**Tonight's Contest**

Lamar and Southeastern Louisiana will be meeting for the second time this season with the Cardinals going for the season sweep after winning 83-59 in Hammond two weeks ago. The game will be broadcast live in Beaumont on KLVI 560 AM with Dave Hofferth providing the play-by-play, and will be streamed live on www.lamarcardinals.com/allaccess.

**Series History**

This will be the 39th meeting between the two schools with Lamar holding a 22-16 series advantage. The Cardinals have now won two straight in the series.

Lamar holds a 13-6 series advantage in Beaumont, but the Lions did win 89-87 in the Montagne Center last year. Lamar head coach Pat Knight is 2-0 against the Lions, while SLU's Jim Yarbrough is 6-5 against the Cardinals.

**Scouting Southeastern Louisiana**

Southeastern Louisiana comes into tonight's contest with a 9-14 overall record and 3-8 Southland Conference mark. The Lions snapped a four-game losing streak Saturday with a 66-61 home win over Northwestern State.

The Lions are 11th in the conference in scoring average at 59.3 points per game, but they do hold their opponents to 62.4 points per game to rank third in the league. As a team, SLU is averaging 35.7 rebounds per game and grabbing just over a half rebound per game more than its opponents.

The Lions have struggled to shoot the ball this season, hitting just 40.5 percent of their shots from the field, 30.5 percent from 3-point range and 57.8 percent from the free throw line. SLU did shoot 54.5 percent in the second half against Lamar two weeks ago.

With senior guard Brandon Fortenberry likely done for the season with an injury, junior forward Roosevelt Johnson is the team's leading scorer at 9.8 points per game. He is also hauling down 7.0 rebounds per game to pace the Lions. Mississippi State transfer Elgin Bailey is putting up averages of 8.8 points and 6.4 rebounds per game.

In the backcourt, LSU transfer Daron Populist is scoring 7.9 points per game and leads the team with 37 3-point baskets. Senior DeShawn Patterson is scoring nearly six points a game, and leads the squad with 3.6 assists and 2.0 steals per game.

## Last Time They Met

Lamar and Southeastern Louisiana met just two weeks ago in the University Center with the Cardinals coming away with an 83-59 road victory. Lamar shot 56.7 percent from the floor in the second half to finish the game at 50.8 percent.

Lamar built a 44-24 lead at the half and the lead never dropped below 20 in the second half as the Cardinals picked up their most lopsided win ever in Hammond.

Lamar used a 12-2 run early in the first half to turn a 7-7 game into a 19-9 lead. SLU responded with a 7-2 run of its own to pull within five points at 21-16 with 8:29 to play in the first half, but the Lions would get no closer.

Brandon Davis, who led all players with 21 points, hit a pair of free throws and a 3-pointer over a 21 second span to push Lamar's lead back to 10 at 26-16. The Cards then closed the half on an 18-8 run with a 3-pointer at the buzzer by SLU's Todd Nelson keeping it from being even worse.

Senior guard Anthony Miles, who finished with 19 points, put in a layup that gave Lamar a 27-point lead at 60-33 with 15:35 to play in the game. The Cardinals hit seven of their first 10 shots in the second half as they opened on a 16-9 run.

Devon Lamb added a double-double for the Cardinals with 11 points and a game-high 10 rebounds. He also led Lamar with four assists and two steals.

Jeremy Campbell led the Lions, who shot 45.7 percent from the floor but just 12-of-19 from the free throw line, with 14 points and four rebounds. Elgin Bailey and Daron Populist each scored 10.

## Lamar Last Time Out

Lamar is coming off a disappointing 72-63 loss at Nicholls on Saturday in which the Cardinals started the game just 1-of-19 from the floor and finished with a dismal 30.6 percent shooting effort.

Lamar trailed by as many as 18 points in the first half, and were still down 35-25 at the break despite closing with a 7-0 run. Devon Lamb scored three straight points to open the second half and draw the Cards to within seven at 35-28.

Lamar continued to chip away and Stan Brown's hook shot in the paint made it a 46-43 game with 8:58 to play. However, the Colonels responded with an 11-1 run over the ensuing 3:27 to build their lead back to 13. The Cardinals would get no closer than seven points the rest of the way.

Lamar improved its shooting in the second half to 36.1 percent, but the Cards had no answer for the Colonels offense. NSU shot 61.9 percent from the floor in the first half and an even 50.0 percent in the second half.

