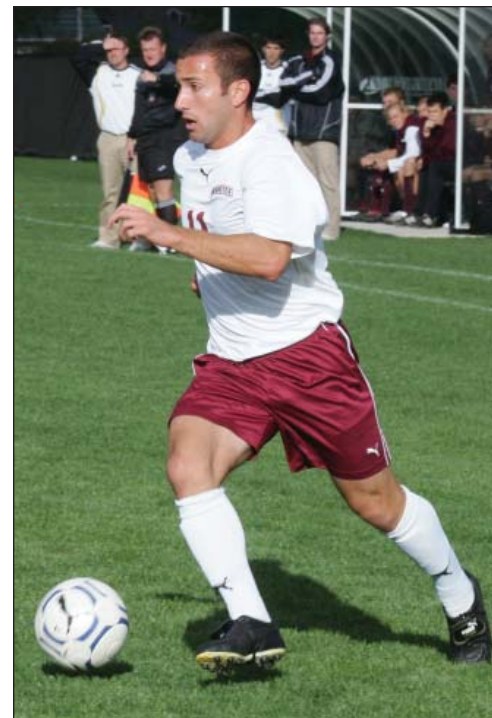

Director: Dennis Bohn



Dennis Bohn is in his seventh season at Lafayette. In those seven years, the Lafayette men's soccer program has produced nothing but winning teams. Bohn has led the Leopards to seven-straight winning seasons, five-consecutive 10-plus win campaigns, a pair of Patriot League championships and two NCAA Tournament berths. He has 73 career victories, all at Lafayette.

In the last five years, Lafayette has totaled 57 victories, notching its fifth-straight double-digit win campaign in 2007 with a 10-6-4 record. The season was highlighted by a trip to the Patriot League Tournament Championship game.

Bohn became the 18th coach in the history of Lafayette soccer in March, 2001. Prior to that, he served two years as an assistant coach for the Leopards. Before coming to Lafayette, Bohn spent the 1998 season as the assistant head coach at his alma mater, Columbia University.

Director: Mick Statham



Lafayette women's soccer coach Mick Statham will enter his third year at the helm of the Leopards in 2008. Statham offers experience at every level of soccer coaching in the U.S. and in his native England.

Before his arrival on College Hill, Statham spent the 2005 season as the top assistant coach at Florida State where he helped guide the women's soccer program to a berth in the College Cup (Final Four). Prior to coaching at Florida State, Statham spent time assisting at Penn on the women's soccer staff and Philadelphia University on the men's side. Statham has been connected to Pennsylvania for almost a decade, coaching at the club and high school levels.

In 2002-03, Statham made the move to the professional ranks, taking over as an administrator/assistant coach with the Philadelphia Charge of the WUSA where he coached some of the world's top soccer players. Then, in 2004, he served as a staff member with the US U-19 Women's National Team.
