LAMAR CONCLUDES FIRST SLC WEST SWING AT UTSA

Quick Hits

** Lamar concludes its first swing through the Southland Conference's West Division with a road game at UTSA Saturday night. Both teams enter having lost their last three games.

** LU's last visit to San Antonio was a 79-72 loss last February. The game of runs saw Lamar lead 19-11 before a UTSA 14-2 run. UTSA led 26-230 at the break before the Cardinals used an 11-0 run early in the second to cut the margin to 42-41. LU secured a 52-42 lead with 14:41 remaining but UTSA fought back and eventually took a 60-58 lead with just under eight minutes to play. Their lead moved to six and the closest Lamar got was 71-67 with 3:03 on the clock.

** Lamar leads the 28-game series 16-12. The winning team has scored at least 67 points in the last 10 meetings.

** Two players on the Lamar roster have ties to UTSA and San Antonio. Sophomore Charlie Harper prepped at Madison HS where he was a three-year letterwinner for the Mavericks. Sophomore E.B. Davis was a walk-on at UTSA as a freshman two years ago and appeared in 18 games, including 10 SLC contests.

** Lamar is 8-3 this season when scoring at least 74 points, 8-1 when leading at the half, 8-3 when shooting better from the floor and 8-2 when blocking more

shots than the opposition.

** Lamar's last two victories came when it trailed at the half. Prior to the come-from-behind win over UTA, the Cards had lost 21-straight when down at the break. They are 2-10 when trailing at the break this year and 8-1 when leading. LU has trailed at the half in all five SLC games - by 14 at SLU, three vs. UTA, one vs. McNeese, 10 at AMCC and 1 vs. Texas State.

** Coaching staffs from both teams will wear sneakers during Saturday's game as part of Coaches vs. Cancer Suits and Sneakers Awareness Weekend, a collaborative initiative of the American Cancer Society and the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC). Participating NABC member coaches will wear sneakers instead of dress shoes with their suits during this weekend's games to demonstrate their support for the American Cancer Society and its vision of a world with less cancer and more birthdays. Fans also are encouraged to wear sneakers to games this weekend to show their support. Lamar will also recognize the event at home on Wednesday against Central Arkansas.

pointers made (1.2), 3-pointers attempted (2.7), FT made (4.4) and FT attempts (5.8). He and UTA's Marquez Haynes are the only players in the SLC to rank among the top 10 in scoring and assists, while Miles also appears among the leaders in 3-point pct. and minutes.

Miles has scored in double figures 16 times and has four 20-plus point games. He scored 25 points in the win over McNeese four games ago after just 16 in the three previous games. He has gone 4-for-11 from outside in the last three games after an 0-for-7 stretch in the previous four contests. He also has three double-doubles this year and five in his career.

Justin Nabors - F

Leads the SLC and ranks 31st in the NCAA in rebounds (9.7), while leading LU in FG pct. (.512), FG made (5.3), FG attempts (10.2), while ranking second in scoring (13.7) and blocked shots (0.8). Has scored in double figures 15 times, but had his streak of 12 straight snapped with a 9-point game at SHSU. Has posted five of his SLC-leading nine double-doubles in the last eight games and is averaging 17.6 ppg and 10.4 rpg in SLC play.

He is six rebounds shy of being one of 23 players in the country to average a double-double.

Kendrick Harris - G

Third on the team in scoring (12.4), second in assists (2.9), steals (1.3) and minutes (32.5). He has produced 12 double-figure scoring games, including 10 of the last 13. Currently averaging 13.6 ppg in the last 13 contests.

Has gone 8-for-16 (.500) from 3-point range in the past five games, after just 7-for-42 (.167) in the previous 16. Tied his season-high with three steals at AMCC, vs. Texas State and at SHSU in the last three games.

Series History

Saturday's game marks the 29th all-time meeting with UTSA. The Cardinals lead the series 16-12 overall and 8-7 in San Antonio.