Lamar outrebounded the Colonels 40-30, including grabbing 21 offensive rebounds and converting them into 15 second chance points. NSU finished with a 42-16 advantage in points in the paint and a 10-0 edge in fast break points.

Senior guard Anthony Miles hit a jumper just 2:47 into the game that gave Lamar a 4-3 lead, its only advantage of the game. The Cardinals would not make another field goal until Miles hit a 3-pointer with 7:09 to play in the first half. That bucket came with Lamar trailing 24-6.

Four Cardinal starters scored at least 12 points, but Lamar got just four points off the bench. Miles finished with 15 points, while Lamb added 13 points and a game-high 10 rebounds.

Leading scorer Mike James added 14 point, but he was just 4-of-13 from the field. He did hit all five of his free throw attempts as Lamar was a solid 21-of-27 (77.8 percent) from the free throw line. Stan Brown chipped in with 12 points and seven rebounds.

The Colonels got the bulk of their scoring from two players as Dantrell Thomas and Trevon Lewis combined for 38 points. Thomas led all players with 21, finishing 6-of-12 from the floor and 7-of-7 from the free throw line. Lewis, who did not score in Lamar's 80-56 home win over Nicholls just two weeks ago, hit all seven of his field goal attempts en route to 17 points off the bench.

## Cardinals Closing in on Katy

With one more victory, Lamar would move to eight conference wins and all but assure itself a spot in the Southland Conference Tournament. The Cardinals have not made it to the conference's postseason tournament, which will once again be held at the Merrell Center in Katy, Texas, since the 2007-08 season.

Making the tournament will be a new experience for the entire team as not one player currently on the roster has ever played in the event.

The top eight teams in the Southland Conference's two divisions qualify for the postseason tournament. Lamar currently sits tied for fourth with UTSA with the Cardinals holding the tiebreaker over the Roadrunners by virtue of their 80-66 win in their only meeting of the regular season.

## Cards Draw George Mason in Sears BracketBusters

The tenth annual Sears BracketBusters weekend is scheduled for Feb. 17-19, and Lamar will take on George Mason in the Cardinals' first ever action in the event.

Lamar and GMU will meet Saturday, Feb. 18, at 3 p.m. from the Patriot Center with the game being broadcast on ESPN3. A record total of 142 teams, representing 16 collegiate athletic conference, are competing.

Lamar and George Mason have met once before with the Patriots winning 65-63 in the first round of the National Invitation Tournament on March 13,

1986, from the Montagne Center. This will be the fourth game between Lamar and current members of the CAA, with the Cards owning victories over both Drexel and Hofstra.

## Where's the Bench?

Lamar has four starters averaging over 10 points per game, but bench production has been a problem since starting Southland Conference play. The Cards outscored Texas A&M-Corpus Christi 15-12 off the bench in the conference opener on Jan. 4. Since that game, Lamar's bench has been outscored in 10 straight contests.

Included in that run was Saturday's 26-4 deficit at Nicholls and a 17-4 disadvantage against UTSA. Lamar has been outscored 228-146 over its 11 conference games.

Prior to opening conference, LU had a bench scoring advantage in eight of 14 games. The Cards outscored their first 14 opponents 379-306 off the bench. Much of that advantage came against Lyon College, though, as four Cardinals scored in double-figures off the bench en route to a 52-4 finish.

## Cardinals Among the Best in Steals

Lamar ranks fourth in the Southland Conference in steals per game at 8.6. The Cardinals picked up a season-high 19-steals against Central Arkansas on Jan. 7 and now rank 25th in the country. East Tennessee State leads the country in steals at 10.5 per game, while Northwestern State is tops in the Southland at 9.1 (10th in the country). The Demons managed just three steals against Lamar in their meeting on Jan. 8, while the Cardinals picked up nine in the game.

Senior guard Devon Lamb is averaging a team-best 1.9 steals per game to rank third in the conference and 57th in the country. Fellow senior Mike James is fourth in the SLC at 1.8 per contest. Anthony Miles had a season-high five steals against Northwestern State to move to sixth in the Southland at 1.7 per game.

Lamar finished second to Northwestern State last season at 8.2 per game with Lamb leading the way at 1.6 per game.

## Cardinal Quick Hits

- Leading scorer Mike James leads Lamar with nine games of 20 points or more this season. Anthony Miles is second on the team with five 20-point games.
- After opening the year with a 10-0 record when outrebounding its opponents, Lamar has now lost three times when finishing with more rebounds. The most recent was in Saturday's 72-63 loss at Nicholls when the Cards had a 40-30 rebound edge.
- Lamar is second in the Southland in blocked shots at 4.2 per game, good enough for 81st in the country.
- Redshirt sophomore Osas Ebomwonyi is doing most of the damage in blocks, averaging 1.8 per game to stand 60th in the nation.
- Fourteen of the Cardinals' 16 victories are by 10 points or more.

