action live on the web. Live video streaming of the match will also be available through K-State's site with the radio call for audio.

THE SERIES

When the Wildcats take on Oral Roberts it will be the first time the two teams have met since 2004. That was their first meeting since 1995 as the two teams played regularly in the mid-90's and throughout the 80's. The series is currently tied with each team winning 11 matches.

K-State's match against Loyola Marymount will be the first time the two teams have tangled on the court.

Saturday night will be just the second meeting between the Wildcats and Yellow Jackets with Georgia Tech getting the edge 3-1 in 2002 at the South Florida Adidas Invitational.

THE COACHES

Kansas State: Suzie Fritz (Florida Atlantic '94) is in her 10th year as head coach of the Wildcats she is the winningest coach in the program's history in terms of wins (184) and is no far off of the best winning percentage in school history as well at .648.

Georgia Tech: Tonya Johnson (LSU '93) is in her second year leading the Yellow Jackets after taking her team to the NCAA Tournament last season and going 21-10.

Loyola Marymount: Tom Black (UC San Diego '96) is leading a program for the first time at the Division I level after coaching heading he UC San Diego program for five seasons. The team was ranked each week of his final four seasons at UC San Diego.

Oral Roberts: Sheera Sirola (Oral Roberts '98) is in her eighth year coaching her alma mater where she has accumulated a record of 140-89.

SCOUTING THE YELLOW JACKETS

Georgia Tech returns five starters from last year's NCAA Tournament team and is looking for another bid to the post-season. The Yellow Jackets opened their season last week by hosting the Georgia Tech Courtland Marriot Classic taking on Alabama A&M, Indiana and UAB. Georgia Tech fell in five sets to Indiana to open the tournament and responded with sweeps over Alabama A&M and UAB.

Monique Mead leads the attack for Georgia Tech averaging nearly four kills a set (3.91) through the first three matches of the season. She also has proven to be efficient at the outside hitter position hitting at a .270 clip. Mead also leads the team in aces.

Asia Stawicka sures up the Yellow Jackets' play at the net both offensively and defensively leading the team in kills averaging one a set and pounding out 2.27 kills per set on a .417 hitting percentage. As a team Georgia Tech is hitting .248 this season. Jordan McCullers leads the team in digs averaging 3.64 per set.

SCOUTING THE LIONS

Loyola Marymount has opened the season with a 2-1 record playing in a tournament hosted by No. 10 USC. The Lions lost to USC to start the tournament and then defeated Cal State Fullerton in five sets and swept Bucknell. The Lions used much of their roster over the weekend with 13 players seeing action.

Felicia Arriola leads the attack averaging 3.55 kills per set and hitting .240. She also leads the team in digs (2.82) through the first three matches of the season. Olivia Bailey directs the offense with 9.82 assists per set and helping the team to a hitting percentage of .224.

Fans will see something out of the norm for volleyball with the Lions on the floor this weekend. Arriola wears number 67 on her jersey, and Bailey has 55 on her back.

SCOUTING THE YELLOW GOLDEN EAGLES

Oral Roberts stands at 2-2 so far this season after going 2-1 at a tournament hosted by UT-Pan Am where the Golden Eagles defeated Lamar and UTPA while losing to Idaho State. They followed that with a loss to Arkansas in five sets at home on Tuesday.

Elizabeth McVicker leads ORU on offense averaging 2.44 kills per set, but the Golden Eagles spread the ball around with five players tallying 20 or more kills through four matches this season. The Eagles are hitting .241 as a team. Defensively, Cassidy Holmes is averaging nearly five digs a set (4.89) for the Eagles and leads the team in aces with seven as the team has combined for 17 so far.

CATCHING UP WITH THE 'CATS

The Wildcats tallied their first win of the season in their home opener against South Dakota on Wednesday night. More than 1,800 fans cheered K-State on in the newly renovated Ahearn Field House with new chairback seating and bleachers added this season along with a large purple banner to add to the atmosphere.