UTSA won both ball games last season - on a tip-in at the buzzer in Beaumont and a come-from-behind win before a large Homecoming crowd in San Antonio. Prior to that the Cardinals had won six consecutive - including four-straight in the Alamo City - after dropping 10 of the previous 11. That stretch followed the first nine games in the teams' history in which LU came out on top in every game.

About UTSA

UTSA is 12-6 on the season but just 2-3 in Southland Conference play following consecutive

losses at UTA (72-66), to A&M-Corpus Christi (66-62 in overtime) and at I-35 rival Texas State (76-62). The Roadrunners opened the season with a 10-3 non-conference mark that was highlighted by a season-opening victory at Iowa (62-50) in the CBE Classic. The 10 non-conference wins are a school record.

UTSA is a veteran team led by four players who average double figures in points and have started all 18 games - Devin Gibson 13.0 ppg, 5.2 rpg and 4.7 apg; Morris Smith IV 12.8 ppg, 4.2 rpg and team-high 45 3-pointers; Omar Johnson 11.1 ppg, 2.5 rpg; and Terry Fields 10.3 ppg, team-high 6.2 rpg and .593 FG pct. Post man DeMarco Stepter has come on this season and averages 7.5 ppg and 5.6 rpg in 18.6 minutes per contest, while Melvin Johnson III comes off the bench with 7.8 ppg.

The Roadrunners lead the SLC in free throw percentage (.747) and 3-point field goal defense (.285). UTSA is 8-0 when holding opponents under 60 points, with five of those coming at the Convocation Center. They are 7-1 at home this season.

Brooks Thompson is 51-58 in his fourth season at UTSA, after serving as an assistant at Arizona State for two seasons. His previous head coaching experience came at Yavapai College in Prescott, Ariz. (pronounced Press-kit), where he went 55-14 (.797) in two seasons from 2002-04.

Senior Justin Nabors is averaging 13.7 points and 9.7 rebounds, while recording an SLC-high nine double-doubles and 10 double-digit rebound games. He has missed an additional two double-doubles by just one rebound as well. In six conference games, the Holly Springs, Miss. native is putting up 16.2 points and 9.7 boards per contest. He is shooting 53.1 pct. in league play.

He has scored 613 points for a 12.3 career scoring average. He also has 390 rebounds to put his board averages at 7.8 rpg, which is on pace to finish among the school's top-15.

Lamar In The NCAA Stats

In the most recent NCAA statistics that were released on Friday, Lamar is ranked in the top half of the country in four team categories. LU is 43rd in rebound margin (+5.0), 89th in blocked shots (4.2), 87th in assists (14.5) and 145th in scoring offense (70.4).

Individually, Justin Nabors is 31st in rebounds (9.7) and 74th in field goal pct. (51.2), Charlie Harper is 149th in rebounding (7.4), Coy Custer is 94th in blocked shots (1.7) and Anthony Miles is 196th in assists (3.7).

Where The Points Are Coming From

Lamar is averaging 40.7 points per game on 2-point field goals which translates to 59.1 pct of its scoring and ranks 30th in the country. LU is getting 25.5 pct of its offense from the free throw line which is 17th nationally.

The Cardinals' shooting percentages may also be misleading because, while the team is shooting just 28.1 percent from outside, they are connecting on 48.1 pct. of their shots from inside the arc. They are shooting 43.1 on the season overall.

Roc Climbing Lamar Victories Chart

Lamar head coach Steve Roccaforte picked up his 54th coaching victory with the Cardinals' win over Rice on Dec. 23. That moved him into sole possession for fifth place on the school's all-time list. Grey Giovanine is next with 80 wins in six seasons from 1993-99.

Home Record Under Roc

Lamar is 44-12 (.800) overall at home since the beginning of the 2006-07 season.

The Cardinals completed their six-game homestand around the turn of the calendar with a 5-1 record and have now won 19 of their last 20 non-conference home games. LU has posted a 25-4 non-league mark in four seasons under head coach Steve Roccaforte.

