CAMP DIRECTOR

Frank Tavani enters his ninth year as the head coach of Lafayette football, and 20th as the director of the Leopard Youth Football Camp. Tavani, who founded the camp in 1989, is no stranger to winning football on College Hill.

Tavani guided the Leopards to three straight Patriot League championships, in 2004, 2005 and 2006 and the program's first three appearances in the NCAA Division I Playoffs. He was the unanimous choice for Patriot League Coach of the Year honors in 2004 and led Lafayette to consecutive top 25 rankings from *The Sports Network* and *ESPN/USA Today* in 2004 and 2005. Lafayette also spent time in the top 25 in 2007 and featured the top ranked defense in the nation.

In his 21 years at Lafayette, Tavani has been a part of six Patriot League titles, helping guide the Leopards to crowns as an assistant coach in 1988, 1992 and 1994, to go with the last three championships as head coach.

Tavani's teams are also getting it done in the classroom. Lafayette has boasted 23 academic all-district selections under Tavani and has led the Patriot League in academic all-district selections five times in the past eight years. Tavani has also coached four Patriot League Football Student-Athletes of the Year.

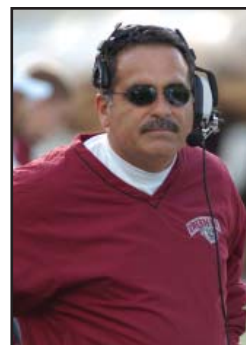
Tavani was a member of Lafayette's staff for 13 seasons before becoming head coach and was the associate head coach for six seasons. He has been the top recruiter since 1987.

Tavani has recruited and coached Lafayette's four all-time rushing yardage leaders including Erik Marsh '95 who is also all-time leading rusher in Patriot League history. He also mentored the all-time leading passer in Patriot League history, Marko Glavic '04. A four-year starter, Glavic holds league records for career passing yards and total offense.

Tavani was an outstanding running back as an undergraduate at Lebanon Valley, earning team MVP honors twice. As a senior, he became the school's first player to rush for 1,000 yards in season and was named *Associated Press* All-American. He was inducted into the school's Athletic Hall of Fame in the fall of 1988. In 2004, he was inducted to the inaugural class of the Lebanon Catholic High School Hall of Fame and entered the Pennsylvania Sports Hall of Fame Central Chapter in 2006.

Tavani earned a bachelor's degree in Psychology from Lebanon Valley in 1975 and has completed graduate work in Counselor Education.

Tavani and his wife, Agnes, reside on College Hill and have four children, Liam, Meghan, Daniel and Bridget.