In the win 3-1 over South Dakota, freshman middle blocker Kaitlynn Pelger continued her emergence onto the college scene with a team-high 15 kills and four blocks while hitting .364. Senior outside hitter JuliAnne Chisholm posted her first double-double of the season with 11 kills and a career-high 15 digs in the winning effort. Senior libero Lauren Mathewson also posted 23 digs to keep the Coyotes from stealing a win on the Wildcats' home floor.

The Wildcats opened their season at the Chevron Rainbow Wahine Invitational as they faced three of the nation's top programs. K-State fell in three sets to No. 16 UCLA and then to host No. 5 Hawaii. On the final day of action K-State dropped to No. 22 San Diego in four sets.

The weekend was not without excitement as the Wildcats battled closely with the Rainbow Wahine throughout most of the match as the large crowd gave multiple standing ovations following long rallies no matter which team scored the point. K-State saw a number of freshman receive extended playing time, three started every match as well.

Middle blocker Kaitlynn Pelger highlighted the group of freshman as she was named to the All-Tournament Team. Dakota Kaufman and Courtney Traxson also made the starting rotation at outside hitter. Defensive specialist Tristan McCarty played a big role off the bench in the back row serving and passing in Kaufman's spot. McCarty tallied an ace and posted 13 digs over the three matches.

KILLER KAITLYNN

Freshman middle blocker Kaitlynn Pelger has started her career strong and continues to get better as the season progresses. In her first action at the Chevron Rainbow Wahine Invitational she posted five kills and two digs against No. 16 UCLA. She then put on a performance that would highlight her selection to the All-Tournament Team against host No. 5 Hawaii.

Pelger was a wall against the Rainbows stuffing attack after attack. She totaled 10 block assists, which ties for second in school history for a three-set match. She also posted four kills against Hawaii. Then, in the final match of the tournament against No. 22 San Diego, Pelger's offense came to form with 13 kills and a .329 hitting percentage. She also added a solo block, three more block assists, two digs and an ace.

Pelger backed up her performance in Hawaii with a stellar home debut as she posted 15 kills on South Dakota hitting at a .364 clip and added four more blocks to her stat line. She has been one of the team's better servers so far through the season as well posting two aces against South Dakota.

CHISHOLM MAKES THE GRADE

Junior outside hitter JuliAnne Chisholm became the school's fourth Academic All-American being selected to ESPN the Magazine Academic All-America Volleyball Team. She was chosen on the third team and currently holds a perfect 4.0 GPA in athletic training/pre-medicine.

Chisholm was eligible for the Academic All-America Team after her selection to the first team of the CoSIDA/ESPN the Magazine Academic All-District Team where she was joined by teammate Kelsey Chipman. The pair also made Academic All-Big 12 First Team along with Abby Fay and Lauren Mathewson.

MATTIE MAGIC

Junior libero Lauren Mathewson earned the team's first Big 12 Player of the Week award of the season in 2009 with her shining performances against No. 23 Texas A&M and Texas Tech. Mathewson set a school record for most digs in a match with 41 against Texas A&M as the Wildcats got their first win over a ranked opponent in more than two years.

Mathewson followed that performance with 19 digs against Texas Tech in four sets and a trio of aces. She averaged 6.67 digs a set during the week and 0.33 aces to receive the honor. It is the second of her career.

She went on a tear over the last half of conference play for the Wildcats including her record setting night against the Aggies (11/4) with 41 digs. Mathewson became the first player in school history to post back-to-back 30-dig matches after posting 30 in a four-set loss at Oklahoma (10/31).

For the year Mathewson averaged 4.72 digs a set and is fifth in career digs with 1,515. After posting the fourth best digs total in 2008 at 505, Mathewson improved on that mark last season with 514 digs.

CROWN JULES

Junior outside hitter JuliAnne Chisholm embraced her new role in the starting lineup last season and turned into a player the Wildcats can go to at any point in the match. Chisholm posted a career-high 22 kills in the loss at Oklahoma and hit .236 for the match.