Rebounding A Key For LU

Lamar has been strong on the glass all season, averaging 40.1 rebounds per game with a plus-5.1 rebound margin. The rebounding off. puts LU first in the Southland while the margin is third and 43rd in the NCAA. LU ranks second in the SLC in offensive boards (14.5) and first in defensive rpg (25.5).

In league play, the Cards have a 0.0 margin and average 37.5 rpg - ranking third and ninth in the SLC, respectively.

The Cards posted season highs in rebounds (53) and rebound margin (+25) against Louisiana College (12/9). LU grabbed a season-best 24 offensive rebounds at Marshall and turned them into a season-best 30 second chance points.

Non-Conference Board Work Highest In 4 Years Under Coach Roc

With one regular-season non-conference game remaining (Lyon College on Feb. 9), Lamar has averaged 40.9 rebounds per game through 15 of its 16 non-SLC contests. Lamar currently ranks eighth in the SLC and 198th nationally with a .671 free throw percentage. The Cardinals have averaged 26.8 attempts per game and 18.0 makes. LU has made 19 or more FTs 11 times this season and is 9-2 in those games. Lamar head coach Steve Roccaforte announced that freshman F Osas Ebomwonyi and freshman G Jonathan Garza will sit out the 2009-10 season and utilize a redshirt season. Both players played their high school ball at Pflugerville (Texas) H.S.

Former Cardinal Kenny Dawkins Made Rio Grande Valley Vipers D-League Roster

Former two-time all-conference honoree Kenny Dawkins made the final roster of the NBA Development League's Rio Grande Valley Vipers.

Dawkins finished his two-year career at Lamar with 818 points - for a 14.9 ppg average, 240 assists, 176 rebounds and 105 steals. His 85.3 career free throw percentage ranks third all-time in school history. He made at least one 3-pointer in 47 of 55 career games and 113 overall makes from outside.

The Vipers are an affiliate of the Houston Rockets.

He is now a member of the ABA's Southeast Texas Mavericks, along with former Lamar teammates Lamar Sanders and Curry Todd.

About the Six-Game Homestand

After playing six of five games on the road over an 18-day stretch in late November and early December, Lamar played six-straight home contests over a 27-day span. Included in the stretch - where LU went 5-1 - were victories over Conference USA schools Rice and Tulane and Arkansas State of the Sun Belt Conference.

The six-game stretch was the second-longest in school history, behind the nine-game skein of Jack Martin's 1971-72 squad. Martin's 1957-58 team also closed the year with a six-straight home contests.

Beginning with the Louisiana College game (Dec. 9), Lamar will play 12 of its next 16 games at home and 15 of its final 23 in Beaumont.

Nabors Breaks Into The Record Books

Senior Justin Nabors had a career-high 24 rebounds in the win over Louisiana College (12/9), making him just the 15th player in school history to grab at least 20 boards in a game. While it was obviously Nabors' career-high, it was notable for a few other reasons. It tied the Montagne Center record for rebounds by a Lamar player, tied this year's NCAA single-game high at the time (which has since been bested by a 25-rebound game by Kevin Thompson of Morgan St.) and were four shy of both the Lamar and Southland single-game marks.

In fact, the last time a Cardinal had a 20-rebound game came more than 20 years ago when Adrian Caldwell had 21 against Louisiana-Lafayette on Feb. 2, 1989.

Did You Know?

The last time a Lamar player posted a 20-point, 20-rebound game - Adrian Caldwell went for 26 points and 21 boards in the Montagne Center on Feb. 2, 1989. The opposing team that day was Southwestern Louisiana - now known as Louisiana-Lafayette. That was actually his second-consecutive game with at least 20 rebounds after he grabbed a then Montagne Center record 24 five days earlier against Texas-Pan American.

Cards Have Fared Well In Pre-Christmas Games

Lamar improved to 36-22 all-time record in the final game before the Christmas holiday, including a current four-game winning streak, all coming under Steve Roccaforte who is now 4-0 following the 77-61 rout of Rice on Dec. 23.