## Lamar Guards Headed in Opposite Directions

Lamar guards Mike James and Anthony Miles have been going in different directions when it comes to their 3-point shooting. James has 24 makes on the year and is shooting 29.6 percent, while Miles has 22 makes and is hitting 39.0 percent.

However, James started his season 3-of-28 (10.7 percent) through the first seven games, but has since made 21-of-53 (39.6 percent) over the last 15 contests. Miles, on the other hand, opened 13-of-23 (56.5 percent) through 10 games before making just 10-of-36 (27.8 percent) over the last 15 outings.

Saturday at Nicholls, though, the two went back to their early season form. Miles was a solid 2-of-4 from beyond the arc, while James hit just 1-of-6.

## Don't Call it a Comeback

Lamar has 16 wins on the season, but only one has come when the Cardinals trailed at the half. The lone game that Lamar was able to come back in and win was the season opener against Arkansas State when LU trailed 37-36 at the half.

While Lamar lost the other eight games when it trailed at the half, the Cardinals have to get credit for holding onto leads. Lamar is a perfect 14-0 when leading after 20 minutes. In seven of those 14 wins, Lamar's halftime lead was single digits.

## Knocking Down the Free Ones

Lamar has been among the best free throw shooting teams in the country, and that proved to be key in its 87-81 win at Rice on Dec. 17. The Cardinals knocked down 37-of-44 free throws (84.1 percent), including hitting 31-of-38 in the second half.

The 37 made free throws is the most Lamar has made in a game since hitting 42 in a 112-105 loss to Sam Houston State on Jan. 28, 2009.

As a team, Lamar shot 68.7 percent from the free throw line last season to rank seventh in the Southland Conference. Through 25 games this year, Lamar is hitting 72.7 percent to rank second in the Southland and 58th in the country.

Lamar has three players ranked among the top 10 in the conference in shooting percentage in seniors Mike James, Anthony Miles and Charlie Harper.

Miles, who ranks fifth in the SLC at 79.5 percent, had a huge night against the Owls. Miles knocked down 15 of his 18 free throw attempts to tie for the fifth-best single game mark in school history.

James is coming off a 5-of-5 effort at Nicholls on Saturday to move to the top of the conference at 81.8 percent, good enough for 96th in the country. Harper, who was 5-of-5 at Rice, is eighth in the conference at 77.5 percent.

## Three go for 20

Three Cardinals scored at least 20 points in Lamar's 103-67 win over Central Arkansas on Jan. 7, marking the 25th time in school history that has been accomplished. Brandon Davis led the trio with a career-high 27 points, while Mike James scored 21 and Anthony Miles added 20.

Ironically, the last time it happened also came against Central Arkansas just

last season and Miles and Davis were also involved. Both players scored 20 points in LU's 107-72 win on Jan. 22, 2011 with Kendrick Harris adding 24 points.

## Pounding the Glass

Lamar knocked off Texas-Pan American 60-49 On Dec. 5, and one key to the victory was rebounding. Lamar finished the game with a 55-28 advantage in rebounds, setting a new Montagne Center record for rebound margin at 27 (previous high: 25 vs. Huston-Tillotson, 12/11/10).

In addition to nearly doubling up the Broncs on the glass, Lamar hauled in 20 offensive rebounds. The Cardinals enjoyed a healthy 15-2 advantage in second chance points.

For the season, Lamar is averaging 40.5 rebounds per game and limiting its opponents to 34.4. The plus-6.1 rebound margin per game ranks second in the Southland Conference and 25th in the country. The Cardinals' 40.5 per game average is tied for fourth nationally. North Carolina leads the country at 46.3 rebounds per game.

Senior Devon Lamb leads the Cards in rebounding at 8.2 rebounds per game, good enough for second in the Southland and 74th in the country.

## Win No. 900 Comes at Rice

Lamar picked up the 900th win in school history Saturday at Rice by an 87-81 score. The Cardinals have been playing as a four-year school since the 1951-52 season.

Win No. 1 was a 52-50 victory over Northwestern State on Dec. 3, 1951, in the third game of the season. Lamar knocked off North Texas 89-66 on Feb. 23, 1984, for the 500th win in school history. The 800th victory came on Nov. 20, 2005, when the Cardinals bested Montana State 92-82.