Chisholm continued to ride that momentum from the Oklahoma match with 20 kills against No. 23 Texas A&M helping guide the Wildcats to their first win over a ranked opponent in more than two years. She began the year on fire as she was named to the BYU Nike Classic all-tournament team after picking apart defenses for 45 kills and utilizing a variety of shots to do it. She backed that up with a career-high 21 kills against South Dakota.

ALEX ATTACK

Freshman middle blocker Alex Muff had her breakout party midway through the season and she put together back-to-back matches with stellar performances at Colorado and then against No. 23 Baylor. In a win at Colorado, Muff had 11 kills and .435 hitting percentage and added two block assists. Next time on the court, Muff hit .308 with five kills and had a career-high five block assists. Against Texas Tech, Muff posted seven block assists to go with eight kills and a .385 hitting percentage.

K-STATE PICKED NINTH IN BIG 12

After finishing ninth in the Big 12 Conference in 2009, the Wildcats were picked to finish in the exact same spot this year. K-State received 37 points in the poll and was just one point behind in-state rival Kansas.

Nebraska was the preseason favorite receiving eight of nine first-place votes. Texas received the remaining two first-place votes and is picked to finish second. After a deep run in the NCAA Tournament, Iowa State returns some of its key players from a year ago and is picked to finish third again. Oklahoma and Missouri round out the top five.

K-STATE TRAVELS TO EUROPE

This May the Kansas State volleyball team had the exciting opportunity to play in Europe on a foreign tour thanks to the generosity of USA Athletes International. The Wildcats traveled to Budapest, Hungary; Ljubljana, Slovenia and Venice, Italy, and competed in five matches over the week.



The trip to Europe provided the Wildcats with the chance to play a different styles than the American game and grow both on the court and off it as teammates. Some highlights from the trip included a guided tour of Budapest as the players learned about the rich history and political changes of the city and Hungary since its founding in 958 A.D. The sights included, Hungarian Parliament, Fisherman's Bastion and Mathias Church, Chain Bridge and Heroes' Square.

While in Hungary, the Wildcats took on the Hungarian National Team and saw a familiar face on the other side of the net. Prior to the match, former Wildcat, Rita Liliom went through her team initiation as she wore her National Team uniform for the first time against her former team after recently being added to the Hungarian National Team. The Wildcats also saw Vali Hejjas while in Budapest. Hejjas was K-State's first Hungarian player and earned All-America status in 2004 and helped K-State to the Big 12 title in 2003.

In Slovenia, the Wildcats toured the largest cave in Europe and visited the capital city of Ljubljana - The Dragon City. In Ljubljana, the Wildcats saw St. Peter's Church where the Pope visited in the 1990's. The church is estimated to be more than 1,000 years old as it was built during the Middle Ages. As a true testament to how small the world can be, the Wildcats ran into a K-State alumnus on the streets of Ljubljana. The Dragon City was full of fun facts as well where the mayor accepts his monthly salary based on his approval rating.

While in Italy, the players experienced real Italian cuisine, learned of the long tradition of glass factories and absorbed the rich history of another amazing city on their tour. The Wildcats toured one of the glass factories on the island of Murano, went on a traditional gondola ride through the Grand Canal and saw the amazing Piazza San Marco.



The trip was made possible by USA Athletes International. The group is a non-profit organization that takes student-athletes from across the nation to create teams for international play in a number of different sports. USA Athletes International donated the trip to Kansas State Volleyball after seeing the team featured on *ESPN Outside the Lines* for a story about a cancelled trip to China in 2008. That trip was cancelled just days prior to departure after the trip organizer filed bankruptcy.

K-State Volleyball would again like to thank Darrell Phipps and William Edington from USA Athletes International for making the trip possible. A special thanks also goes out to trip director Petra Lehrner and bus driver Sorin. The Wildcats also wish to say thank you and good luck to their new friends with the Hungarian National Team, Vasas Sport Club, OK Vital and Cus Venezia.