Jack Martin was 13-12 in pre-Christmas games, Billy Tubbs was 3-4, Pat Foster was 6-0, Tom Abatamarco was 0-2, Tony Branch was 1-1, Mike Newell was 2-1, Grey Giovanine was 5-1 and Mike Deane was 3-1.

The Dec. 23rd date with Rice tied six other teams

for the game closest to the front-end of the Dec. 25 date. The Cards improved to 3-4 on this date.

It was also the fifth time LU and Rice have met before the break, tying UTPA for the most in school history.

November Numbers

Lamar completed November with a 3-4 record to move to 12-11 in the month over the last four years under coach Steve Roccaforte. LU has won six of its last nine.

Lamar One of the Nation's Youngest Teams In 09-10

While the Cardinals return six players who saw significant action over the past two seasons, this is still a young team with 10 freshmen and sophomores on the 16-man roster. In fact, with 10 underclassmen, Lamar ranks among the 20 youngest teams in the country. Harvard is the youngest with 14 underclassmen, followed by Toledo and UCF at 13. Denver was the youngest team in the nation a year ago and ranks tied for fifth this season with 11.

Ashton Hall, Justin Nabors and Lawrence Nwevo have each received their bachelor's degree either in May or August. Nabors and Nwevo are working on a second bachelor's degree, while Hall is working on a teacher certification program that will allow him to pursue a coaching/teaching career.

In Steve Roccaforte's coaching career, he has now been on the bench with a total of five players who completed their coursework before their eligibility had expired. Canisius and Niagara each have two players on their teams this season who have received their diplomas. The Lamar trio are part of five players within the Southland Conference to have their degrees, joining Ashton Mitchell of Sam Houston State and Michael McConathy of Northwestern State.

2009-10 LU Squad Tallest In School History

Fourth-year head coach Steve Roccaforte has assembled a 15-member roster with no student-athlete measuring under six feet. In fact, seven players are at least 6-7 and five top out at 6-9 or taller. The average height is 77.8 inches (6-5 ¾), just a bit taller than the previous tallest team of 77.7 in. in 05-06.

Cardinals Sport New Uniforms

Lamar is wearing newly designed Nike uniforms during the 2009-10 season. The new threads use Nike's Elite-Fit pattern, with the front of the uniform constructed of a lightweight sphere fabric, while the back is an ultra-lightweight mini mesh, engineered to help the players stay cool along their spine, which is where they traditionally heat up the most.

The white home jerseys have 'CARDINALS' written in block lettering with red numerals and black trim. The red away jerseys have 'LAMAR' written in block lettering with white numerals and black trim. The shorts have alternating red, white and black blocks down each side.

This is the first uniform change for the men's team since August of 2004.

What's Back

Lamar returns six letterwinners and two starters from the past two seasons. The returning starters are senior guard Ashton Hall (8.8 ppg, 3.9 rpg in 08-09) and sophomore guard Anthony Miles (6.3 ppg, 2.8 rpg). The other four letterwinners include seniors Justin Nabors (11.2 ppg, 6.4 rpg in 07-08) and Lawrence Nwevo (4.8 ppg, 2.8 rpg in 07-08), who both sat out last season with injuries. Junior postman Coy Custer (5.1 ppg, 3.5 rpg) and sophomore forward Charlie Harper (4.8 ppg, 3.6 ppg) account for the other returnees.

The Cardinal roster features eight new faces and a redshirt, consisting of five true freshman, two sophomore transfers and a pair of junior transfers. As many as six or seven of the newcomers could see considerable playing time early. Juniors Kendrick Harris and Reggie Mathis, along with freshmen Osas Ebomwonyi and Justin Wesley have shown solid skills a a strong knowledge of the playing schemes in practice while adjusting to Division I ball nicely.