## Lamar Double-Doubles

Senior guard Devon Lamb leads Lamar with eight double-doubles on the year. After finishing with 13 points and 10 rebounds at Nicholls on Saturday, he has now posted double-doubles in four straight games. Lamb, who led the Cardinals with nine double-doubles last year, posted 13 points and 15 rebounds in the season opener against Arkansas State (11/11). He would add his second of the year with 15 points and 10 boards in LU's 85-65 win at Tennessee Tech (11/25), and got his third with 17 points and 11 boards at Rice (12/17). He also posted an 18-point, 10-rebound game against UT Arlington on Jan. 14. His current run of four straight double-doubles began with 11 points and 10 rebounds at Southeastern Louisiana (2/1) and continued with 16 points and 10 boards against UTSA (2/4) and 16 points and 11 rebounds against Northwestern State (2/8).

Fellow senior Charlie Harper has three double-doubles this year. Harper posted 22 points and a career-high 18 rebounds in Lamar's 72-54 win over Charlotte (11/19). He added 21 points and 10 rebounds against TCU (11/30). Harper would match his season-high with 22 points at Central Arkansas on Jan. 21, also grabbing a team-high 14 boards to complete the double-double.

Junior Stan Brown has LU's only other double-double this season when he finished with 10 points and 10 rebounds against Ohio State (12/20). It was the second double-double of his career.

## Reaching a Miles(ton)

Senior guard Anthony Miles scored six points at Louisville on Nov. 13, to become the 19th player in school history with 1,000 career points. The senior guard from Clear Brook High School in Houston opened the 2011-12 season with 15

points against Arkansas State. He scored 188 points as a freshman, 433 as a sophomore and 358 as a junior.

Miles moved into a ninth place on the all-time list following his 12-point effort against Northwestern State on Wednesday. He needs six points to move up two spots to seventh place ahead of Phil Endicott. Miles is on pace to finish his career with over 1,400 points.

Ironically, Miles' 1,000th point did not actually go through the basket. After hitting four free throws to get within two points, his only made field goal at Louisville was actually goal tended by Chane Behanan.

## Southland Players of the Week

A pair of Lamar guards have combined to earn five Southland Player of the Week honors, more than any other school this season. Mike James was named the Southland Conference POW on Jan. 9, giving him his third of the season. It was the second straight week, and third in the previous four, that James had won the award.

Lamar senior guard Anthony Miles was named the Southland Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week on Nov. 28, and then repeated the honor one week later.

## Cardinals Suffer Home Setback

Lamar's 91-82 loss to UT Arlington on Jan. 14 marked the first time this season the Cardinals lost at home. LU had been a perfect 7-0 in the Montagne Center on the season and had won eight straight home games dating back to last season.

In the seven home games prior to the loss to UTA, Lamar had averaged 81.4 points on offense and only allowed 58.9 ppg on defense. The Cards were also outrebounding their opponents by over 14 rebounds per game, while limiting their opponents to 37.4 percent shooting from the field and 36.4 percent from 3-point range.

UTA was able to get the win by turning all of those statistical categories around. The Mavericks shot 53.3 percent from the floor, made 10-of-20 from 3-point range and outrebounded the Cards 43-41.

Since the Montagne Center opened for the 1984-85 season, Lamar has never had an undefeated home record.

## Caution, Road Work Ahead

The Cardinals are looking to improve their road record under head coach Pat Knight over what it has been the past five seasons. After falling at Nicholls 72-63 on Saturday, Lamar stands at 6-8 on the road this season with the six wins surpassing its win total from the last two seasons combined.

While Lamar's 4-11 road record in 2010-11 was not great, it was an improvement over the 1-13 mark that Lamar achieved the year before (2009-10). In fact, heading into this season, Lamar was a dismal 17-53 away from the Montagne Center (not counting neutral site games) over the previous five years.

Lamar's last season with a winning road record was 2005-06 when the Cardinals were 7-6 under Billy Tubbs. Tubbs' coaching career would end on the road as Lamar fell 80-66 at Northwestern State in the semifinals of the Southland Conference Tournament.

## Cardinals vs. the AP Top 25

Through its first 13 games of the season, Lamar faced three teams ranked among the AP's top 25. Lamar fell 68-48 to then No. 9 Louisville on Nov. 13, 70-50 at No. 2 Ohio State on Dec. 21, and finally lost 86-64 at No. 3 Kentucky on Dec. 28.