Donte Lopez Added To Roster

Lamar added freshman Donte Lopez to the roster prior to the season-opener against Huston-Tillotson. Lopez recently completed his first fall with the LU football team. The 5-foot-9, 180-pound guard played both sports at West Brook HS in Beaumont. He was a three-year letterwinner in hoops and a two-year starter at point guard for the Bruins. He was named the District 21-5A Offensive Player of the year as a senior after he averaged 16 points per game. He also picked up second team Super Gold honors from the *Beaumont Enterprise* and was a finalist for the James Gamble Mr. Outside Award in 2009.

2009-10 Schedule Notes

Steve Roccaforte

7th season at Lamar

4th season as head coach

Embarking on his fourth year at the helm, Steve Roccaforte has begun making headway in returning the Lamar University basketball program to its storied past. He had the Cardinals within a game of playing the conference tournament title game his first season and went 13-3 to lead LU to its first SLC regular-season championship in more than 20 years.

In his first three seasons, Lamar has gone 34-10 in the Montagne Center and compiled a 27-21 regular-season mark in Southland Conference play.

Last season the Cardinals led the SLC in home attendance for the seventh-consecutive season, averaging more than 3,500 fans per game with a season-high 6,182 on hand for the 85-79 win over Big 12 member Texas Tech.

Lamar benefitted from Roccaforte's up-tempo style as it finished the year averaging 73.3 points per contest.

The league's coaches recognized his abilities to develop players into solid performers as three Cardinals picked up all-conference honors. Guard Kenny Dawkins was named to the second team and forward Jay Brown was named to the third team, while guard Brandon McThay was named to the honorable mention list.

Academics remained a high priority for Roccaforte as six more student-athletes earned their degrees between May and August, including current players Ashton Hall, Justin Nabors and Lawrence Nwevo. With that trio on the floor in 2009-10, they will make Lamar the only team in Division I basketball with three players who have earned their undergraduate degrees with eligibility remaining.

Coy Custer was honored for his work in the classroom and on the court as he was named to the five-member Academic All-Conference squad.

The 2007-08 season featured a number of impressive streaks and great players. Among them were a 14-2 home record, a school-record six-consecutive conference road victories and the eighth-largest home crowd in school history.

Senior Lamar Sanders and junior Kenny Dawkins were both named first team All-SLC, with Dawkins matching his teammate with SLC Newcomer of the Year honors.

Roccaforte guided the Cardinals to a 15-17 overall record and an 8-8 mark in SLC play last year. Lamar finished tied for third in the SLC East Division. As the No. 7-seed in the SLC Tournament, Lamar upset No. 2-seed Sam Houston State in the opening round before falling to No. 3-seed Northwestern State in the semifinals.

Among the Cardinals' 15 victories was a thrilling 86-77 overtime win over Brigham Young, who won over 20 games and was an at-large NCAA Tournament selection.

Lamar ranked 12th in the NCAA in assists at 17.3 per game, 31st in three-pointers made per game (8.3) and 52nd in three-point percentage (.379). Individually, Lamar Sanders led the SLC and ranked 12th in the NCAA in rebounding at 9.8 rpg. The Cardinals set a new single-season school record for three-point attempts (702) and posted the second-best mark in three-pointers made (266).

Roccaforte's first recruiting class as the head coach paid immediate dividends as forward Lamar Sanders was named SLC newcomer of the year and earned second-team all-SLC honors. Center James Davis was a third-team all-SLC performer and guard Darren Hopkins was an honorable mention selection.

University president Dr. James Simmons and athletics director Billy Tubbs could not have found another person on the planet with as much enthusiasm, passion and desire to be the men's basketball

coach at Lamar University than Steve Roccaforte, who was hired March 21, 2006.

He guided the Cardinals to 34 overall victories in two years and a share of the Southland Conference regular season title in 2007-08, which included the East Division title. Lamar ranked eighth in the nation in scoring offense (81.5 ppg.) last season and in the top 50 in both field goal percentage (46.9) and 3-point field goal percentage (38.2).

His rosters featured multiple all-conference performers, including back-to-back league newcomer of the year honorees. Lamar advanced to the league tournament semifinals in 2006-07, upsetting the event's No. 2 seed.

With nearly 20 years of experience at the NCAA Division I level, Roccaforte has worked with some of the top coaches in the business and has recruited some of the top talent in the country. He has served under Billy Tubbs, John Calipari and Perry Clark and helped develop multiple nationally ranked recruiting classes.

Roccaforte was listed as one of the top four assistant coaches ready to take over their own program according to Dan Wetzel of *CBS Sportsline.com* and was voted the seventh-best assistant coach in the country by *Basketball Times* for the 2002-03 season. According to recruiting analyst Dave Telep, Roccaforte is one of the 25 hardest-working coaches in the nation as well as one of the top 15 recruiters in the country. Clark Francis of *HoopScoop.com* listed Roccaforte as the top mid-major assistant coach in the country in 2005.

Roccaforte is also no stranger to postseason play, having served on the staff of seven teams that extended their seasons. He has been to a pair of NCAA Tournaments, one each with Tulane and Memphis, and five NITs with Tulane, Wyoming and Memphis. Tulane advanced to the NIT Final Four at Madison Square Garden in 1996. Memphis made a pair of trips to MSG, including a championship run in 2002.

During his career, Roccaforte has coached or recruited such future NBA players as Larry Robinson-Centenary, Jerald Honeycutt-Tulane, Chris Owens-Tulane, Linton Johnson-Tulane, Josh Davis-Wyoming, Dejuan Wagner-Memphis, Antonio Burks-Memphis, Earl Barron-Memphis, Sean Banks-Memphis, Qyntel Woods-Memphis, Amare Stoudemire-Memphis, Kendrick Perkins-Memphis and Rodney Carney-Memphis.

Known as a relentless recruiter, Roccaforte put together top 25 recruiting classes at Tulane, Memphis and Lamar. In fact, Memphis had the nation's top-rated recruiting class in 2001 Lamar's class in 2004, the first full recruiting class with Roccaforte on staff, was rated among the top 10 in the country by *HoopScoop.com*.

Prior to being named to the top spot at Lamar, Roccaforte served for three seasons with the Cardinals as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator under Billy Tubbs. Lamar posted winning campaigns in two of those years and the team's recruiting classes included a pair of junior college All-America selections.

Roccaforte spent three years as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis before returning to Lamar. He helped the Tigers advance to the NIT final four in 2001, won the NIT championship in 2002 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2003 for the first time in seven years. Included during that run was a pair of Conference USA National Division titles in 2001-02 and 2002-03. The Tigers had top-10 recruiting classes in all three years of his tenure, including the No. 1 rated class in 2001, and he

recruited two McDonald's All-Americans.

Prior to Memphis, Roccaforte spent two seasons as an assistant coach on the Wyoming staff (1998-2000). The Cowboys were 37-22 during his tenure which included a trip to the NIT, where they advanced to the second round. He helped put together the top-rated recruiting class in the Mountain West Conference in his first season.

Before heading to Wyoming, Roccaforte worked at Tulane where he coordinated the Green Wave's recruiting activities. During his four years at Tulane, the Green Wave consistently ranked among the top-25 recruiting classes in the nation and included an All-American and seven All-Conference USA selections. The final recruiting class that he helped sign was ranked eighth nationally.

Roccaforte was part of a Tulane staff which coached the Green Wave to three consecutive 20-win seasons during his tenure (1994-98). The Green Wave advanced to the NCAA Tournament second round in 1995, the NIT Final Four in 1996 and a second NIT appearance in 1997. The program also captured Conference USA Red Division titles in 1995-96 and 1996-97.

Prior to coaching stints at Tulane and Wyoming, Roccaforte was an assistant coach at Centenary College for five seasons (1989-94). Centenary won its first TAAC regular-season championship during his tenure.

Roccaforte began his coaching career as a student assistant coach for three seasons at Lamar. He earned his bachelor of applied arts and sciences degree from the University in 1989.

Roccaforte, 44, and his wife Tina have two daughters, Victoria Elise (14) and Sofia Rose (2) and a son, Lucien Anthony (10).