Following its loss at Kentucky, the Cardinals are now 5-378 all-time against teams ranked in the AP Top 25 poll. Lamar has dropped its last 22 games against ranked opponents, with its last win coming on Jan. 26, 1985, over No. 12 Louisiana Tech (72-64).

## Pat Knight facing new teams

Lamar's first six opponents of the 2011-12 season were all against schools that new head coach Pat Knight had never coached against. Knight and the Cardinals completed the six-game opening stretch with a 4-2 record.

TCU, which defeated Lamar 77-72 on Nov. 30, was the first team that Knight had ever faced as a head coach. He is now 1-3 against the Horned Frogs.

In fact, Lamar will take on 18 teams this season that Knight has never coached against (including the BracketBuster game). The former Texas Tech head coach has only faced eight of the teams on the Cardinals' schedule before this year.

## Billy & Pat Tubbs Court

When Lamar takes the floor at home this season, it will be on Billy & Pat Tubbs Court.

At halftime of Lamar's Feb. 19, 2011, game with Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, the arena floor in the Montagne Center was officially named the "Billy & Pat Tubbs Court" in honor of the legendary LU coach and his wife. Tubbs played at Lamar from 1955-57 before leading Lamar to its first two NCAA Tournament appearances, including a spot in the 1980 Sweet 16 which included a win over No. 5 Oregon State.

In 30 years as a head coach, Tubbs compiled a 641-340 record, is just the 28th coach to record 600 career wins, is the ninth head coach to record at least 100 wins at three different schools (Lamar, Oklahoma, TCU) and earned national coach of the year honors twice and conference accolades eight times. Tubbs also guided the Sooners to six straight NCAA Sweet 16 appearances and a spot in the 1988 national championship game.

## Up Next for the Cards

The Cards will take a break from Southland Conference action Saturday when they travel to George Mason for the Sears BracketBusters game at 3 p.m. est. Lamar then hosts Stephen F. Austin one week from tonight.

## HEAD COACH PAT KNIGHT

First Season at Lamar  
5th Season as Head Coach

Looking to re-energize the Lamar University men's basketball program, former Texas Tech head coach Pat Knight was named to the same position at Lamar on April 5, 2011.

Knight came to Lamar after 10 seasons at Texas Tech, including the final three-plus years as head coach. Named head coach designate at Tech prior to the 2005-06 season, Knight took over for his Hall-of-Fame father Bob Knight toward the end of the 2007-08 season.

"It's an honor and a dream come true to be the head coach at Lamar University," Knight said. "It's an opportunity to build my own program and hopefully establish my own legacy in college basketball."

In three-plus seasons as head coach of the Red Raiders, Knight compiled a 50-61 record. His 2009-10 squad posted a 19-16 overall record and advanced to the quarterfinals of the postseason National Invitation Tournament before falling at Mississippi in double overtime.

Knight, who becomes the 10th person to coach Lamar since the university became a four-year institution in 1951, guided the Red Raiders to an 83-80 win over fifth-ranked Texas in just his eighth game as a head coach, while his first victory on the college level came against No. 18 Kansas State five games earlier. The Red Raiders were a solid 40-20 (.667) at United Spirit Arena under Knight.

Knight served for nearly

seven years as an assistant at Tech under his father which included four trips to the NCAA Tournament and a run to the Sweet 16 in 2005. Texas Tech enjoyed five 20-win seasons during Knight's tenure as an assistant.

Knight's professional career began as a scout and administrative assistant with the NBA's Phoenix Suns after his four-year playing career at Indiana. In 1997, Knight became an assistant coach with the Connecticut Pride of the Continental Basketball Association.

In 1998, Knight became a head coach for the first time, guiding the Wisconsin Blast of the International Basketball Association to a 19-15 record.

Knight began his college coaching career at his alma mater as an assistant for two seasons from 1998-2000. The Hoosiers were 43-20 during that time and played in the NCAA Tournament both years. In his second season at Indiana, senior guard A.J. Guyton earned AP First-Team All-America honors before becoming a second-round draft choice of the Chicago Bulls.

Knight then spent one season as an assistant at Akron before moving to Texas Tech.

A four-year letterwinner for the Hoosiers from 1991-95, Knight graduated in 1995 with a degree in sports management. During his playing days, Indiana appeared in the NCAA Tournament every season and advanced to the "Elite Eight" in 1993.

Knight and the former Amanda Shaw were married on May 10, 2002.
